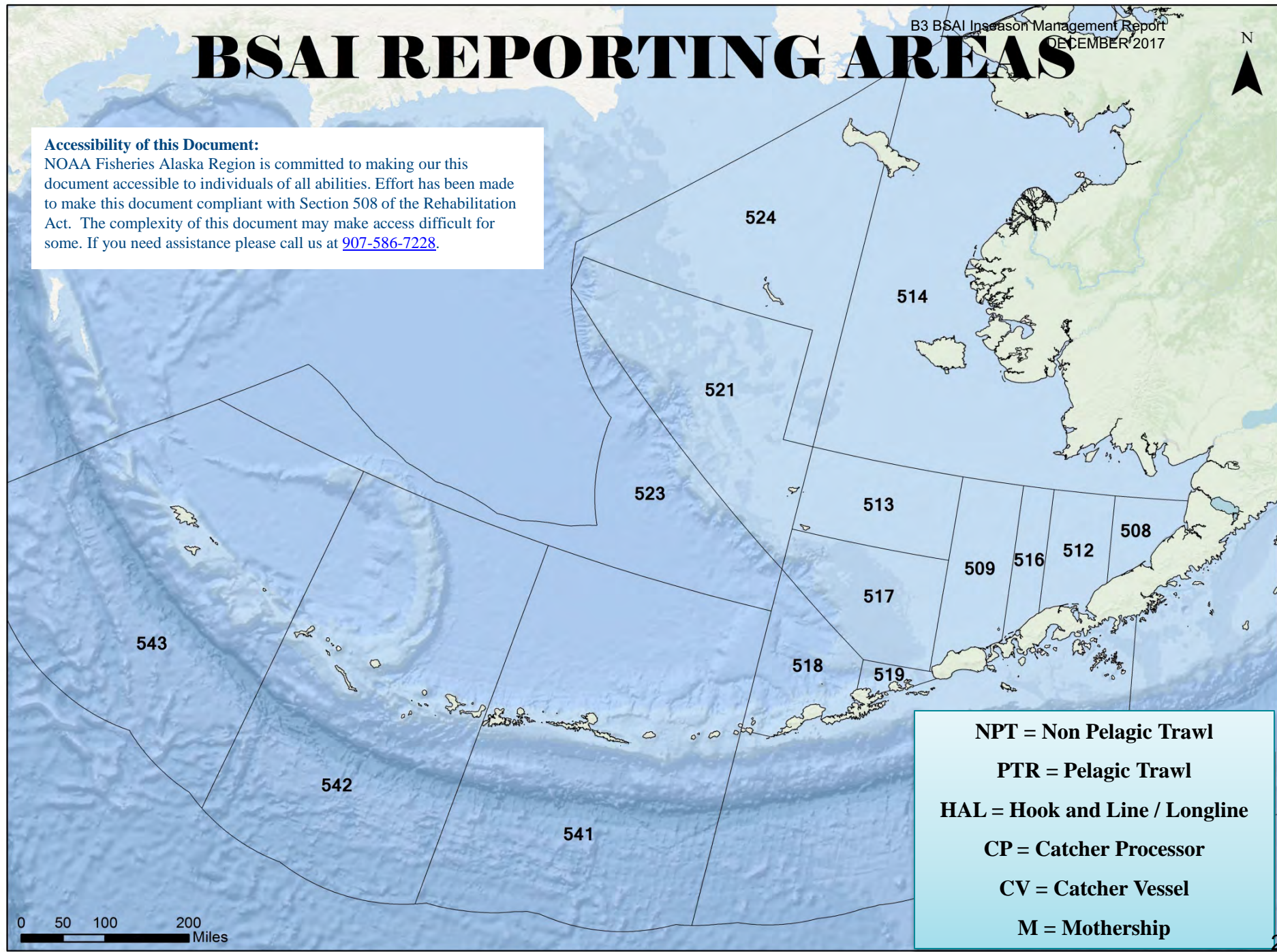

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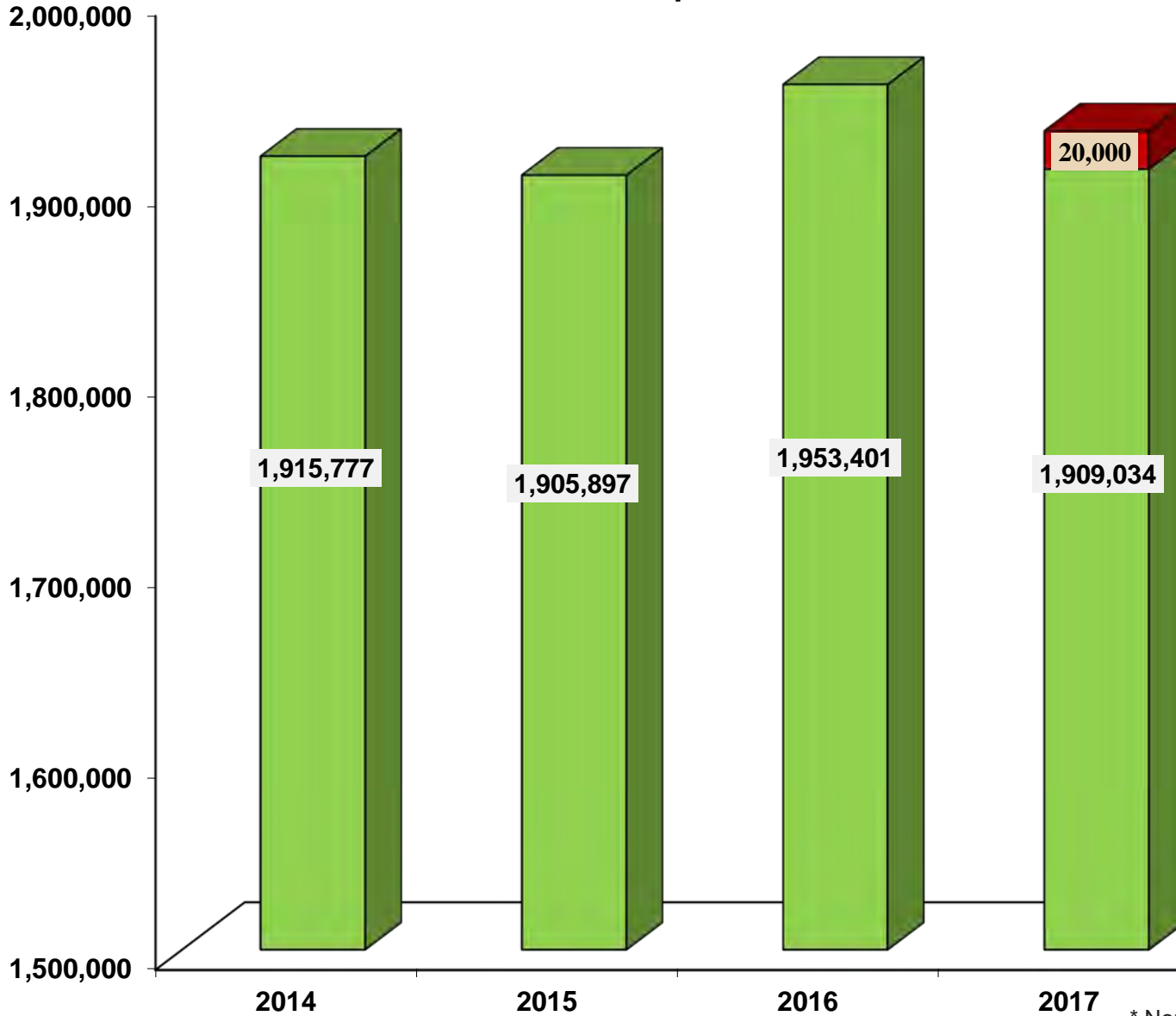

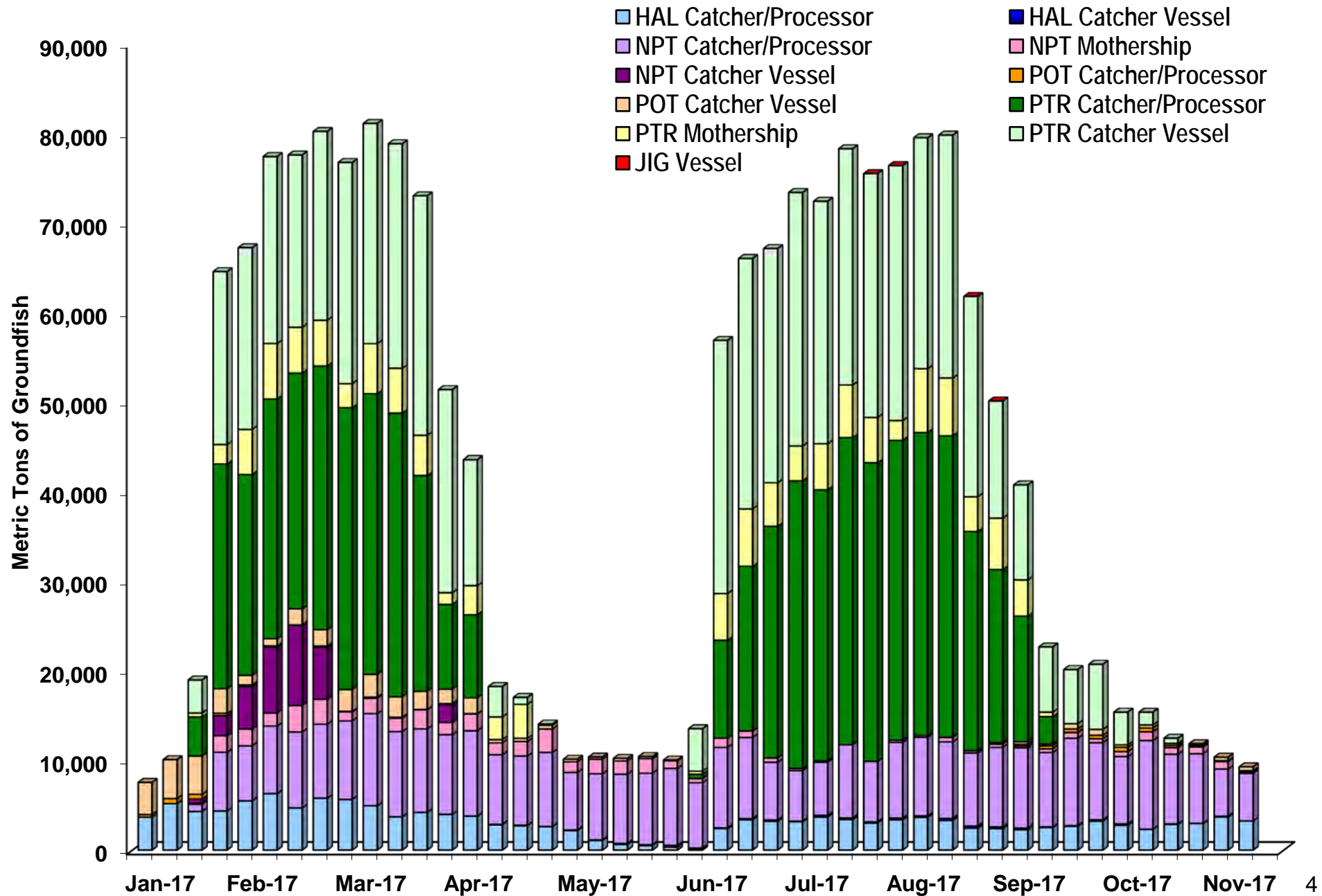

2017 BSAI Total Groundfish Catch by Gear & Sector

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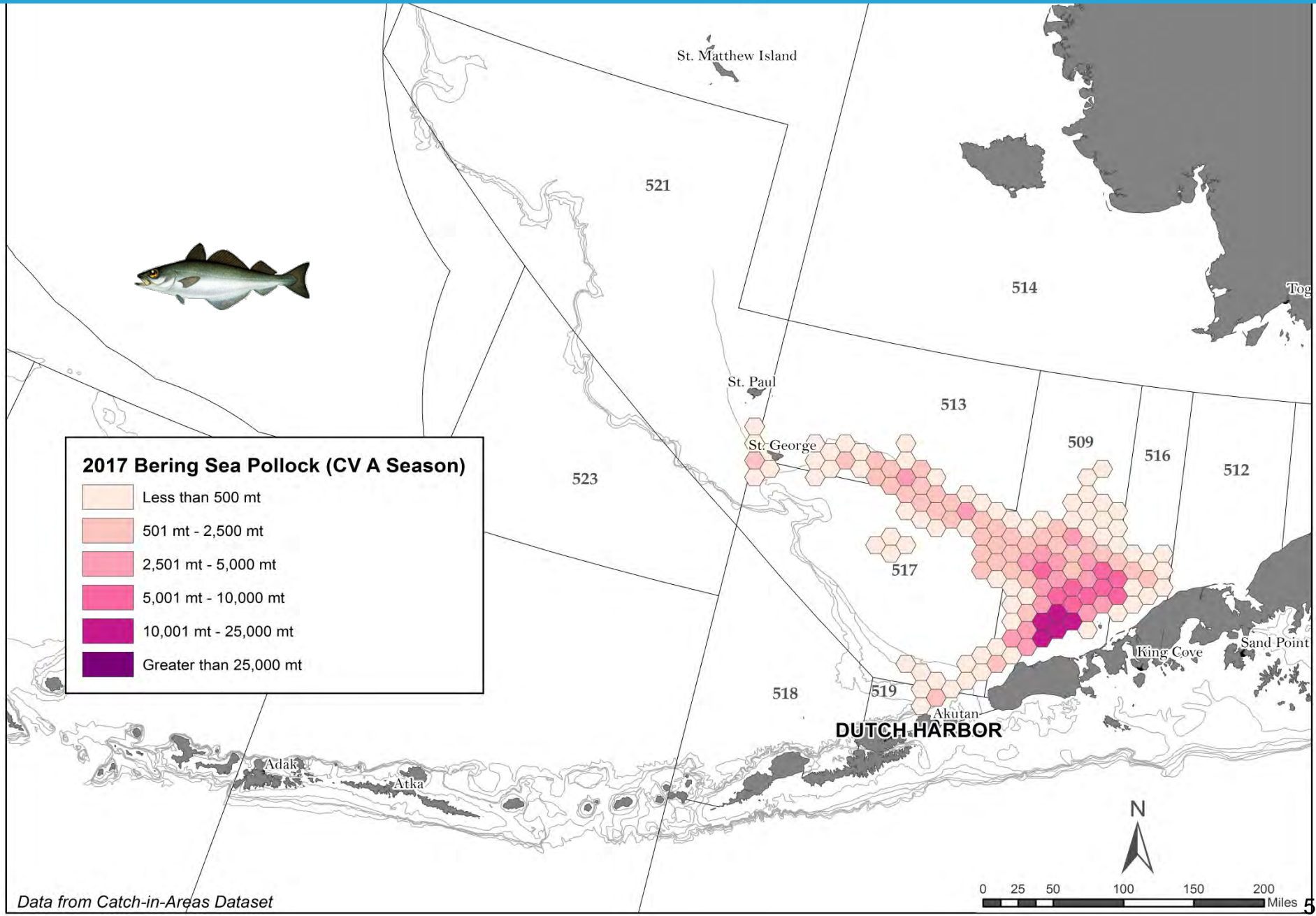

