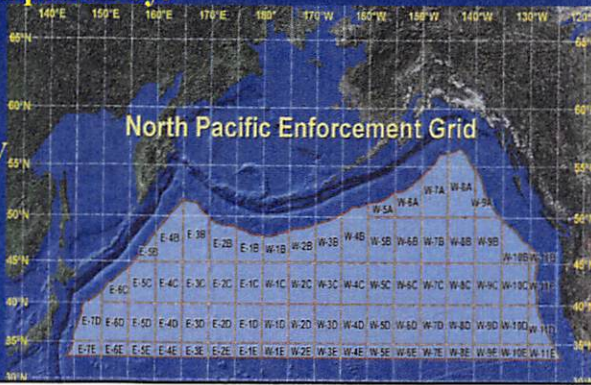

- HSDN Deployment wrapped up on 01 Nov 2011
 - Surface Patrols
 - 100 day patrol by USCGC MUNRO
 - 30 day patrol by Russian patrol vessel
 - Chinese patrol vessel (diverted for SAR)
- 376 hours of aviation patrols by:
 - USCG C-130
 - Canadian DFO CP-140
 - Japanese CG Gulfstream V
 - Russian Aircraft

 - FF/V BANGUN PERKASA
 - Seized and turned over to NOAA for prosecution on 16 Oct 2011
 - FF/V SHUN LI NO.6
 - Unknown location

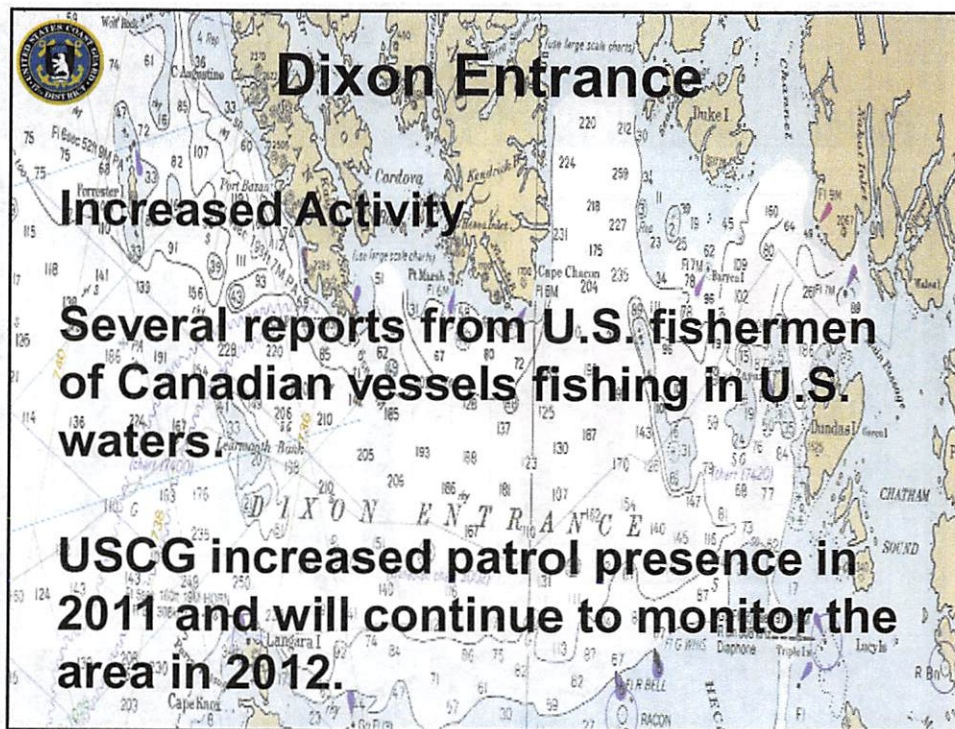
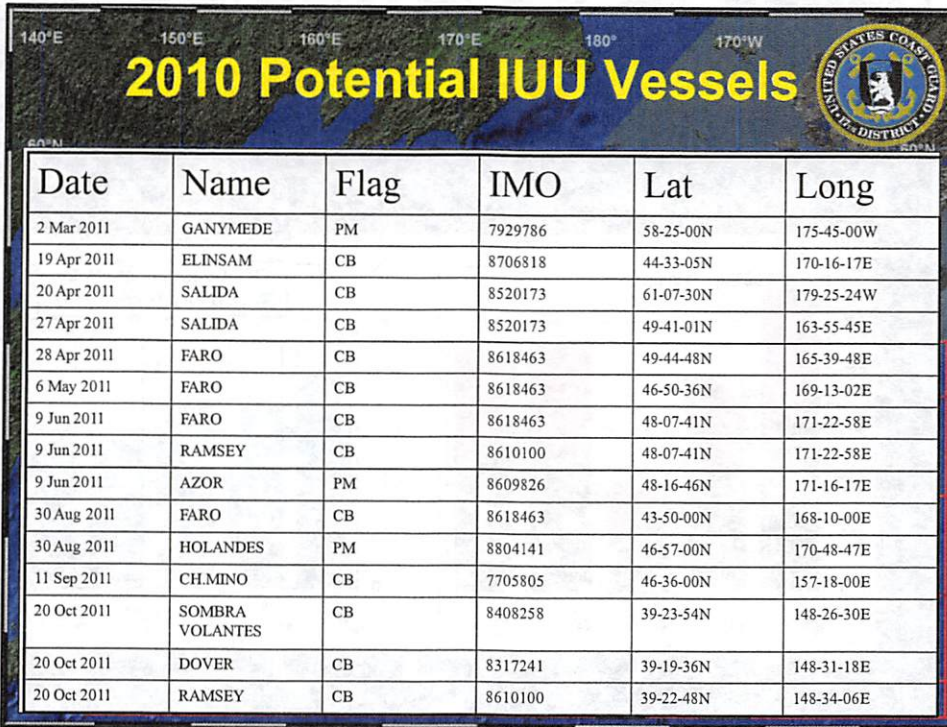


