

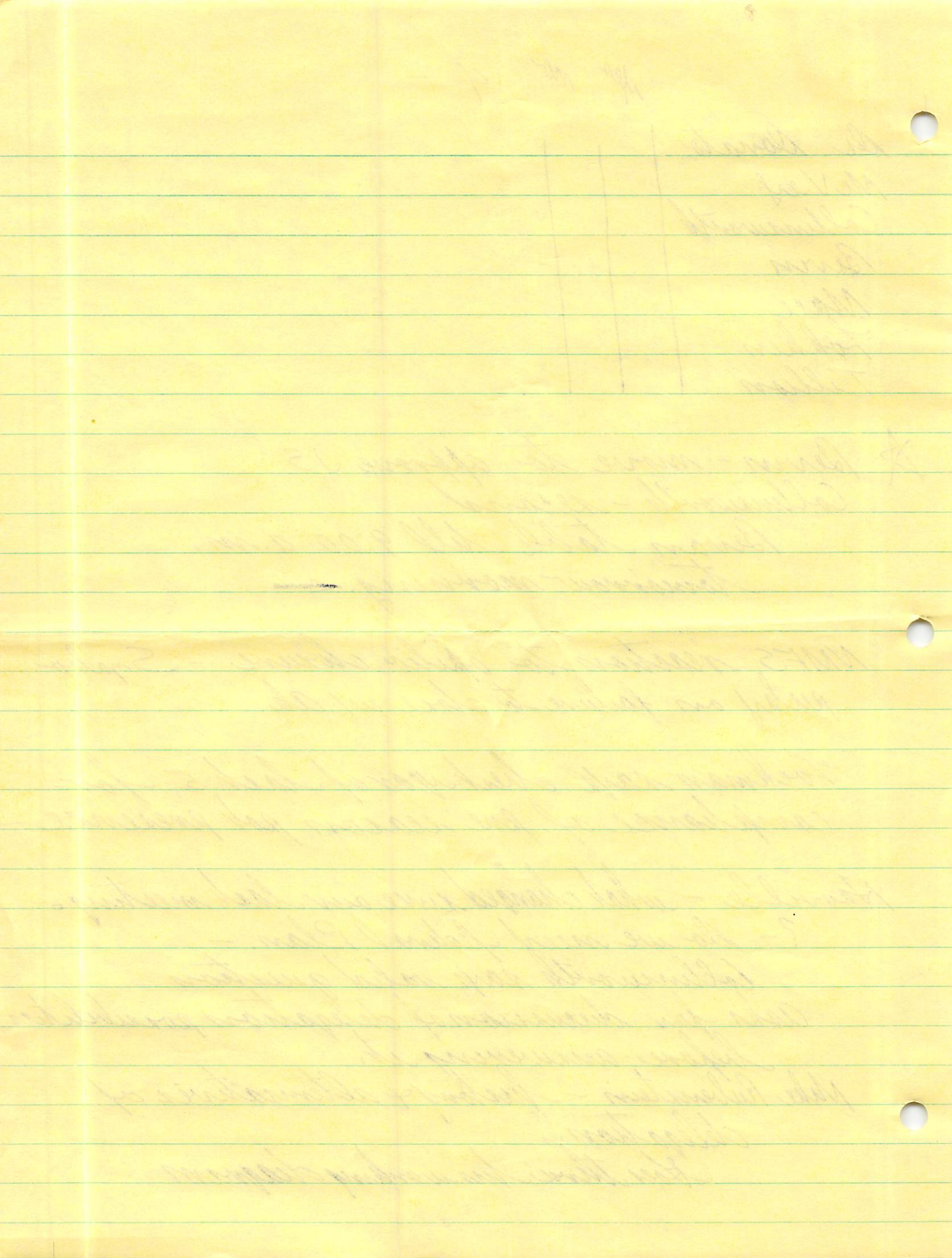

