- **10 Lives Lost**





COVID-19 Operations



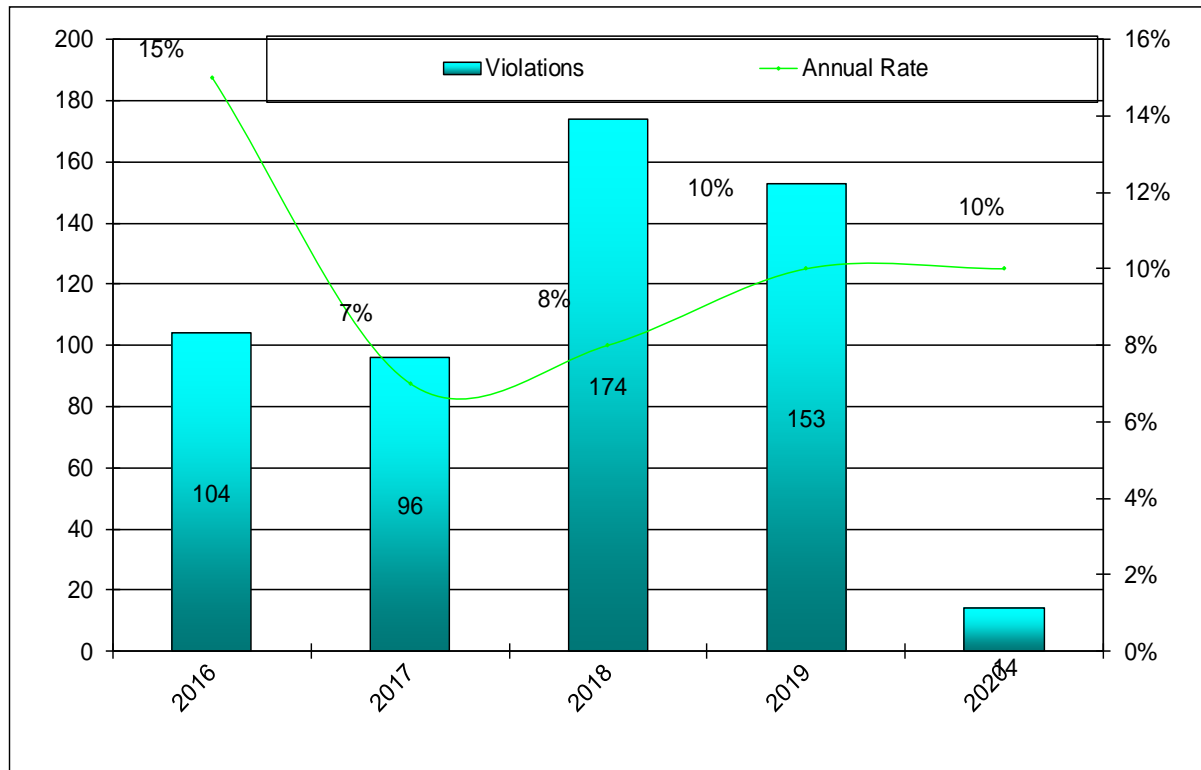
- Continued to enforce laws and treaties
- Heightened safety precautions
 - Enhanced pre-screening questions
 - N95 masks/PPE use
 - Practiced social distancing
- Out of state CG cutters self-quarantined for 14 days

- Boarding teams conducted health screenings prior to each boarding to provide to F/V
- USCG D17 Enforcement Reps participated in weekly Alaska Fishing Industry Safety and Health Committee calls





