

Mr. Tweit's motion:

1. Reformulate Alt 3 with revised area boundaries consistent with the Enforcement Committee recommendations
2. Reword current Opt e to "suggest" adding additional research and monitoring of areas of skate egg concentration to the Council's annual research priority list
3. Add to Alt 2 a Council statement of intent to discourage fishing in these areas of skate egg concentration with any fishing gear that makes contact with the sea floor
4. Incorporate the AP motion's first 3 bullets into the analysis
5. Incorporate the SSC's recommendations, including consistency of terms, but not the comments on enforcement
6. Provide for Alt 2 a discussion of potential industry monitoring and reporting mechanisms and agency monitoring and reporting mechanisms
7. Incorporate the comments from the Ecosystem and Enforcement Committees

- Alt 2: Identify HAPC(s)
- Alt 3: Identify and conserve HAPC(s)
 - Opt a: No "mobile bottom contact" gear
 - Opt b: No "mobile bottom contact" and pelagic
 - Opt c: No "bottom contact" gear
 - Opt d: No fishing gears
- Opt e: research and monitoring to annual priority list
