SUBJECT: Foreign Permit Application Review

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

We received a joint venture application from the Soviet processor/trawler PRIAMURYE as a replacement vessel for the previously approved KAZATIN. In a routine check for record of violations five citations were listed.

Details of the citations are attached in a letter from Ron Naab dated May 24, 1979. Other pertinent information on the PRIAMURYE is also attached.

COUNCIL ACTION

A recommendation is needed from the Foreign Permit Review Committee for Council consideration. Council recommendation is necessary.


Dear Jim:

2/23/78	CITATION	Failure to log catch to nearest hundredth of metric ton.
3/28/78	CITATION	Failure to return prohibited species to the sea in a timely manner.
3/28/78	CITATION	Failure to give adequate notification to the start in fishing.
3/28/78	CITATION	Failure to prominently display permit in the wheelhouse.
3/28/78	CITATION	Failure to give adequate notification of change in fishing area.

I do not consider the above citation as grounds for denial of a permit.
