



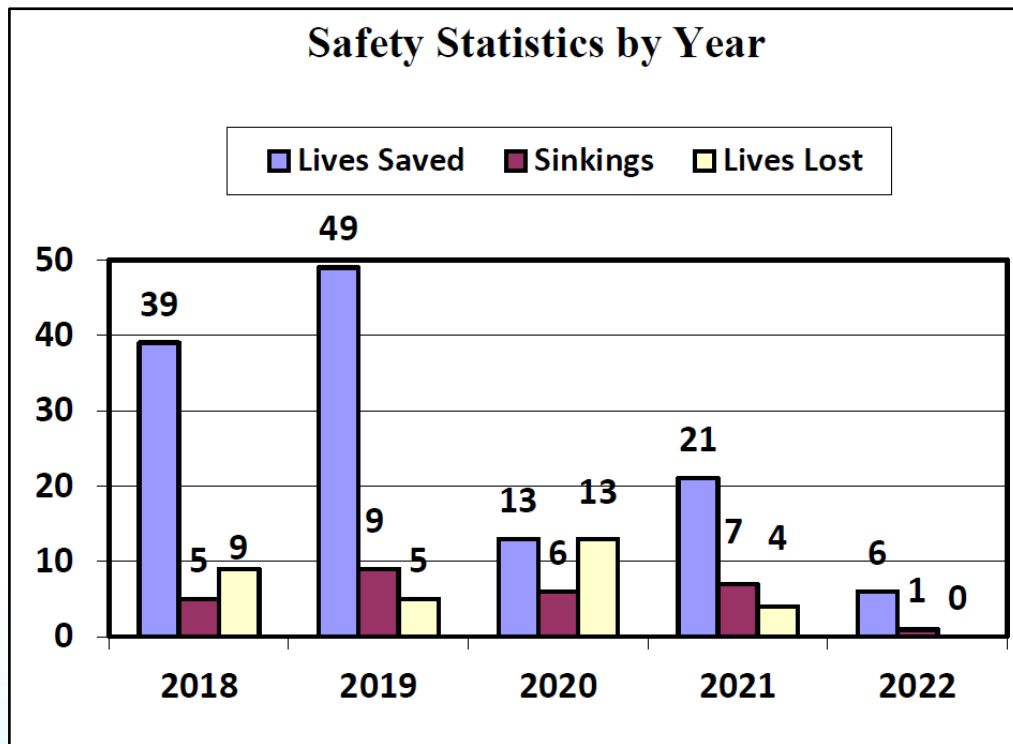

# Search and Rescue (SAR)

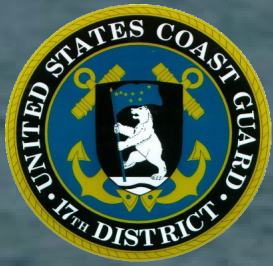


8 F/V SAR cases

1 Voyage termination

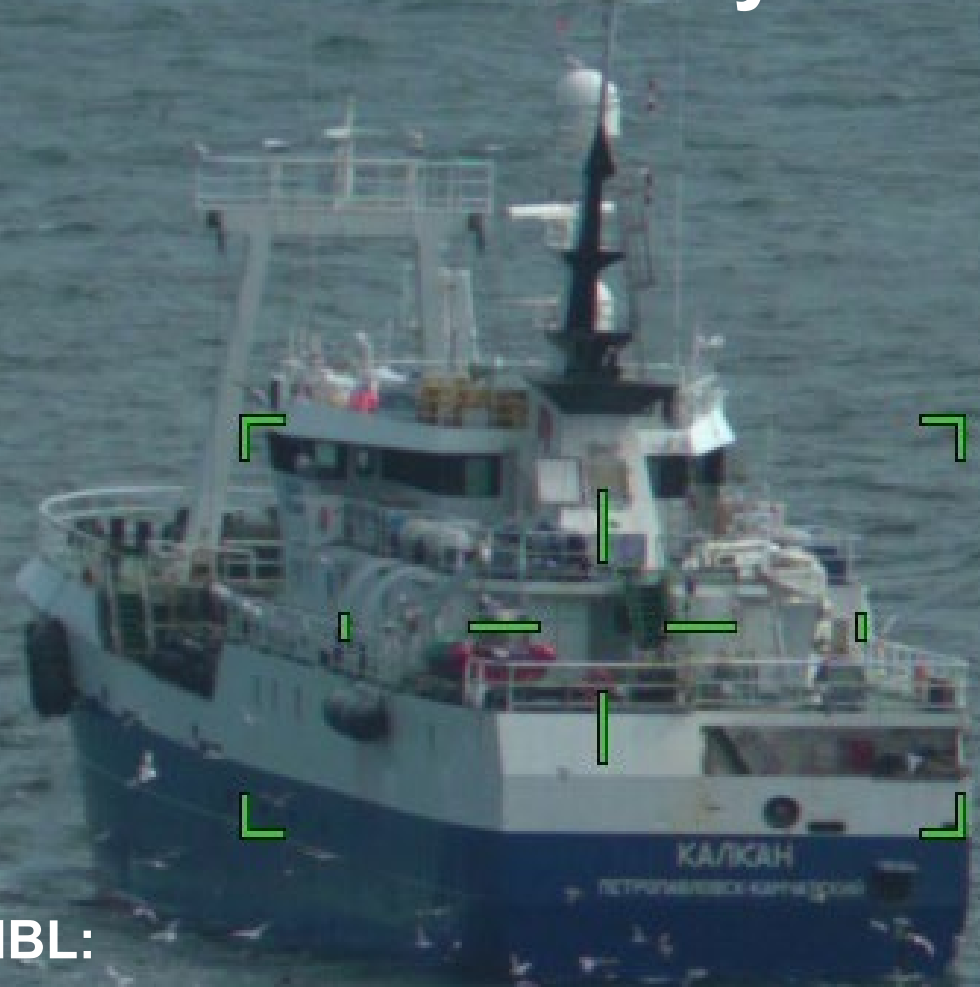
