REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL CONCERNING COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT

- 1. Recent FCMA Infractions. Since the last council meeting two reports of violation (civil penalty procedure) and five citations (written warning) have been issued for FCMA infractions. A brief summary of each infraction follows.
- a. 15 April. USCGC STORIS issued a citation to the South Korean stern trawler SOO GONG No. 91 for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log. The daily cumulative catch log was totaled for all areas rather than by individual area.
- b. 22 April. USCGC STORIS issued a citation to the Polish stern trawler PERSEUS for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log. The daily cumulative catch log reflected cumulative totals from the 1980 permit period and combined cumulative totals for all areas rather than by individual area.
- c. 23 April. USCGC STORIS issued a citition to the Polish stern trawler SATURN for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log. The daily cumulative catch log reflected cumulative totals from the 1980 permit period.
- d. 25 April. USCGC STORIS issued two reports of violation to the South Korean longliners DONG WON HO No. 31 for under logging of sablefish (black cod) and for failure to use the most accurate measures to determine the round weight of the sablefish.
- e. 29 April. USCGC CONFIDENCE seized the Japanese stern trawler DAIRIN MARU No. 28 in the central Bering Sea for underlogging of its catch of flatfish (turbot/flounder) by 59% and a corresponding overlogging of other species.
- f. 29 April. USCGC CONFIDENCE seized the Japanese stern trawler DAIKICHI MARU No. 35 in the central Bering Sea for underlogging of its catch of flatfish (turbot/flounder) by 44% and a corresponding overlogging of other species.

g. 12 May. Coast Guard Air Station Kodiak issued a report of violation to the Soviet stern trawler LEMMETS for fishing within the U.S. Fisheries Conservation Zone (western Bering Sea) without a permit.
