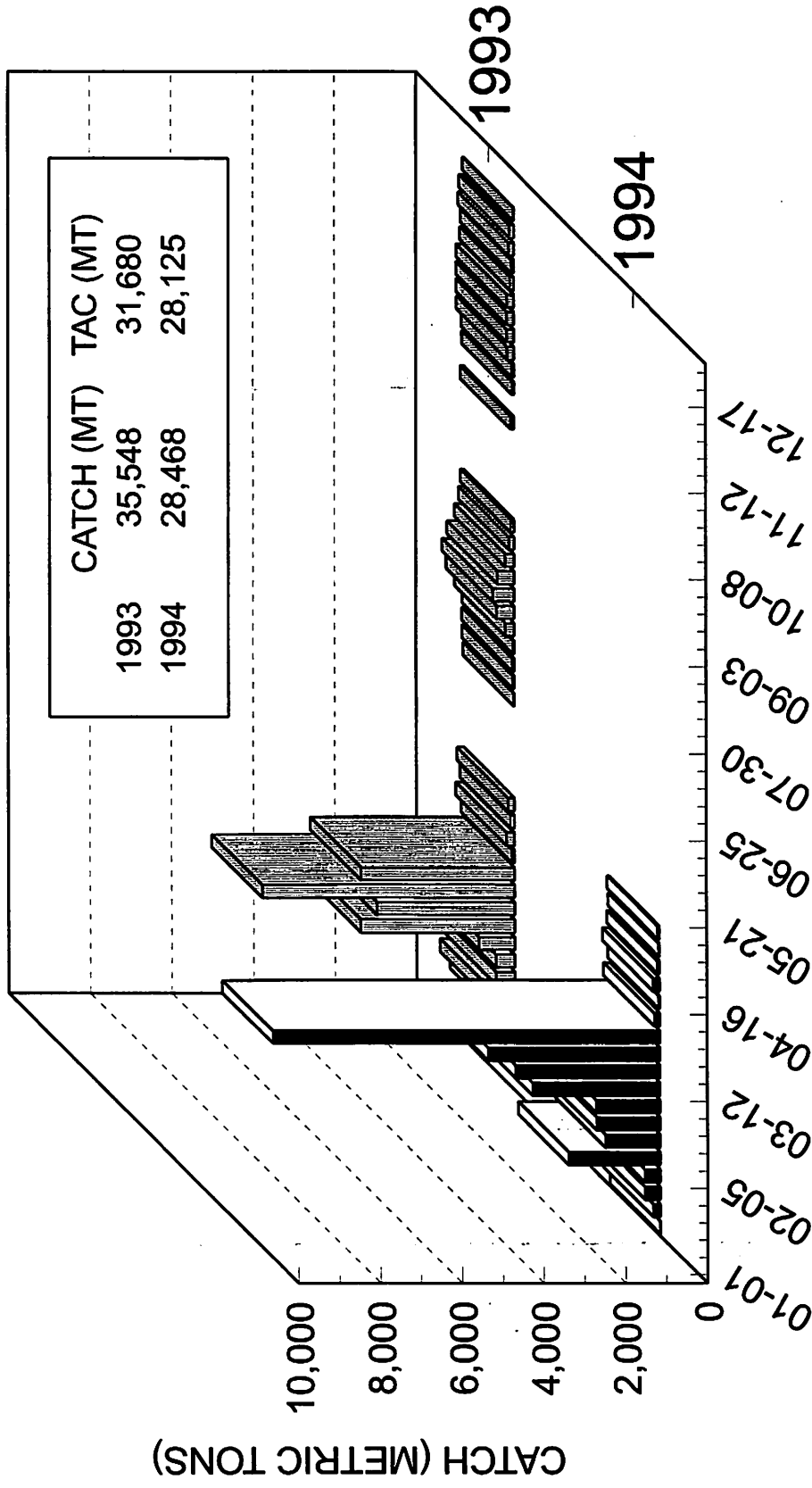

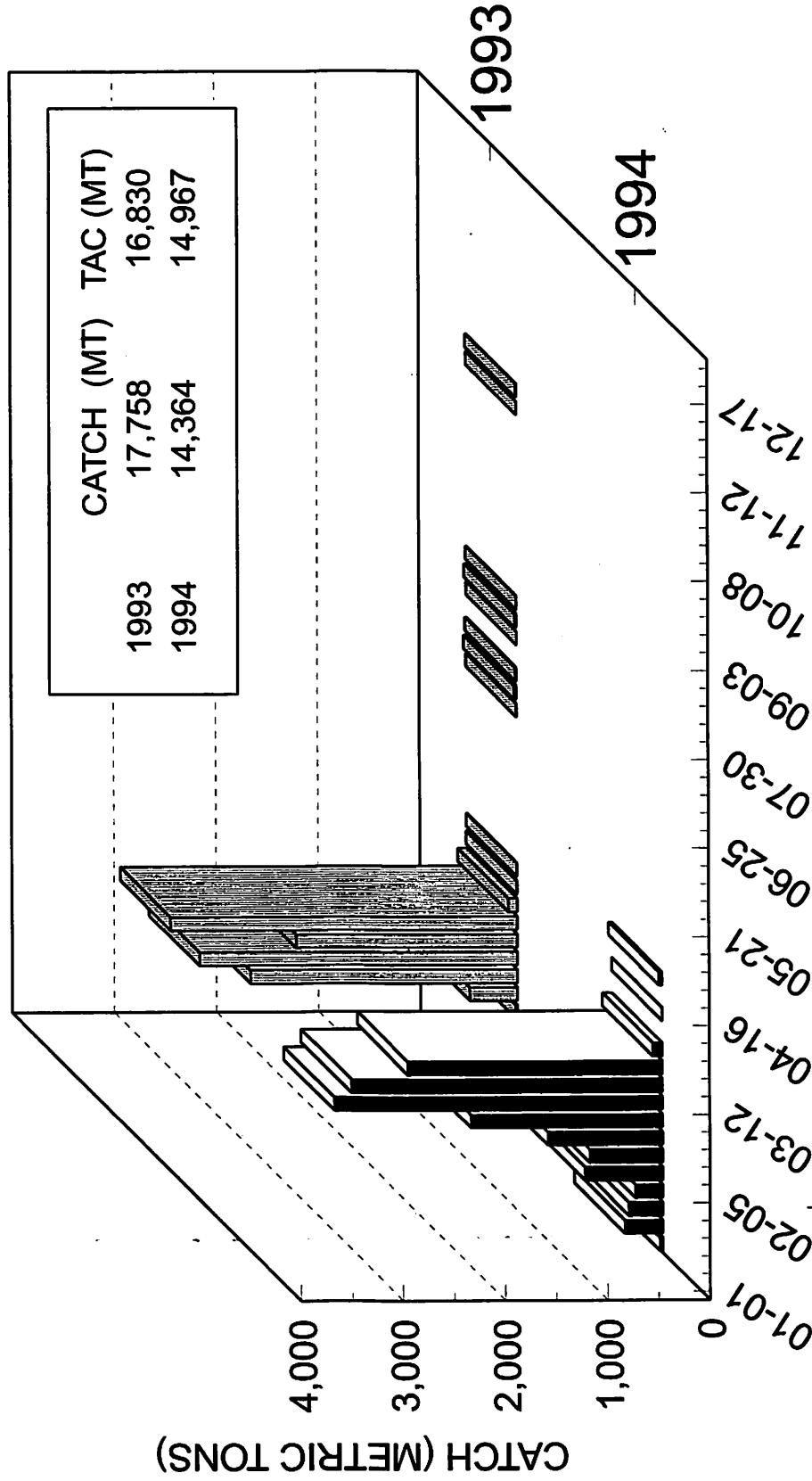

1993 & 1994 CENTRAL GOA INSHORE PCOD CATCH



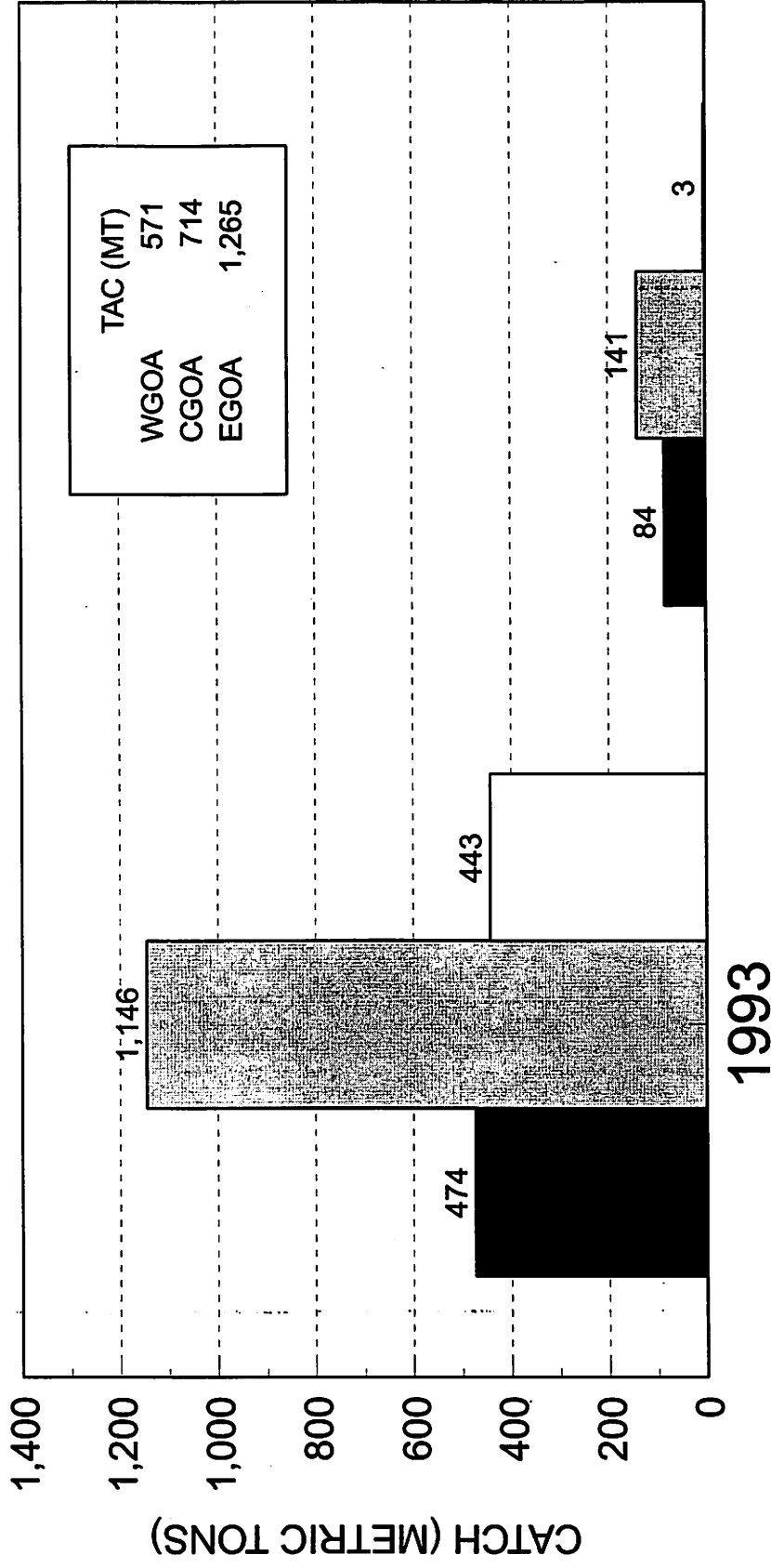

1993 & 1994 WESTERN GOA INSHORE PCOD CATCH



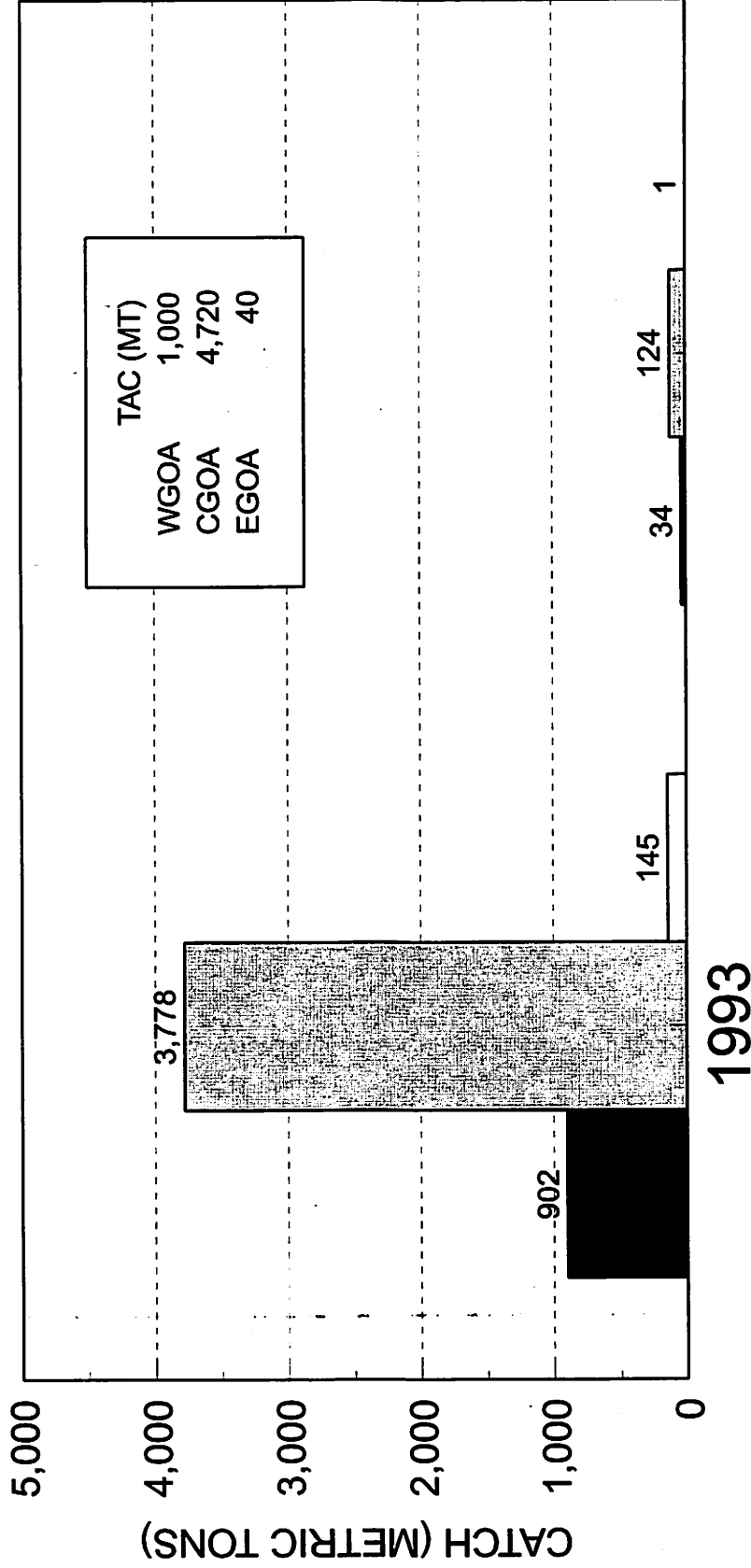

