NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE ENFORCEMENT FOR
THE PERIOD JUNE 1, 1992 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 1, 1992

During the reporting period NMFS and the Coast Guard opened a total of 163 investigations. NMFS independently initiated 89 investigations. 18 of these cases originated from the observer program. 68 cases were closed during the reporting period.

The Alaska Enforcement Division has again been hit with a hiring freeze in anticipation of FY 1993 budget shortfalls. We currently have two vacancies each in Dutch Harbor, Kodiak, and Juneau. We now have only 12 non-supervisory field enforcement personnel and 3 supervisory field agents. The loss of these positions has severely limited our ability to pursue investigations and support U.S. Coast Guard patrol efforts. We have taken a number of steps to more effectively utilize our existing staff. However, we believe the net effect will lead to a further deterioration in compliance in a number of areas.

Steps taken to focus our efforts include elimination of most deployments aboard U.S. Coast Guard vessels. Elimination of the deployments will allow our agents to expend more effort in pursuing reported or known violations. Most of our agents have been handling an average of 24 open cases at a time. We believe a case load of no more than 15 is the optimum number for acceptable resolution. In the future, agents will primarily be limited to pursuing assigned investigations rather than detection of unreported violations or routine dockside inspections. Further some types of violations will simply not be pursued except when case load and time allows. These violations include such issues as mishandling or minor retention of prohibited species, submission of logbooks, license violations, gear limitation requirements, and major violations which would require extensive investigative time. Major investigations will be conducted by no more than 3 to 4 agents at a time.

The division recently closed 86 investigations due to lack of enforcement resources. Many of these investigations originated from the observer program and include primarily mishandling, misreporting, or minor retention of prohibited species. We have also suspended 173 investigations dealing with failure to submit logbooks and or failure to meet observer coverage requirements for 1990. These investigations will be reopened upon hiring of additional agents for the Juneau office. Observer compliance investigations for 1991 and 1992 have been limited to violations detected in the field. We currently do not have the staff available to analyze logbook submissions to determine coverage compliance for 1991 and 1992. Even if



analyzed, we do not have the capability to pursue the large number of investigations that would result.

In addition to other ongoing investigations we currently have 218 cases undergoing review in Juneau. We expect that approximately half of these cases will be referred to General Counsel over the next 6 months. The remaining cases will be resolved by summary settlement, downgraded to written warning or dismissed.

1. MFCMA Groundfish Violations:

(a) In July, NMFS enforcement assisted the Alaska Fish & Wildlife Protection Division in an investigation of the salmon processing vessel FORT YUKON. The operator of the vessel was subsequently charged with 30 counts of illegal purchase of subsistence caught salmon. Pursuant to a plea bargain arrangement the operator has agreed to a \$50,000 penalty and has been sentenced to 6 months in jail. The operator will also forfeit a fleet of vessels with an estimated value of \$4.5 million.

(b) August 11, 1992 - The trawl vessel MAR DEL NORTE was cited for retention of excess bycatch of sablefish. The excess (3,780 lbs.) constituted 41% of the sablefish catch.

2. Halibut Violations:

(a) June 10, 1992 - The longline vessel ALEXANDERA C was cited for failure to mark halibut longline gear. The vessel was offered a \$1,650 summary settlement.

(b) July 4, 1992 - The longline vessel CAPT N ART was cited for no IPHC license in possession. The vessel paid a \$375 summary settlement.

(c) August 16, 1992 - The longline vessel LORVON was cited for fishing without an IPHC license and failing to clear for the area 4A fishery. The case is to be referred to NOAA General Counsel.

**U.S. COAST GUARD/NMFS JUNEAU FISHERIES ENFORCEMENT FOR PERIOD
June 01, through August 31, 1992**

1. ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

a. Vessel Seizures:

(1) On 17 June, the CGC YOCONA seized the fishing vessel *Pacific Trawler* for illegal fishing in the Round Island Closed Area. Investigation found ten positions from vessel's daily production log which plotted inside the closed area with the deepest incursion of 5100 yds. The vessel was directed to Dutch Harbor with a custody crew from the CGC YOCONA. *Pacific Trawler* was released 15 July on \$250,000 bond.

(2) On 03 July the CGC YOCONA seized the Panamanian flagged M/V *No.1 Kotoku* for violation of 16 USC 1857(2)(A), fishing within the boundaries of the state of AK. The vessel was initially observed 2350 yds north of St. Paul Island, receiving frozen fish product from a U.S. fishing vessel. *No.1 Kotoku* was directed to Kodiak with a YOCONA custody crew onboard and settled on 08 July for \$50,000 plus Coast Guard costs.

