**INFORMATION FOR PERSONS WISHING TO TESTIFY AT COUNCIL MEETINGS**

Those wishing to testify at Council meetings on a specific agenda item must fill out and deposit a registration card in the box at the registration table before public comment begins on that agenda item. Additional cards are generally not accepted after public comment has begun. A general comment period is scheduled toward the end of each meeting for comment on matters not on the current agenda.

**Submission of Written Testimony at Council Meeting.** Some agenda items have a formal, published deadline for written comments; for example, April 19 for agenda item C-2, North Pacific Fisheries Research Plan. For those items, written comments submitted after the published deadline or at the Council meeting, other than simple transcripts of oral testimony, will be stamped "LATE COMMENT." They will not be summarized or analyzed in preparation for the Council meeting, nor will they be placed in the Council member notebooks. All "LATE COMMENTS" will be placed in a special notebook, marked as such, and made available to the Council members only upon their request.
