SUBJECT: Foreign vessel applications for joint ventures and directed fisheries

*ACTION REQUIRED*

*Review vessel applications for Norway and Japan.*

BACKGROUND

Joint Venture and Directed Fishing Permits for Norway

The Council has received permit requests for the Norwegian vessel OLE SAETREMYR to fish, and receive in joint ventures, pollock and cod in the Bering Sea/ Aleutian management area [item C-3(a)]. Oceantrawl is requesting 5,000 mt Pacific cod and 2,000 mt pollock for each activity. A portion of the cod caught by the vessel will be offloaded to a domestic tramper, taken to Kodiak and reprocessed into IQF fillets and other added value products. Those plans are described in item C-3(b).

Directed Fishing Permit for Japan.

A permit application for the Japanese medium stern trawler TAISEI MARU 58 to fish in the Bering Sea is under C-3(c) for your review. The vessel was cited in 1983 for failure to submit a cease message prior to departing the FCZ. Penalties are expected to exceed \$3,000.

RE: Allocation West Germany

I am sorry but I have to approach the council because our ship, the "Friedrich Busse," is running out on the allocation of pollock.

In the December meeting I told the council that a 14,000 MT pollock allocation of direct fishery, would not be sufficient to keep the vessel operating through the whole year. A 26,000 MT direct fishery and 6,000 MT Joint Venture fishery is needed to keep the vessel in operation for 1984.

The "Friedrich Busse" received 7,269 MT pollock allocation of direct fishery would not be sufficient to keep the vessel operating through the whole year. A 26,000 MT direct fishery and 6,000 MT Joint Venture fishery is needed to keep the vessel in operation for 1984.

The "Friedrich Busse" received 7,269 MT pollock for direct fishery, which will be fished out by March 15, 1984. We have a Joint Venture contract for 3,000 M.T. pollock with two Kodiak boats, which will start June 1, after the boats finished their contract in the Shelikov Straits. A second Joint Venture for an additional 3,000 MT pollock will start on September 1, 1984.

The "Friedrich Busse" would need 8,000 MT pollock to overcome the period from March 15 to June 1, when the Joint Venture will start. An other 4,000 MT pollock is needed sometime in October to keep the ship operating through the rest of the year.

Here is a breakdown on the 1984 pollock allocation needed:

January 1, 1984	7,269 MT	allocated
March 15, 1984	8,000 MT	additional allocation
May 1,	7,269 MT	2nd allocation
June 1,	3,000 MT	Joint Venture
September 1,	3,000 MT	Joint Venture
October 1,	4,000 MT	additional allocation

I hope that this will clarify my request and I thank the council for their co'operation in this matter.