Maritime Boundary Line

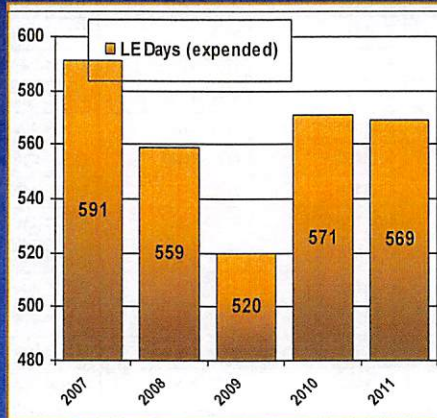




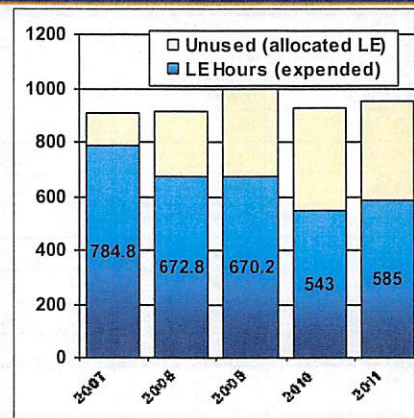


Major Cutter & C-130 Effort

Major Cutter Days

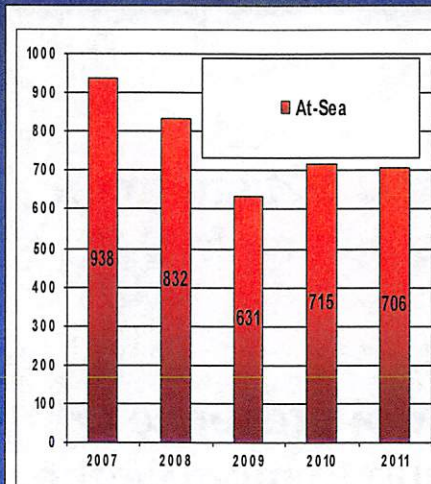


