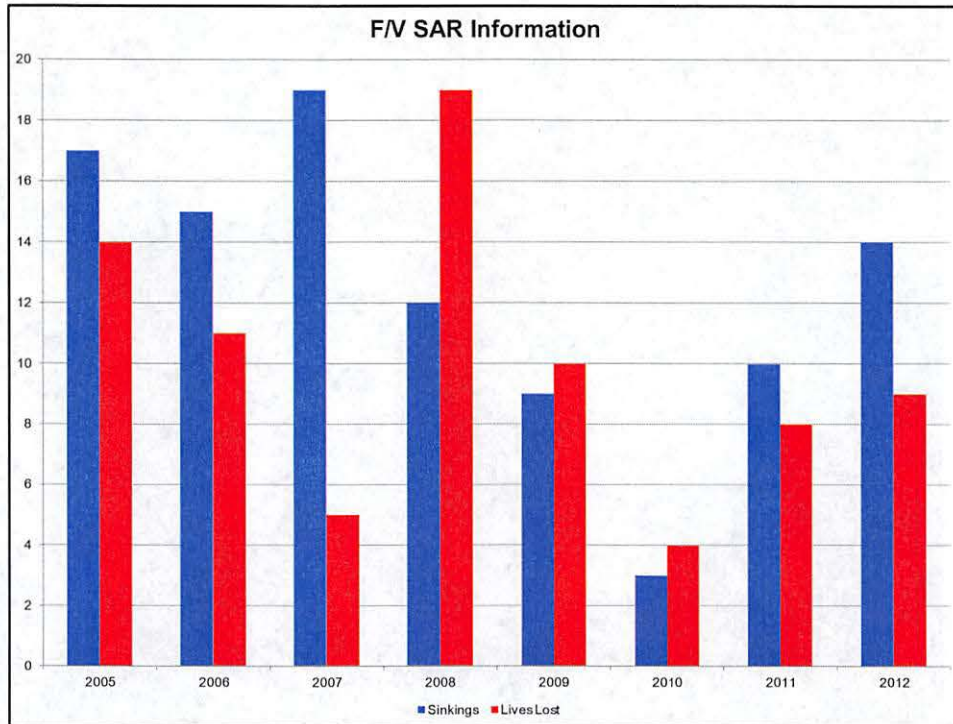




**Search and Rescue**

- 79 Vessels – 177 Safety Violations
- 22 Voyage Terminations

### • Most Common Violations

- Insufficient/Unserviceable Immersion Suits (22)
- Visual Distress Signals (21)
- Type IV PFD/Life Ring (18)
- Insufficient/Unserviceable Fire Fighting Equipment (16)
- Missing/Expired Life Raft (15)
- Expired/Unregistered EPIRB (13)