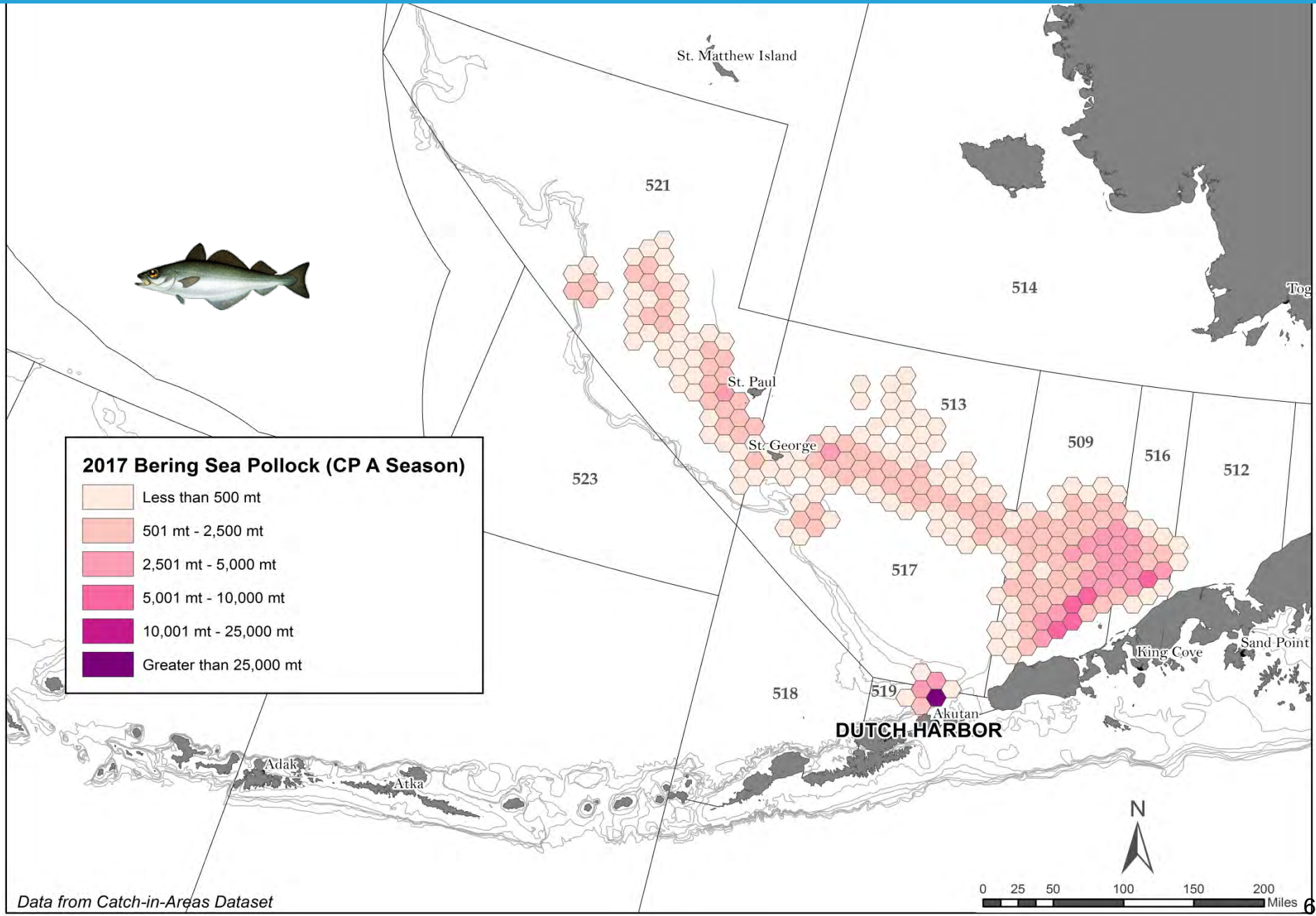
2017 A Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CP)

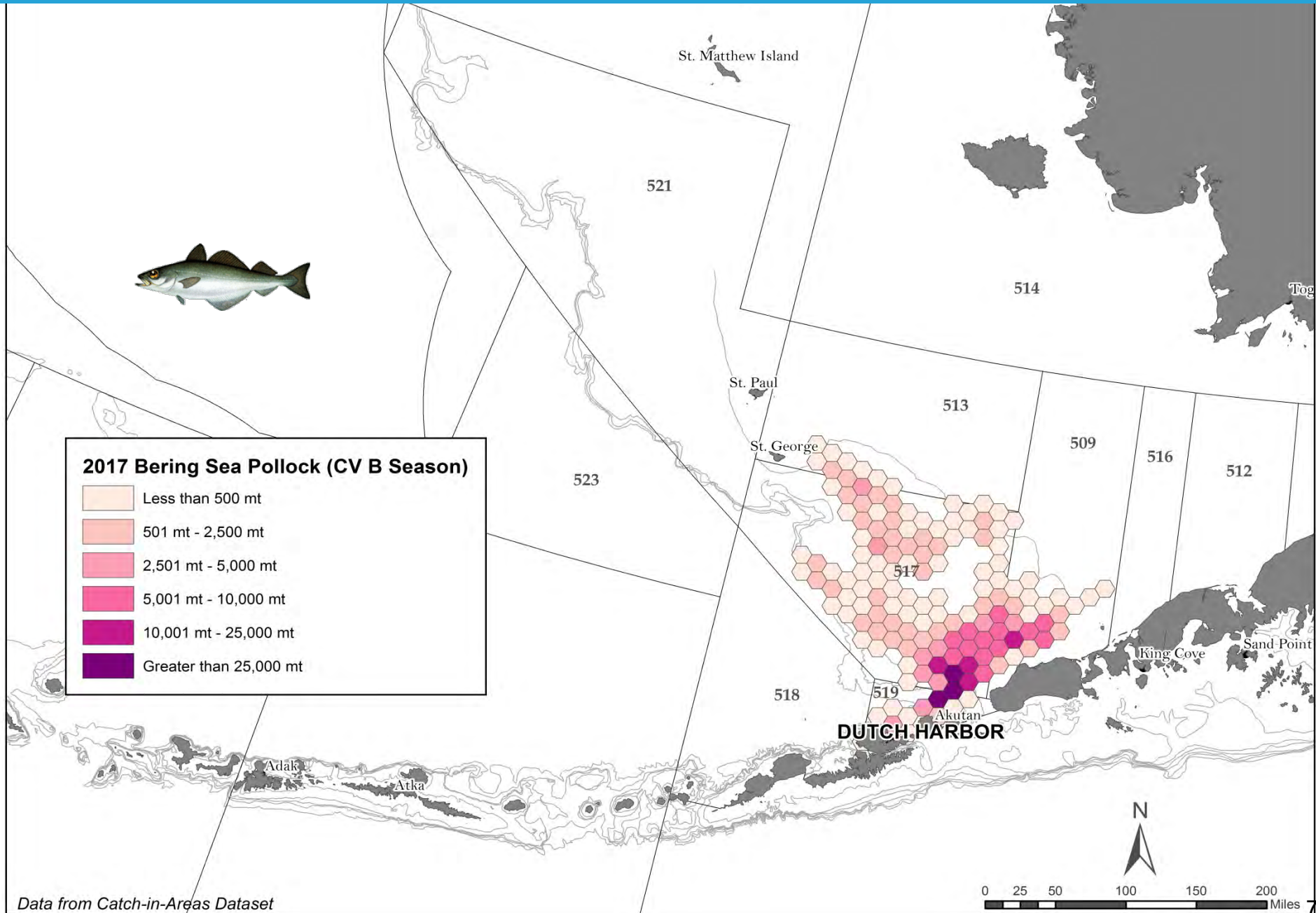

2017 B Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CV)

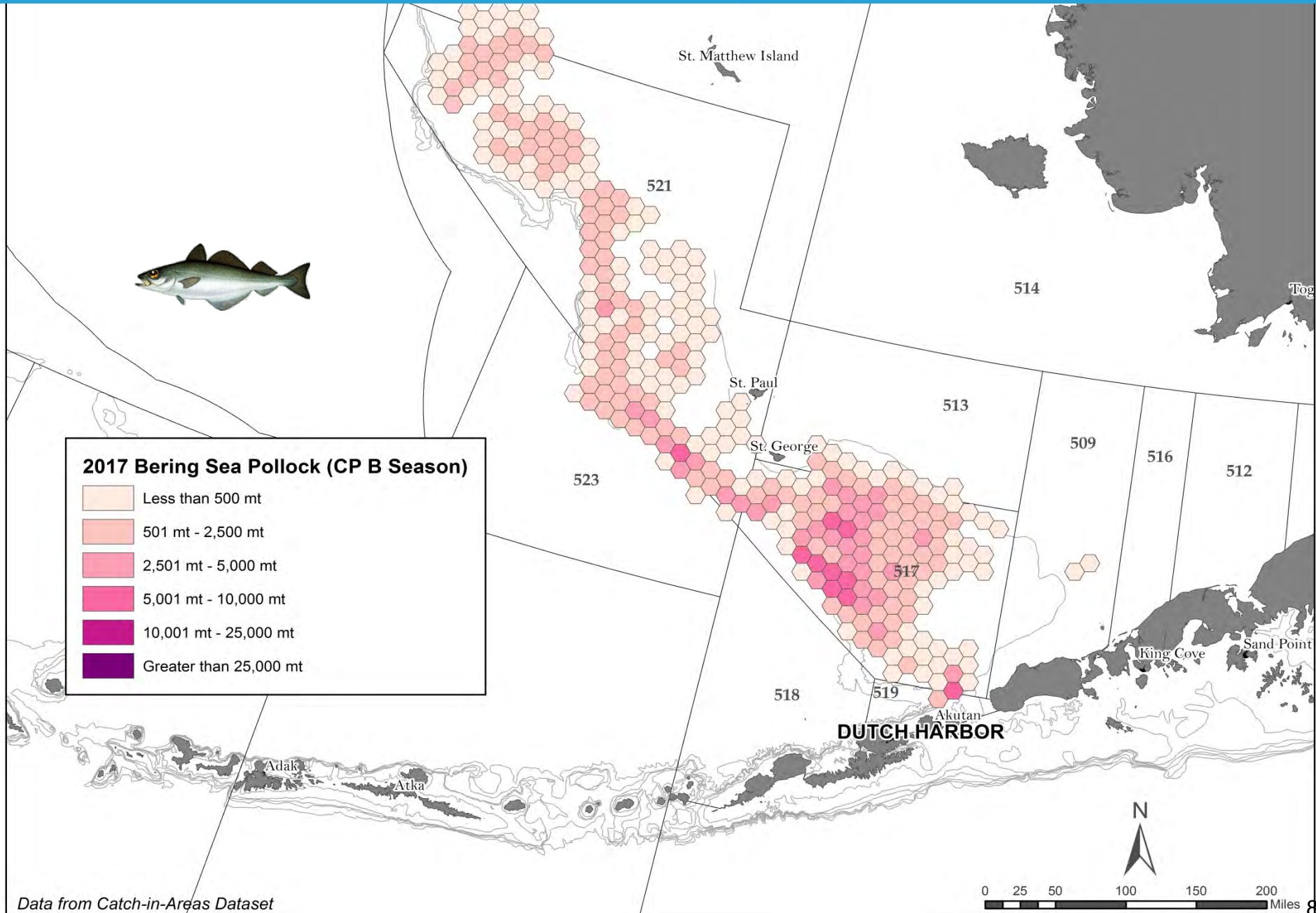

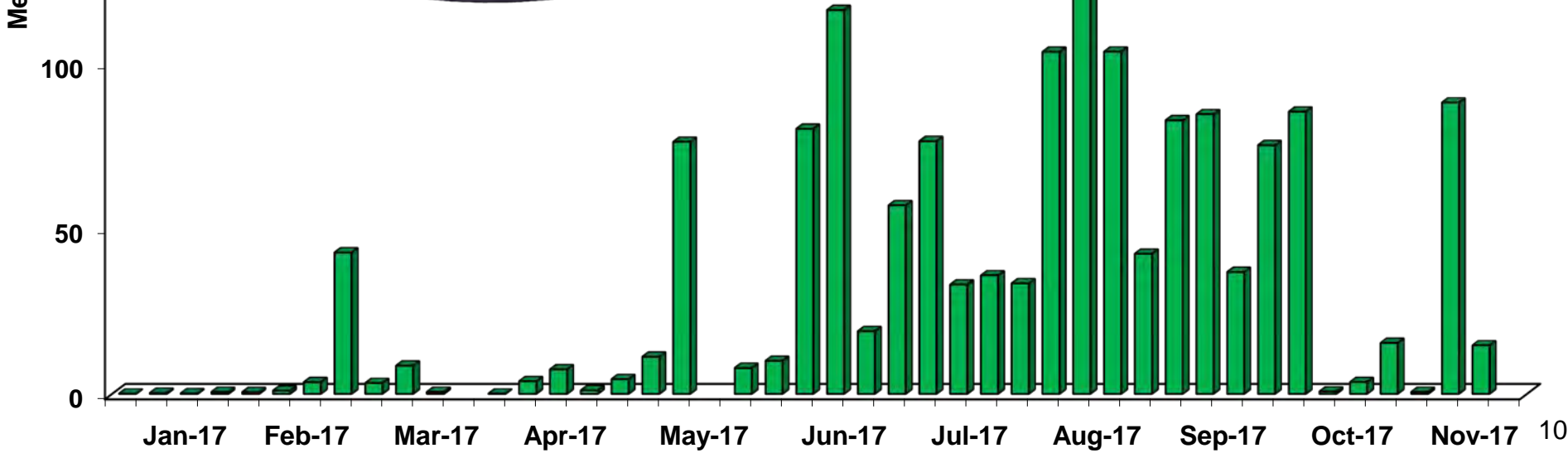
2017 Aleutian Islands Pollock Catch by Week and Sector