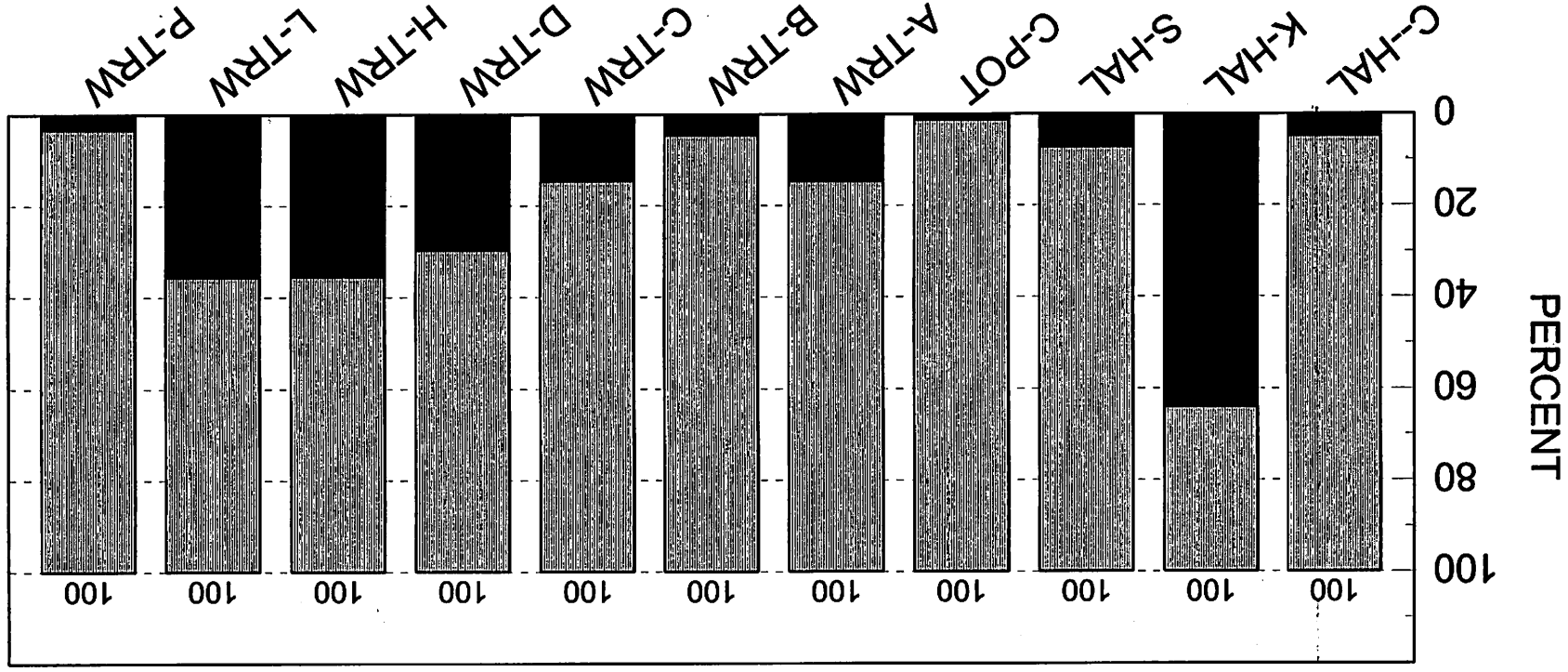
1993 & 1994 GOA NORTHERN ROCKFISH CATCH

1994 GOA PERCENT DISCARDS BY GEAR AND TARGET FISHERY

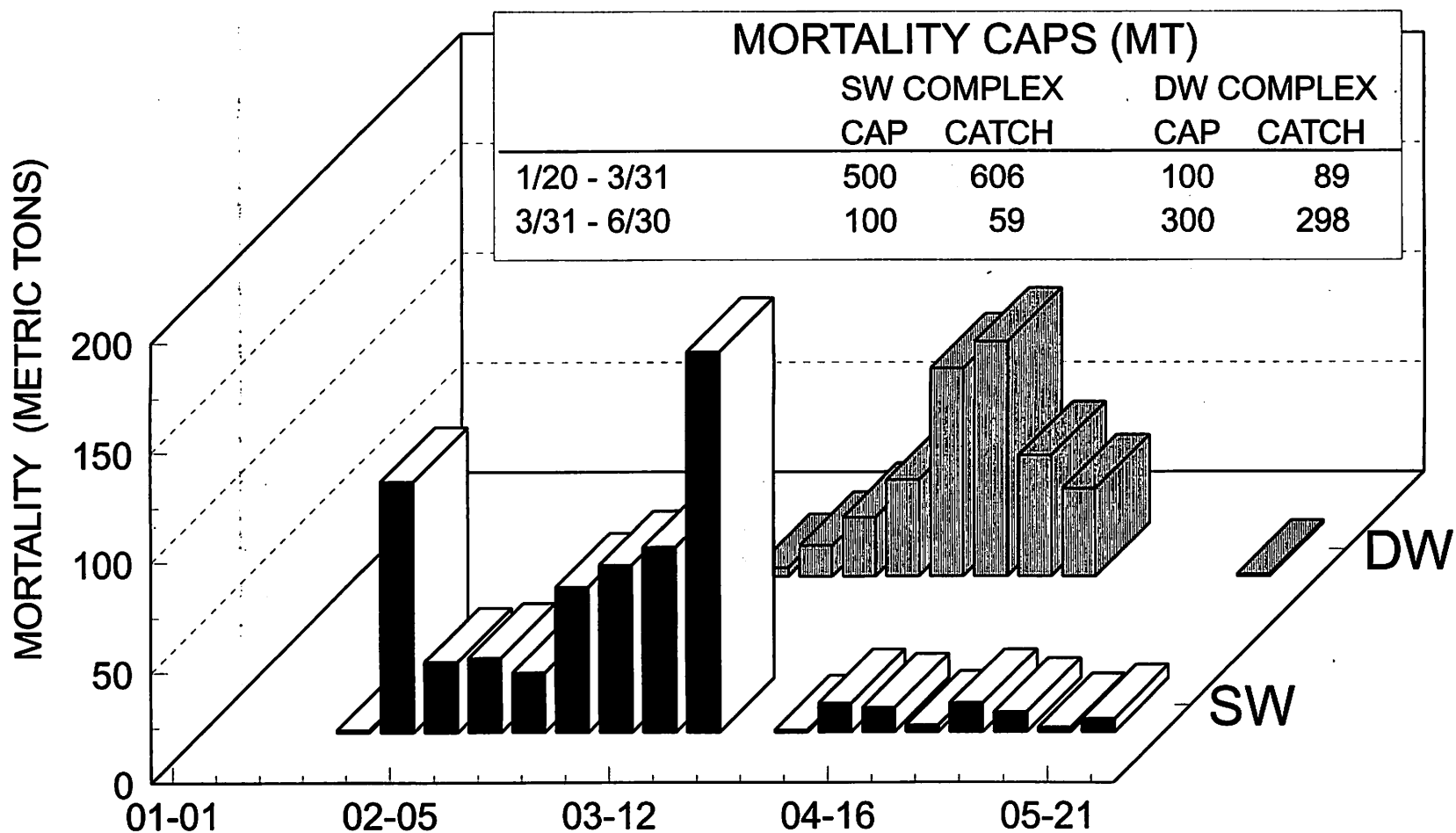

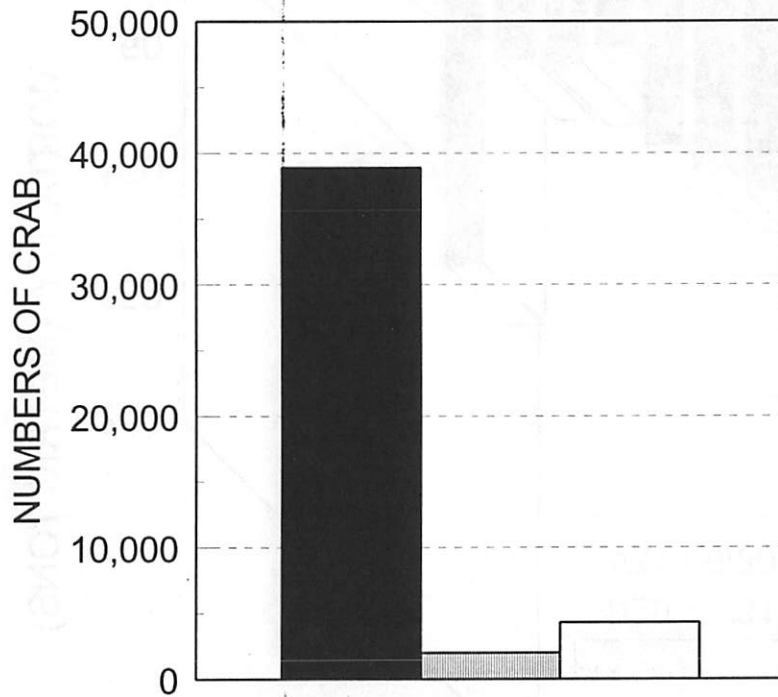

1994 GOA TRAWL HALIBUT BYCATCH MORTALITY

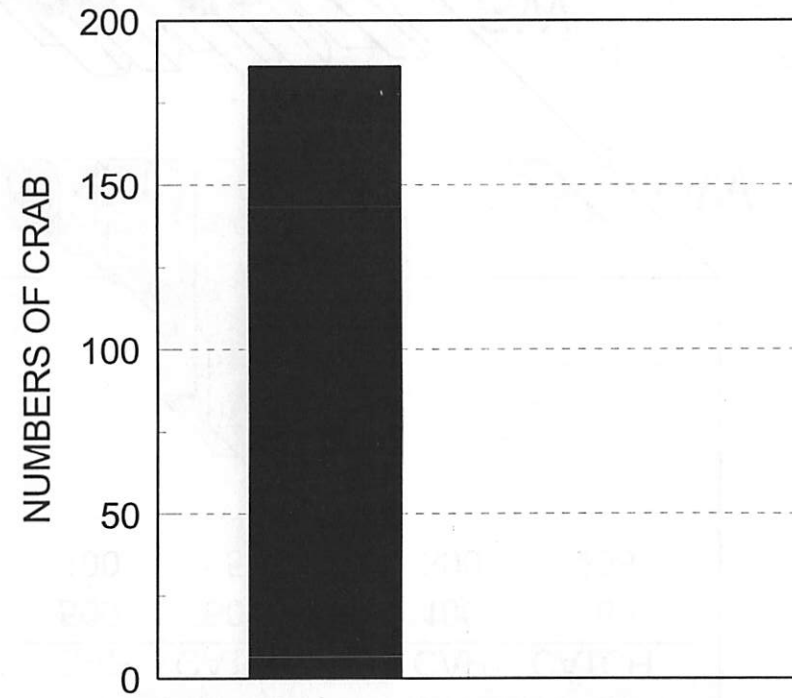

