

SUBJECT: DAP for 1988

**ACTION REQUIRED**

Review projected U.S. processed groundfish (DAP) for 1988.

**BACKGROUND**

NMFS has surveyed U.S. processors to determine their estimated groundfish needs for 1988. The results of the survey will be tabulated by species and area and placed under this tab when available. The purpose of this agenda item is to focus Council and industry attention on projected DAP for 1988 and provide opportunity for public comment. A list of the companies surveyed by NMFS will be available under this tab.

The DAP projections by species and area will be used in subsequent decisions on availability of groundfish for joint ventures and foreign directed fisheries under agenda items D-2 and D-3.

## DOCUMENTATION

## 1988 NMFS DAP SURVEY

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** Sent to fifty-two companies. Response received from fifty. Two non-respondents thought to be small operations. One response, received too late to be included in tables, included request for 8000 mt pollock in Western Gulf, and 13,600 mt P. cod and 2200 mt flatfish in same area. One respondent provided no data because of uncertainties whether four vessels he represented would operate in 1988.

**SHORESIDE REQUESTS:** Eighteen companies reported for 21 plants.

**CURRENT FLOATERS :** 22 companies reported for 32 vessels. Vessels included Six motherships, six longliners, one pot vessel and nineteen trawlers.

**NEW FLOATERS:** Fourteen companies reported for 21 vessels. Vessels included two strictly motherships, one mothership/trawler, twelve trawlers, and six longliners. Start-up dates are:

- January - four trawlers
- February - one mothership
- March - one mothership, one trawler
- May - three trawlers, one mothership
- July - one trawler
- August - one trawler
- October - two trawlers.

It appears that longliners will begin targetting on Pacific cod after sablefish is closed; specific start-up date unspecified.

**SPECIES INFORMATION:**

**Pollock :** only four companies did not request at least bycatch amount of pollock.

**Pacific cod:** only six companies did not request Pacific cod.

**Greenland turbot :** Seventeen companies representing four shoreside plants and 27 floaters requested G. turbot.

**Rock Sole/Flatfish :** Twenty companies representing 28 operations requested one (or usually, both) species. Twelve were shoreside plants.

**Yellowfin sole:** Six companies representing sixteen vessels requested this species