15 Safety Violations on 5 Vessels

## Activity w/in 20NM of US/RS MBL:

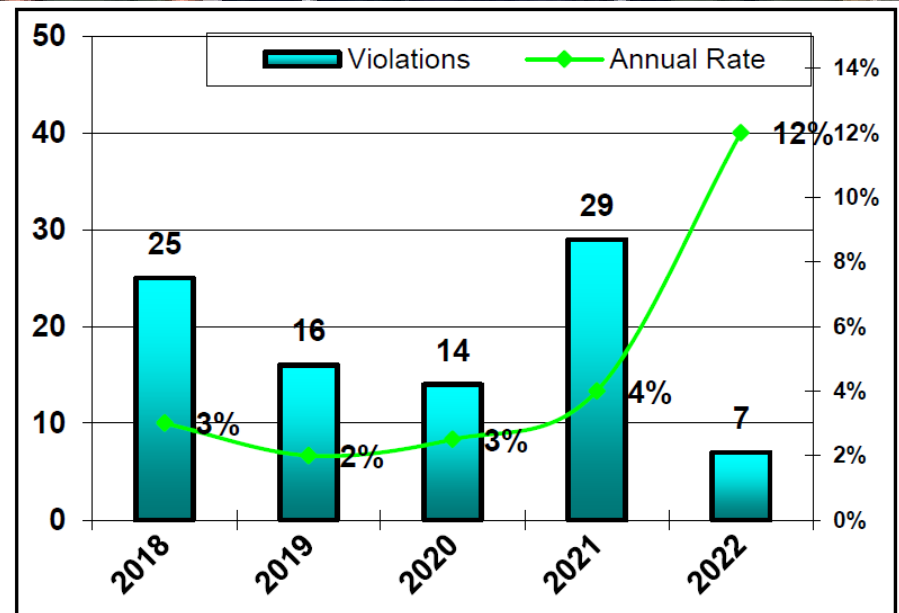
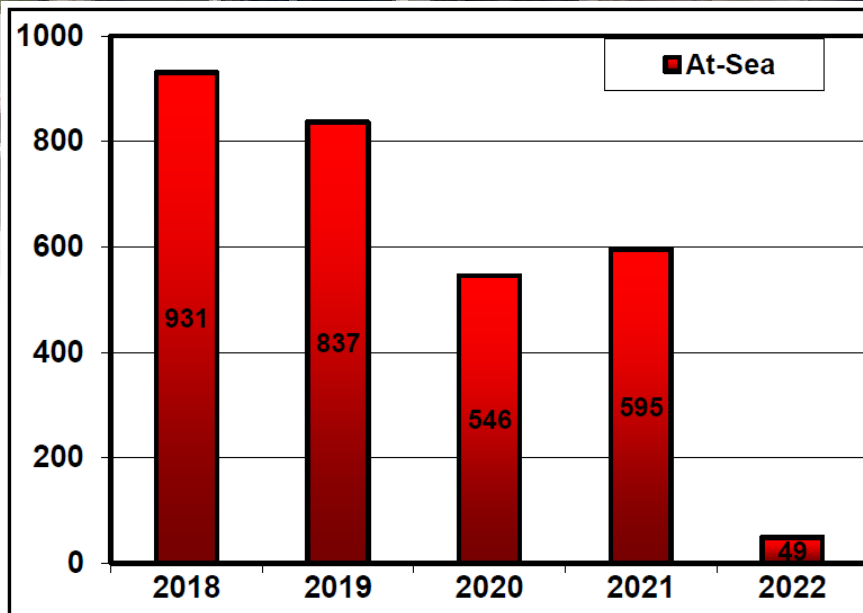
- Averaged less than 1 vessel/day

