



Cook Inlet Area Shellfish Districts






Cook Inlet Area (H) Scallop Management


- Season
 - Kamishak District: August 15 October 31, unless closed by EO.
 - All other districts by commissioner's permit only.
- Guideline Harvest Range (GHR):
 - 10,000 to 20,000 lb of shucked meat.
- Gear
 - Single 6' dredge (only area different than statewide regs)
 - Other gear requirements same as statewide (4" rings, chafing gear)
- Crab bycatch limits
 - King crab fixed 30 crab (reduced from 60 in 2005)
 - Tanner crab
 - 0.5% of ≥ 70 mm crab estimated from scallop survey
 - Set at 3,933 crab after 2012 Kamishak Tanner crab survey (no trawl surveys since)
- Observer Requirements
 - Observer not required under statewide program.
 - Department observer accommodated upon request typically about half of trips observed.
 - When no observer onboard, skipper collects 100 top valves per trip.
 - Observer data compiled by Central Region staff.
 - Analysis of fishery data, scallop catch, deadloss, discard rate, & catch composition provided to SPT for SAFE.
- Reporting by Vessel Operator daily catch reports and logbooks.
- NEW adopted by BOF March 2018:
 - Allow commercially caught scallops in Kamishak Bay District to be delivered live.
 - No opportunity since fishery was closed in 2018 after survey results were analyzed.







Prince William Sound Area (Kayak fishery)







PWS Area (E) Scallop Management

- Season
 - Eastern Section, Outside District: July 1 February 15 (unless closed by EO).
- Guideline Harvest Range (GHR):
 - Zero to 50,000 lb of shucked meat.
- Gear same as statewide regulations
 - Maximum of two dredges, 15' wide; 4" rings; chafing gear specs
- Crab bycatch limits
 - Tanner crab
 - Fixed at 8,700 crab in Eastern Section and 2,700 in Western Section.
 - Set at 0.5% of historical crab estimate.
 - Tanner crab observed during fishery are small generally <70 mm; catch has been low, well below limits.
 - (No king crab limit set.)
- Observer requirements
 - Onboard observer required per statewide regulations.
 - Observer data compiled by statewide staff and distributed to Central Region staff.
- Reporting by vessel operators daily catch reports and logbooks.