C-130 Hours

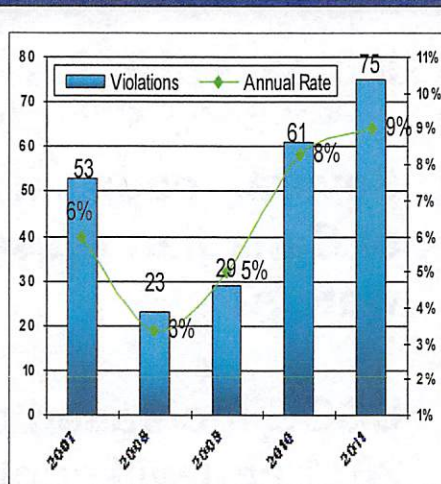

Vessels With Violations



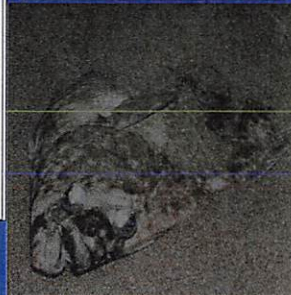
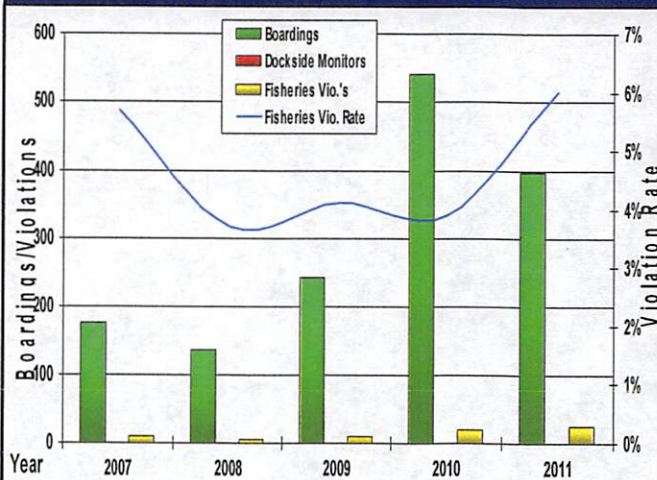

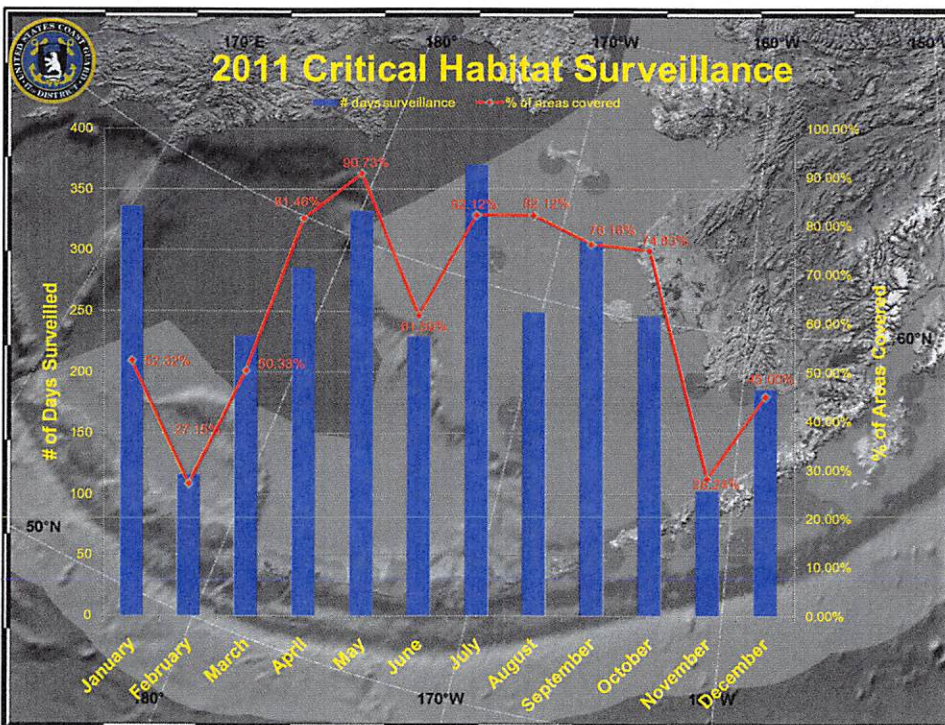