Boardings with Safety Violations

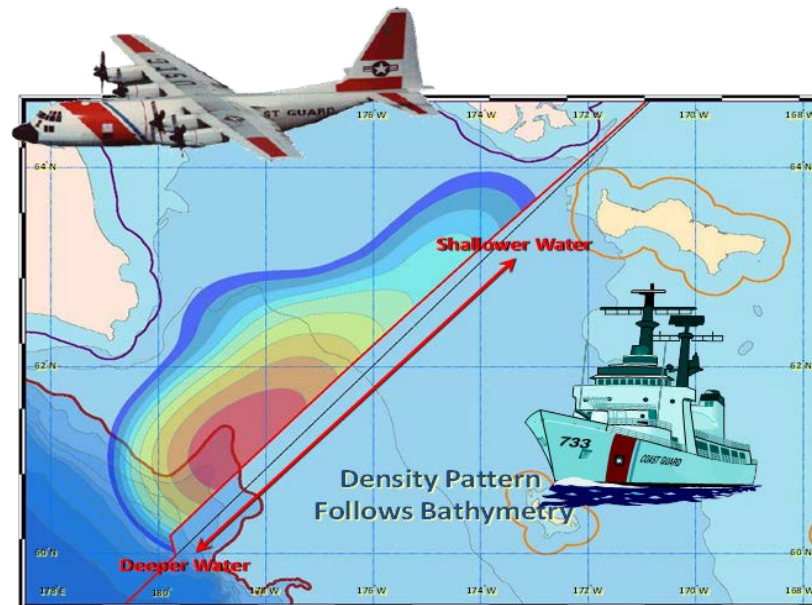


- **132 Boardings**
 - 14 Safety Violations detected on 8 Vessels
 - 6% of vessels boarded had safety violations