1993 & 1994 GOA TRAWL CRAB BYCATCH



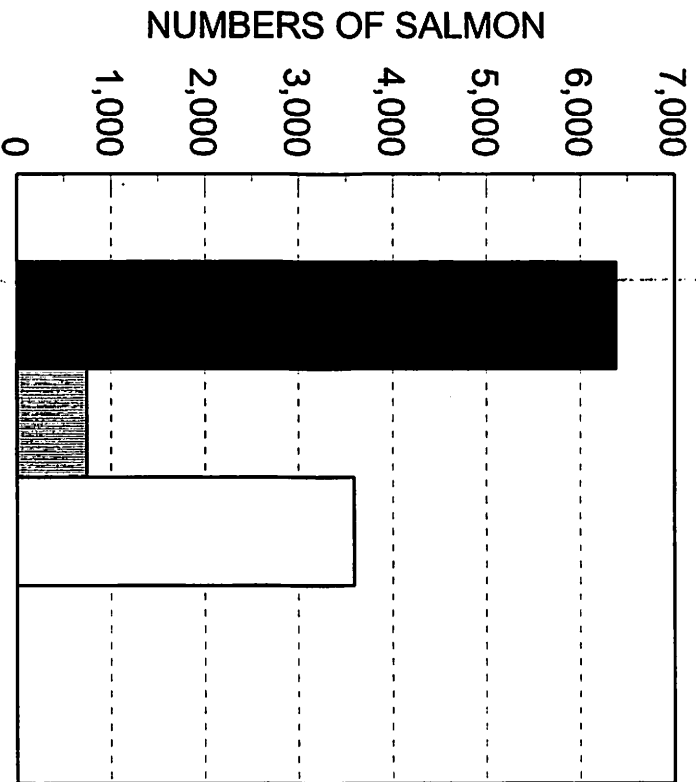

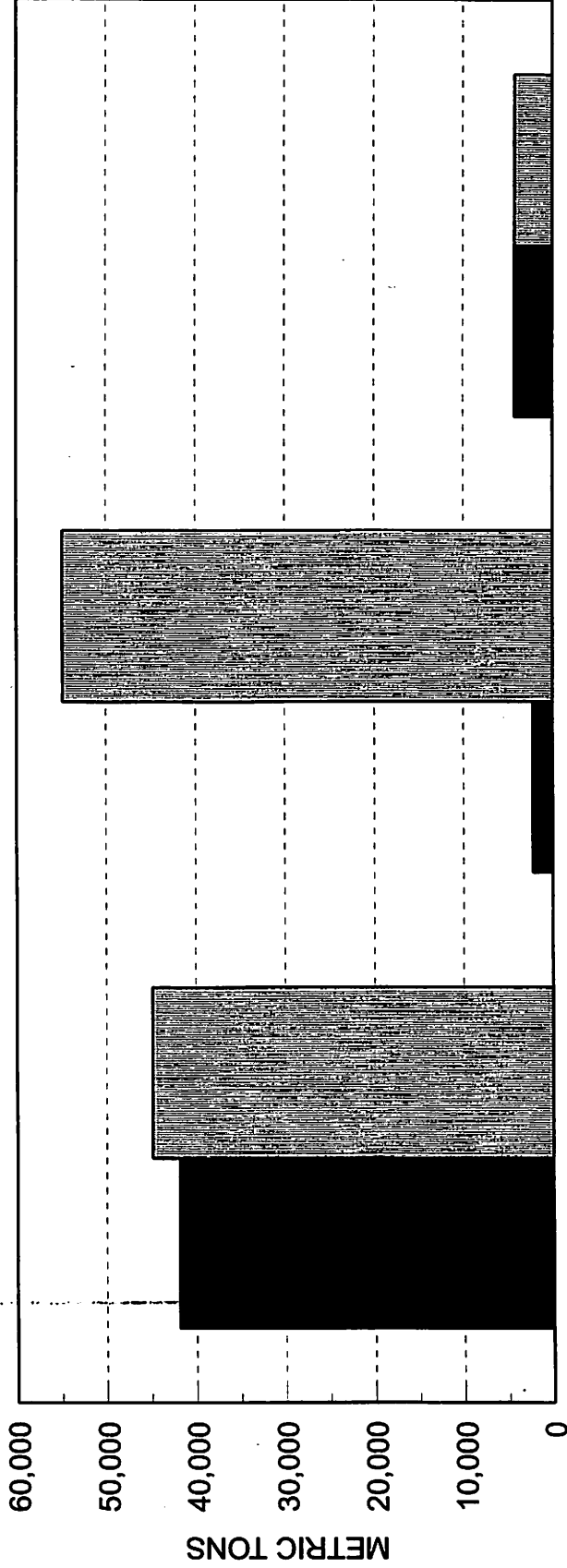

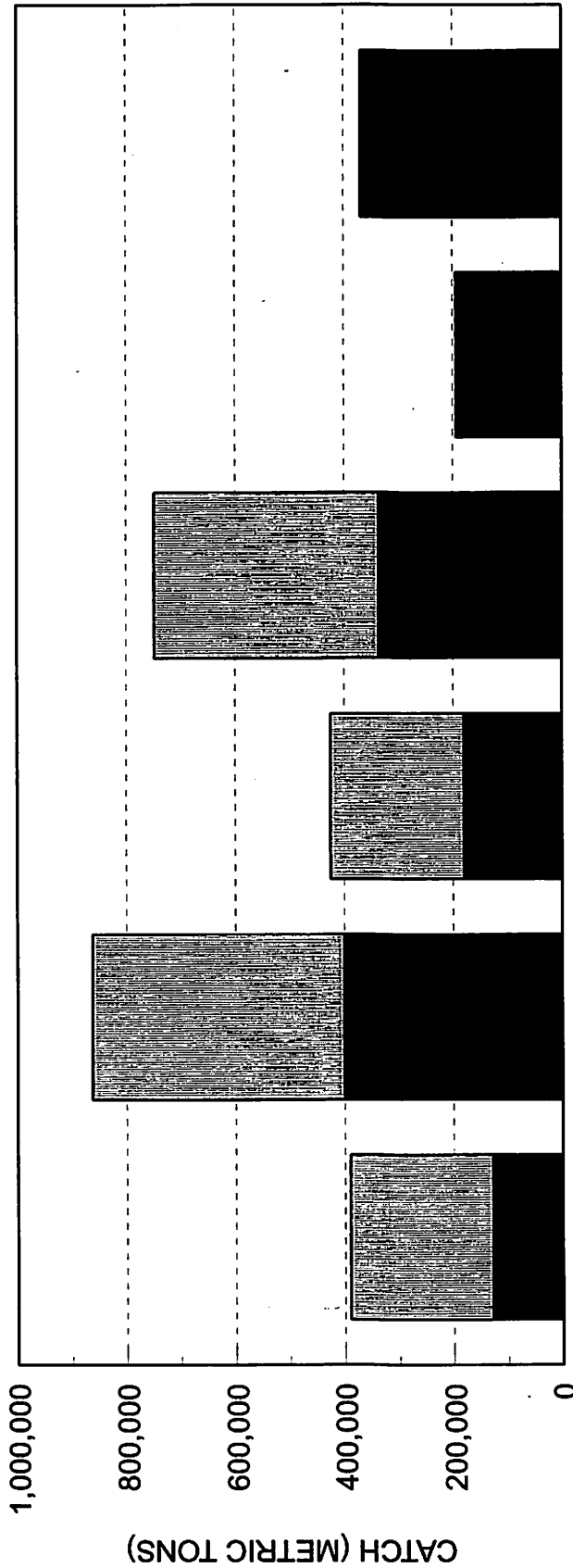

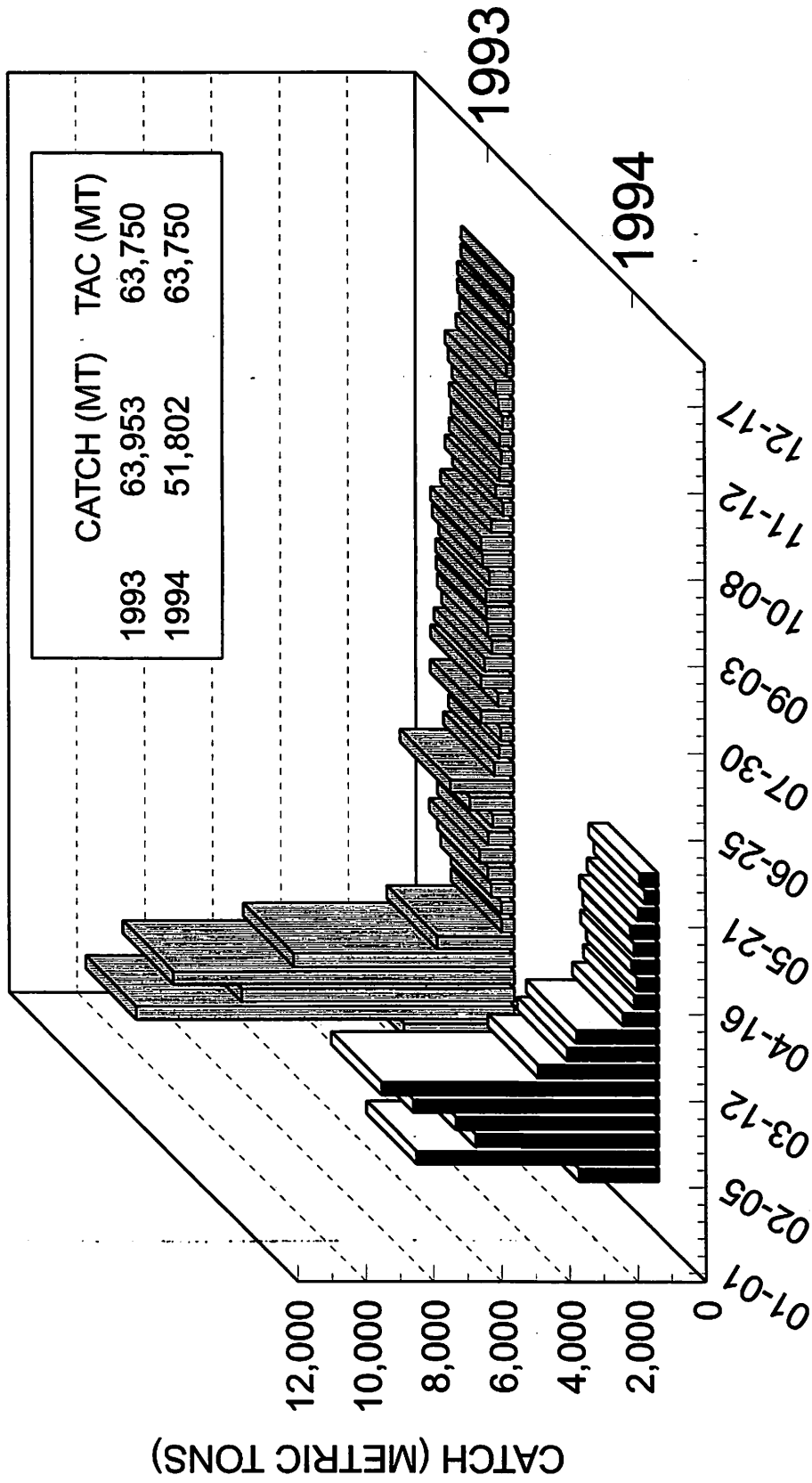
1992 - 94 INSHORE/OFFSHORE POLLOCK CATCH*, BERING SEA