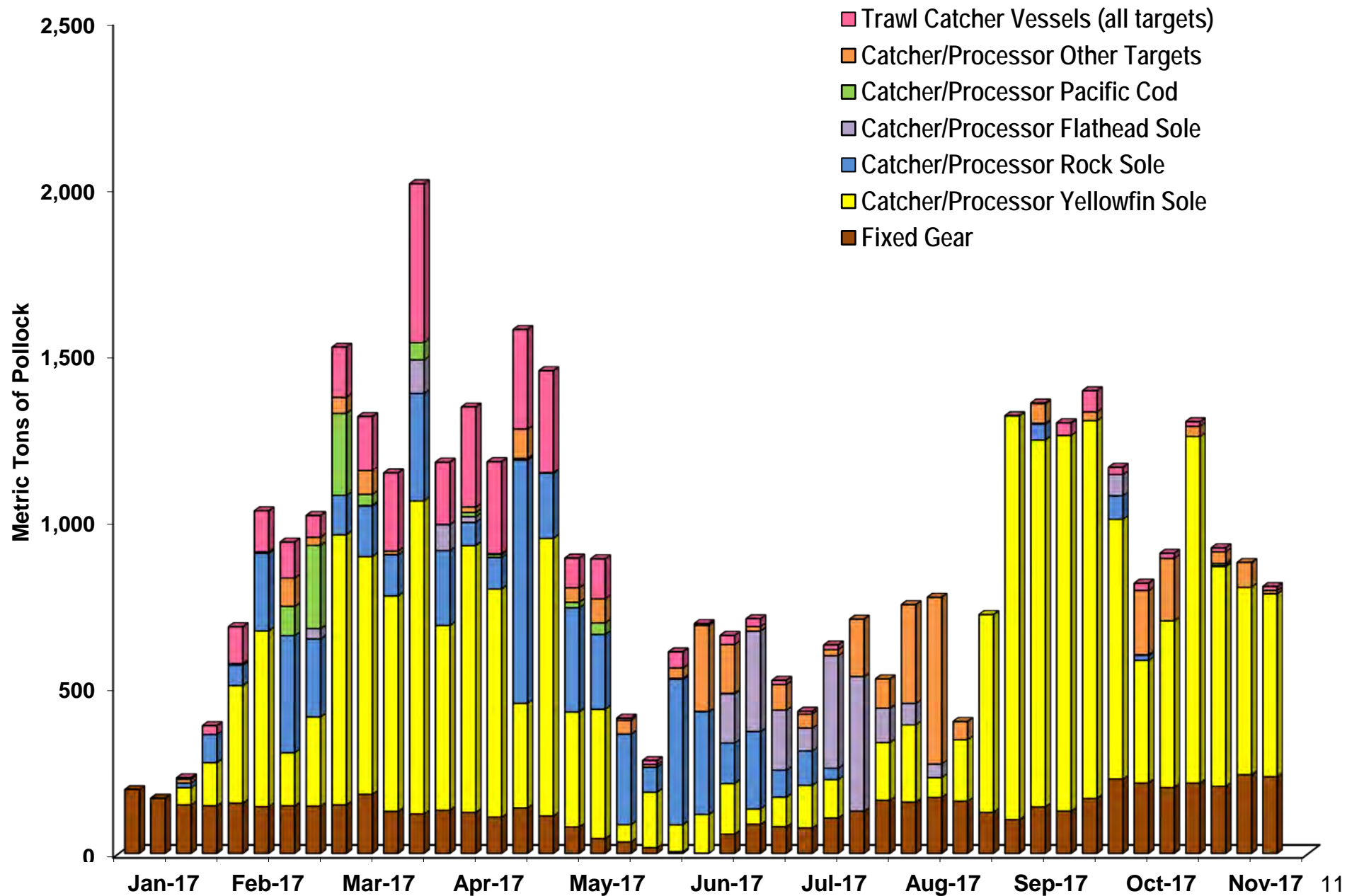

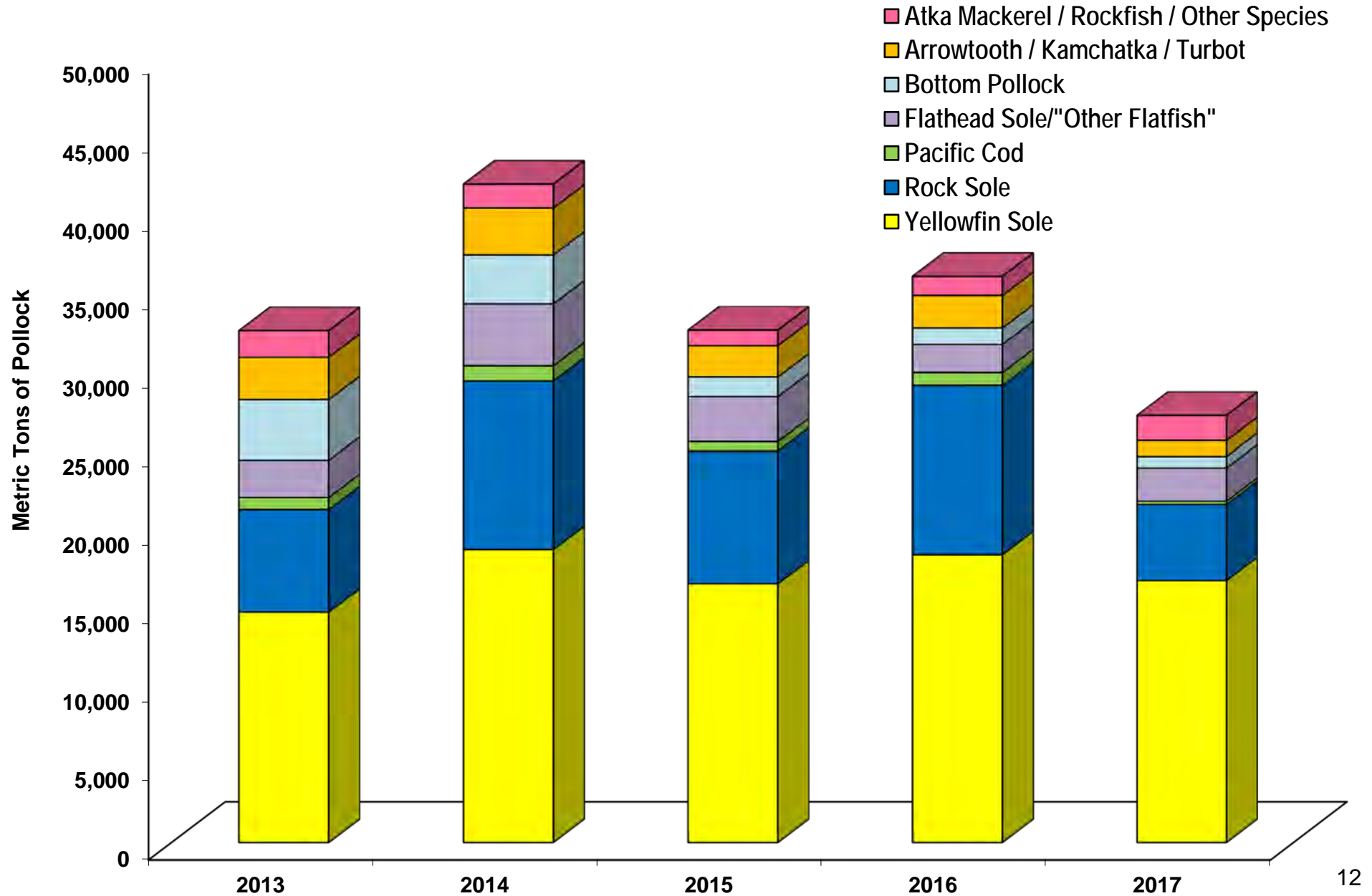
2017 Bering Sea Pollock ICA Catch by Week and Sector

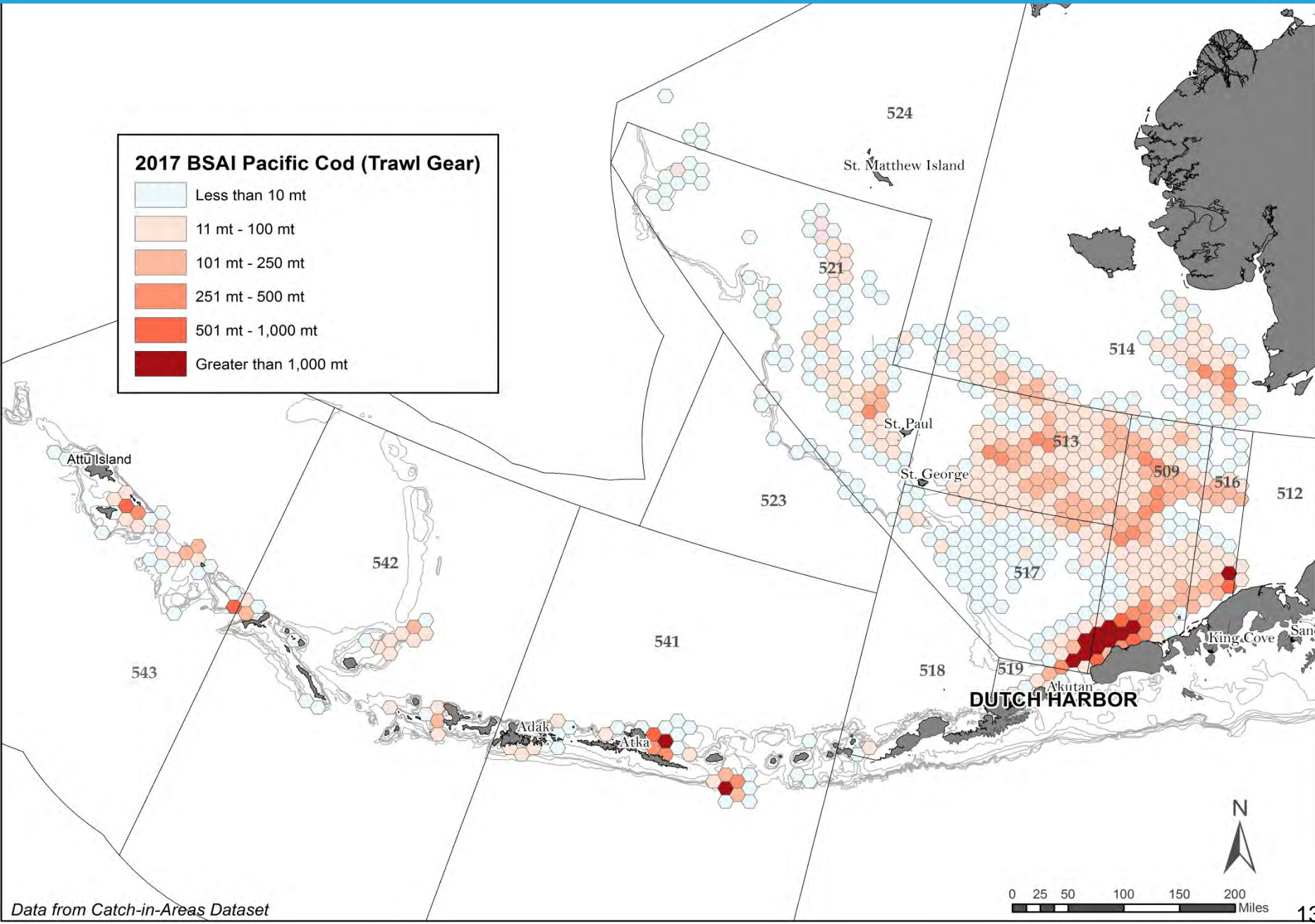
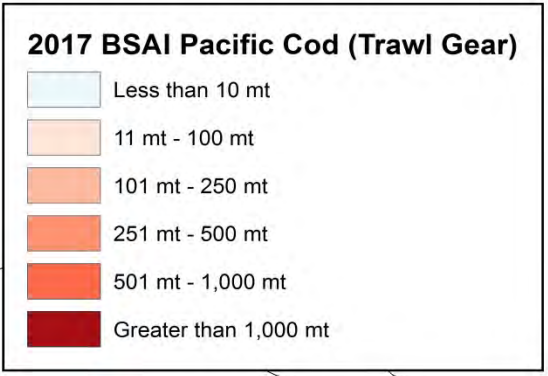