Maritime Boundary Line

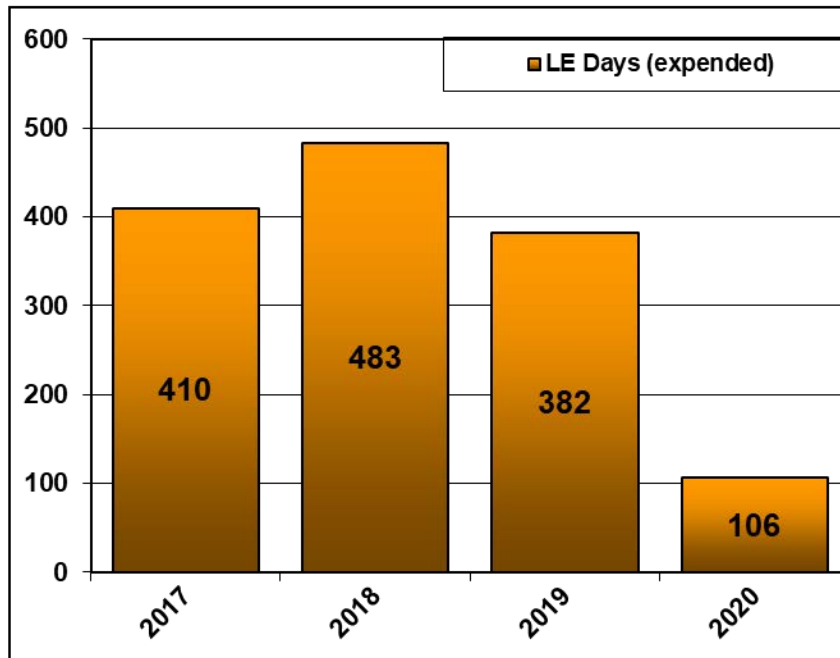
- Low activity until May

- 2 incursions by the same vessel- Investigation led to Russia issuing fines