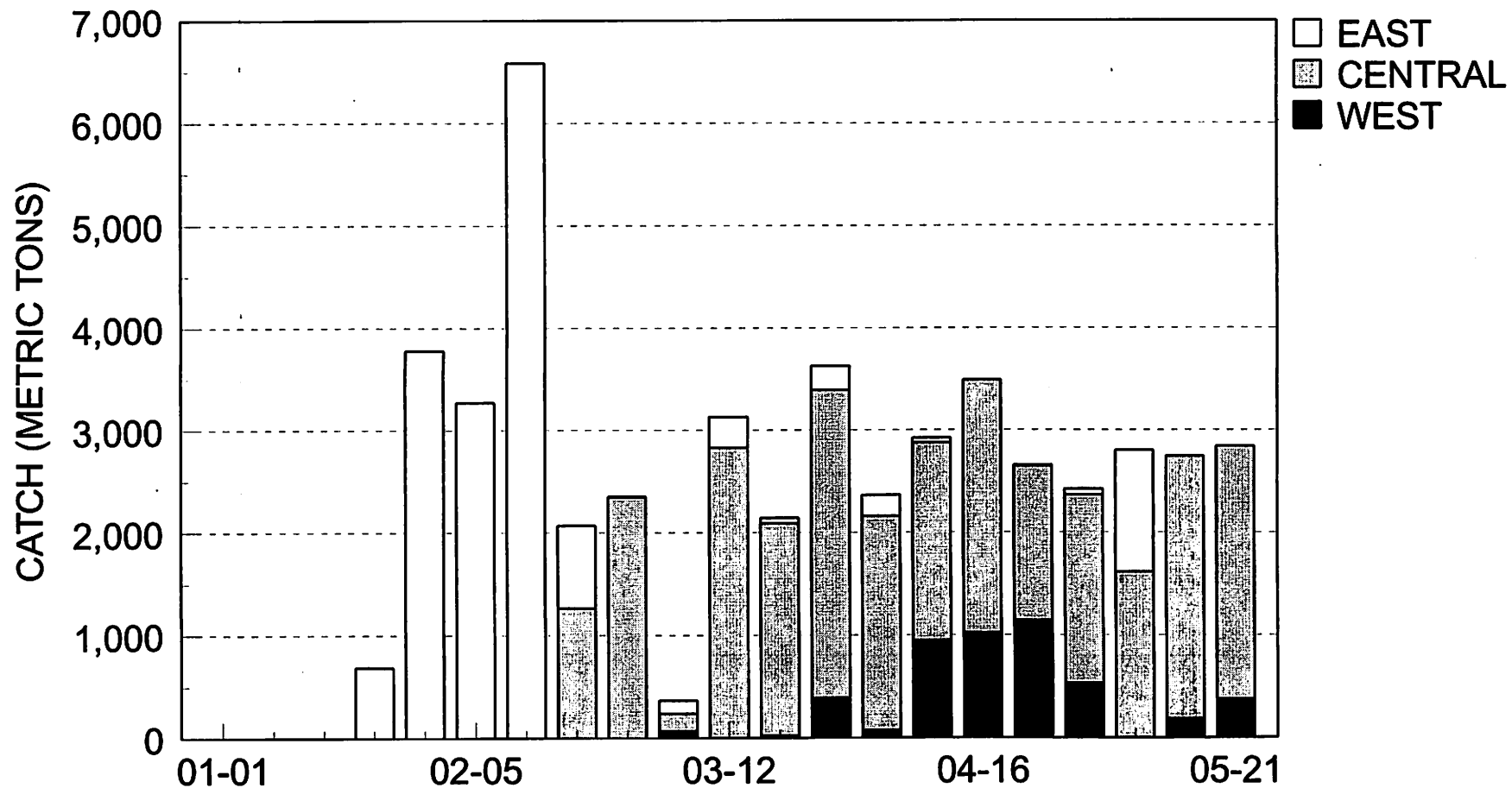

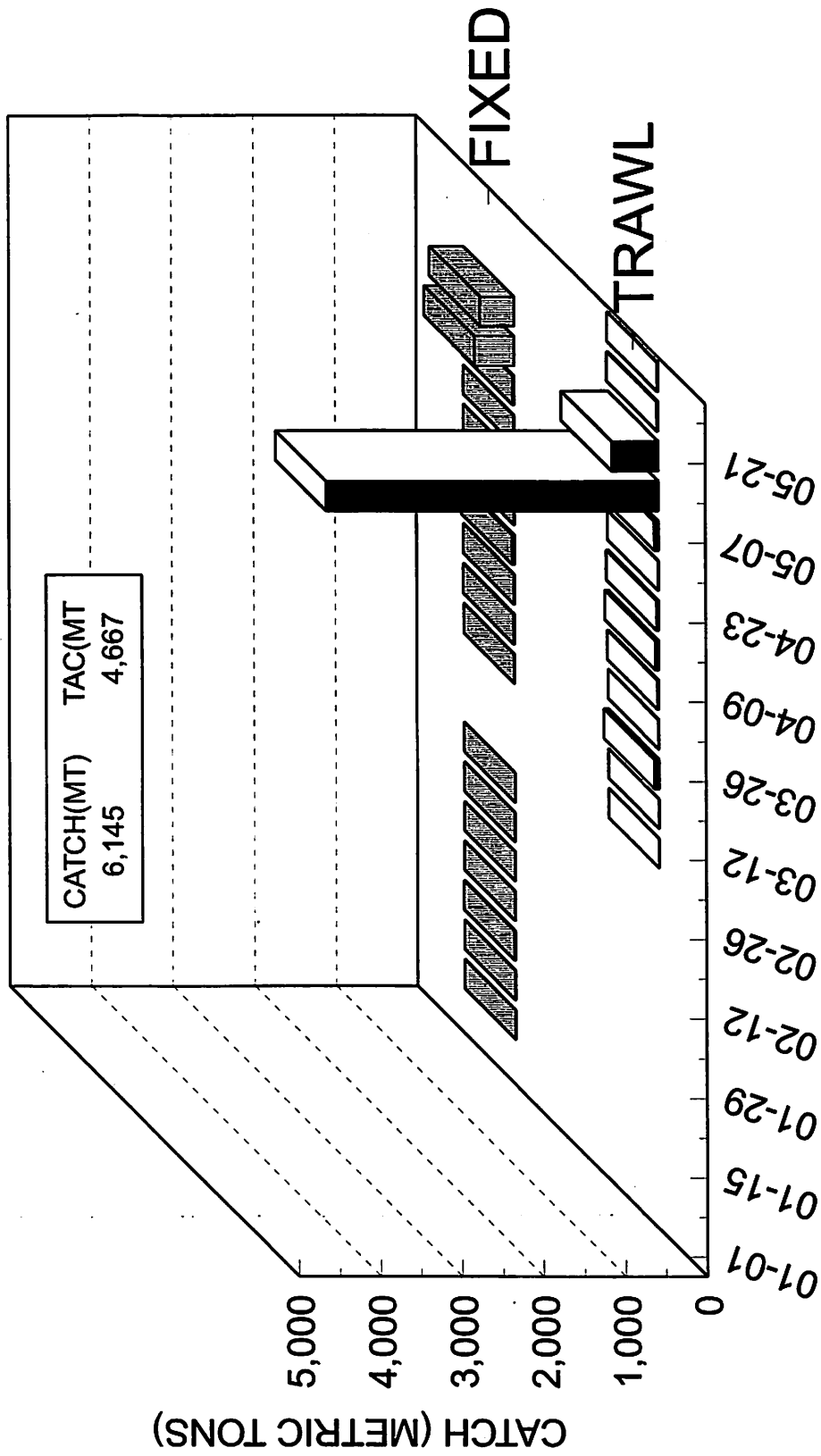

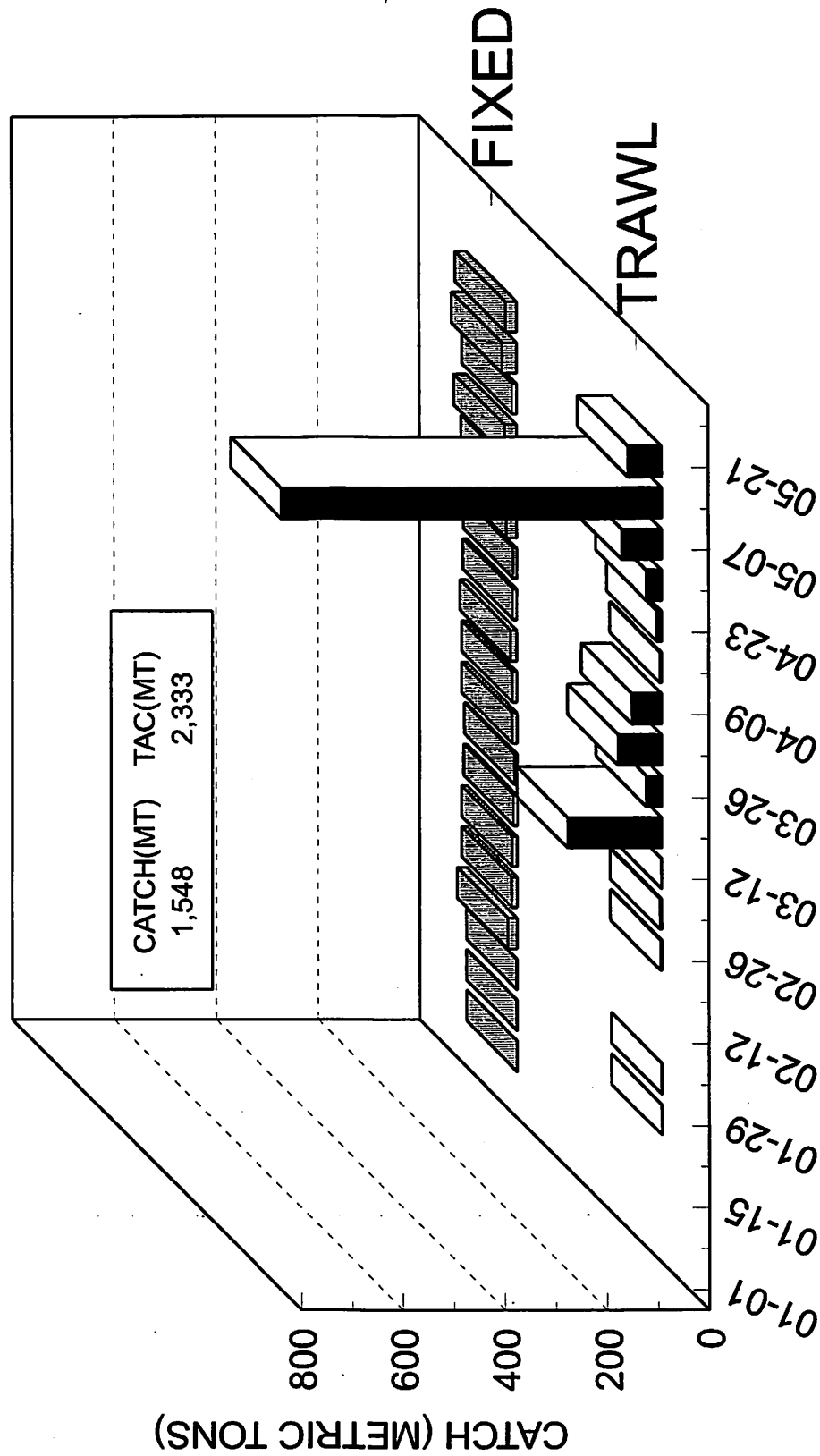

1994 BERING SEA TRAWL GREENLAND TURBOT CATCH