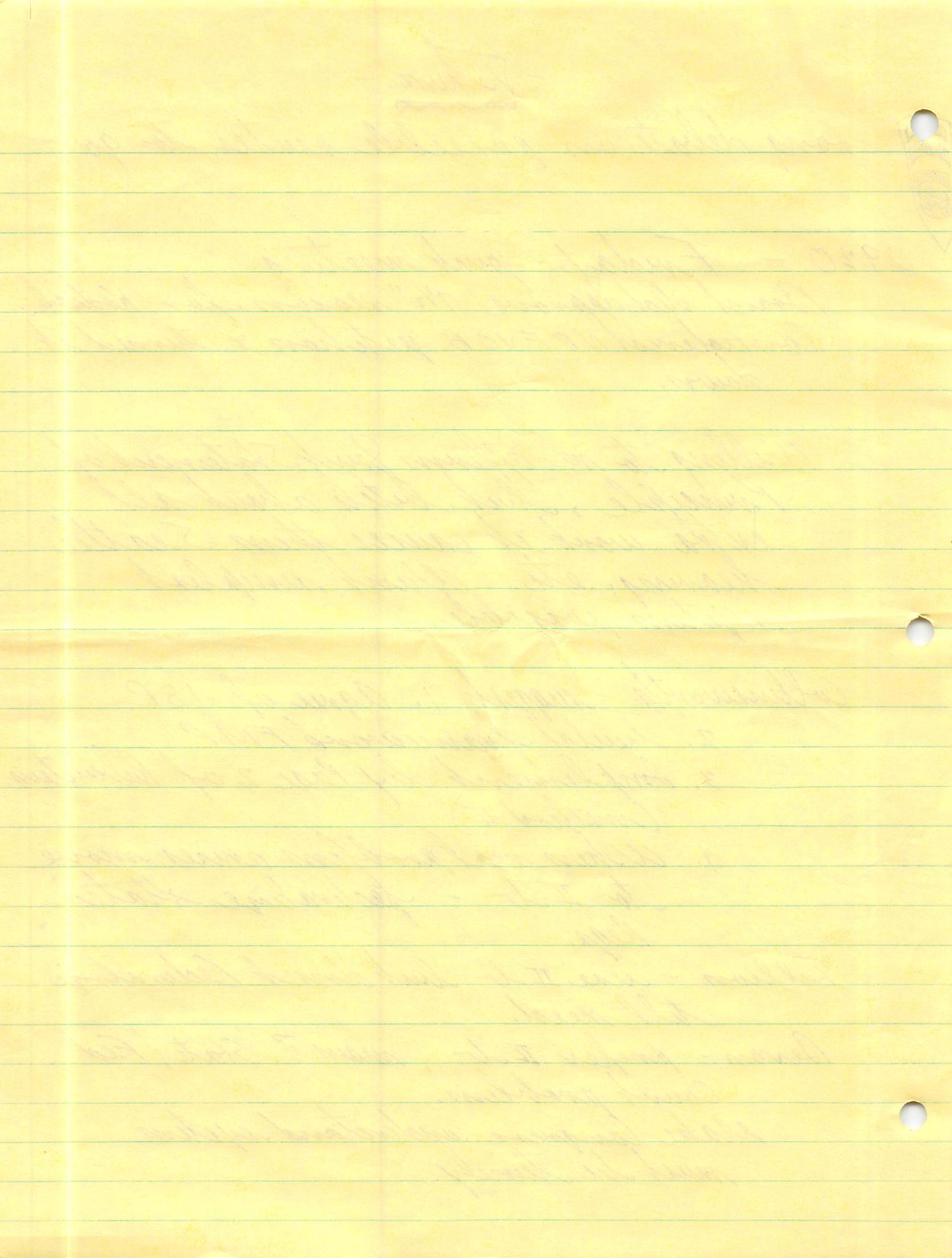

de Donato nay)