(3) On 12 July the CGC SHERMAN seized the Panamanian flagged M/V *No.2 Pohah* for violation of 16 USC 1857(2)(A), fishing within the boundaries of the state of AK. Investigations of the vessel's logs revealed they had previously taken product from 03 other vessels in the vicinity of Summit Island. The vessel was escorted to Dutch Harbor where it settled for \$50,000 plus Coast Guard costs.

(4) On 17 July the CGC SHERMAN seized the fishing vessel *Phoenix* for operating without federal fisheries permit/log, failure to have required NMFS observer coverage, failure to make required reports to NMFS, and numerous other MFCMA violations. Positions taken from the master's personal log revealed 122 longline sets in federal water from May through July.

(5) On 20 July the CGC LIBERTY seized the Canadian fishing vessel *Serene* for fishing in undisputed U.S. water. *Serene* was sighted 875 yds north of the A-B line, with gear in the water. The vessel was escorted to Ketchikan, where it's catch of 1624 lbs of salmon was sold for \$1860. The *Serene* settled on 24 July for \$5,000 plus USCG and Marshal costs.

(6) On 26 July the CGC STORIS seized the fishing vessel *Stimul* (CIS) for violation of 16 USC 1857, fishing in U.S. EEZ without a valid permit. The vessel was fishing northeast of the Donut Hole and Eastern Special Area, approximately 7.5nm inside the 1990 U.S./USSR convention line. After being escorted to Kodiak, a settlement was reached on 07 August, for \$200,000 plus Coast Guard costs.

b. Catch Seizures:

(1) On 06 June the CGC LIBERTY seized the catch of the fishing vessel *Shamrock*. The vessel was directed fishing for Black Cod during a closed period, and was observed discarding fish product upon approach of the cutter. Approximately 336 lbs of Black Cod was seized, and the vessel was prohibited from participating in the 08-09 June Halibut opening.

(2) On 10 June the CGC ROANOKE ISLAND seized the catch of the fishing vessel *Sonia Francine*. The vessel was found to have retained 53 undersized Halibut during the 08-09 June Halibut opening.

(3) On 10 June the CGC IRONWOOD seized the catch of the fishing vessel *Lady Lee Dawn*. The vessel was found to have retained 38 undersized Halibut during the 08-09 June Halibut opening.

c. Captain of the Port Order:

(1) On 18 August the CGC YOCONA boarded the mothership processor *Alaskan Eight*, while anchored in Nazan Bay, Atka Island. The vessel had over thirty marine safety violations, and several MARPOL violations. Further investigations by the Marine Safety Office in Anchorage resulted in a Captain of the Port Order for the vessel to remain at anchor until serious safety discrepancies were corrected.

d. Significant Law Enforcement Cases:

(1) On 12 August the USCGC YOCONA boarded the fishing vessel *Bering Empire* west of Attu Island. The vessel was cited for fishing within a sea lion rookery, retention of prohibited species (Halibut and crab), failure to report incidents with marine mammals, failure to make required reports to NMFS and several other MFCMA violations. Determination of action for violations of the Endangered Species Act (rookery incursions) is pending results of NMFS investigation.

e. Significant Aircraft Sightings:

(1) On 19 August a Kodiak C-130 sighted and photographed the Fishing vessel *Bering Empire*, retrieving gear from within the Attu Island Rookery. This sighting represented the second

incident of this vessel being within the sea lion rookery within one week. Determination of action for this alleged violation of the Endangered Species Act is pending results of NMFS investigation.

f. High Seas Driftnet:

(1) On 16 July CGC BOUTWELL rendezvoused with the Japanese enforcement vessel *Hakuryu Maru* and conducted joint boardings of the Japanese high seas driftnet vessels *Genei Maru No. 78* and *Genei Maru No. 68*. The cutter gathered statements and collected evidence from an alleged incident between the driftnet vessels and 02 vessels of the Sea Shepherd Society. Sworn statements from both driftnet vessels allege that M/V *Edward Abbey* (U.S.) and *Sea Shepherd II* (U.K.) harassed both fishing vessels by maneuvering in close proximity (at times 2 meters away) and throwing approximately 20-30 glass bottles (approximately 5 oz. each) containing an unknown liquid. In addition, the driftnet vessels stated *Edward Abbey* purposely destroyed approximately 2.5 miles of driftnet. Evidence obtained on scene indicated that no physical damage or personal injury was sustained on either driftnet vessel.