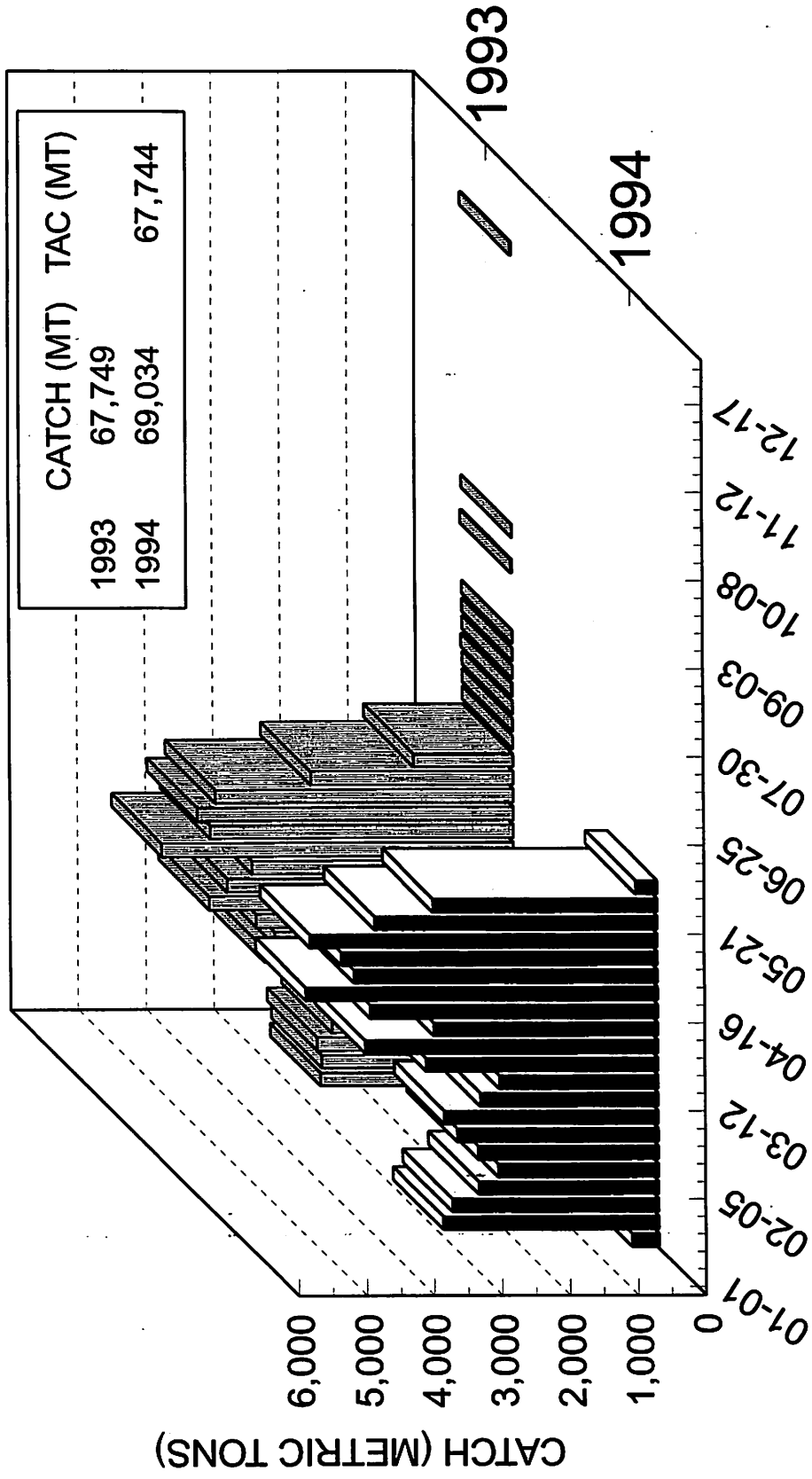

1994 ALEUTIAN ISLANDS GREENLAND TURBOT CATCH



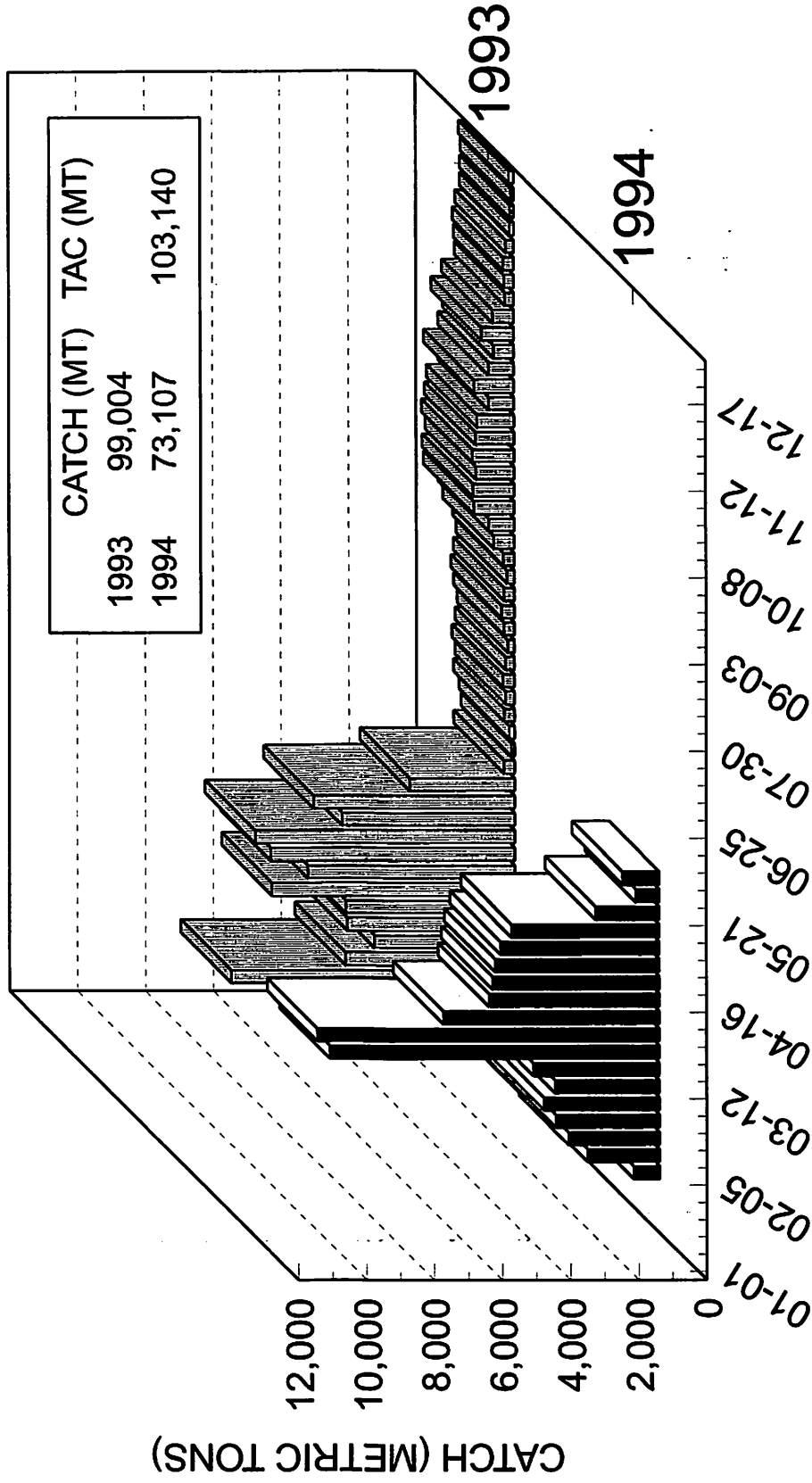

1993 & 1994 BSAI HOOK-&-LINE AND POT (FIXED) PCOD CATCH



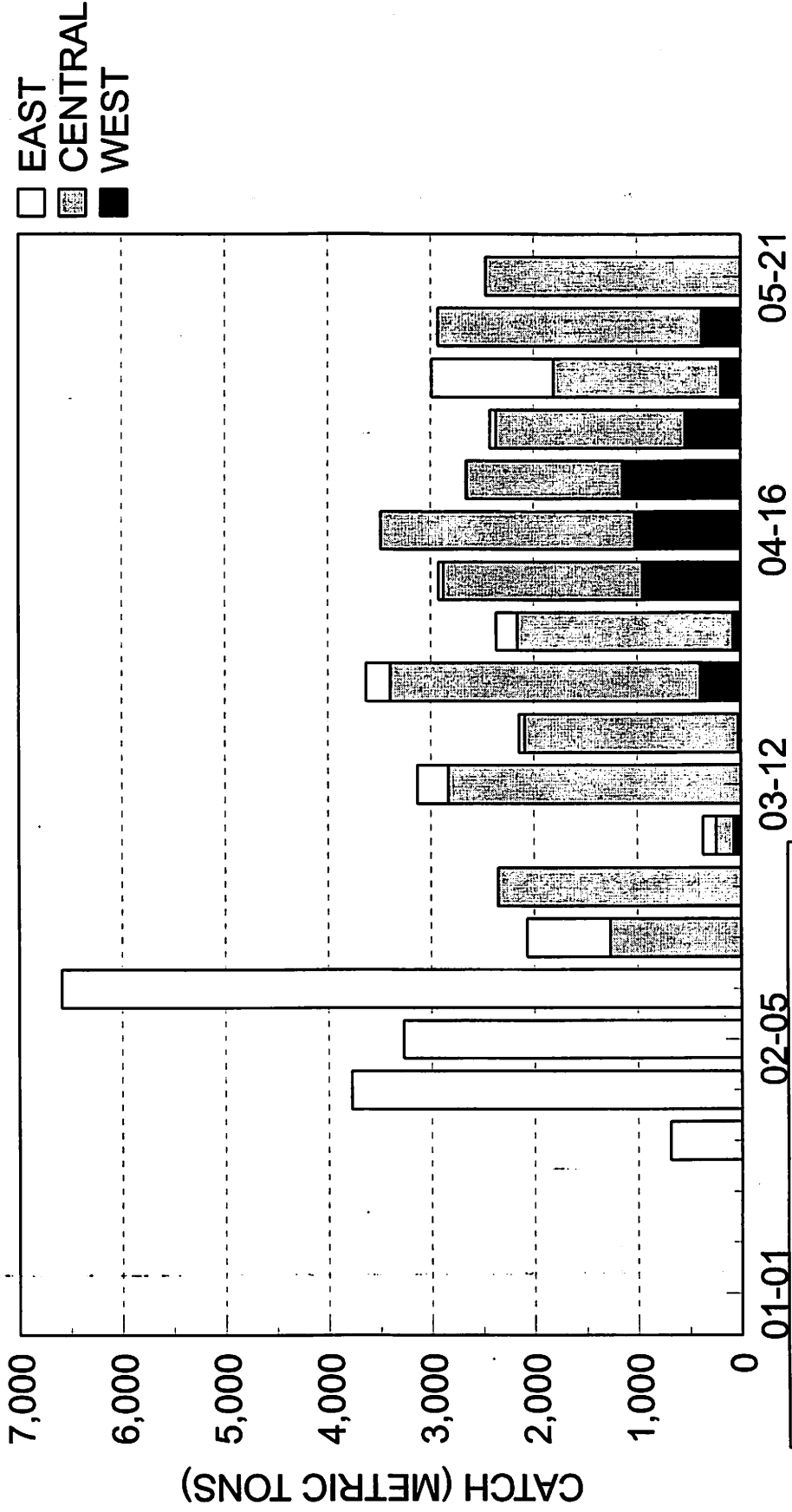

