


1998 BSAI TRAWL GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE PACIFIC COD FISHERY




1998 BSAI H&L GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE PACIFIC COD FISHERY



1998 BSAI TRW GROUNDFISH CATCH AND HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE YELLOWFIN SOLE FISHERY




1998 BSAI H&L GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE GREENLAND TURBOT FISHERY*



1998 REPORTING AREAS OF THE GULF OF ALASKA




1998 GOA TRW GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE DW COMPLEX* FISHERY





We wish to inform the North Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) of certain proposed revisions to the recordkeeping and reporting (R&R) requirements established for the groundfish fisheries of the exclusive economic zone off Alaska at 50 CFR part 679. Most of the proposed revisions address technical edits and clarifications to existing R&R requirements. Other revisions are more substantial and are described below. We anticipate that a proposed rule to implement these revisions would be published in the <u>Federal Register</u> by mid-August.

- o All retained fish, not just National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) managed groundfish, would be required to be recorded in the mothership, shoreside processor, catcher/processor, catcher vessel, and buying station logbooks and in the mothership, catcher/processor, and shoreside processor weekly production reports using an expanded and combined Alaska Department of Fish & Game (ADF&G)/NMFS species code list. This change would allow the U.S. Coast Guard and NMFS Enforcement to formulate more accurate bycatch amounts based on all catch.
- o A question would be added to the Federal fisheries and processor permit application to indicate whether or not the applicant is considered a "small business entity" for purposes of the Regulatory Flexibility Act. This information would be used in economic analyses on proposed management measures.
- o Separate logbook formats would be developed for nontrawl catcher vessels (equal to or greater than 60 ft length overall) and catcher processors. The revised formats would combine NMFS and International Pacific Halibut Commission (IPHC) logbook requirements, so vessel operator could fill out one logbook rather than two separate logbooks when fishing for both groundfish and Pacific halibut. The combined nontrawl logbook also would collect additional information for NMFS scientists for use with sablefish stock assessments (see attached). Separate

logbook formats would be developed for trawl vessels that would eliminate logbook field sections strictly for nontrawl operators. All catcher vessel and catcher/processor logbooks would include the addition of a field to enter the printed name of the vessel operator.

Staff will be available during the Council's June meeting to answer questions about these proposed revisions.






1998 BSAI TRAWL GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE PACIFIC COD FISHERY





1998 BSAI TRW GROUNDFISH CATCH AND HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE YELLOWFIN SOLE FISHERY




1998 BSAI H&L GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE GREENLAND TURBOT FISHERY*



1998 REPORTING AREAS OF THE GULF OF ALASKA




1998 GOA TRW GROUNDFISH CATCH & HALIBUT MORTALITY IN THE DW COMPLEX* FISHERY