(2) On 25 July ARGOS transponder data was received which indicated numerous South Korean (KS) driftnet vessels were operating north of the authorized boundary for July. The CGC BOUTWELL located the KS vessel *No.105 Hwa Dong* 8.6 NM north of the boundary. Although a boarding detected no evidence of illegal fishing or salmonids, the vessel's IRCS and name were not displayed on the hull (and both had been painted over) in violation of the U.S./KS agreement. Several other radar contacts were observed north of the boundary, but immediately headed south when the CGC BOUTWELL contacted *Hwa Dong* on CH 16 VHF-FM. CGC BOUTWELL later intercepted and boarded *No.23 Dea Woo* (KS). Inspection of the vessel's logs revealed their nets had been set north (up to 26nm) of the authorized July boundary on several occasions. In addition, fresh squid, not yet flash frozen, was observed in flash freezers as further evidence of recent catch. This vessel also had its IRCS and name painted out.

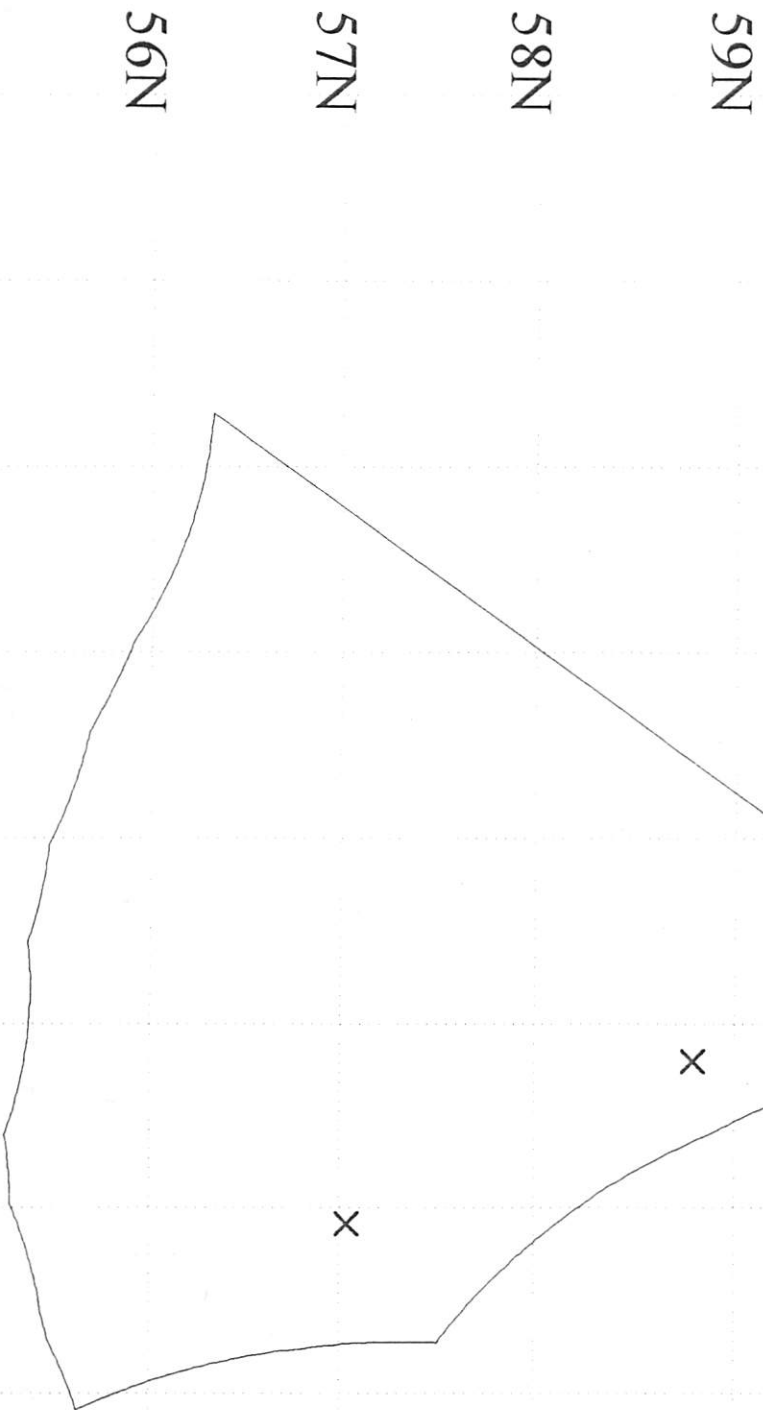