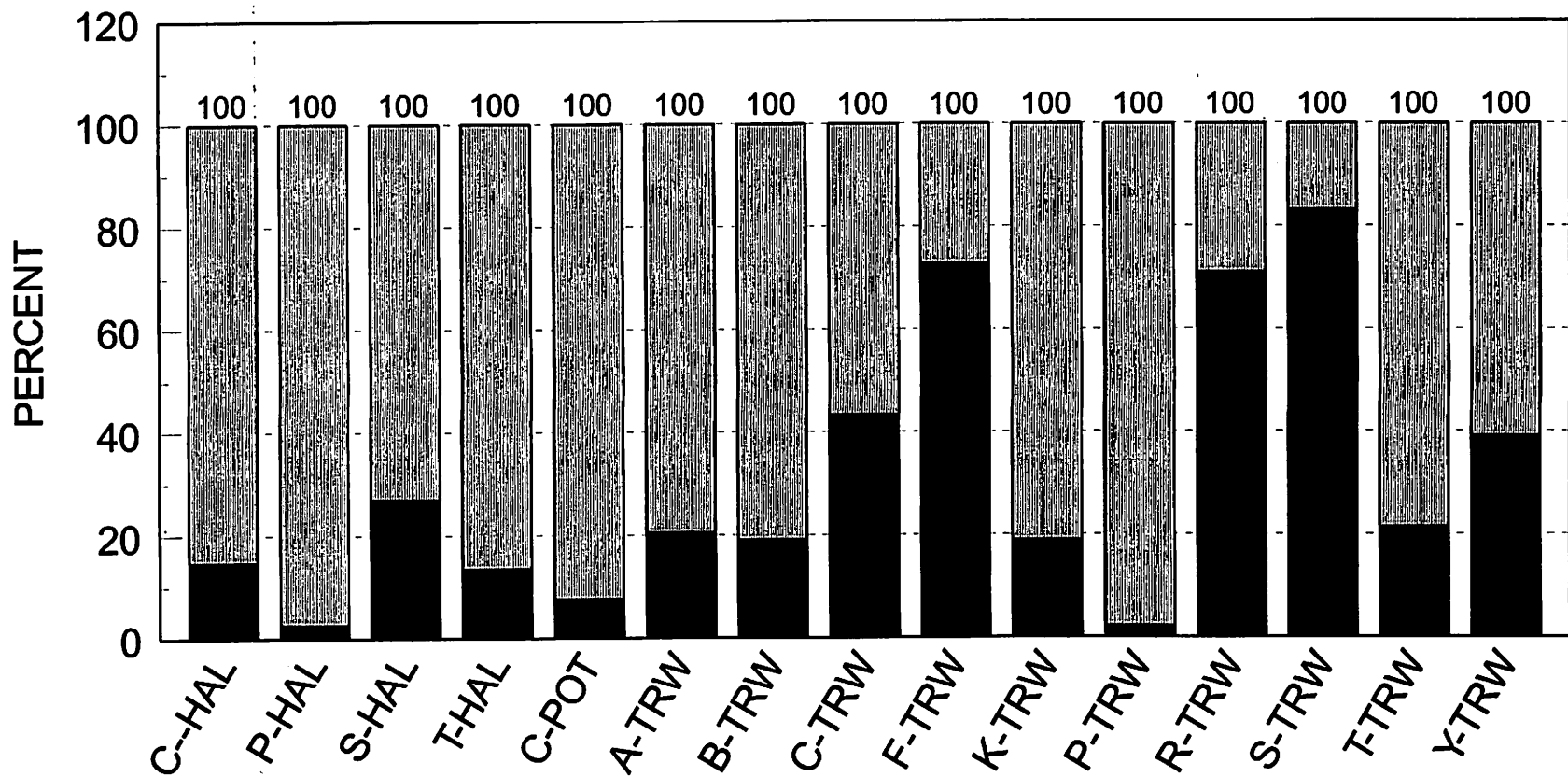

1994 BSAI PERCENT DISCARDS BY GEAR AND TARGET FISHERY

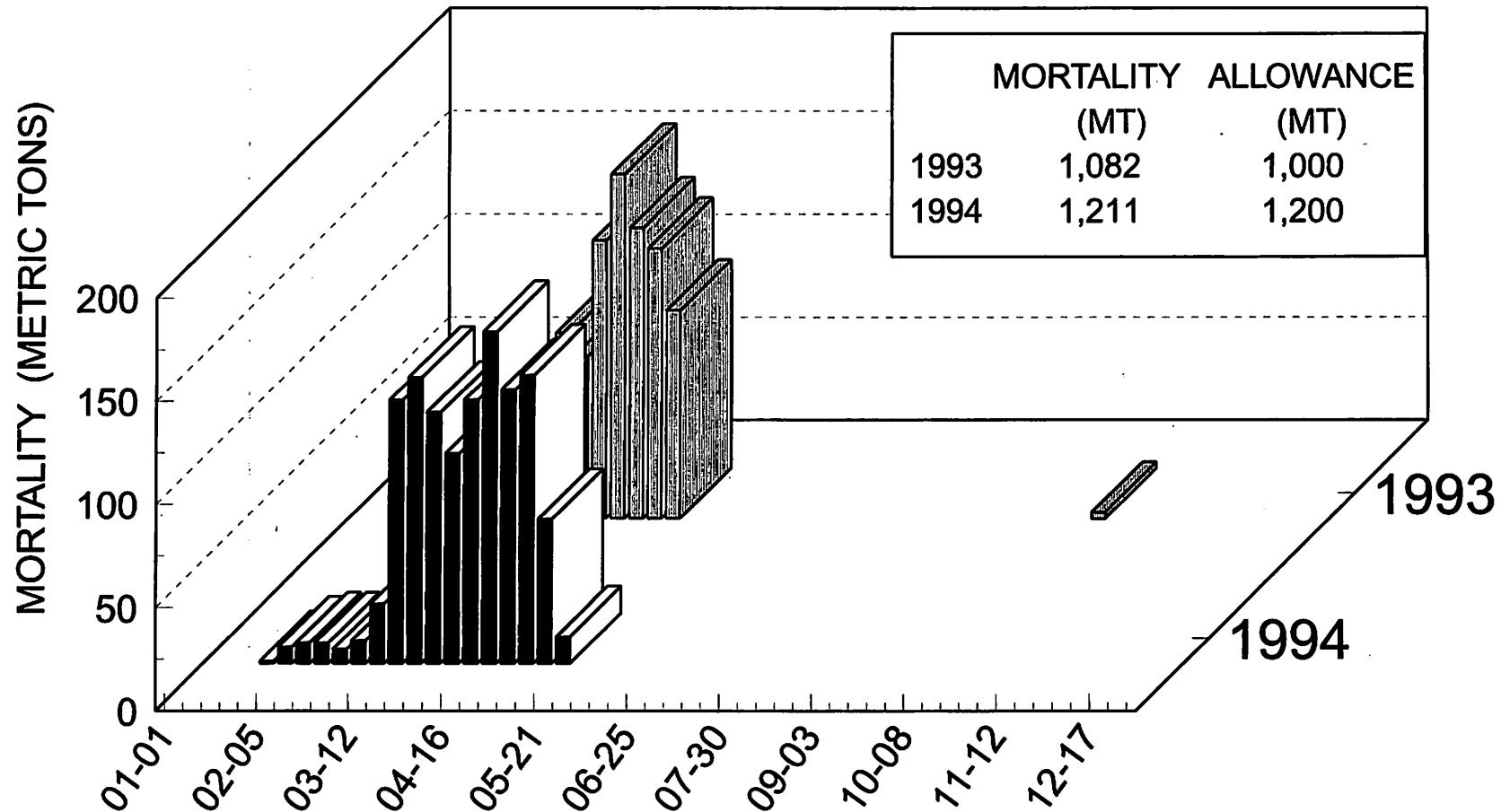

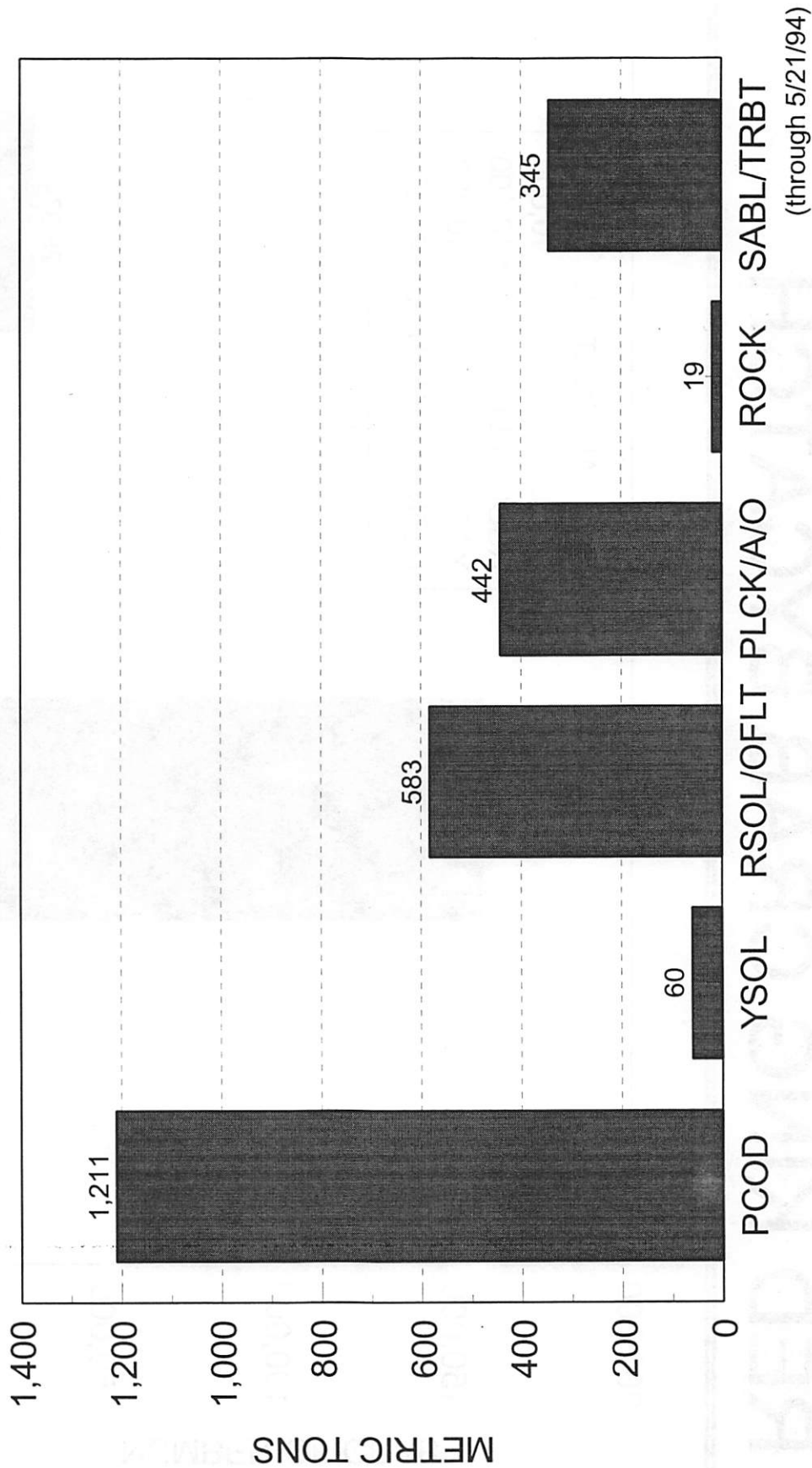
