1. U. S. COAST GUARD ENFORCEMENT EFFORT FOR 1986.

a. U. S. Coast Guard enforcement efforts for calendar year 1986, through 30 November, have totalled 512 cutter days and 1,323 aircraft patrol hours. Coast Guard ships and aircraft have patrolled over 15 million square miles of ocean in the Bering Sea, Gulf of Alaska, and North Pacific Ocean. To date, a total of 123 notices of violation and written warnings have been issued foreign fishing vessels.

b. The most significant MFCMA enforcement incident since the last council meeting was the alleged sexual harassment and assault of a female NMFS observer assigned to the South Korean stern trawler SHIN YANG HO. The vessel was seized 5 November 1986 by the cutter MORGENTHAU and escorted to Kodiak where it was held until a release bond was posted.

2. MFCMA INFRACTIONS.

a. 1 September 1986. USCGC BOUTWELL issued a notice of violation to the Japanese snail pot vessel KAIYU MARU NO. 5 for failure to have a radio beacon and light attached to its gear as required. A written warning was also issued to the vessel for failure to provide a proper boarding ladder.

b. 11 September 1986. USCGC YOCONA issued a written warning to the Japanese stern trawler YAMASAN MARU NO. 102 for failure to properly maintain their Daily Catch Log.

c. 12 September 1986. USCGC MUNRO issued two notices of violation to the South Korean stern trawler NAMBUG for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log and for failure to return prohibited species (crab) to the sea as soon as possible after retrieval of net.

d. 22 September 1986. USCGC YOCONA issued a written warning to the Polish stern trawler PROFESOR BOGUCKI for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log.

e. 18 October 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler KASHIMA MARU NO. 8 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder.

f. 20 October 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler FUKUYOSHI MARU NO. 38 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder.

g. 30 October 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the U.S. stern trawler NORTHERN GLACIER for failure to return prohibited species (halibut and tanner crab) to the sea immediately.

h. 31 October 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler ANYO MARU NO. 18 for failure to accurately maintain it's Daily Joint Venture Log.

i. 3 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued two notices of violation to the Japanese long liner RYUSHO MARU NO. 15 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder and for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log.

j. 3 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese long liner KOEI MARU NO. 10 for storing non-fisheries material (conveyor belts) beneath fish products in the freezer holds.

k. 4 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued two notices of violation to the Japanese stern trawler AKEBONO MARU NO. 27 for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log and for failure to submit weekly Mammal Reports.

l. 4 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler KAIYO MARU NO. 11 for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log.

m. 5 November 1986. USCGC MORGENTHAU seized the South Korean stern trawler SHIN YANG HO for the alleged sexual harassment and assault of the embarked NMFS observer.

n. 6 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Polish stern trawler AMAREL for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log.

o. 8 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler SHINEI MARU NO. 63 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder.

p. 8 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler ANYO MARU NO. 11 for failure to monitor 2182khz and 500khz during the required periods of the day.

q. 8 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler KYOWA MARU NO. 15 for failure to properly maintain it's Daily Catch Log.

r. 9 November 1986. USCGC JARVIS issued a notice of violation to the Japanese stern trawler SEITOKU MARU NO. 106 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder.