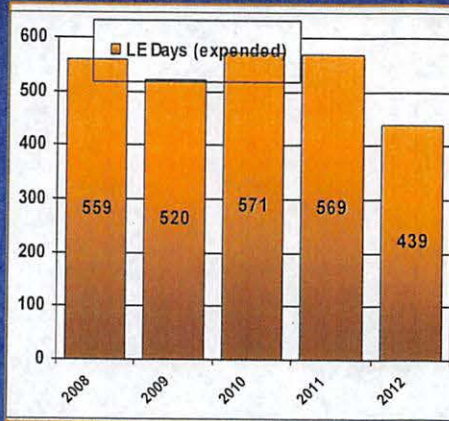




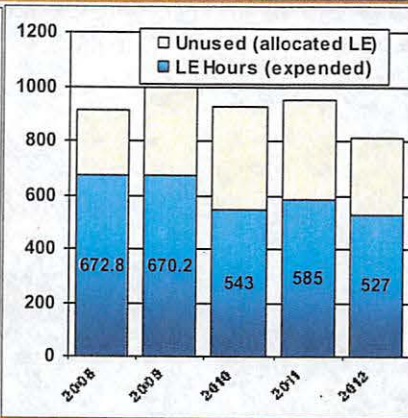


## Major Cutter & C-130 Effort

### Major Cutter Days

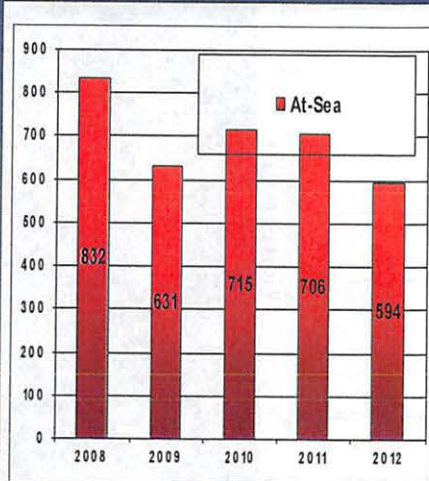

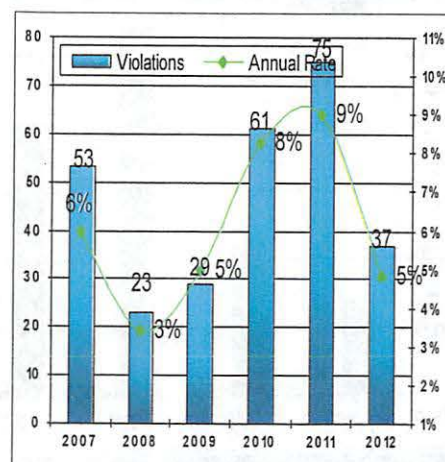

### Vessels With Violations





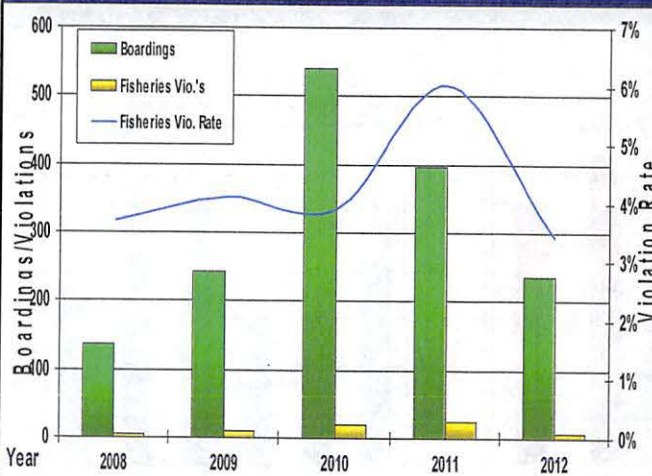
## 2012 Fishing Violations

- 3 - Failure to meet required observer coverage rates

- 1 - Halibut Closed Season Violations
- 1 - Illegal Subsistence Halibut fishing

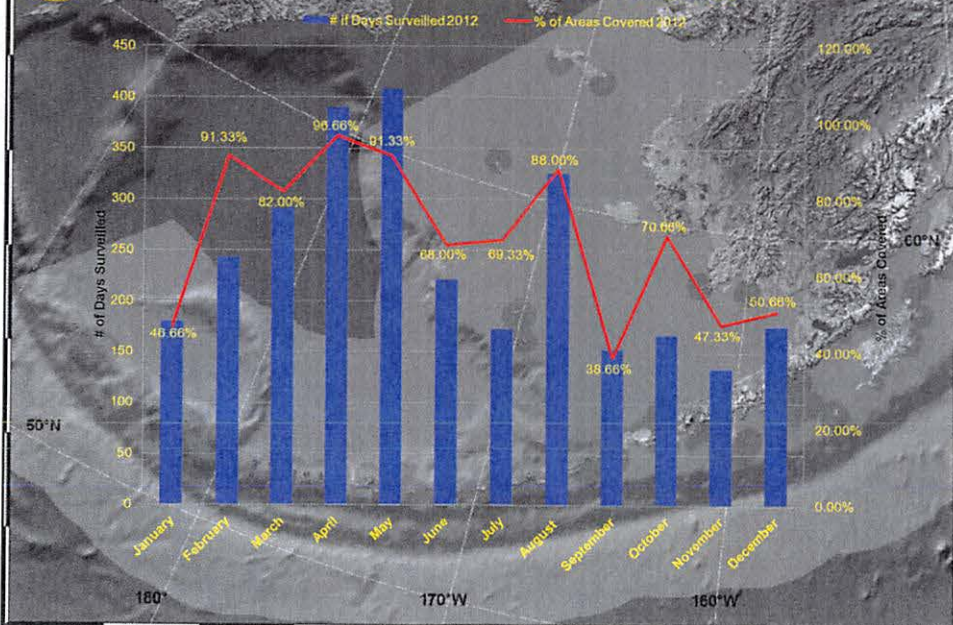

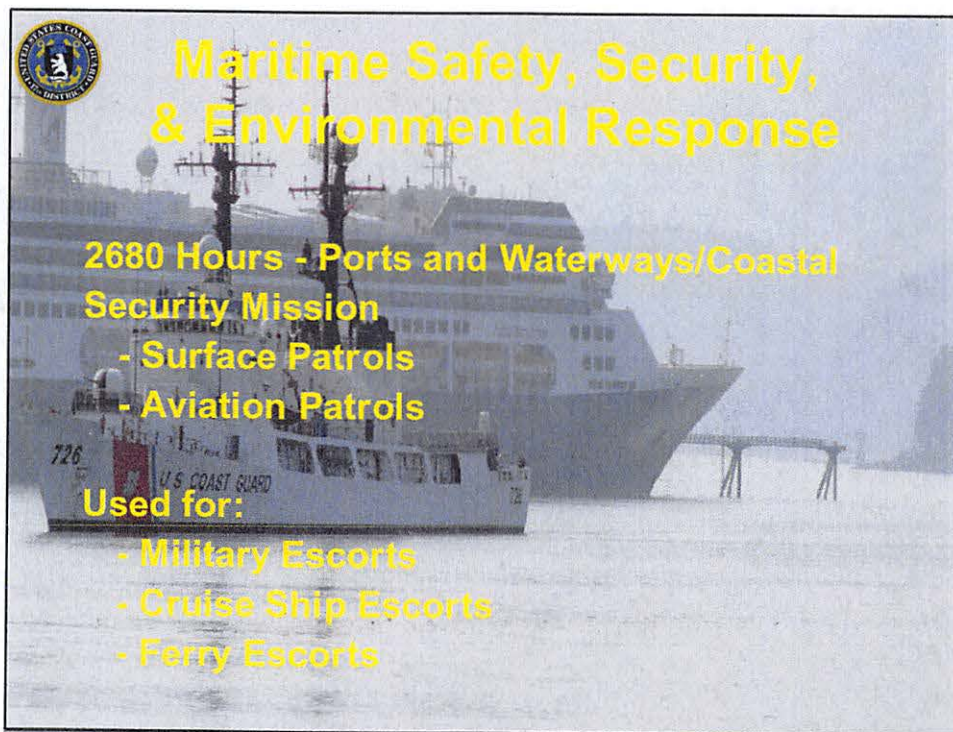
