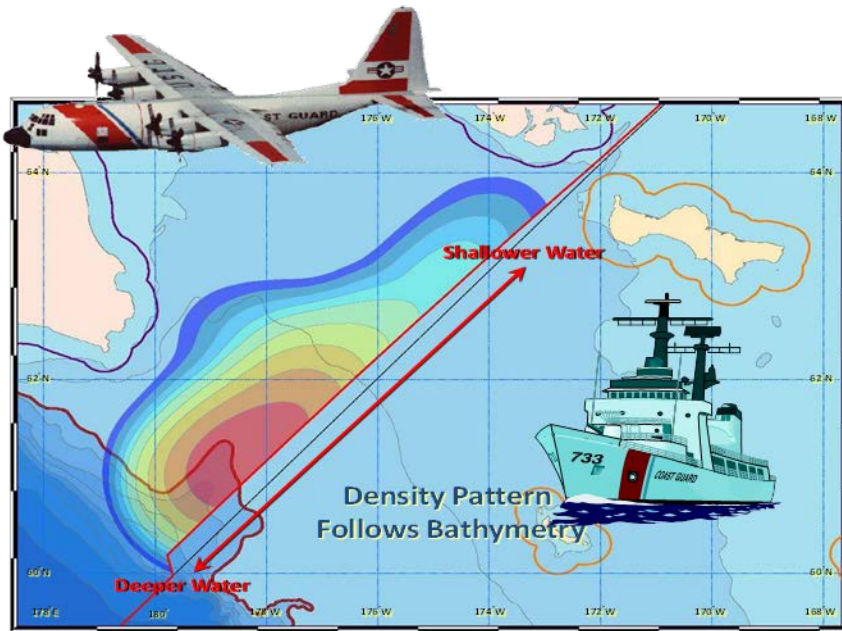

- 0-1 vessels daily average

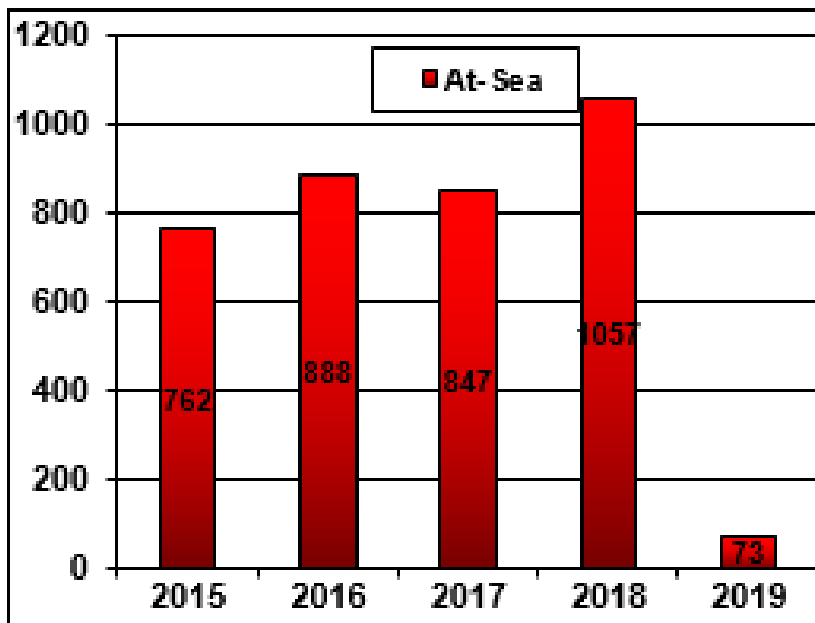

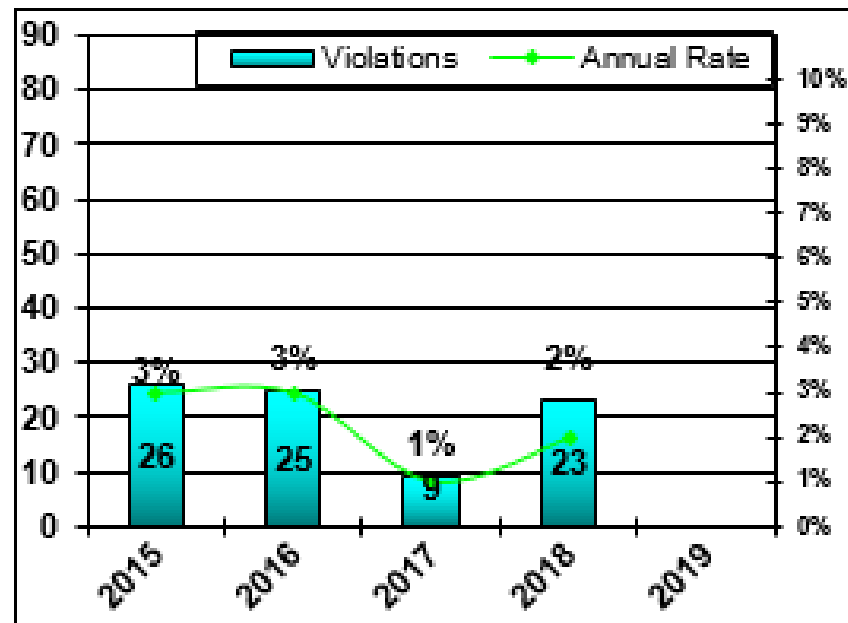

- No fisheries violations