2017 Trawl Catcher/Processor Incidental Catch of Pollock by Year and Target

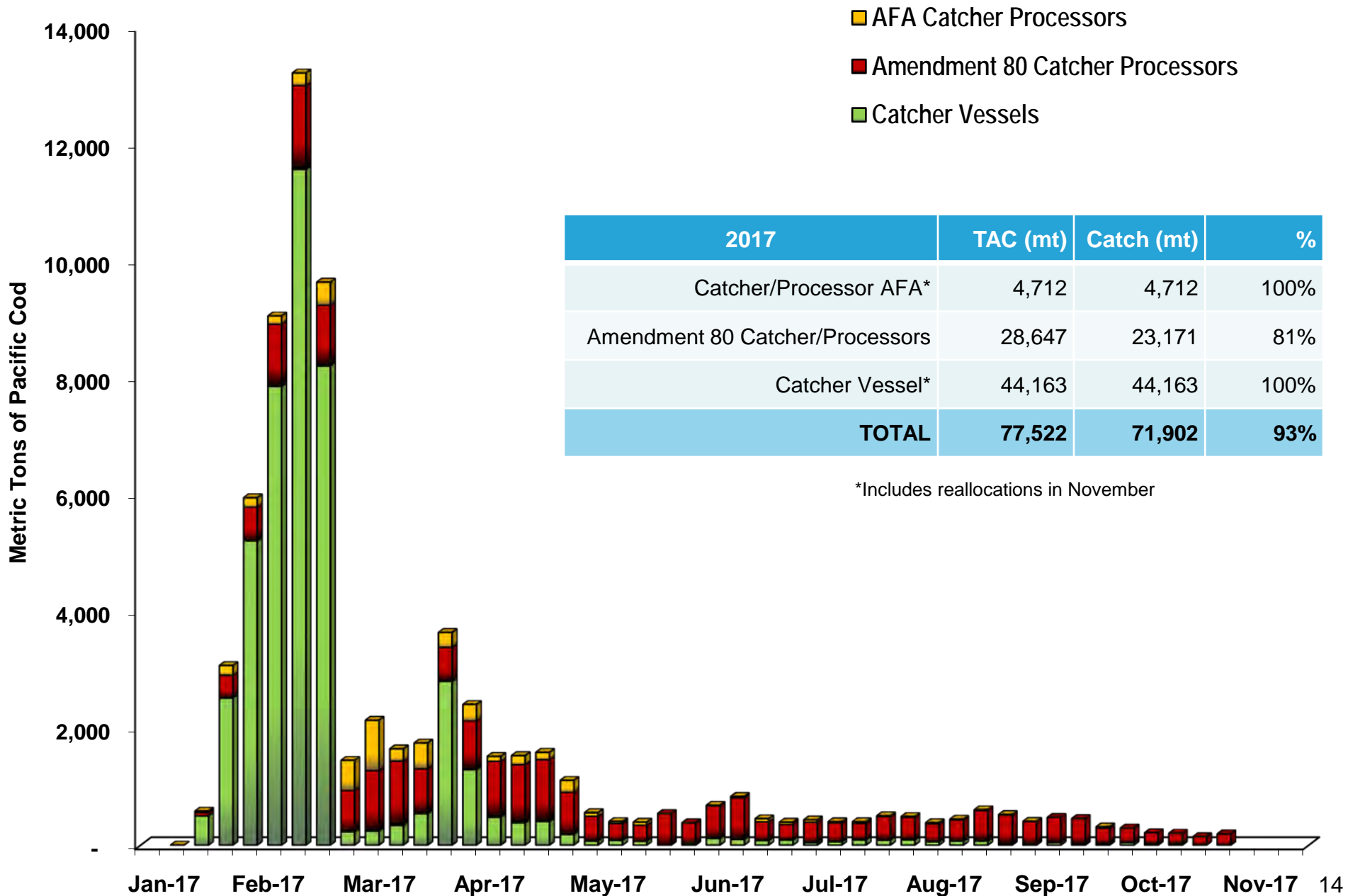
2017 Pacific Cod Catch by Trawl Gear



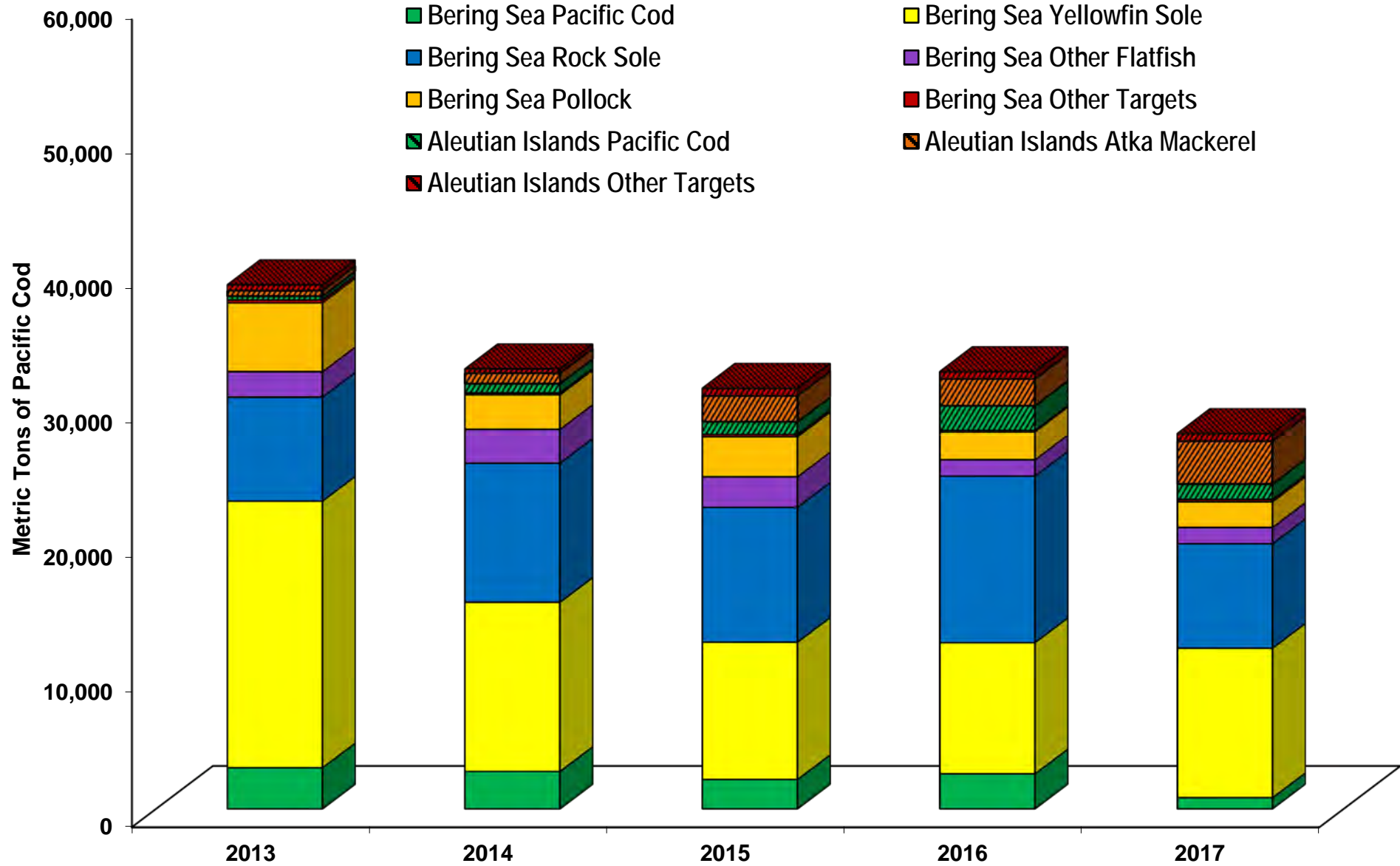

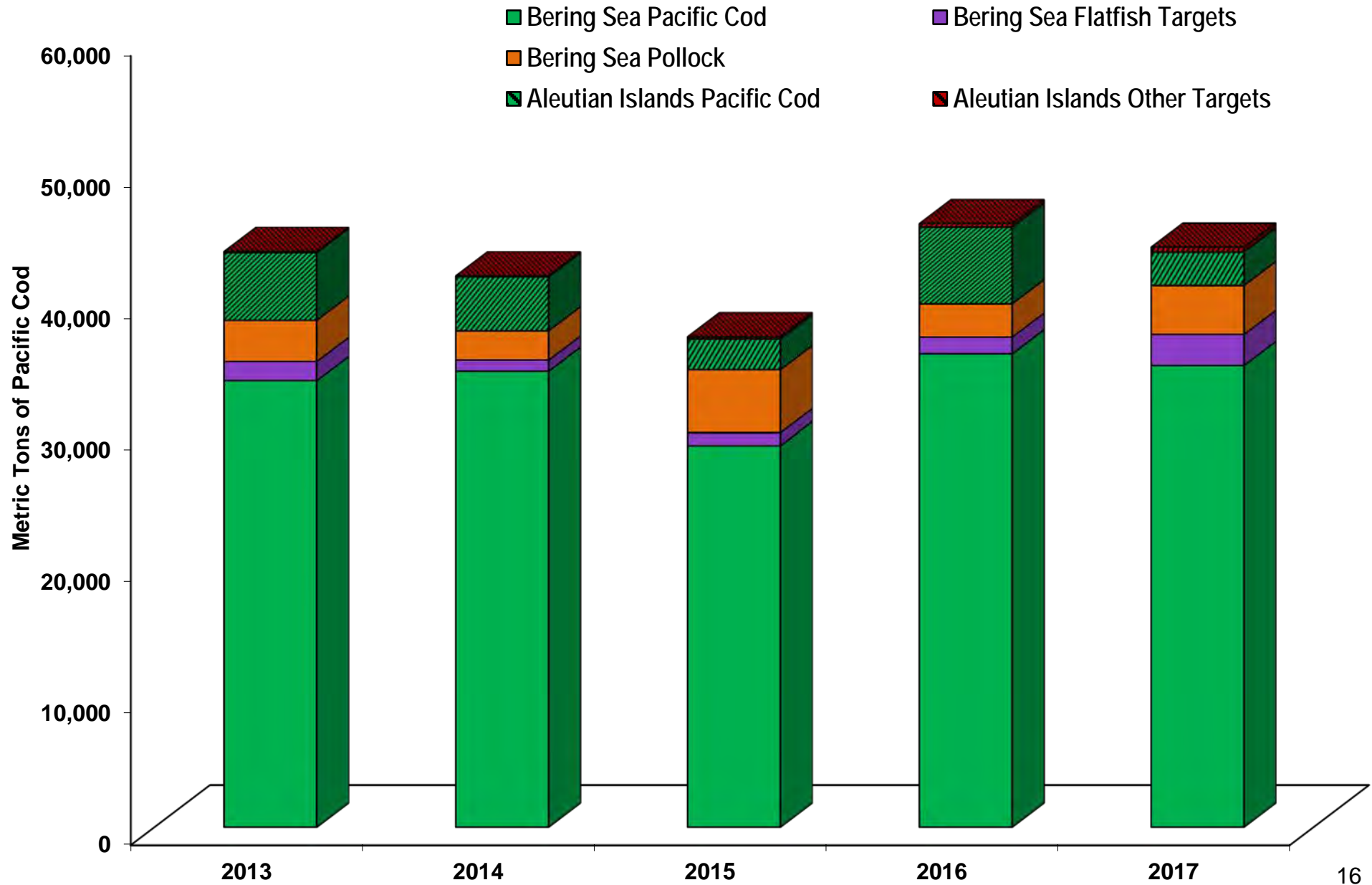


2017 BSAI Trawl Catcher/Processor Pacific Cod Catch by Target



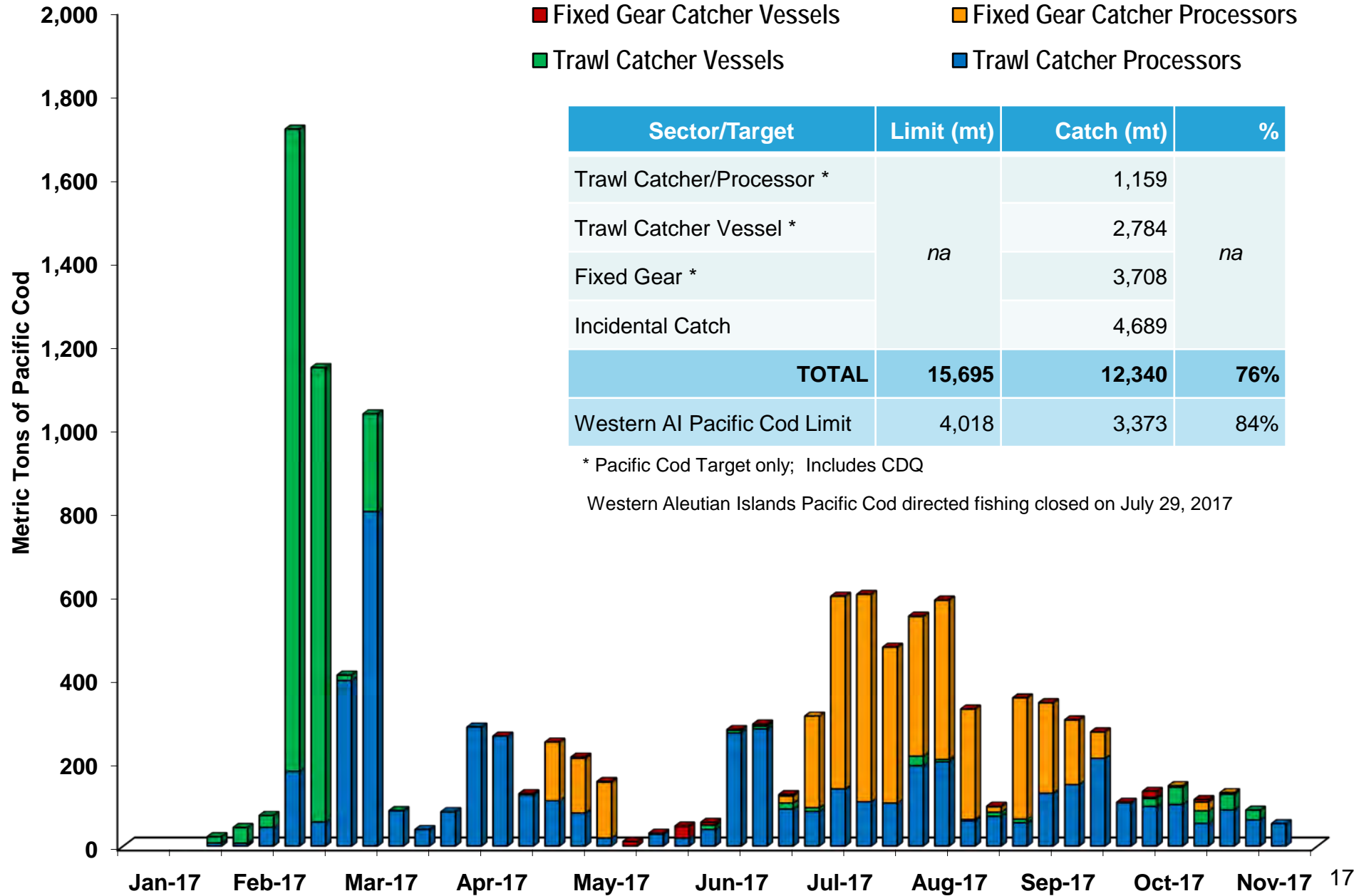

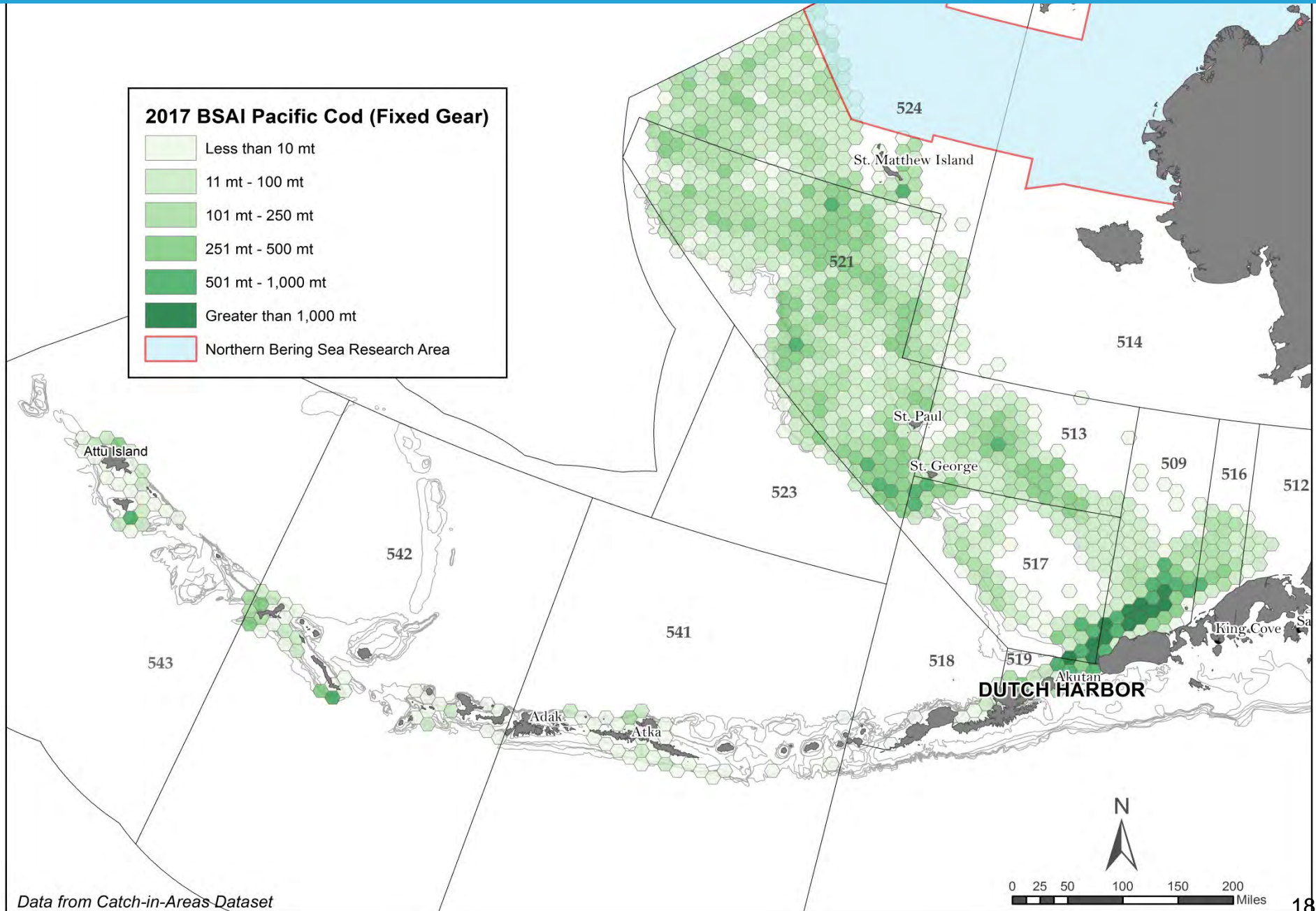
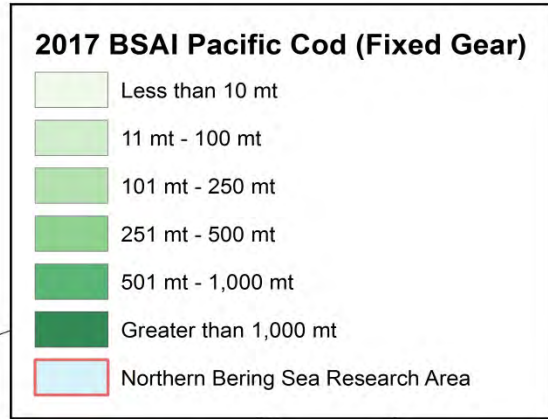