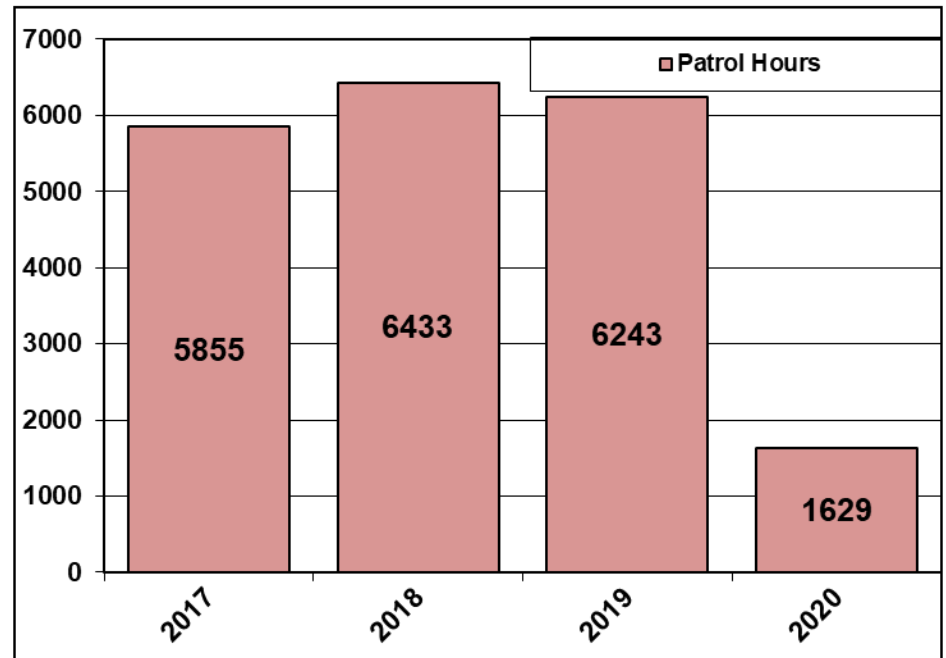


Cutter Usage

Major Cutter Days



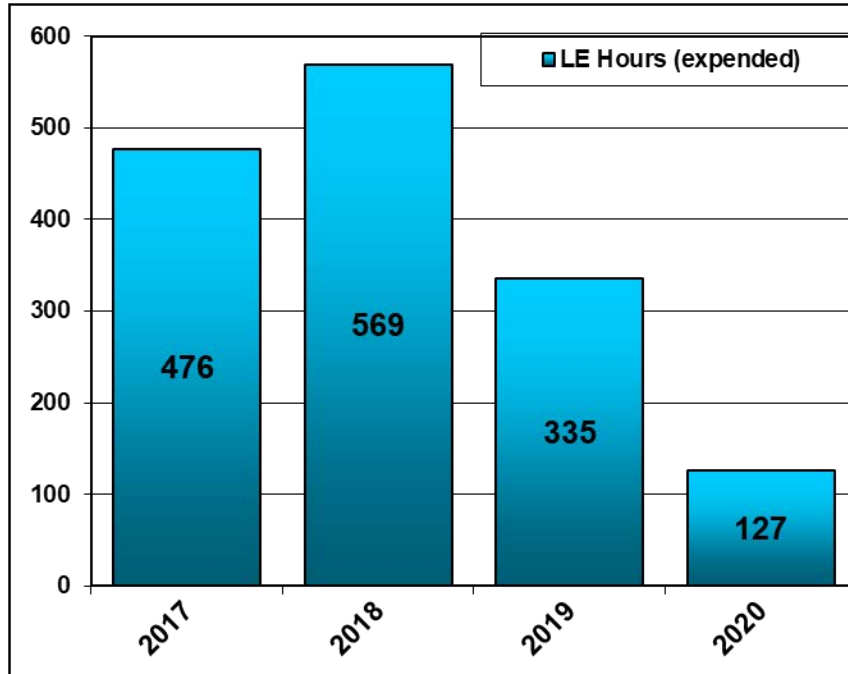
FRC/WPB Hours



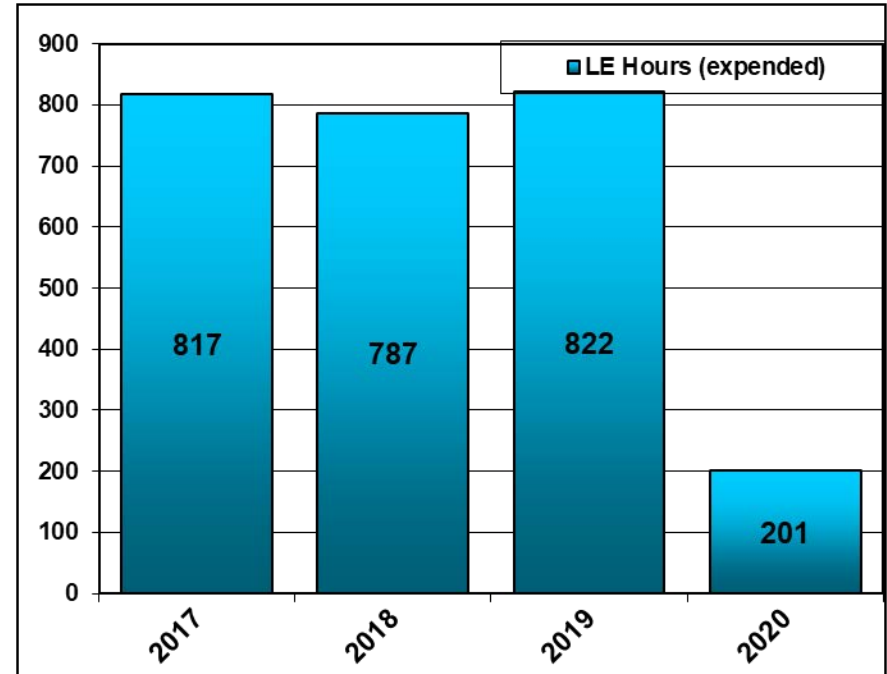


Aircraft Usage