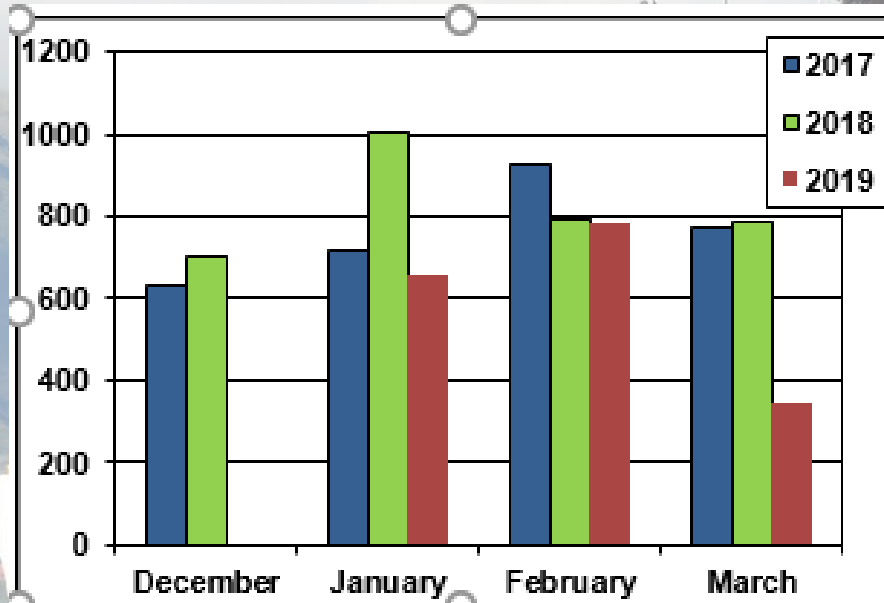
Charter & Recreational/Subsistence Halibut

- No fisheries violations

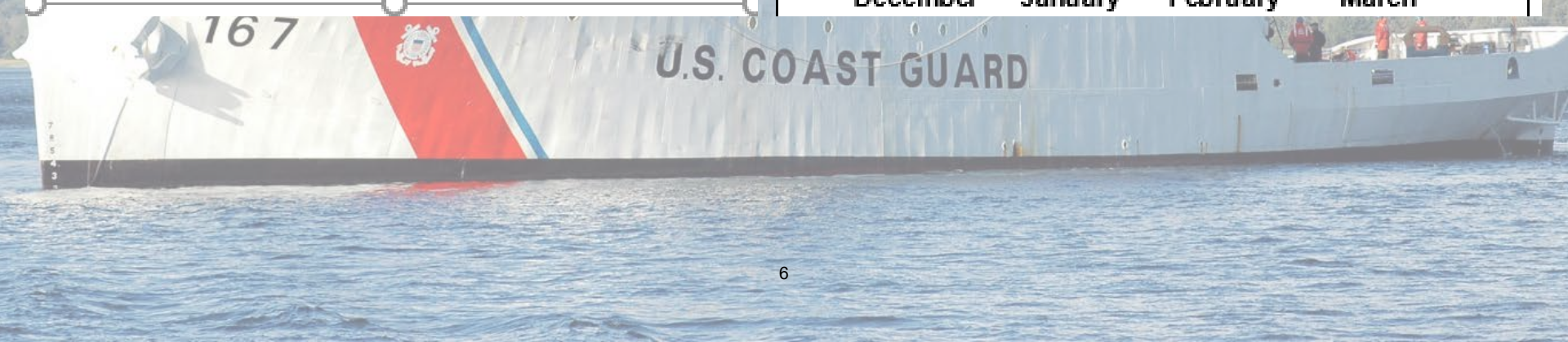
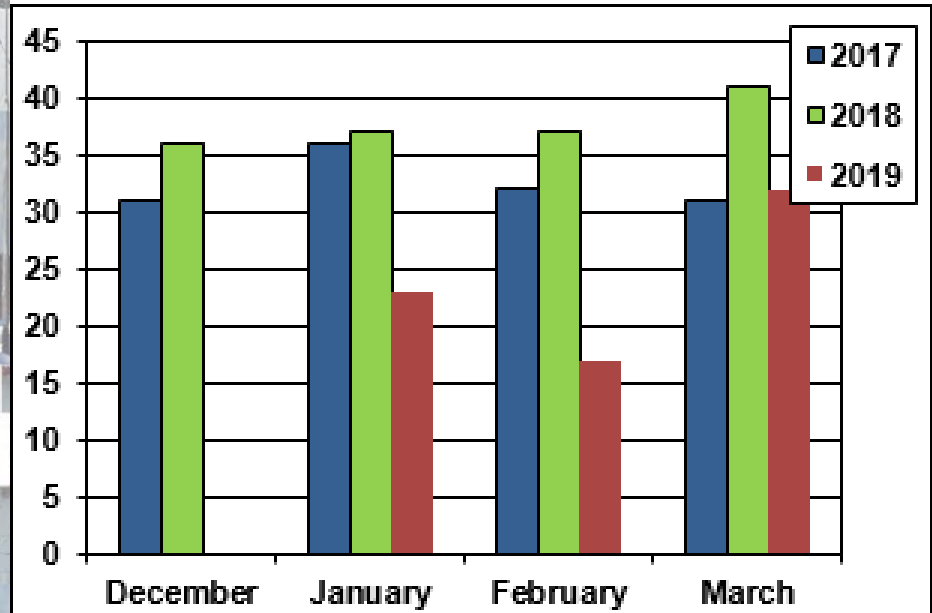