2017 Aleutian Islands Pacific Cod Catch by Sector and Target

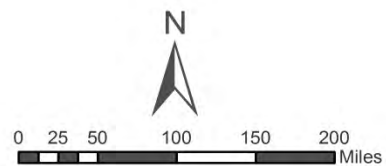

2017 Pacific Cod Catch by Non-Trawl Gear

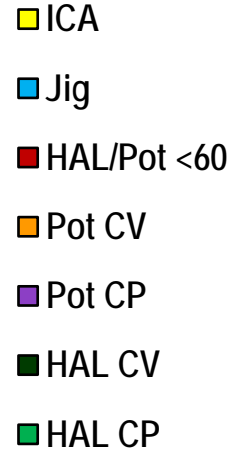

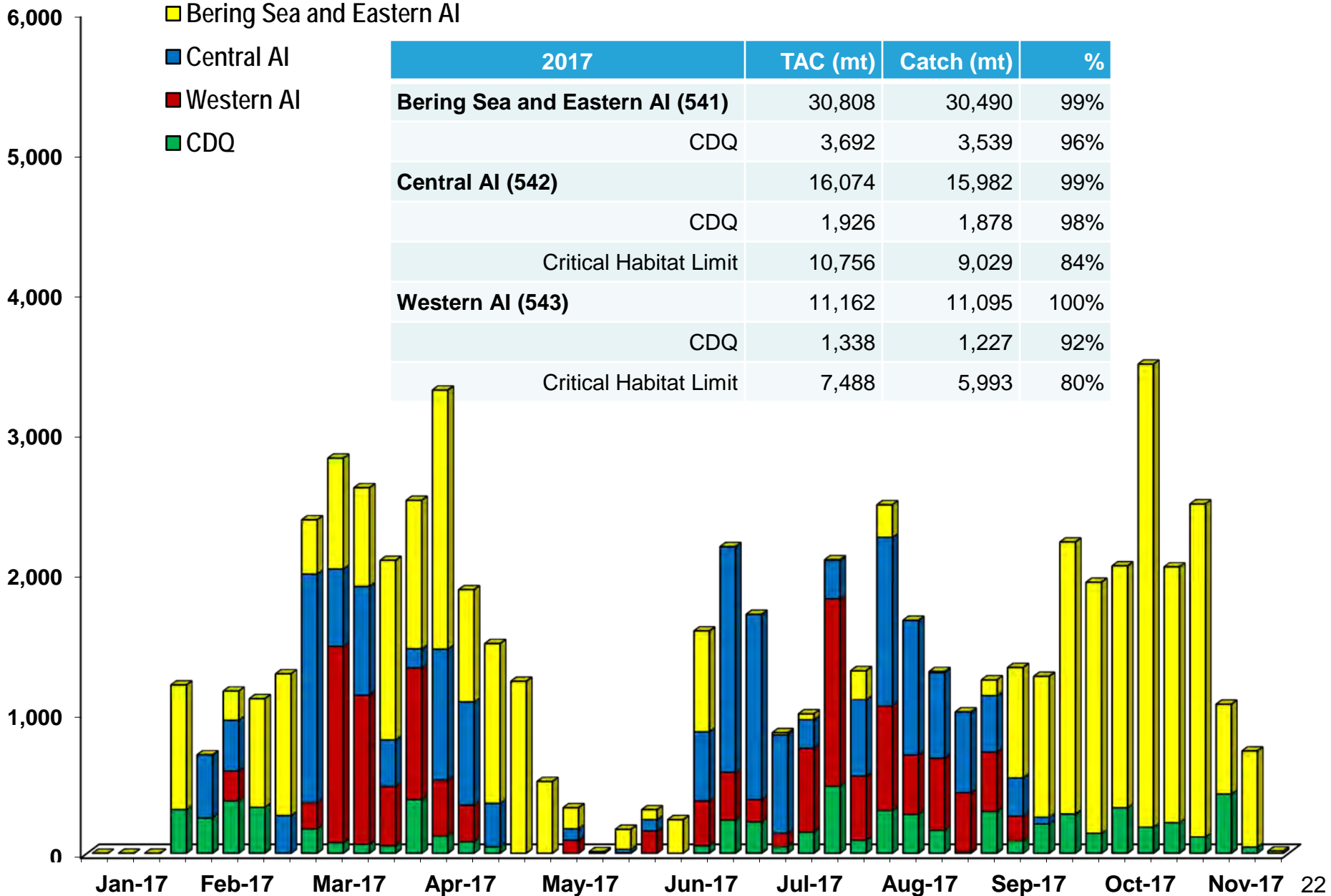

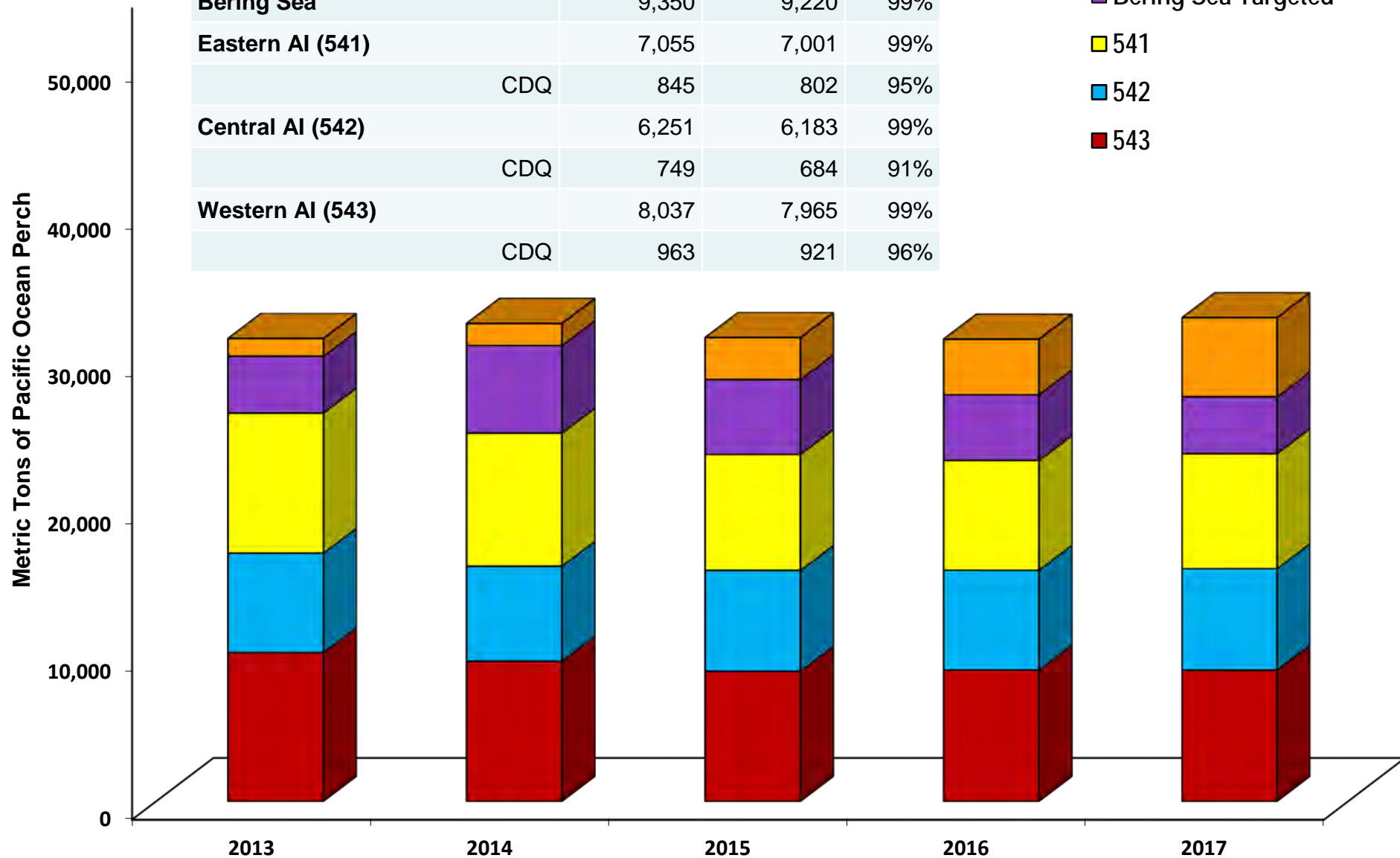
2017 Atka Mackerel Catch by Week and Area

