# ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL FEBRUARY, 2002

Fisheries managed under delegated authority of the State of Alaska since the last council report: salmon, crab, and groundfish.

#### Salmon Troll Fishery

(FIGURE 1) The 2001 winter troll season for chinook salmon opened October 11, 2001 and will close April 15, 2002, or when 45,000 treaty chinook salmon are harvested, whichever occurs first. There are 179 fishermen participating, and they have made 833 landings to date. The total winter catch is now at 17,755 chinook salmon. The recent 5-yr average is 14,540 fish. Alaska hatchery contribution is running about 4%. The average weight for these chinook salmon is approximately 3 pounds below recent averages. Average price is about \$3.10 per pound, and has even been over \$4.50, but few fish are being delivered.

#### Bering Sea opilio (Snow) crab

The 2002 snow crab fishery opened as scheduled on January 15<sup>th</sup>. The Guideline Harvest Level (GHL) was 28.51 million pounds. The post-season Community Development Quota (CDQ) is 2.31 million pounds. ADF&G, in conjunction with the United States Coast Guard and National Weather Service assessed weather conditions prior to the fishery and announced that no postponement was necessary. ADF&G is managing the 2002 Bering Sea snow crab fishery based on inseason reports from fishermen. There are 190 vessels registered to participate in the open access fishery. Very preliminary projections indicate the GHL will be reached. Fishing appears a little slower than last year because of crab distribution, increased encounters with old shell animals, lower effort (pots and boats), as well as poor weather and some problems with ice. The season will open for the CDQ allocation in the near future.

#### Aleutian Islands golden king crab

(FIGURE 3) The Aleutian Islands (Area O) opened to commercial fishing for golden king crab on August 15, 2001 with guideline harvest levels (GHL) of 3.0 million pounds east and 2.7 million pounds west of 174° W. longitude. That portion of Area O east of 174° W. longitude closed to commercial fishing on September 10<sup>th</sup>, when the GHL was reached. Fishing remains open West of 174° W. longitude, with about 5 vessels participating. Total catch now stands at just less than 5 million pounds for the entire fishery.

#### Central Region Pacific Cod

#### Cook Inlet

(FIGURE 4) Reviewing the 2001 State managed Pacific cod fishery in the Cook Inlet Management Area, that fishery opened on March 5 (24 hours after the close of the Federal fishery). The 1.92 million pound GHL was allocated 50% to pot gear and 50% to jig gear. The GHL is calculated as 2.25% of the Acceptable Biological Catch (ABC) for the federal Central Gulf of Alaska Area. Pot gear closed by regulation on May 1 and reopened June 15, while jig gear remained open throughout the season. By regulation, the exclusive area registration and gear limits were lifted October 30. Final harvest was 895,352 pounds by 14 vessels.

#### **Prince William Sound**

The 2001 Prince William Sound (PWS) state managed Pacific cod season opened March 11 with a 2.62 million pound GHL allocated 60% to pot gear and 40% to jig gear. The GHL is calculated as 25% of the federal Eastern Gulf ABC. Harvest data from the fishery is confidential due to the low level of participation. By regulation the exclusive area registration and gear limits were lifted October 30 and the fishery remained open through the end of the year.

#### Westward Region Pacific Cod (FIGURE 5)

#### Kodiak (FIGURE 6)

The 2001 Kodiak Area GHL for state-managed Pacific cod was 10.6 million pounds. This was 12.5% of the Central Gulf of Alaska Acceptable Biological Catch (ABC) for cod. The guideline was split equally between pot and jig gear. Prior to September 1, vessels over 58 feet can take no more than 25% of the guideline. The fishery opened on March 11, seven days after the closure of the Central GOA to cod fishing. The 2001 fishery resulted in a harvest of about 5 million pounds, of which 75% was from pot gear landings.

#### **Chignik** (FIGURE 7)

The 2001 Chignik area GHL for state-managed Pacific cod was 6.0 million pounds. This was 7% of the Central Gulf of Alaska ABC for cod. The guideline was allocated 85% to pot gear and 15% to jig gear. The 2001 season total harvest was about 2.5 million pounds.

#### South Alaska Peninsula (FIGURE 8)

The 2001 South Alaska Peninsula Area GHL for state-managed Pacific cod was 13.4 million pounds. This was 25% of the Western Gulf of Alaska ABC for cod. The guideline was allocated 85% to pot gear and 15% to jig gear. The fishery opened March 6, seven days after the closure of the Western GOA to cod fishing. The fishery closed to pot gear on April 13, and to jig gear in early June. The pot harvest was 10.4 million pounds; the jig harvest was 3.0 million pounds...

#### **State Pacific Cod Enforcement**

The Alaska Department of Public Safety's Division of Fish and Wildlife Protection conducted targeted patrols during the Pacific cod fisheries.

In the Prince William Sound area for 2001, the Protection Vessels (P/V) Safeguard, and Bering, conducted sea patrols. No violations were reported. Shorebased patrols were conducted in Cordova by state troopers, which included plant inspections and boarding of vessels that were offloading. There were no violations.

During the 2001 Westward Pacific cod state fisheries, the Alaska Department of Public Safety's Division of Fish and Wildlife Protection conducted patrols from the P/V Stimson and P/V Woldstad. The patrol schedule was as follows:

Patrols primarily concentrated on ensuring compliance with gear requirements, pot limits if applicable, registration and permits, vessel and crew licensing, seasons, closed waters, and landing requirements. The detachment's patrol vessels reported the following actions:

#### **Southeast Groundfish**


To date 87 mt of Demersal Shelf Rockfish (DSR) has been delivered, and the Central Southeast Outside (CSEO) and Southern Southeast Outside (SSEO) areas are now closed to directed fishing. The Northern Southeast Inside (NSEI) and Southern Southeast Inside (SSEI) areas are still open. The department did not open the East Yakutat (EYKT) and Northern Southeast Outside (NSEO) areas to directed fishing.


