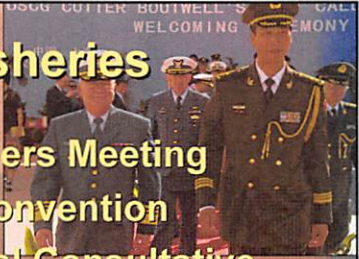

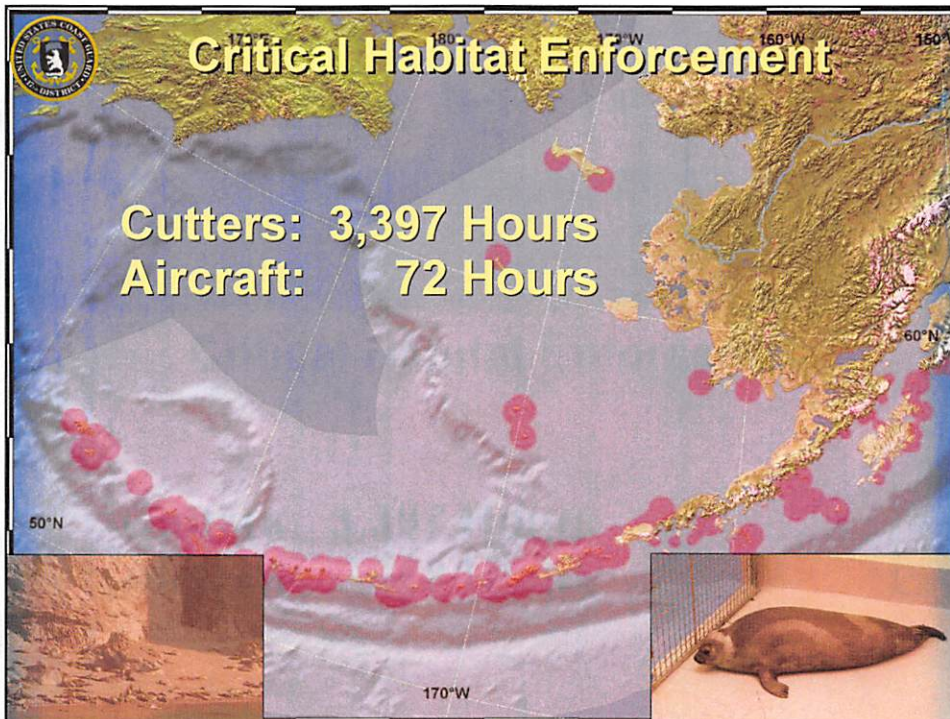
2007 Crab Fisheries

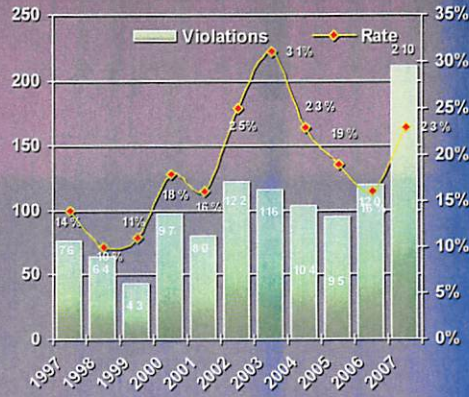

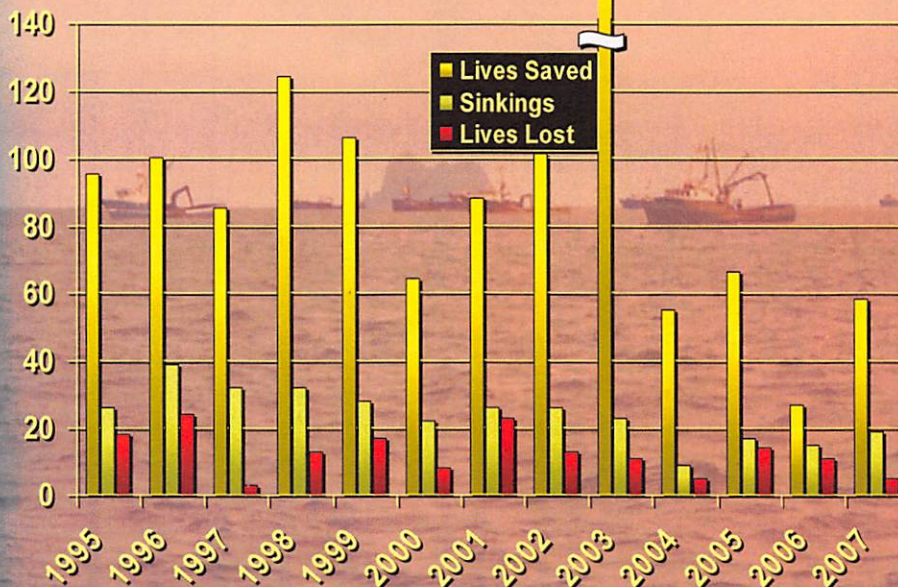