1993 & 1994 TRAWL HALIBUT MORTALITY, BSAI PCOD FISHERY



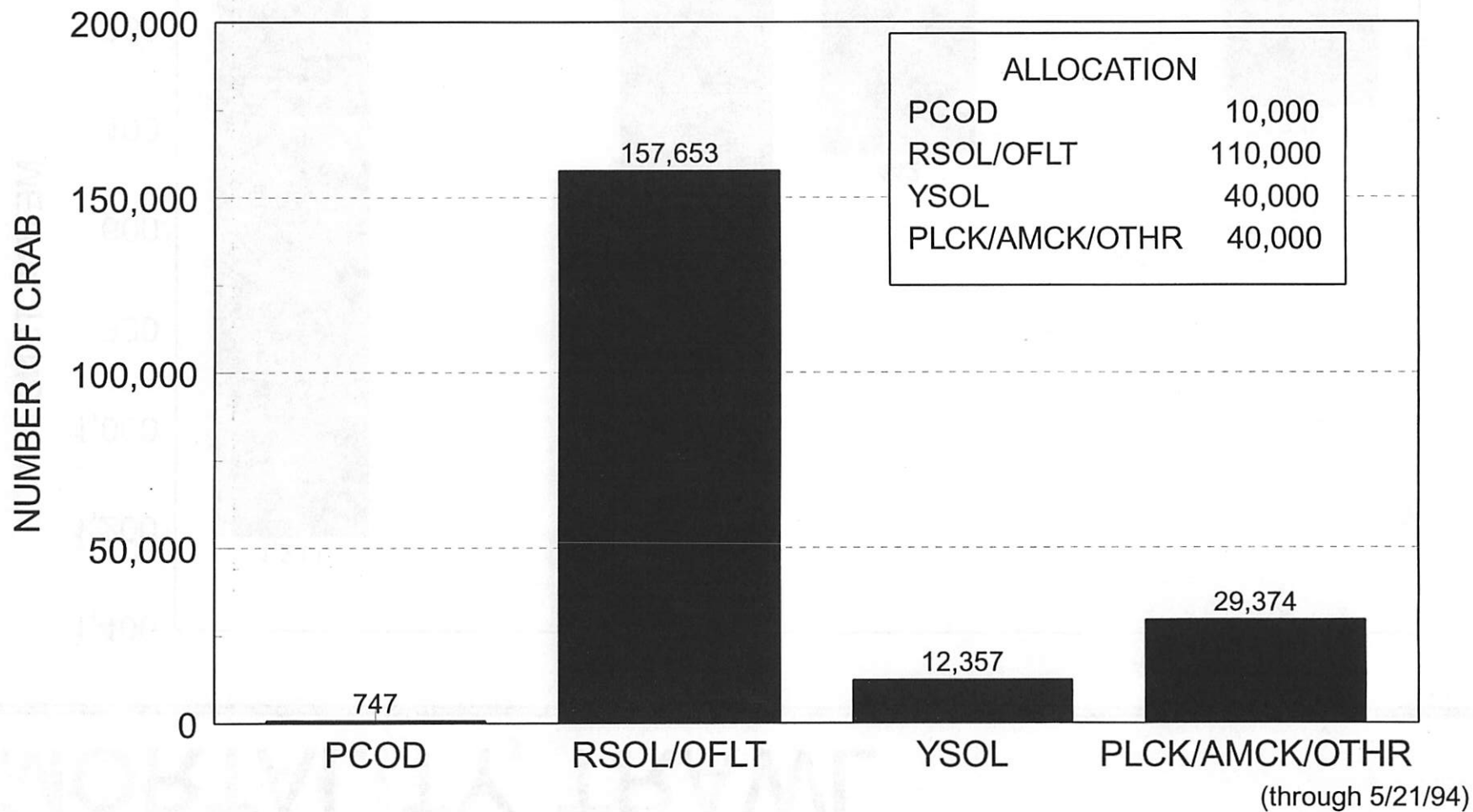

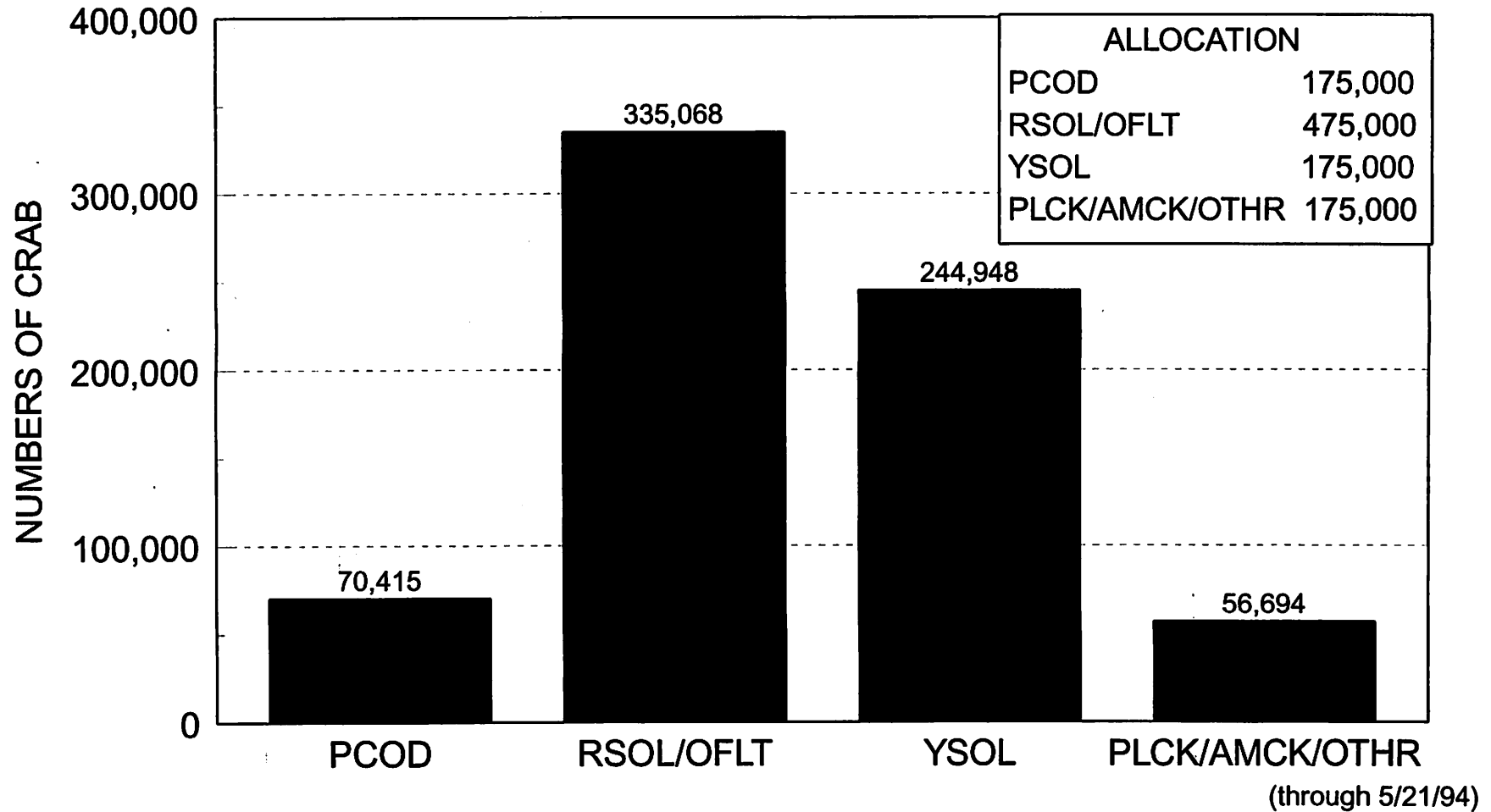
1994 BSAI HALIBUT BYCATCH MORTALITY, TRAWL