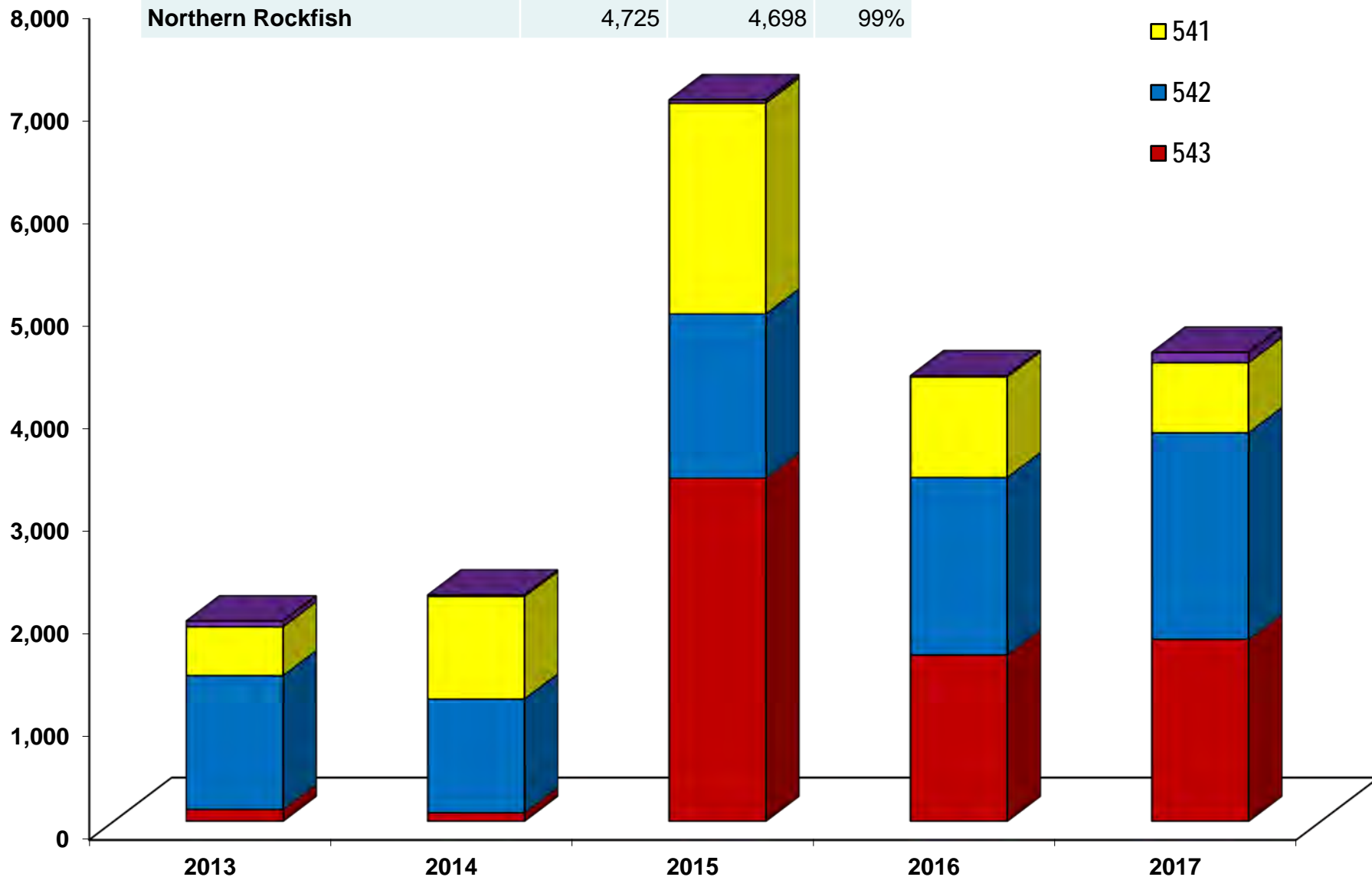


2017 Northern Rockfish Catch by Area

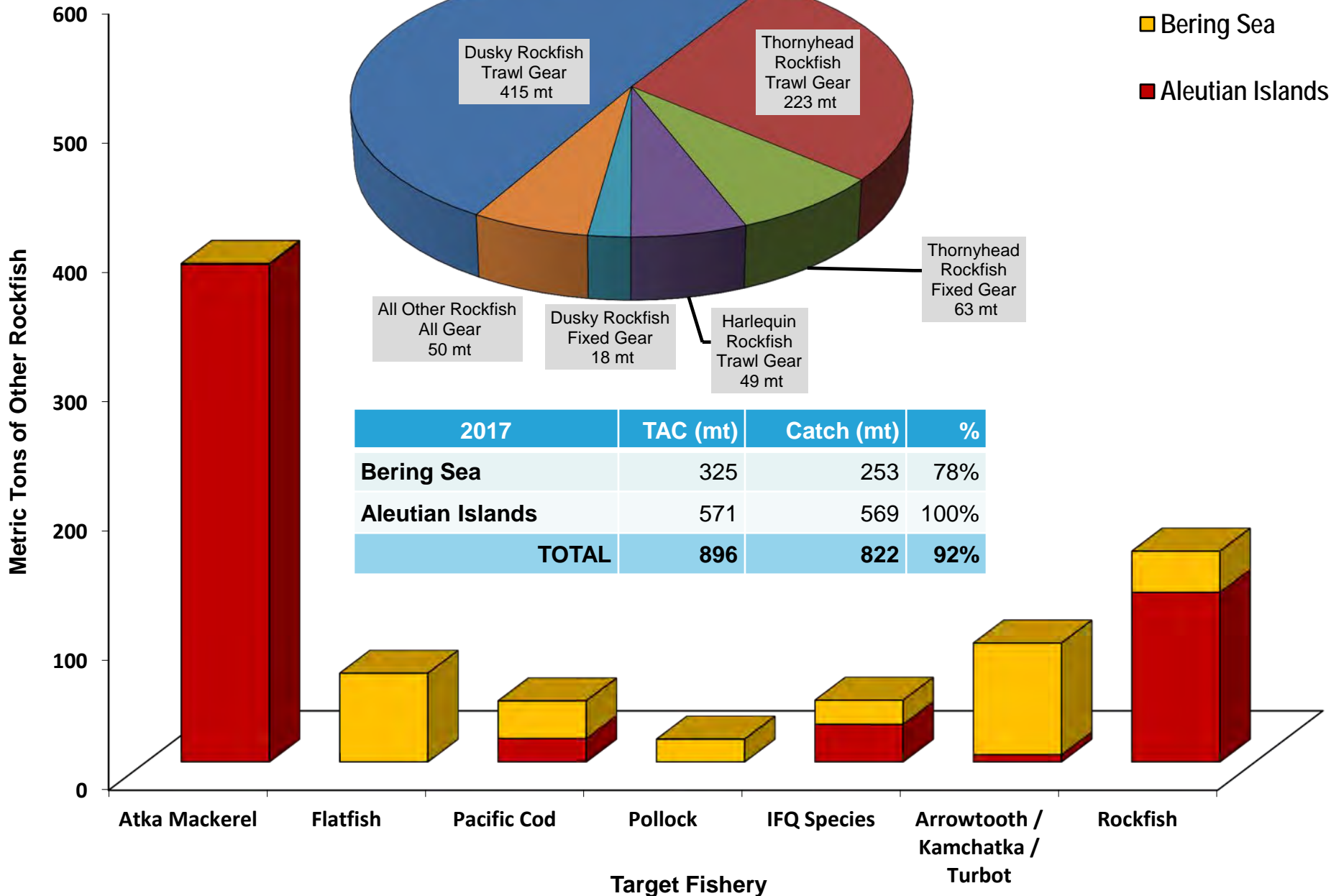

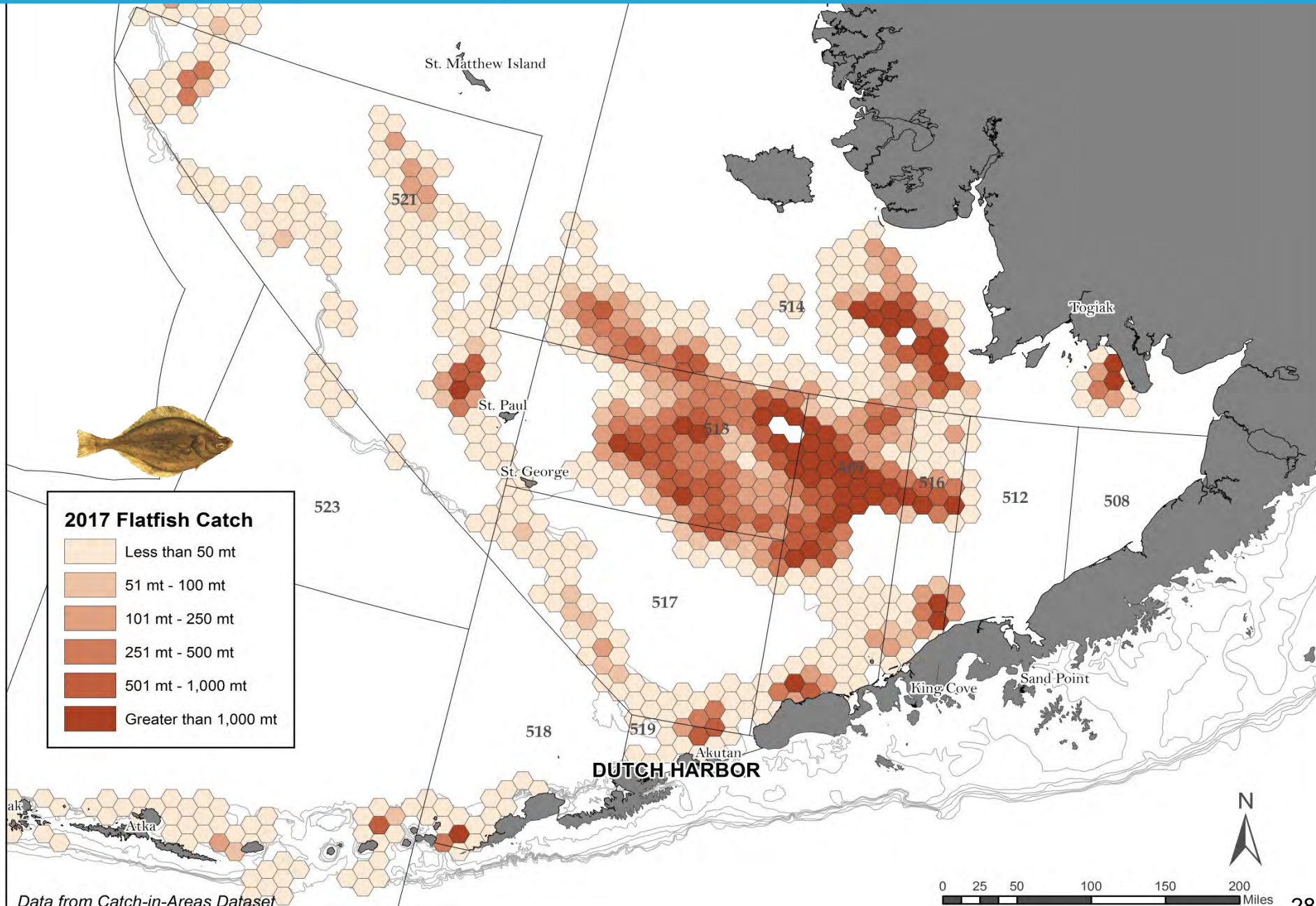


2017 BSAI Shortraker Rockfish Catch

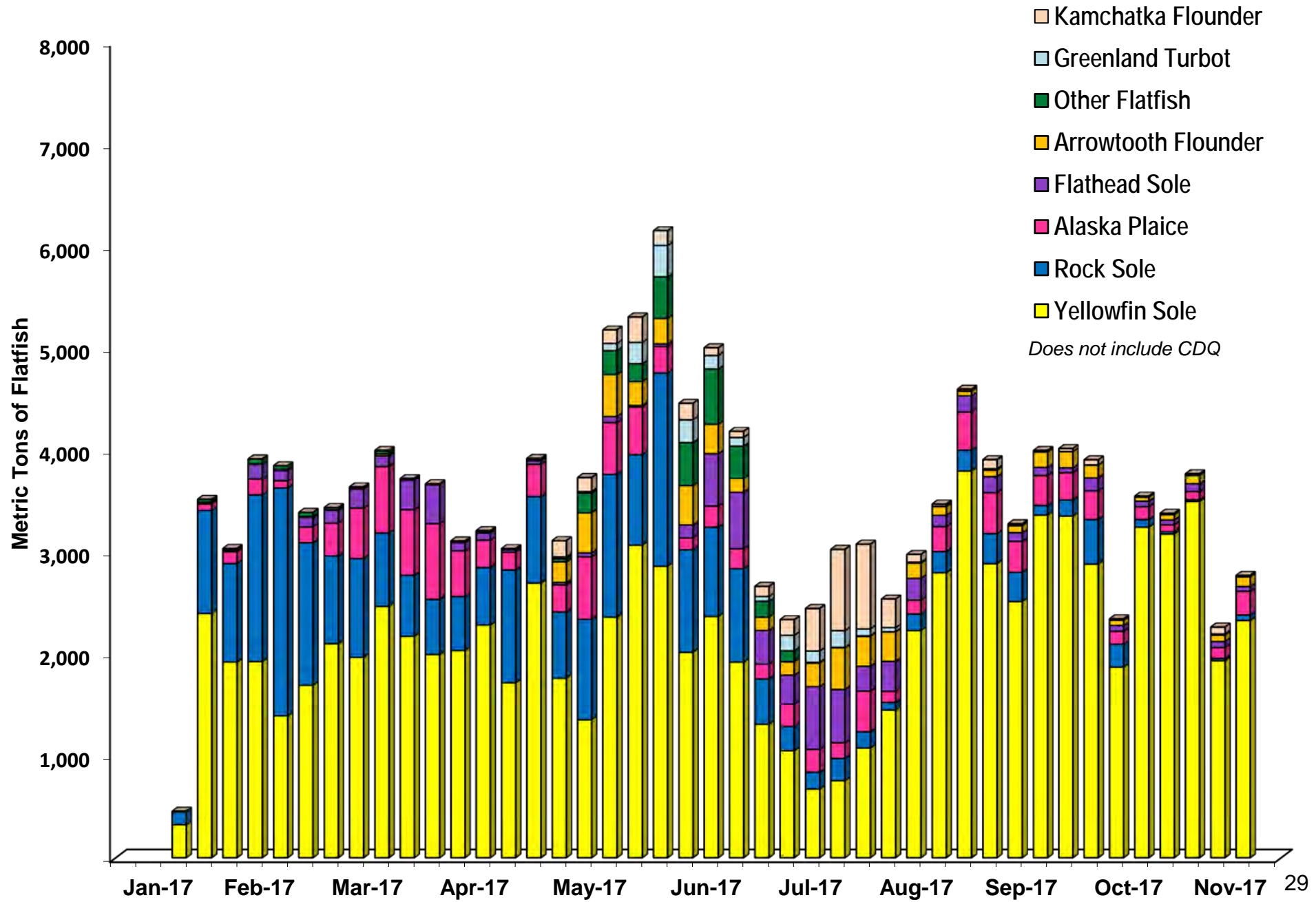

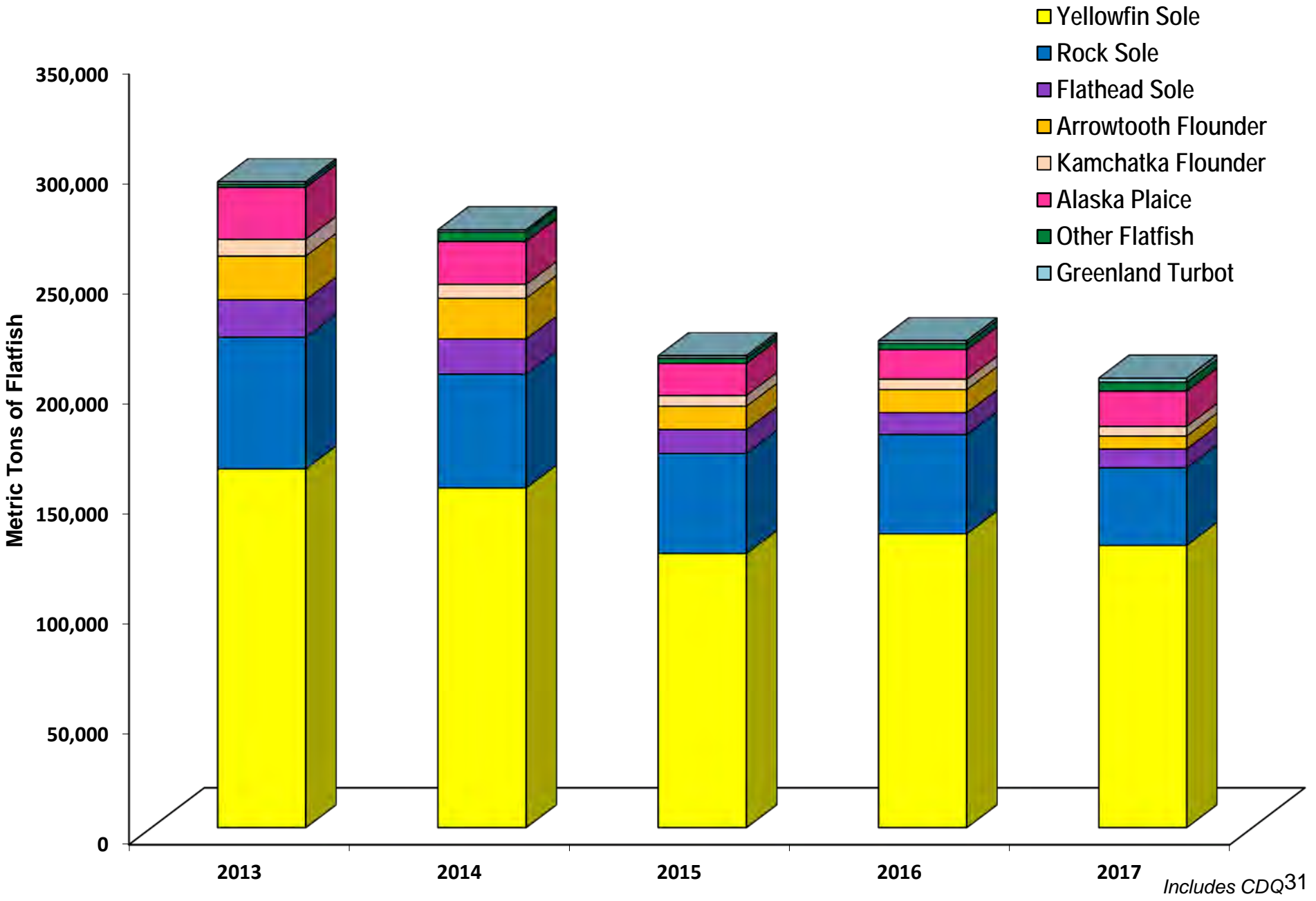
2017 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Amendment 80 Catcher/Processors

