
2022 GOA Total Groundfish Catch by Gear all Confederation Sees on Might Report December 2022




2022 Gulf of Alaska Pollock Directed Fist 904 Inseason Mgmt Report December 2022








2022 Gulf of Alaska Pacific Cod Catch by Track Insert Report December 2022




2022 Gulf of Alaska Pacific Cod Catch by Non-Backar Pacific Cod Catch Catch



2022 Western GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week 2011 Telephore 2022






2022 Central GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week Bankul Report December 2022







Central GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Sector






2022 GOA Rougheye/Blackspotted Rockfist GO Character Mgmt Report December 2022





2022 GOA Thornyhead Rockfish Cate GOA Inseason Mgmt Report December 2022













Sablefish Catch by Trawl Vessels B2 GOA Inseason Mgmt Report December 2022






2022 Sablefish and Incidental Catch in Fixed Gear Sablefishing Tiggres






GOA C. Bairdi Tanner Crab Incidental Catch by Targets




Chinook Salmon PSC in Western GOA Pollock God Inselson Mgmt Report December 2022




Chinook Salmon PSC in Central GOA Pollock Fisheries




Chinook Salmon PSC in B2 GOA Inseason Mgmt Report December 2022 Non-Pollock / Non-Rockfish Program by CV