Cutter Resource Allocation December- March

Major Cutter Days

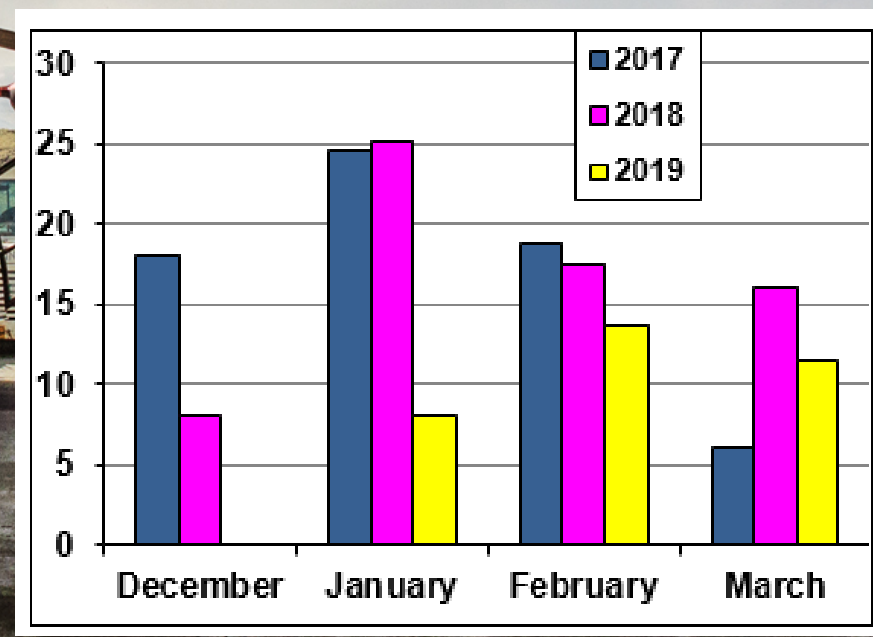
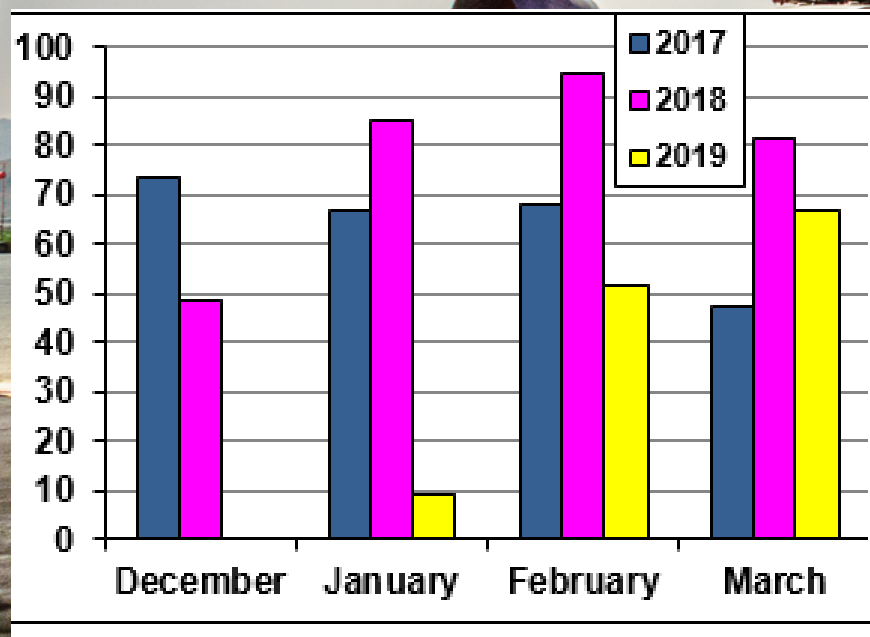




Aircraft Resource Allocation December- March
