Southeast Troll Fishery

Since the October 1 opening of the Southeast Winter Troll fishery, approximately 22,000 chinook salmon have been landed. The winter fishery will close April 14 and is projected to take 30,000-35,000 chinook salmon. Last year's harvest was 22,000. The average price paid to fishermen is currently \$3.50-4.00 per pound.