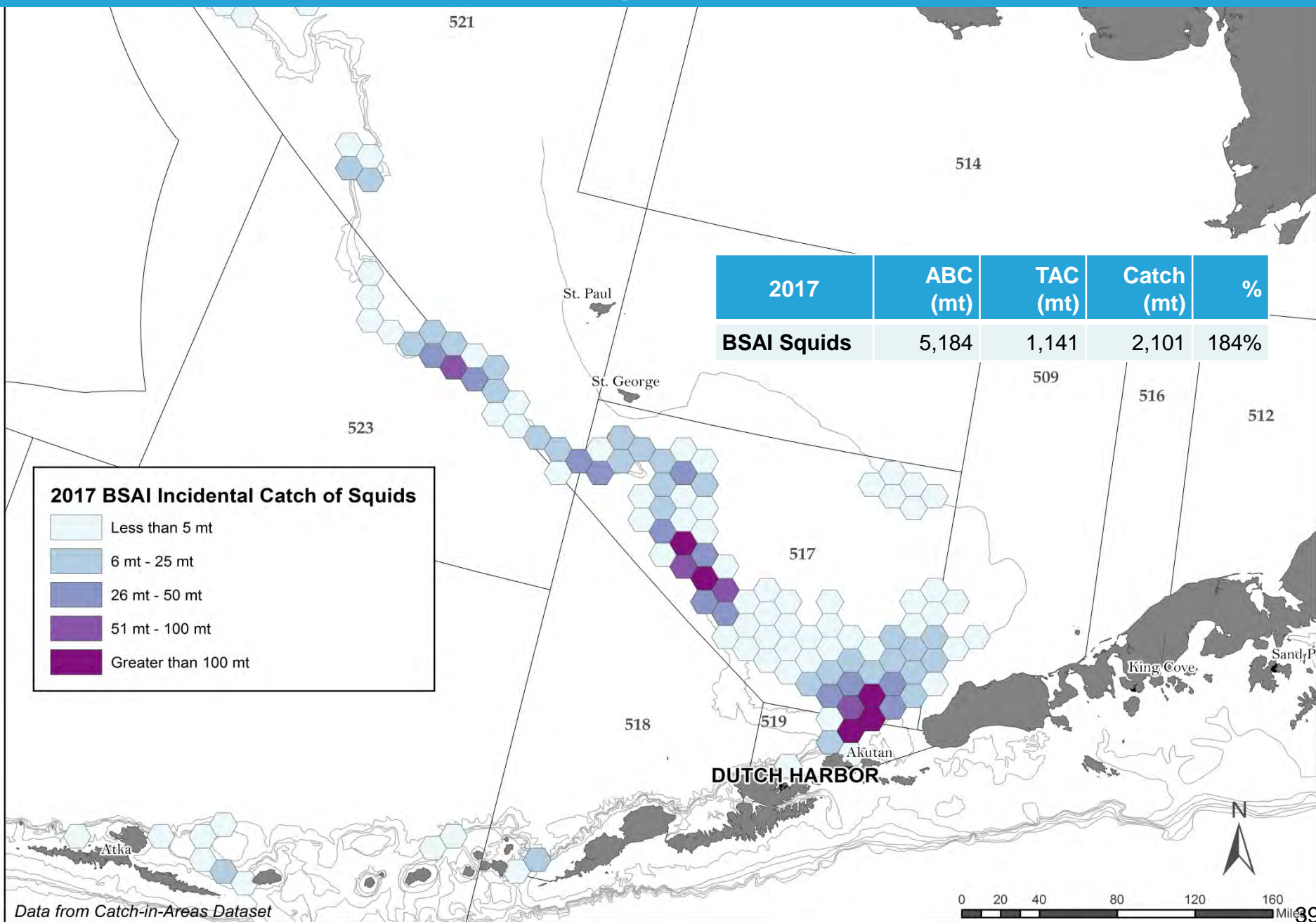
2017 Skates Catch

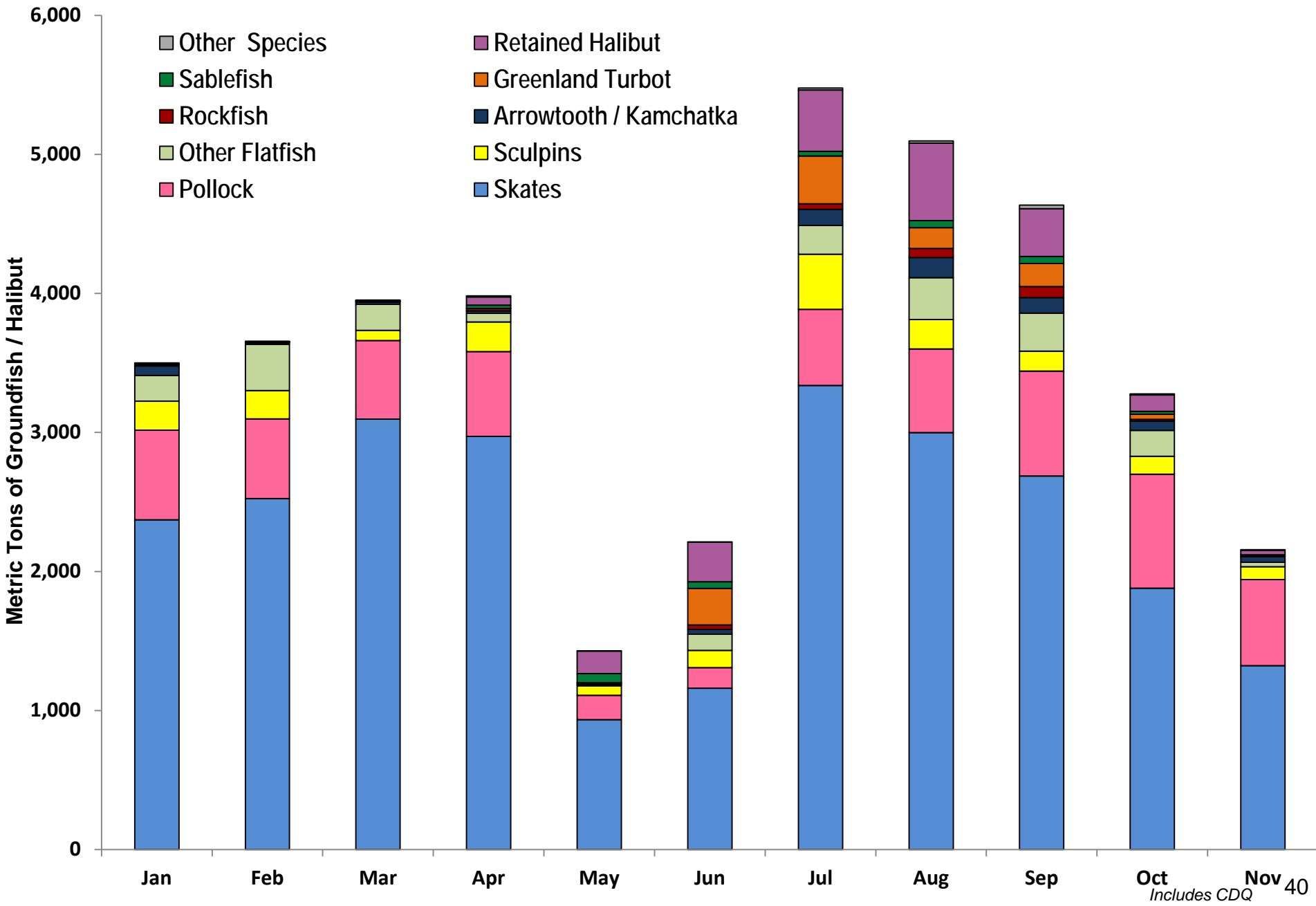


2017 Squids Catch



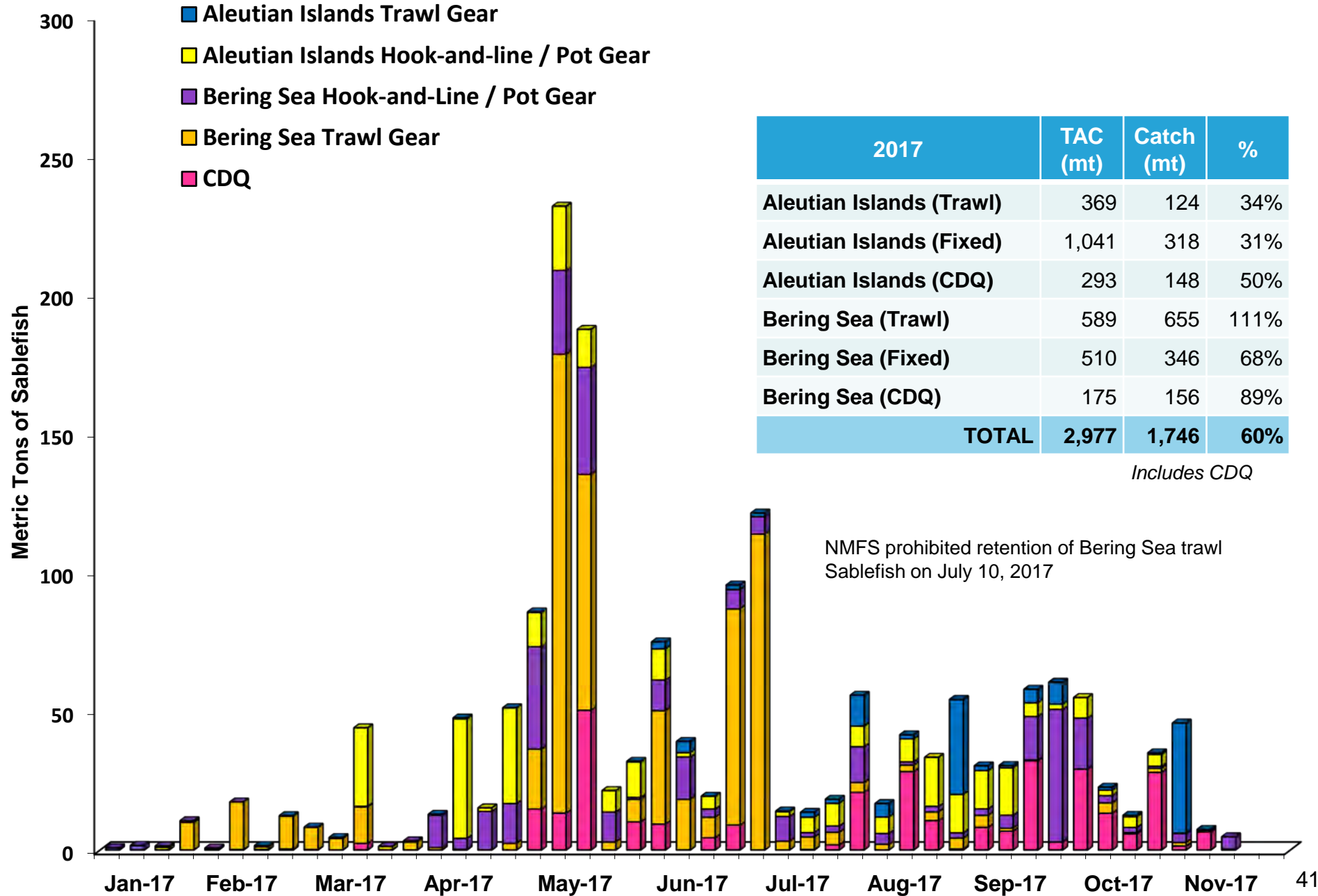

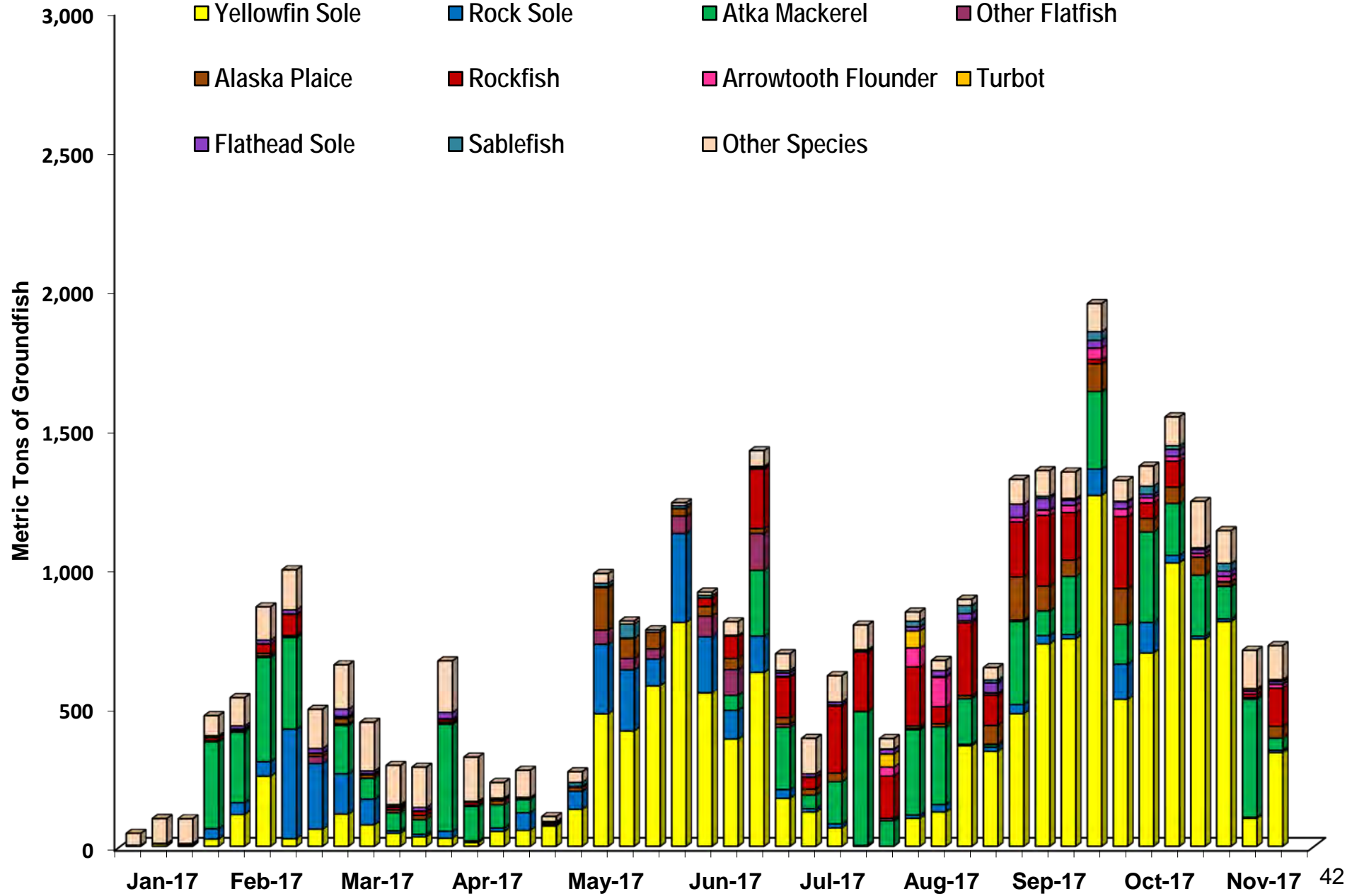

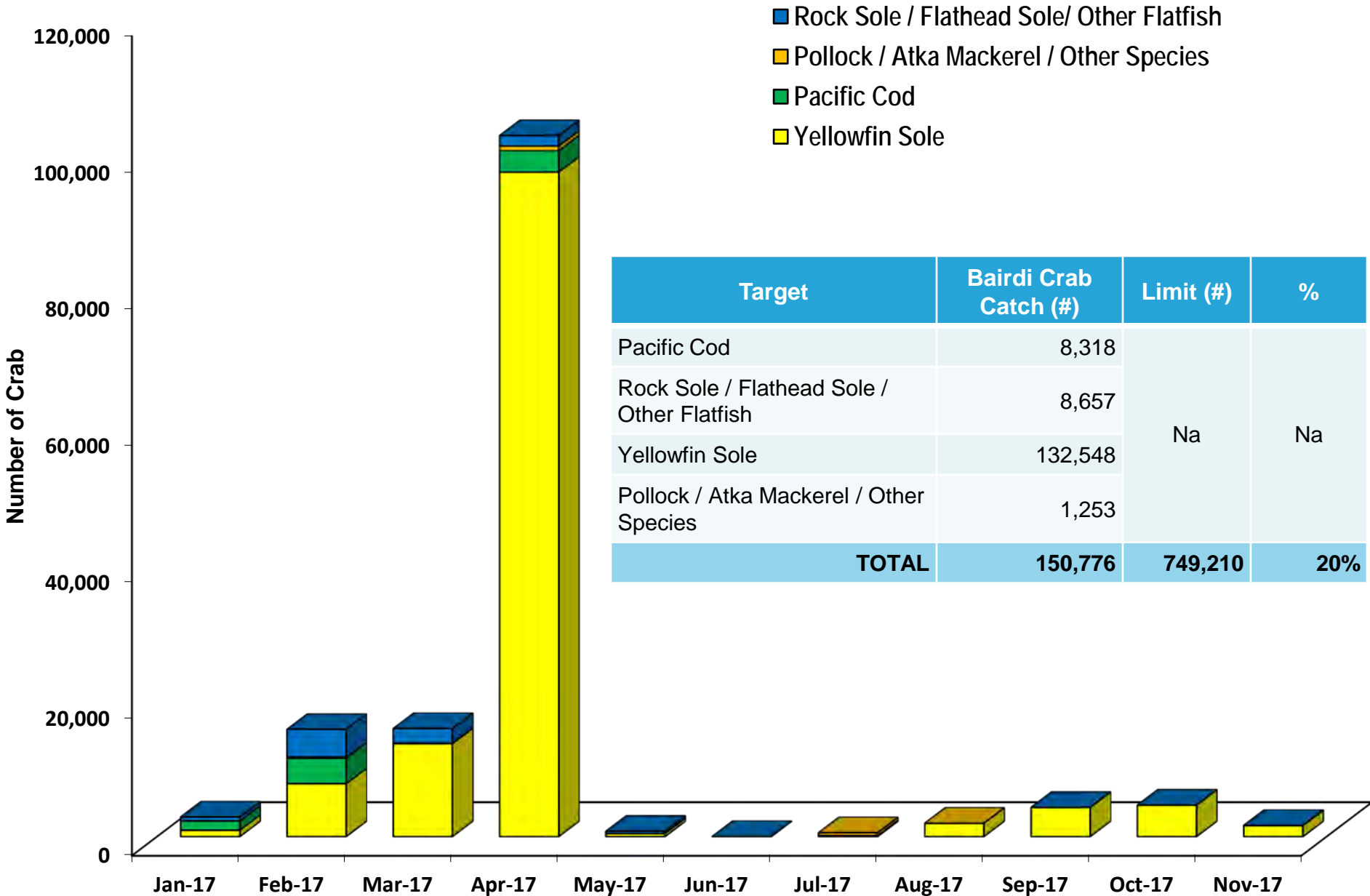
2017 COBLZ Trawl Opilio Crab Incidental Catch by Target

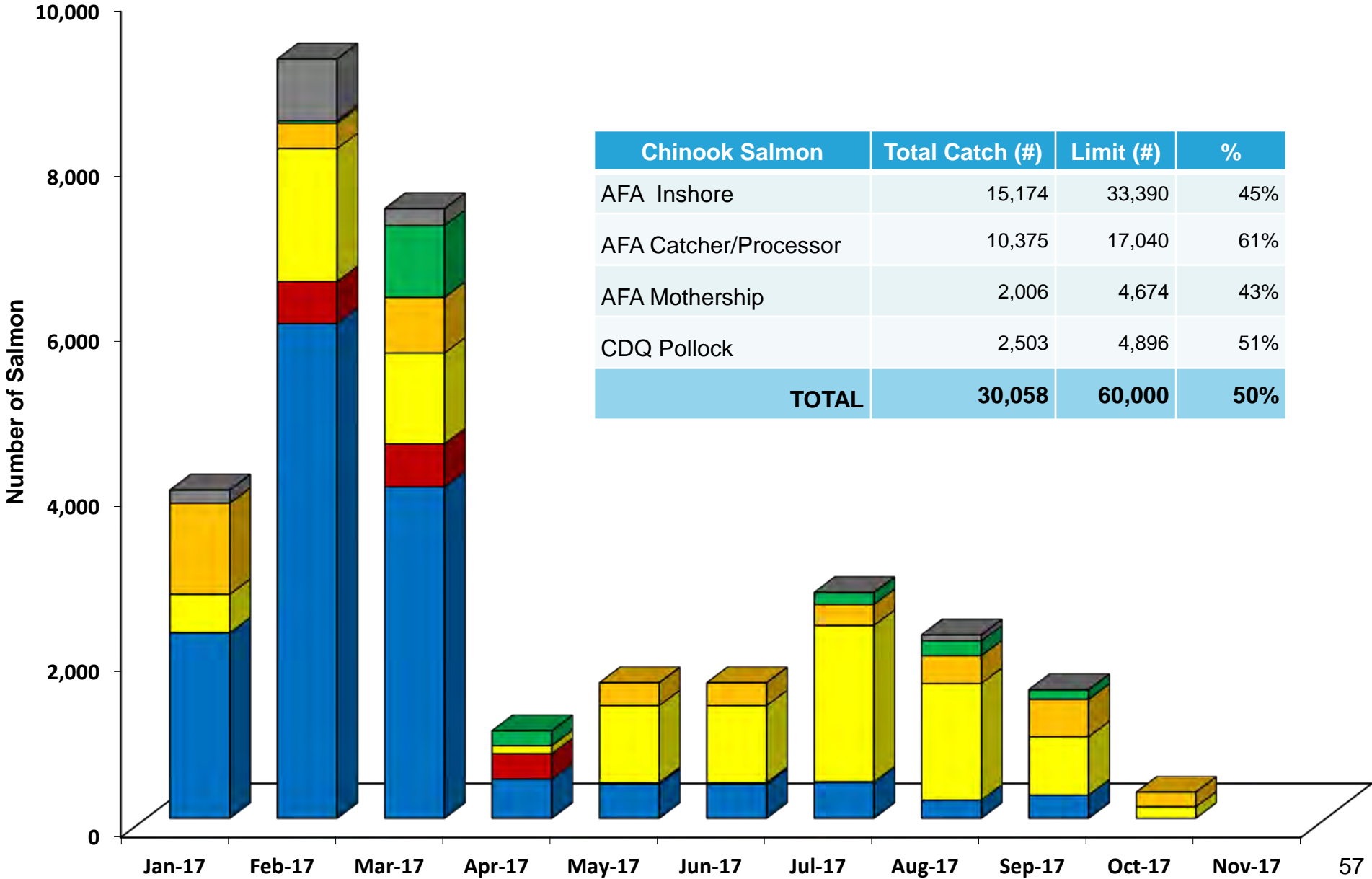
BSAI Trawl Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch