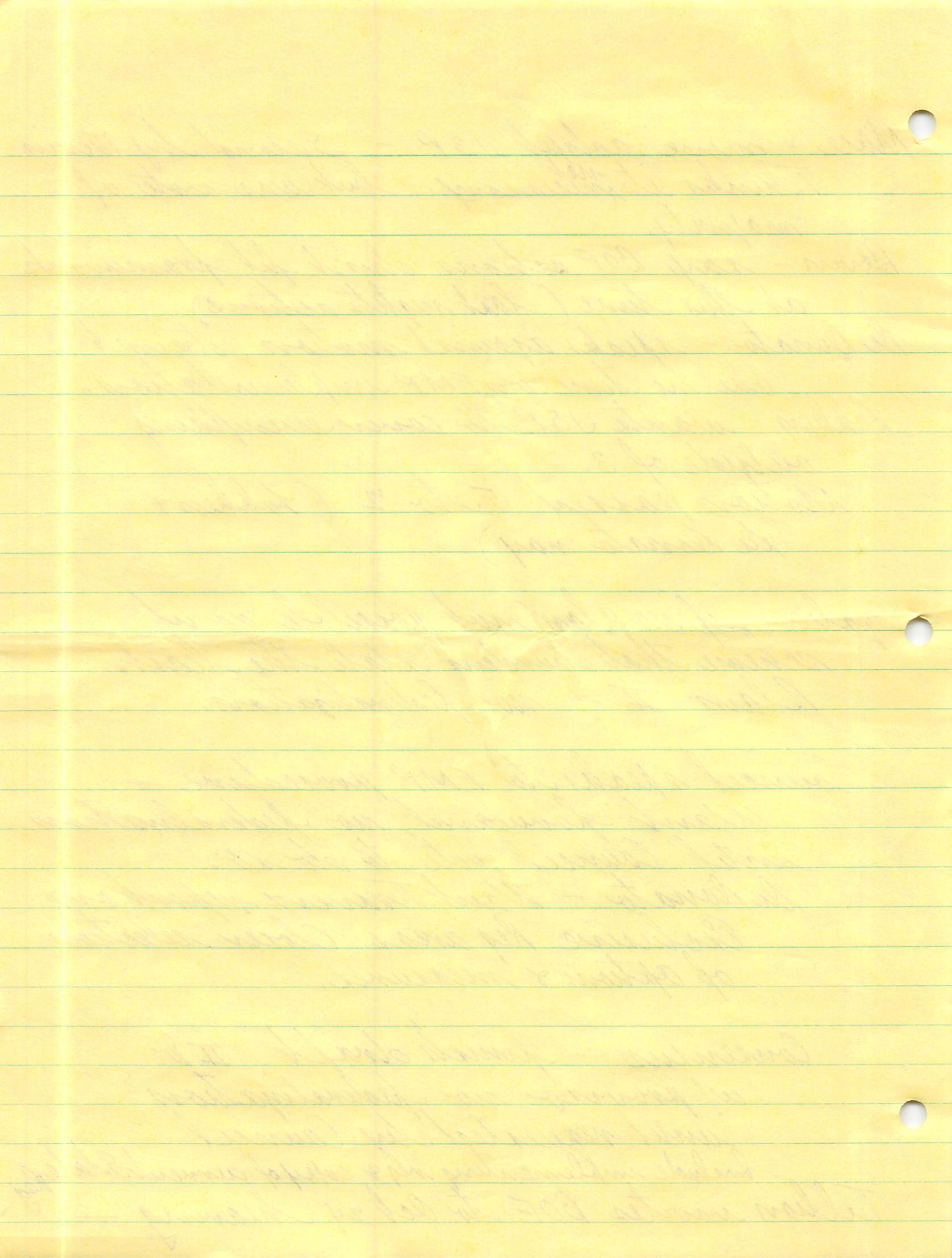

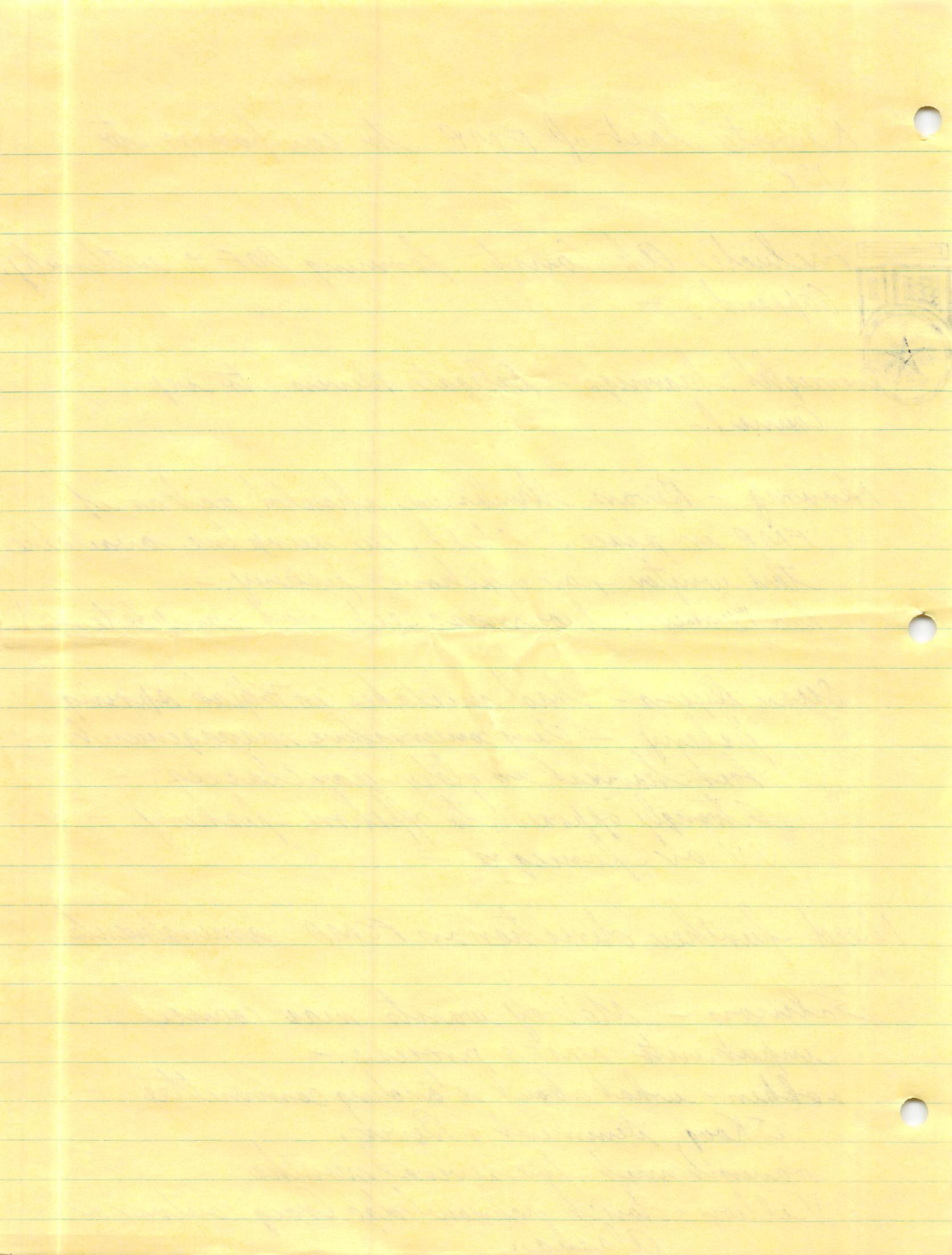

