REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL
CONCERNING COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT

1. Recent FCMA Infractions. Since the last Council meeting, three reports of violations (civil penalty procedures) and two citations (written warnings) have been issued. A brief summary of each infraction is as follows:
 - a. 4 November. The South Korean Trawler SOO GONG NR 51 was issued a citation by USCGC RUSH for failure to properly maintain the cumulative catch log.
 - b. 7 November. The South Korean Trawler Long Liner O DAE YANG 212 was issued two reports of violation by USCGC RUSH for failure to maintain a cumulative catch log and for failure to have a boarding ladder.
 - c. 15 November. The Soviet Trawler MYS VORONINA was issued a citation by USCGC CAMPBELL for improper species logging in the cumulative catch log.
 - d. 20 November. The Soviet Trawler TAJIKISTAN was issued a report of violation by USCGC JARVIS for failure to properly maintain the cumulative catch log.
