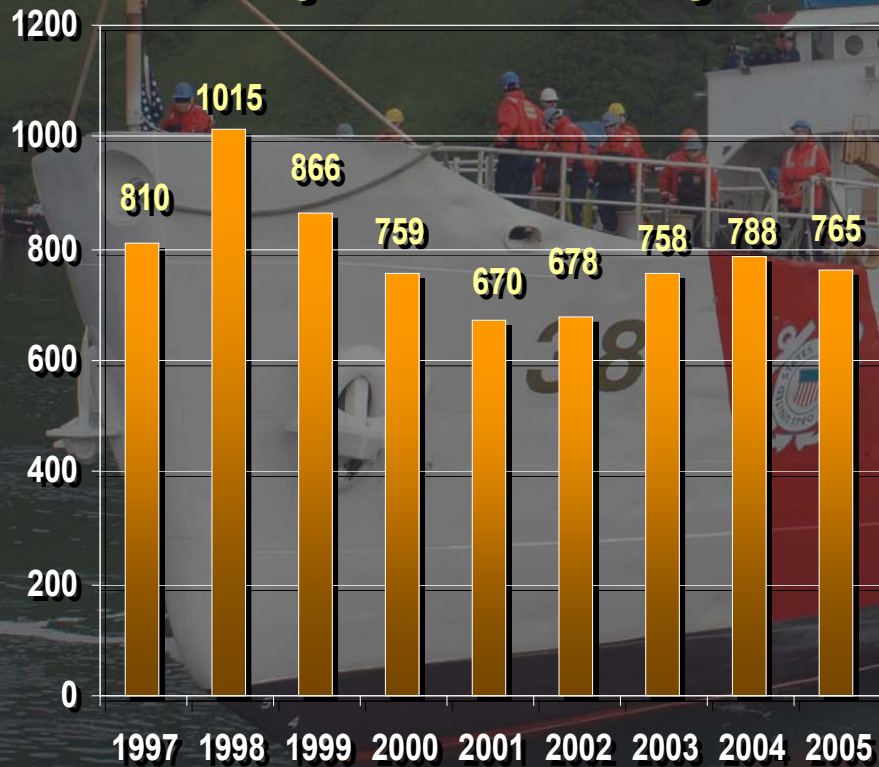

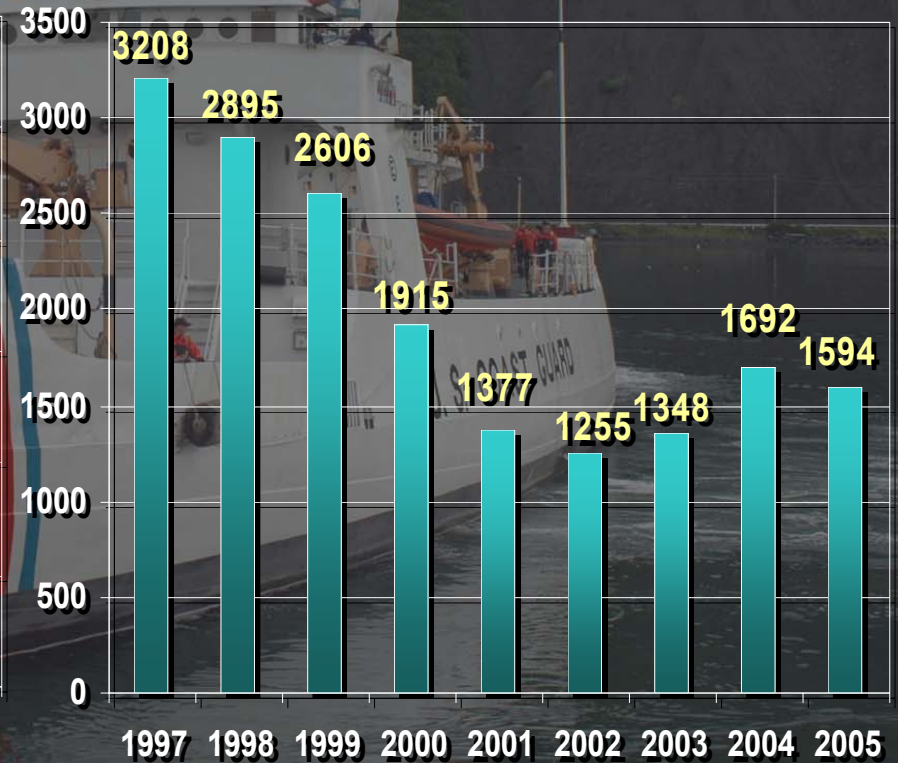


# Major Cutter & C-130 Effort

## Major Cutter Days

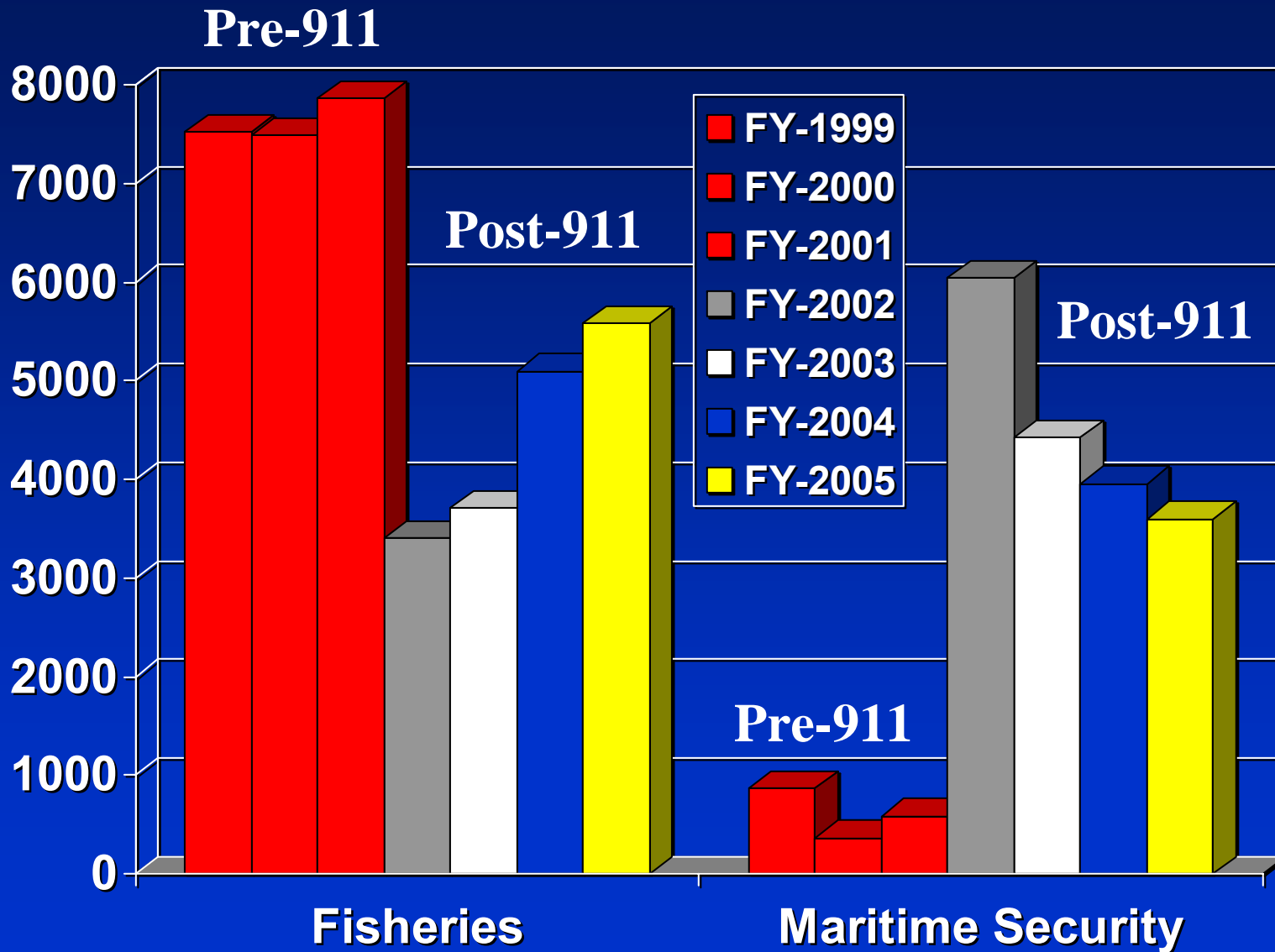

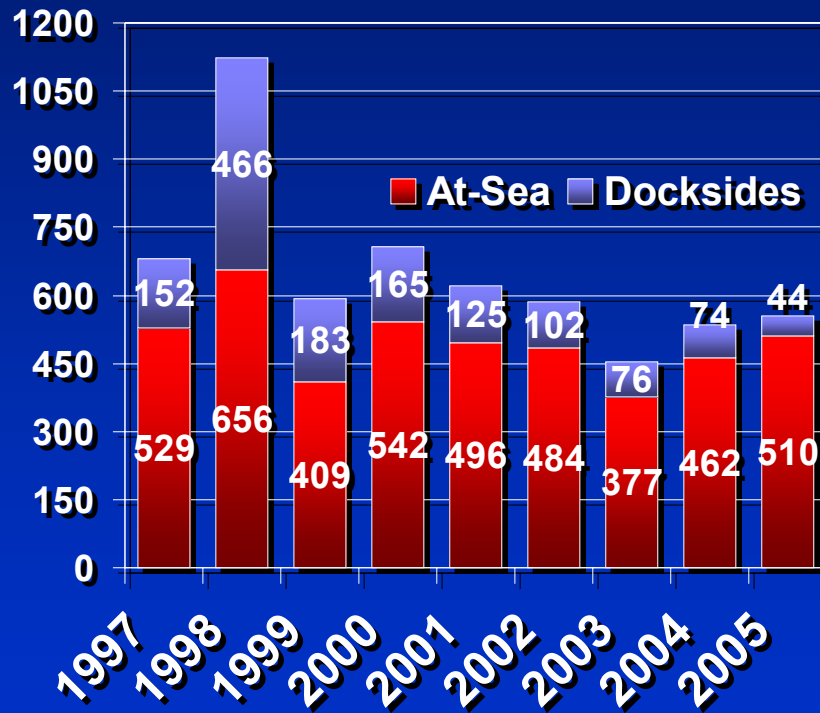
# Patrol Boat Resource Hours



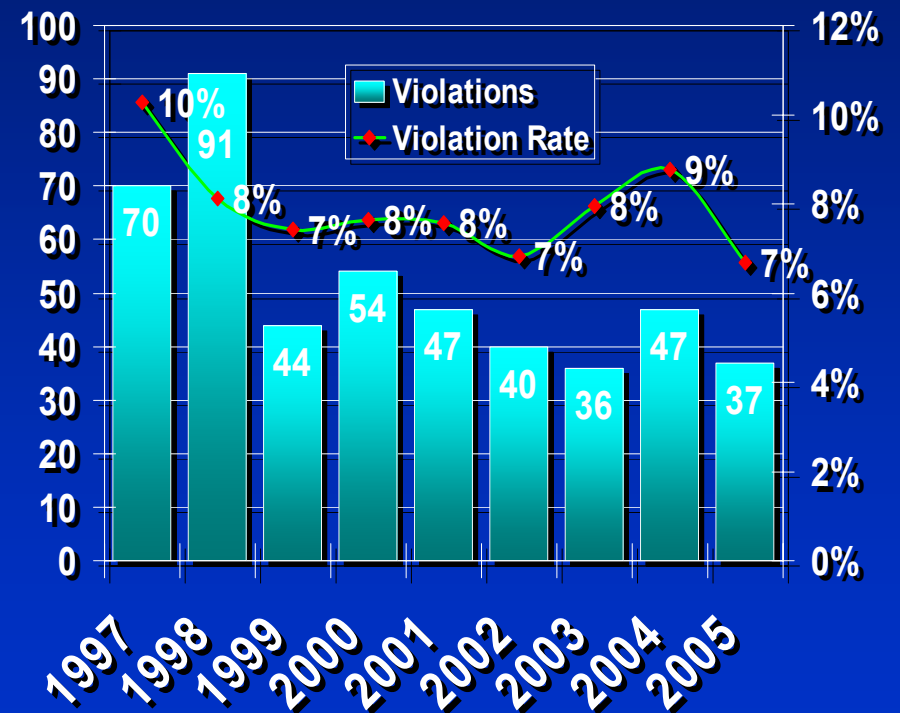

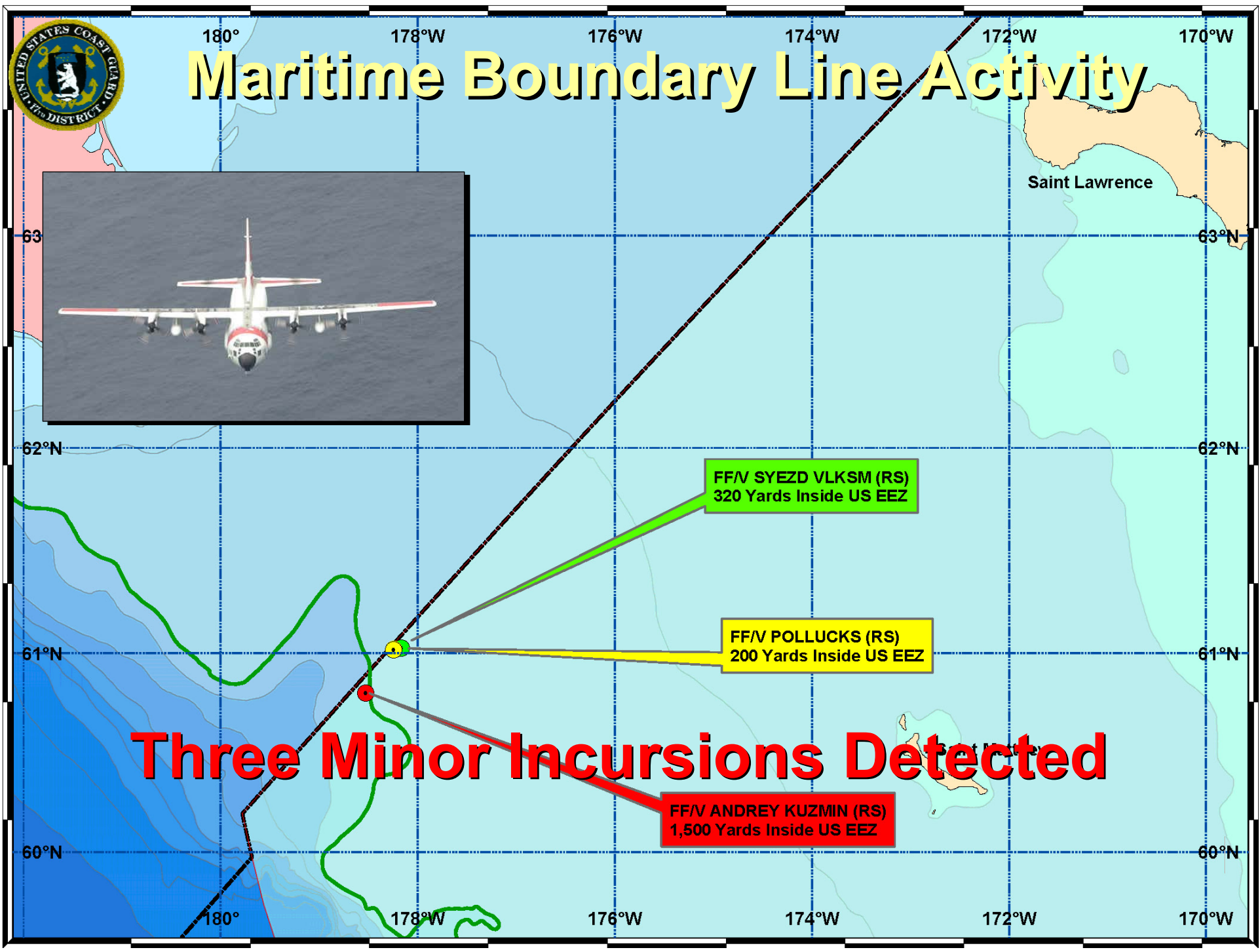

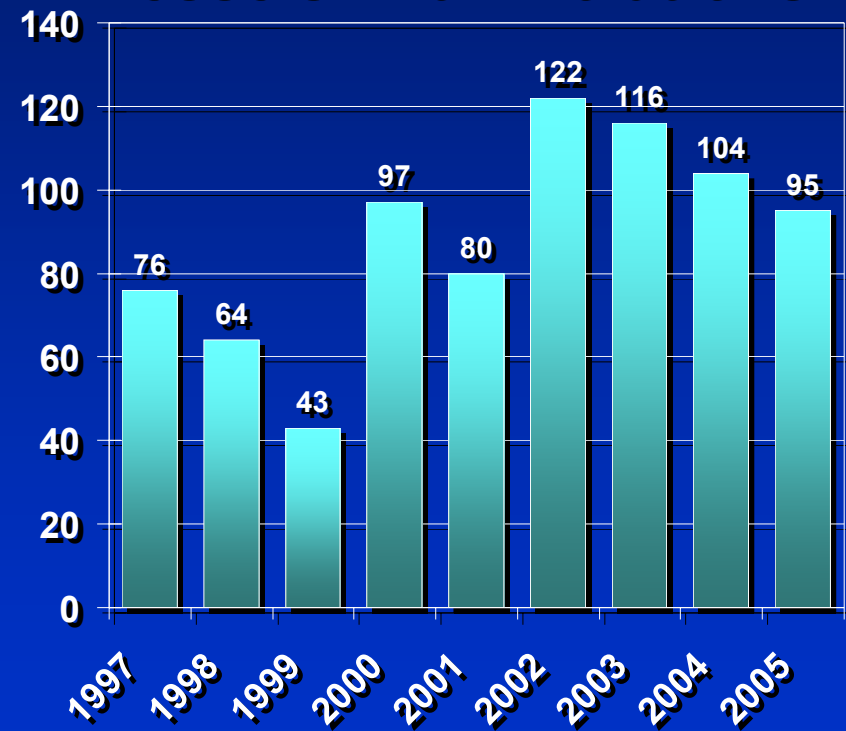

## Vessels With