HC-130 Hours



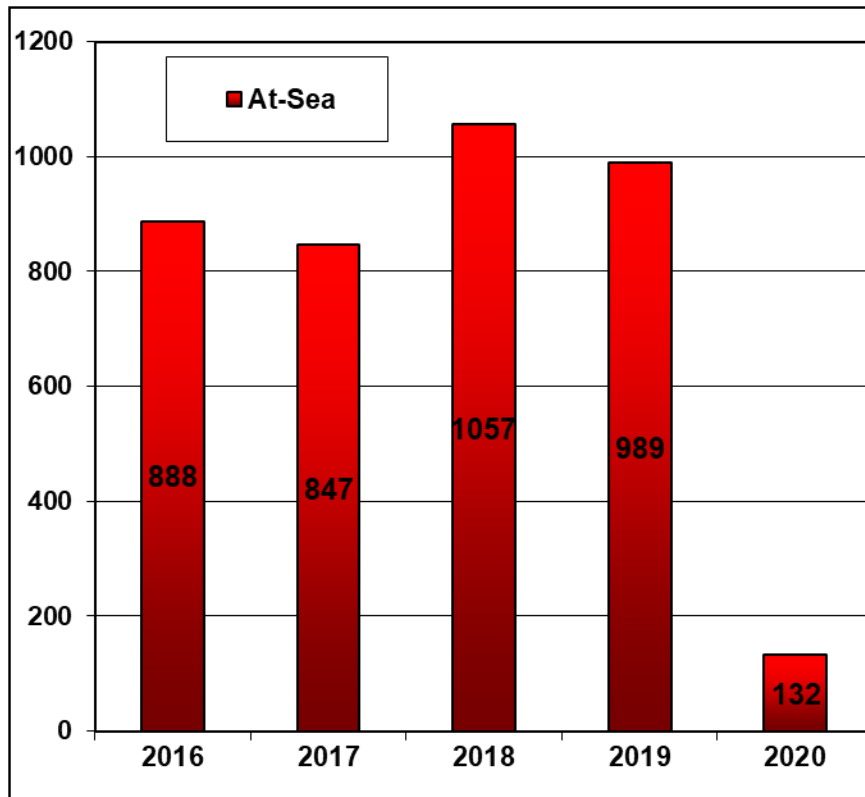
H-60/65 Hours



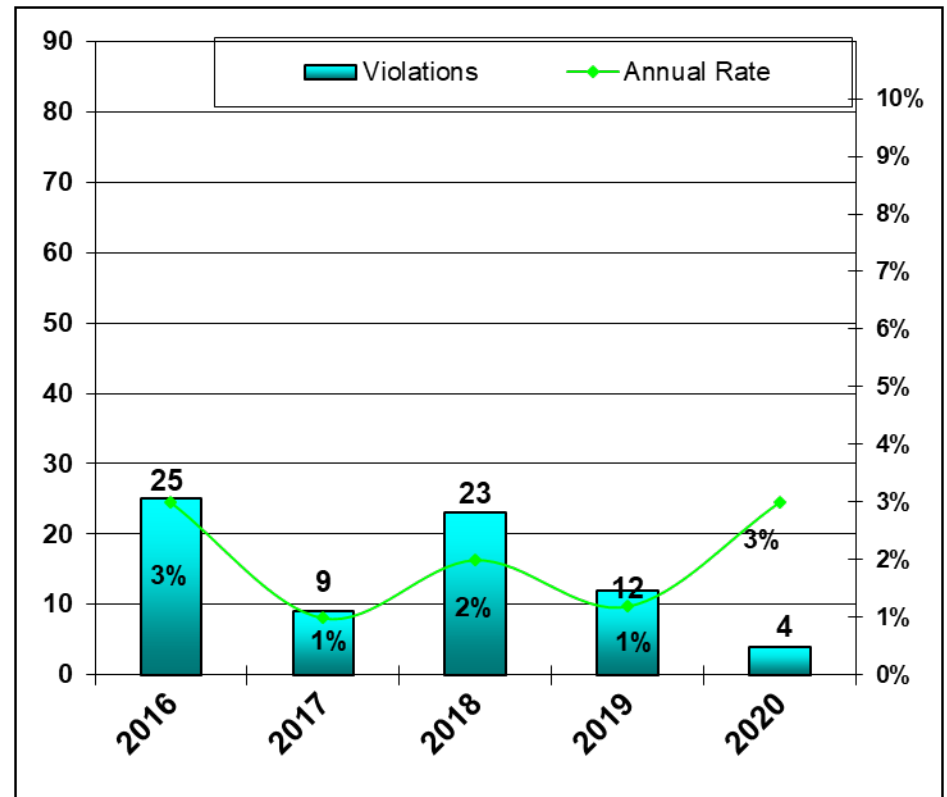

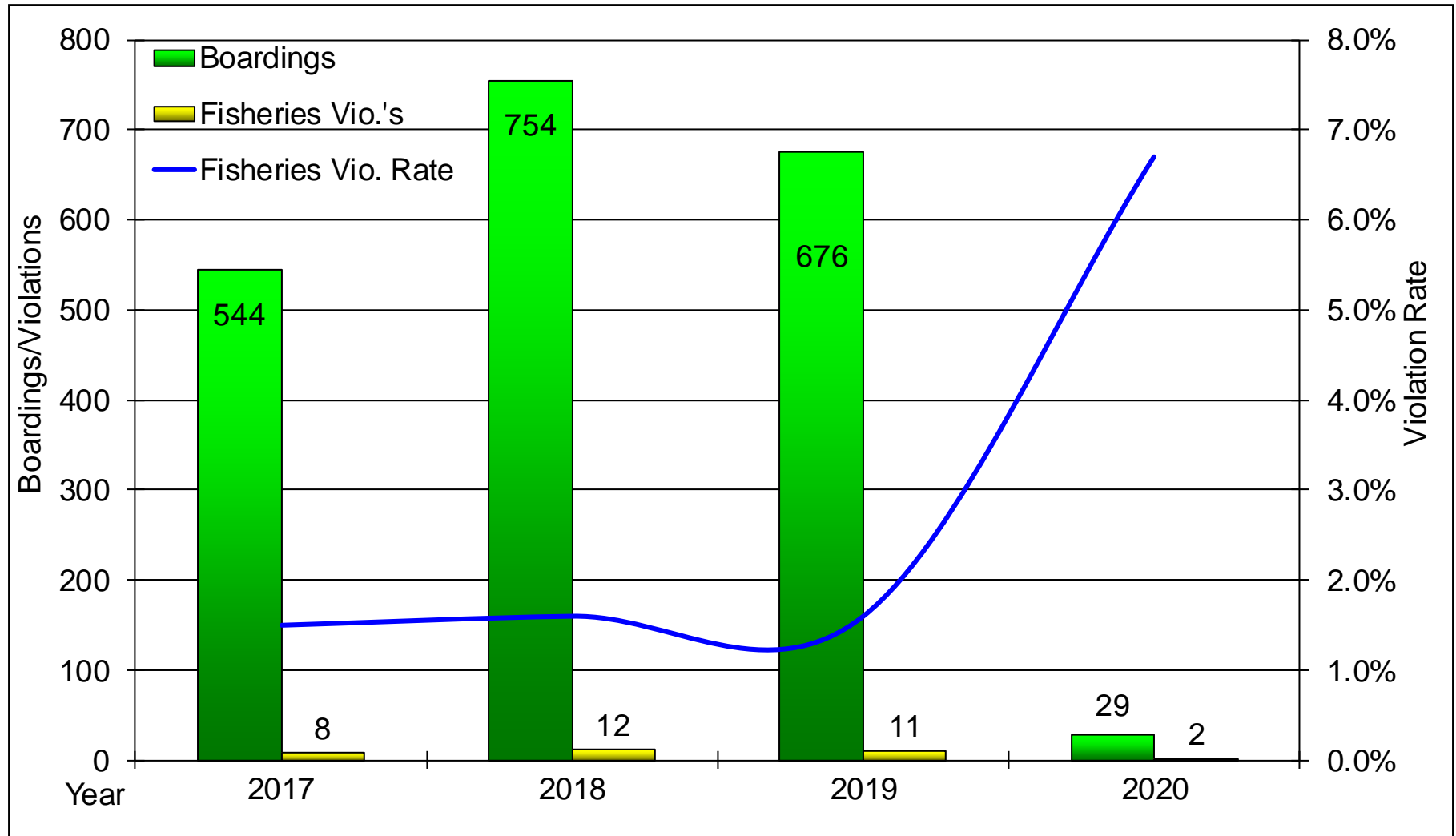


Fisheries Violations