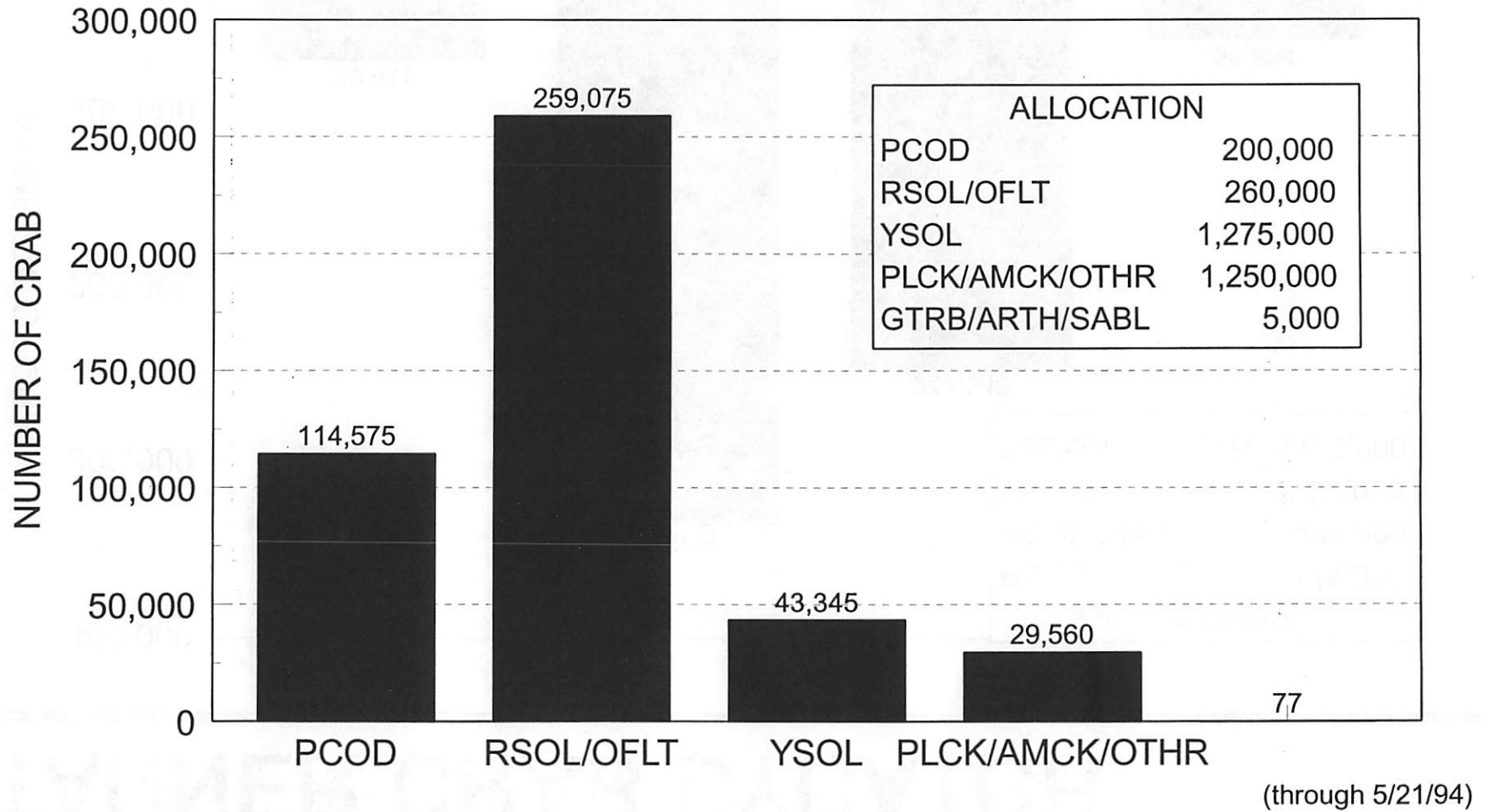
1994 BSAI ZONE 1 TRAWL RED KING CRAB BYCATCH



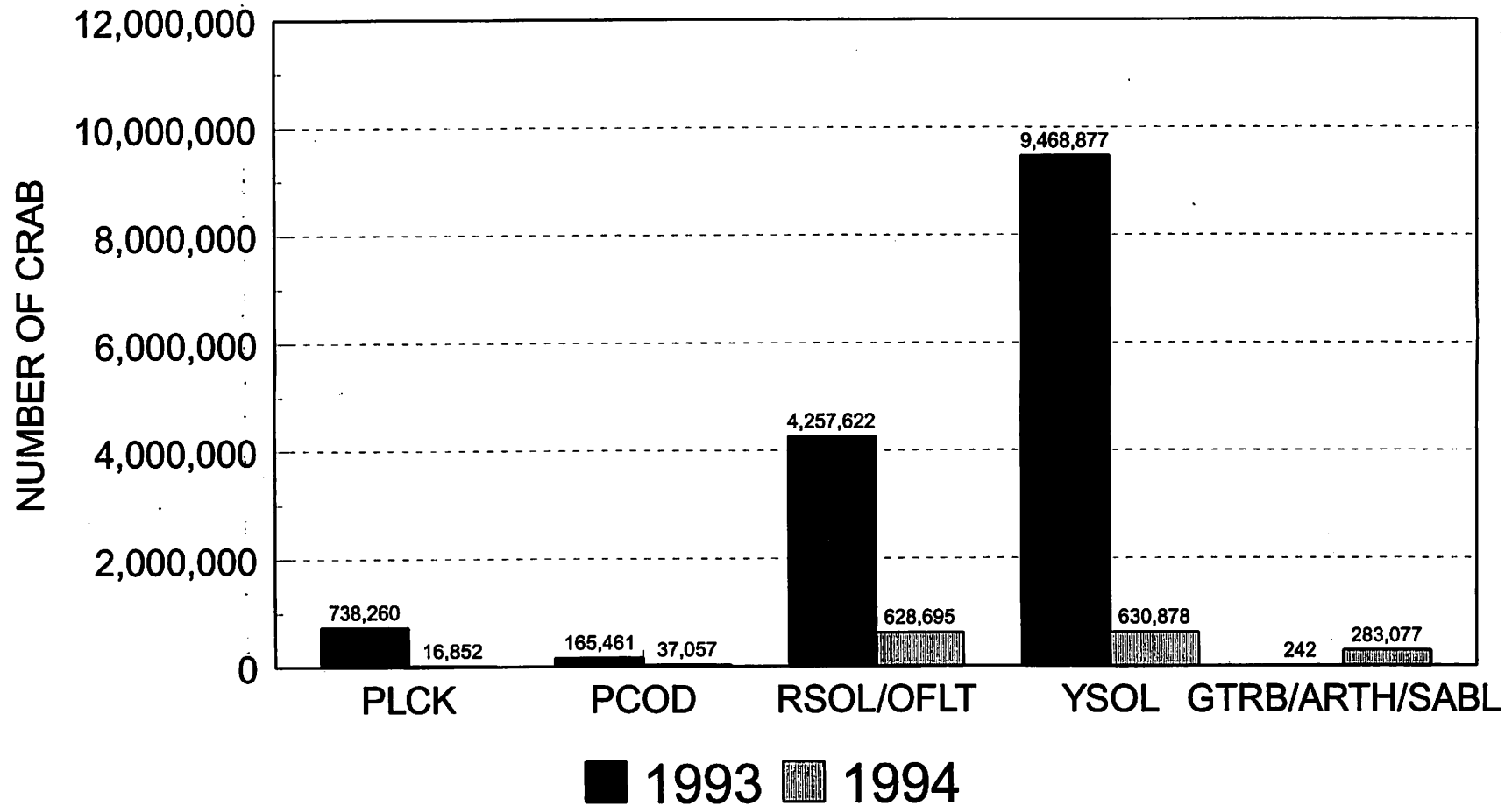
1994 BSAI ZONE 1 TRAWL BAIRDI TANNER CRAB BYCATCH

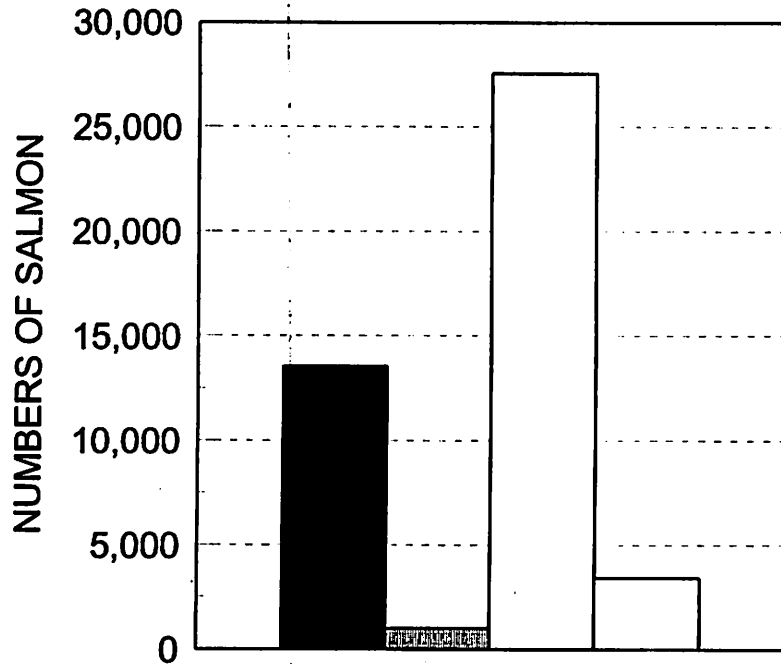


1993 & 1994 BSAI TRAWL OPILIO TANNER CRAB BYCATCH



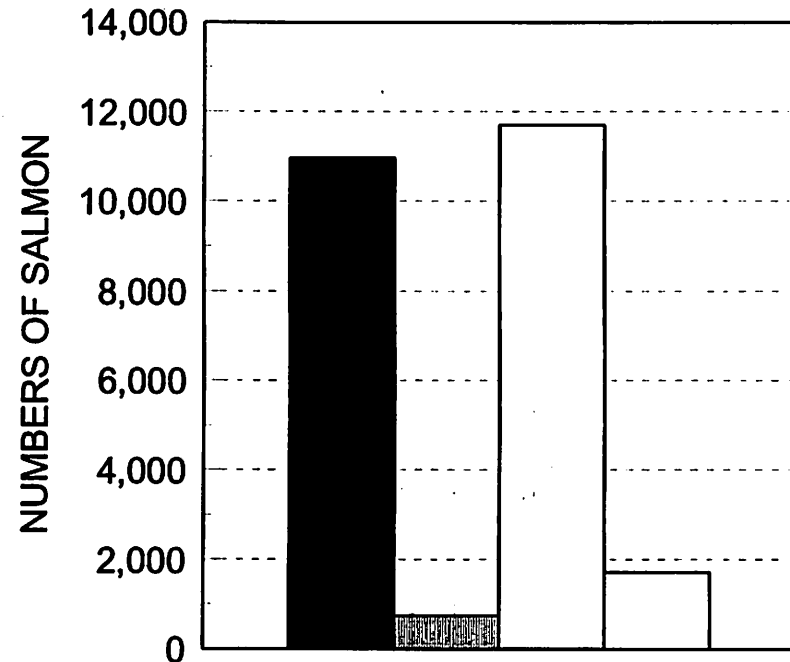

NOTICE OF BYCATCH RATE STANDARDS FOR THE SECOND HALF OF 1994
FOR PURPOSES OF THE VESSEL INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Halibut and red king crab bycatch rate standards for the Alaska groundfish trawl fisheries included under the vessel incentive program are established for the second half of 1994, according to Steven Pennoyer, Director, National Marine Fisheries Service, Alaska Region.

These standards are specified for the Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands Area (BSAI) and Gulf of Alaska (GOA) trawl fisheries during the second half of 1994 as follows:
