




2018 GOA Total Groundfish Catch by Gear and Sector




GOA Total Groundfish Catch and Maximum Weekly Harvest




2018 Gulf of Alaska Pollock Directed Fishery




2018 Pollock Catch in the GOA




2011 – 2018 Counts of Vessels Targeting GOA Pollock




2018 Gulf of Alaska Pacific Cod Catch by Trawl Gear




2018 Gulf of Alaska Pacific Cod Catch by Non-Trawl Gear




2017 Western GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week and Sector




2018 Western GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week and Sector




2011 – 2018 Counts of Catcher Vessels Targeting Western GOA Pacific Cod




2011 – 2018 Western GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Sector






2017 Central GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week and Sector




2018 Central GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Week and Sector




2011 – 2018 Counts of Catcher Vessels Targeting Central GOA Pacific Cod




2011 – 2018 Central GOA Pacific Cod Catch by Sector








2018 Central GOA Trawl Rockfish Program Fishery by Month








2018 GOA Shortraker Rockfish Catch




2018 GOA Rougheye/Blackspotted Rockfish Catch




2018 GOA Thornyhead Rockfish Catch














2018 Sablefish and Incidental Catch in Fixed Gear Sablefish Targets




2018 GOA Longnose Skate and Other Skates








2014 – 2018 GOA *C. Bairdi* Tanner Crab Incidental Catch by Target




2014 – 2018 Chinook Salmon PSC in Western GOA Pollock Fisheries




2014 – 2018 Chinook Salmon PSC in Central GOA Pollock Fisheries




2014 – 2018 Chinook Salmon PSC in Non-Pollock / Non-Rockfish Program by Catcher Vessels