- McVey - small group - use inter council group Skoog / Lemment / Beran -

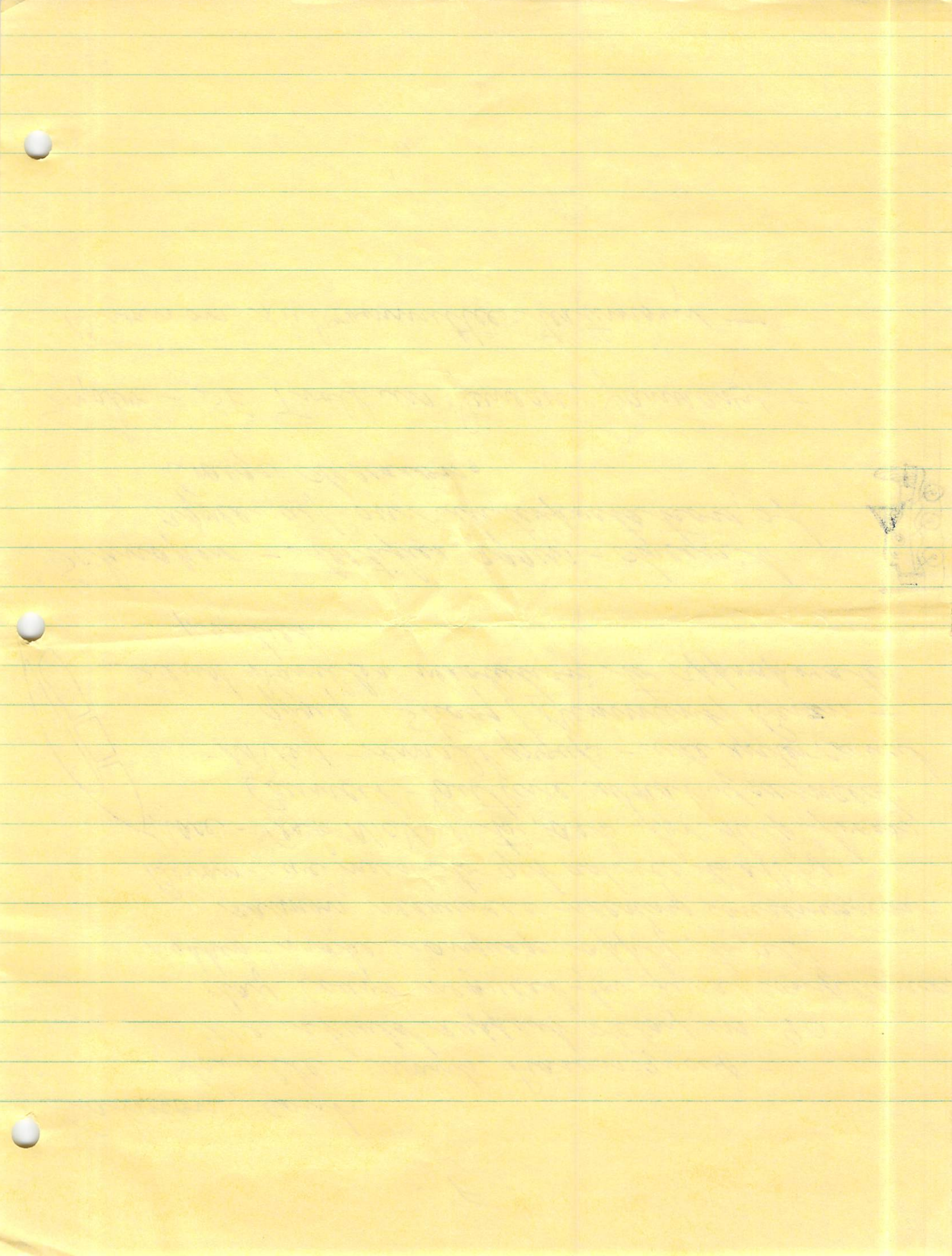
