State of Alaska Draft Climate Action Policy

On October 31, 2017, AK Governor Bill Walker signed Administrative Order 289 establishing the Alaska Climate Change Strategy and Climate Action for Alaska Leadership Team. The Leadership Team is a 20-member team composed of a diverse group of leaders from different sectors of the state. The Strategy creates a flexible and enduring framework for Alaskans to build a strategic response to climate change informed by the best available science, integration of indigenous and local knowledge, and consideration of Alaska's economic interest. A draft Alaska Climate Change Policy was published in May 2018. The committee will review the draft policy ad provide comment for the Council's consideration.