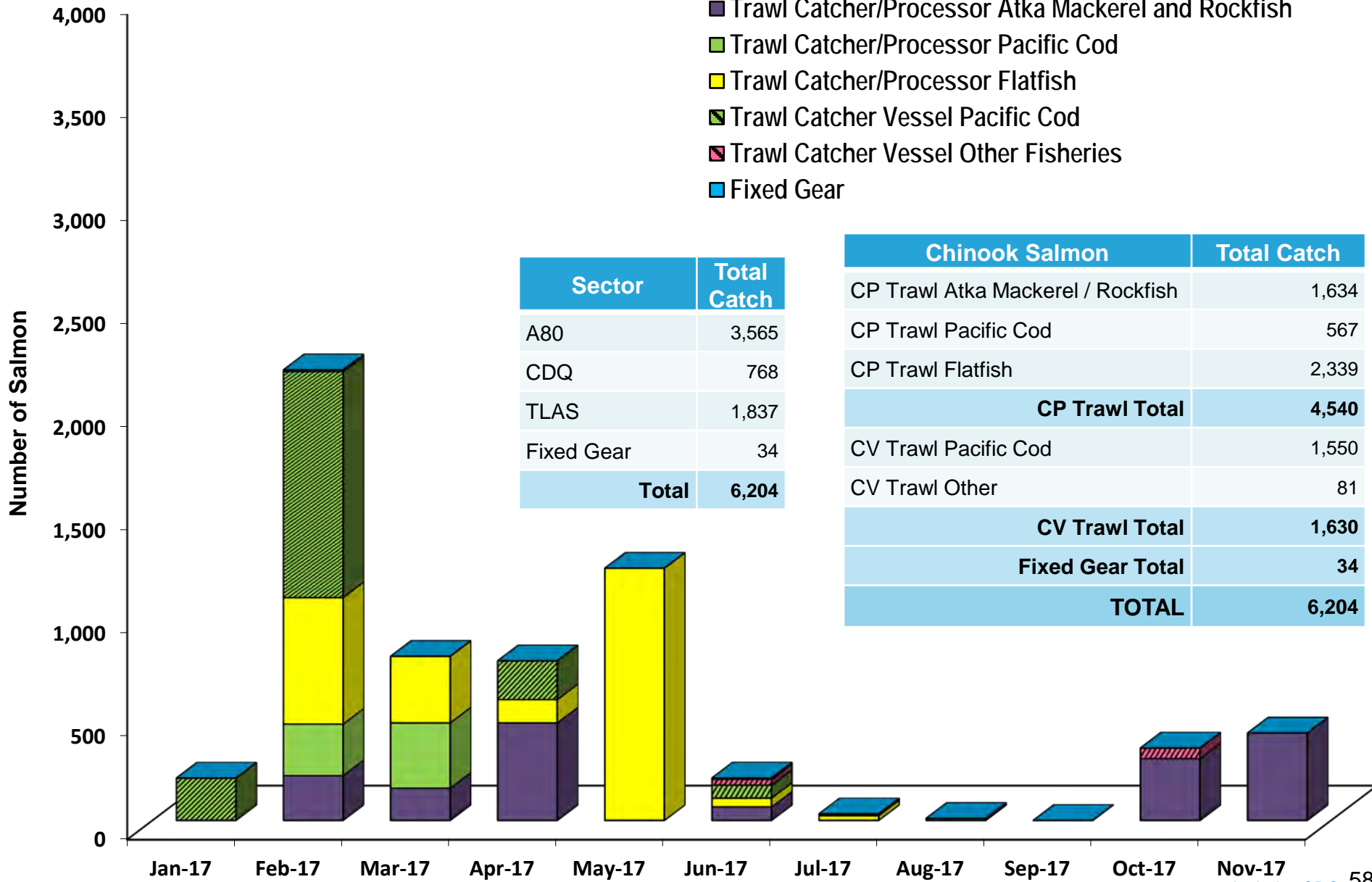

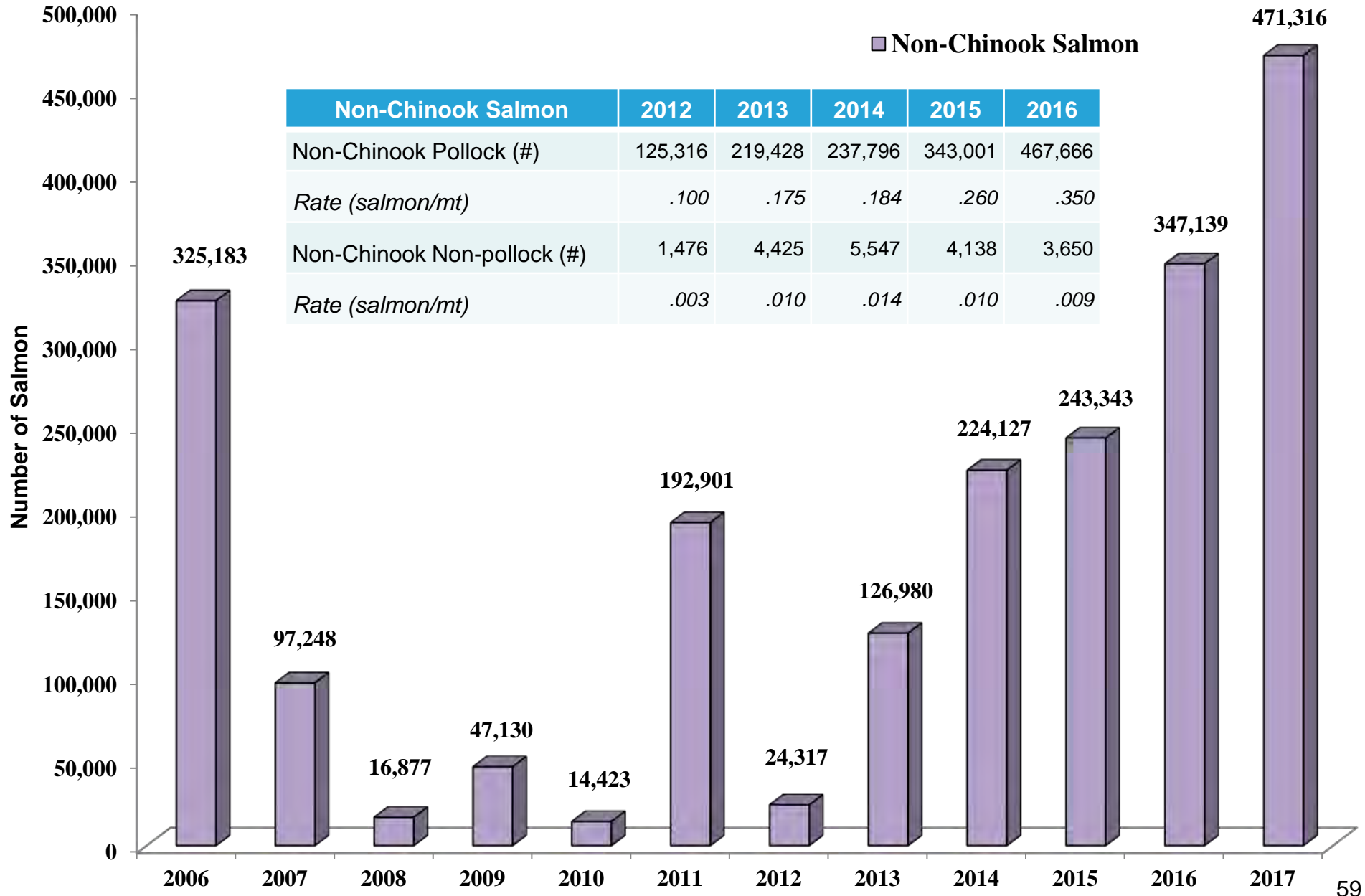

Incidental Catch by Fishery and Sector

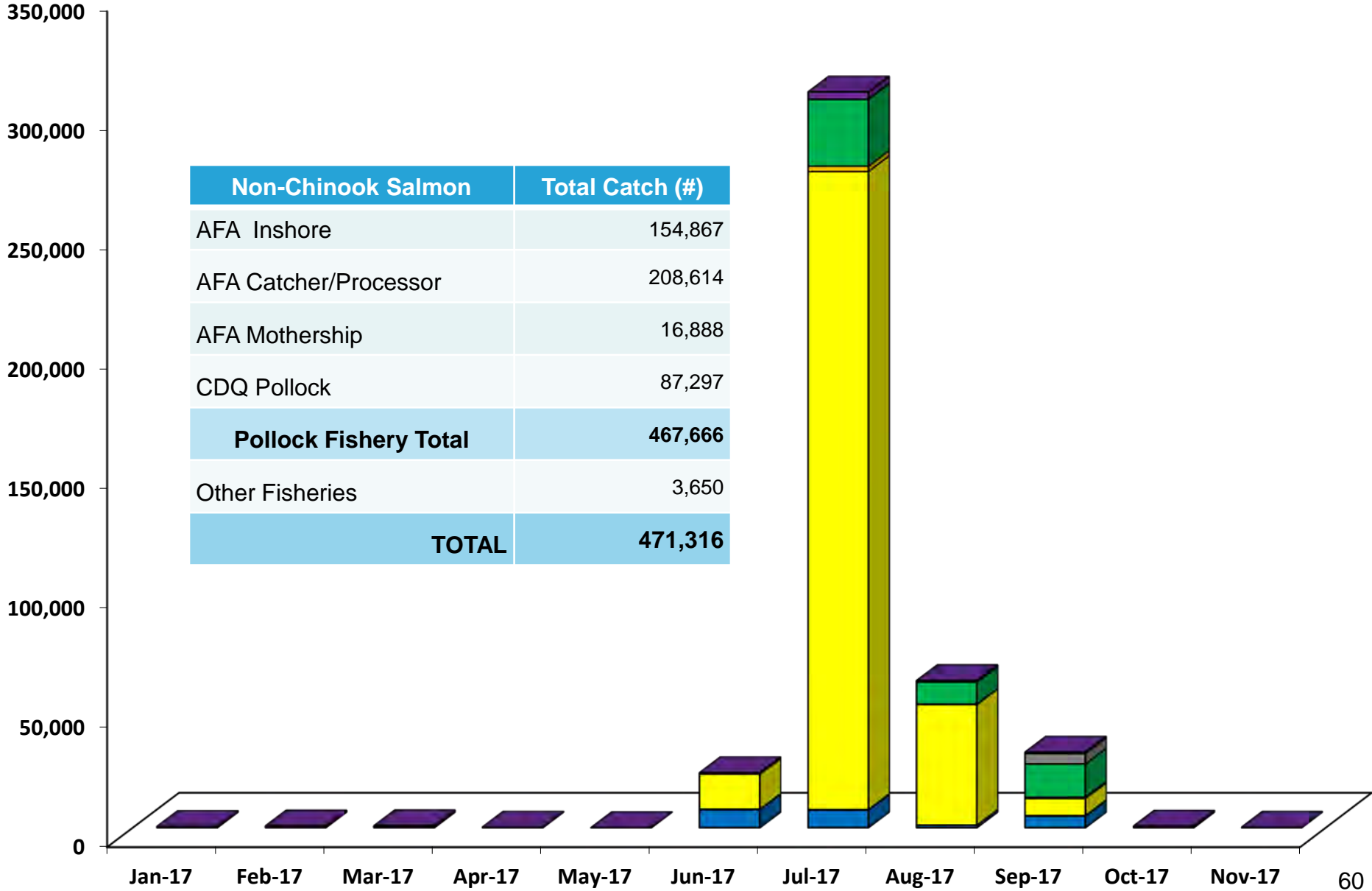


BSAI Trawl Non-Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch

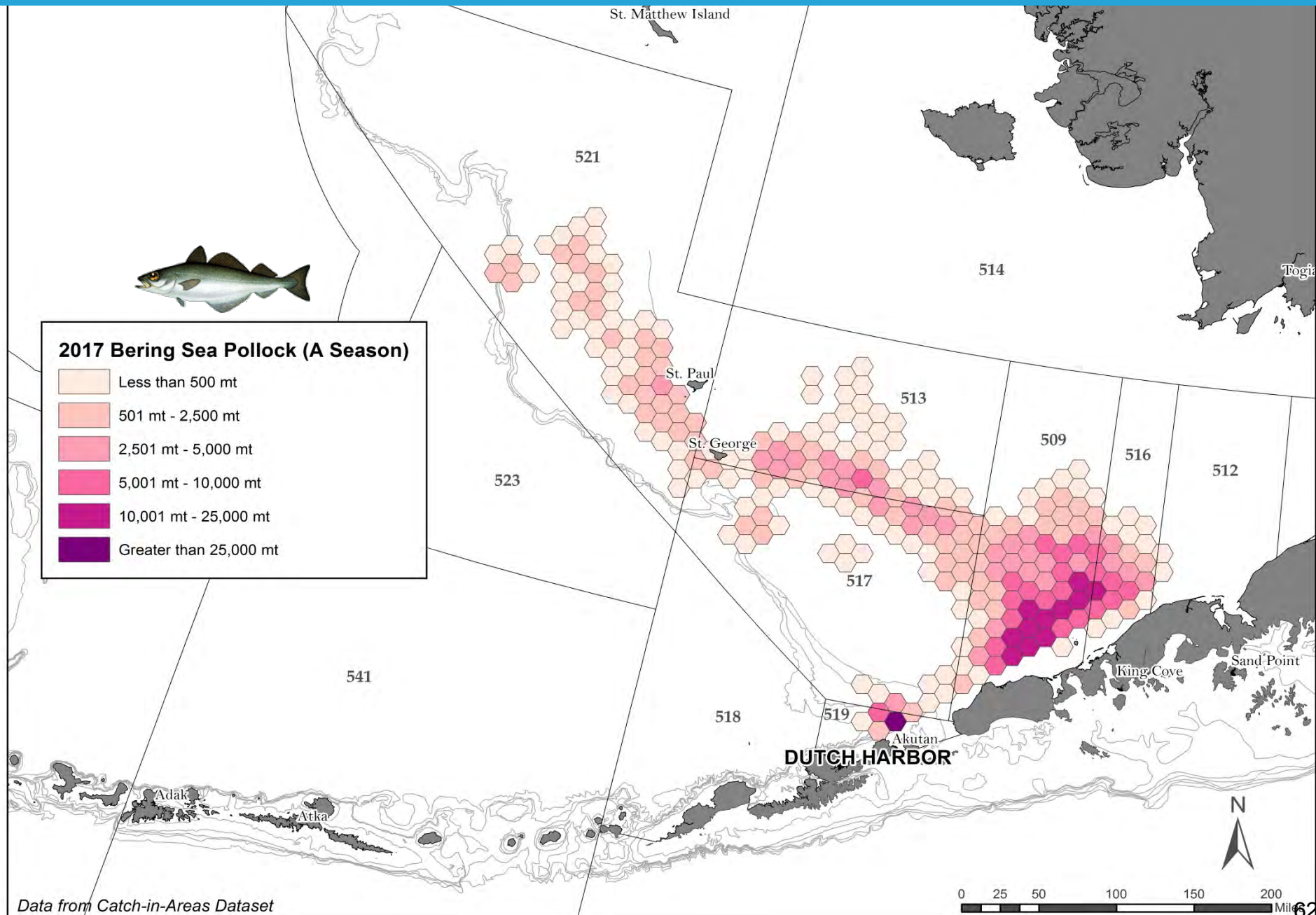

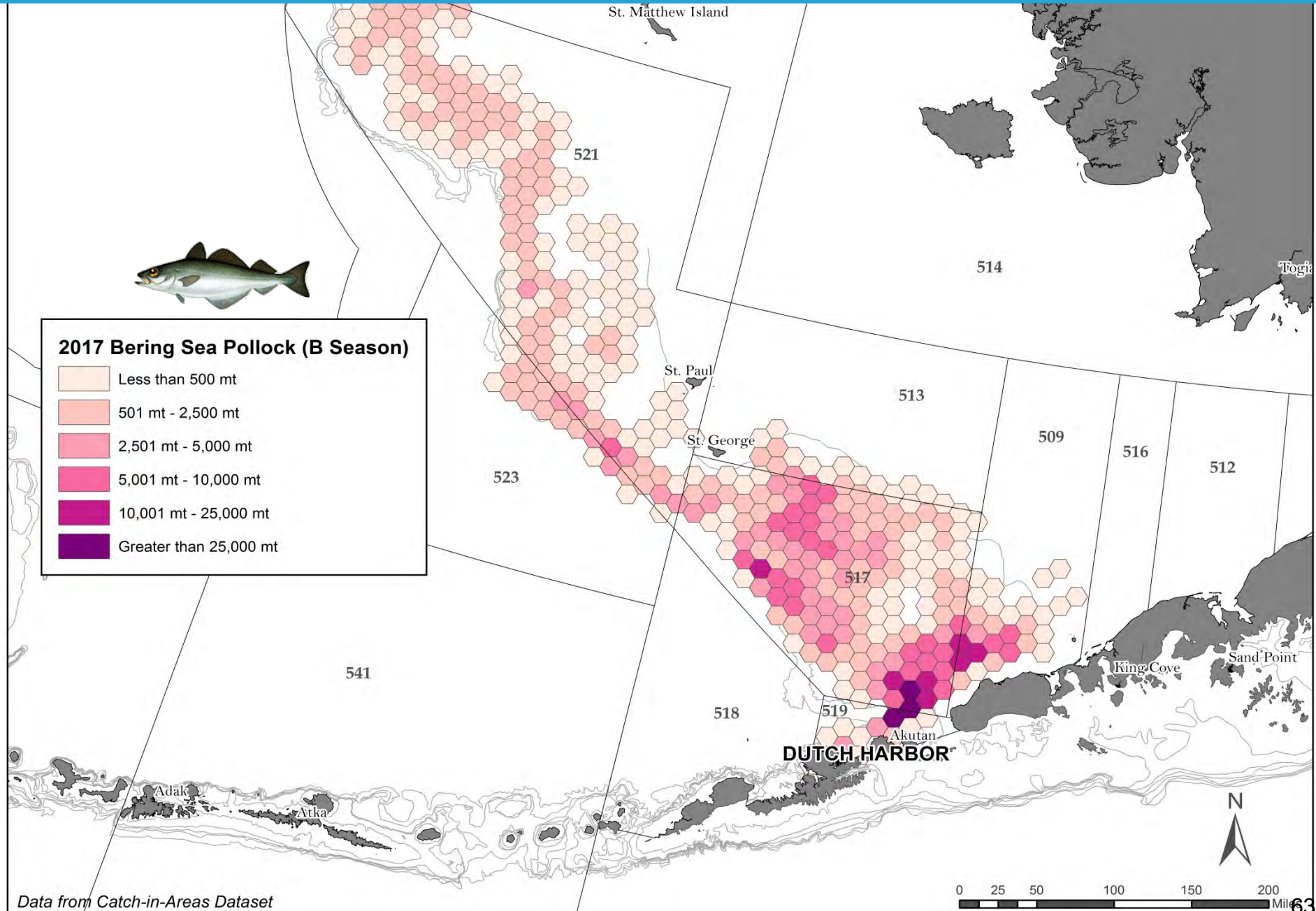