Violations





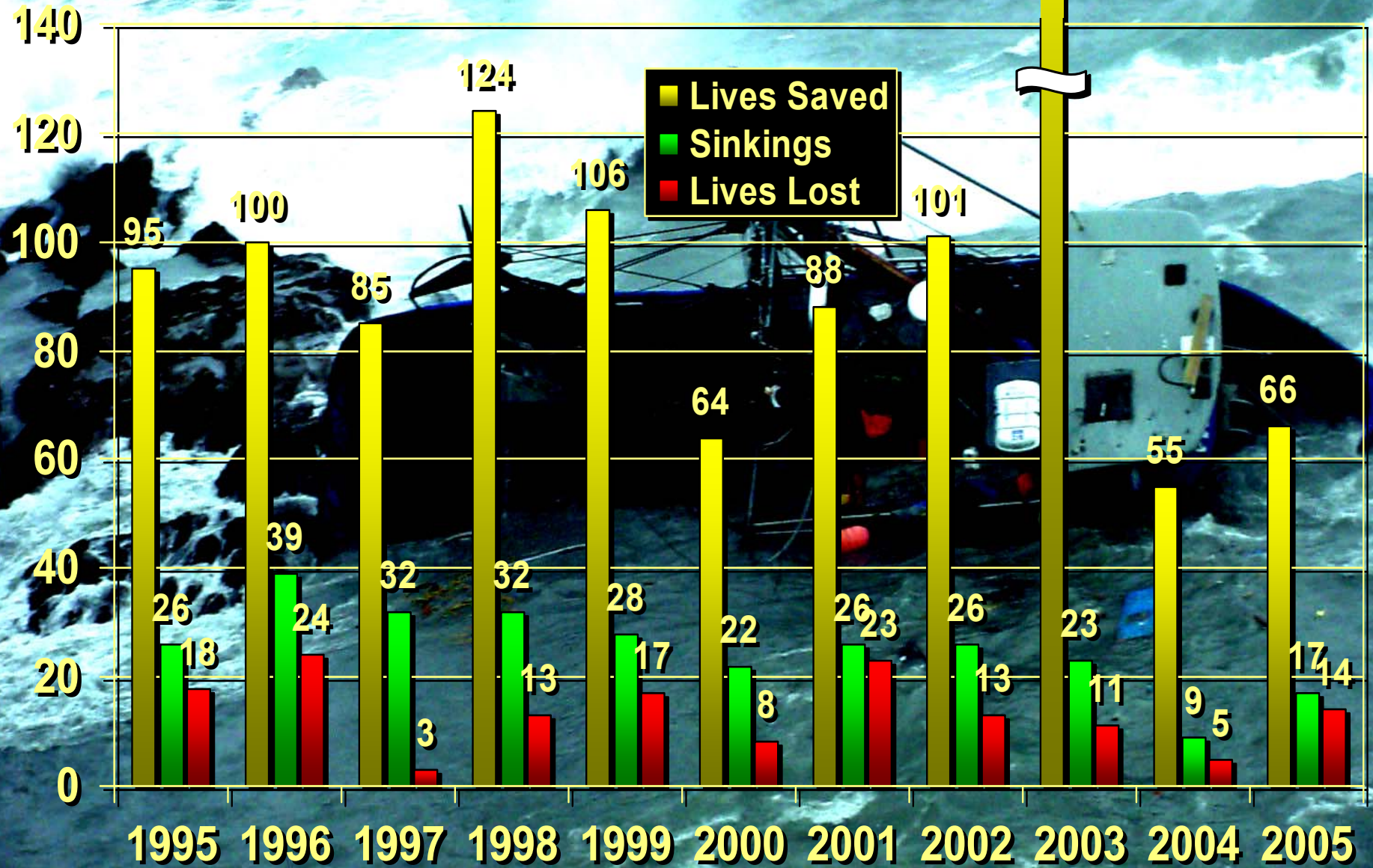

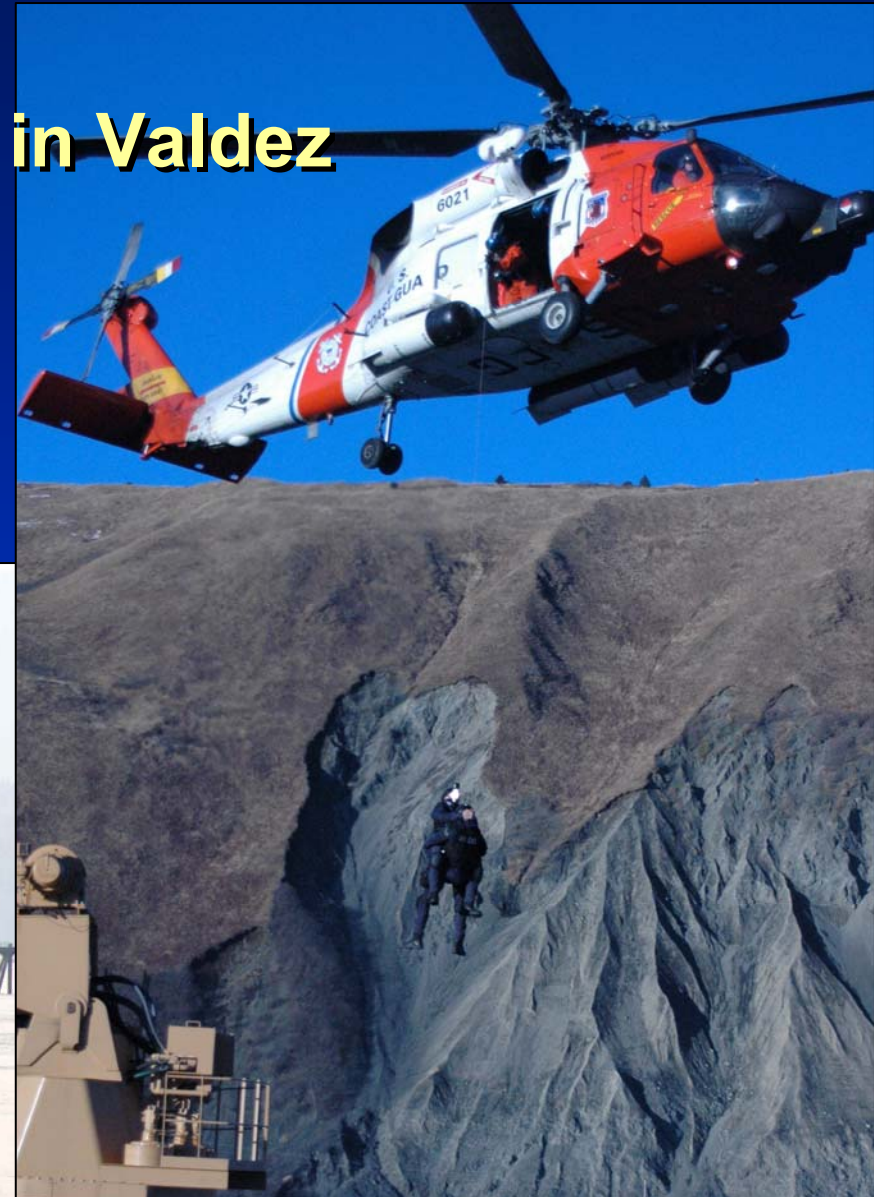
## 2005 Crab Fisheries

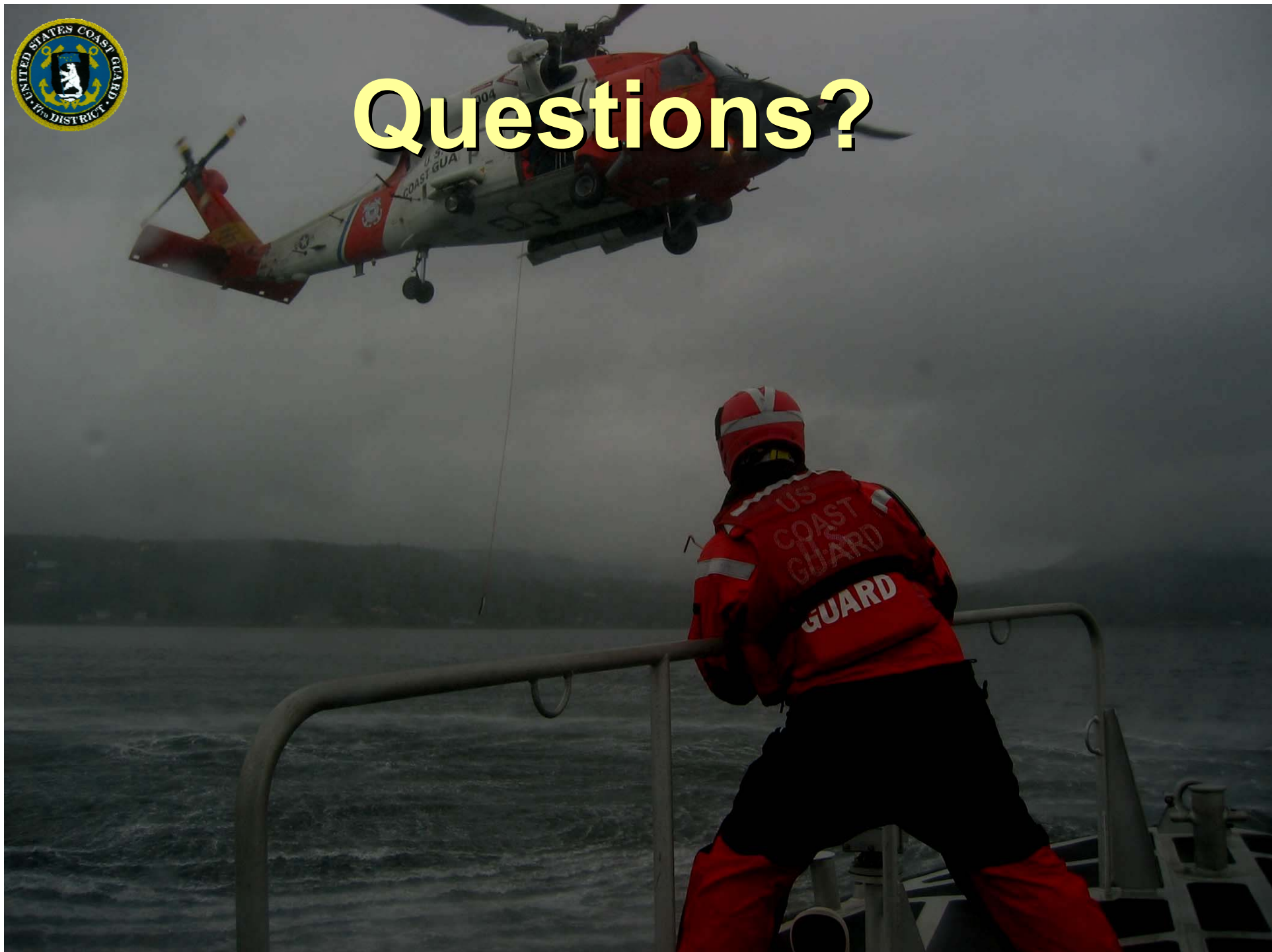