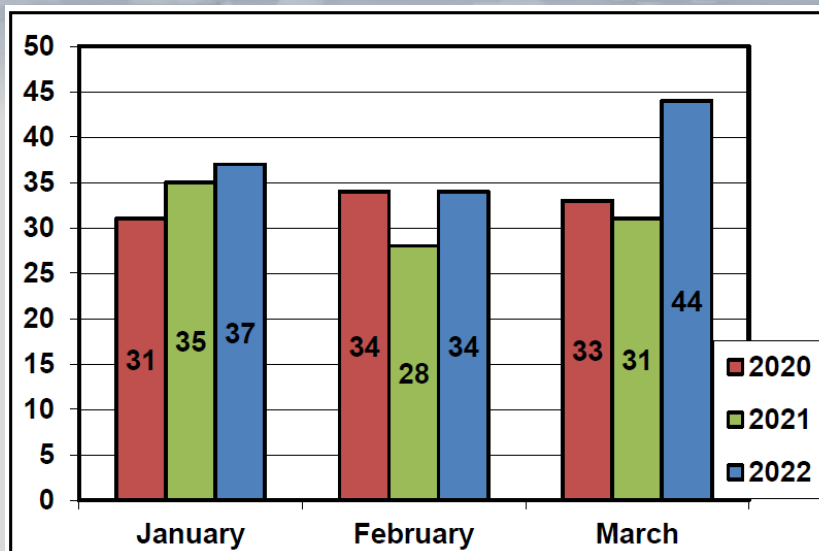

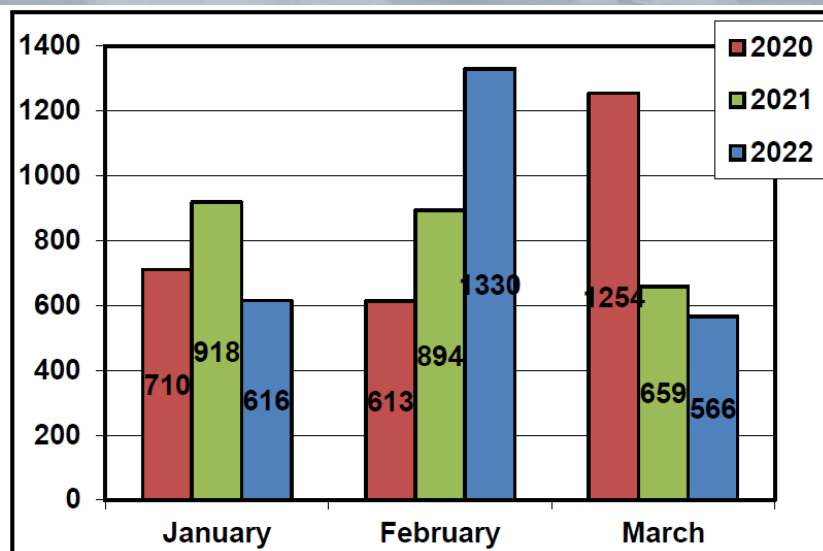
# Cutter Resource Allocation



## Major Cutter Days



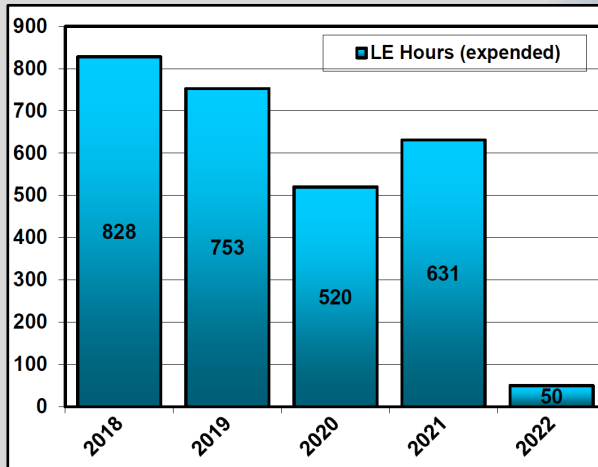
## Patrol Boat Hours



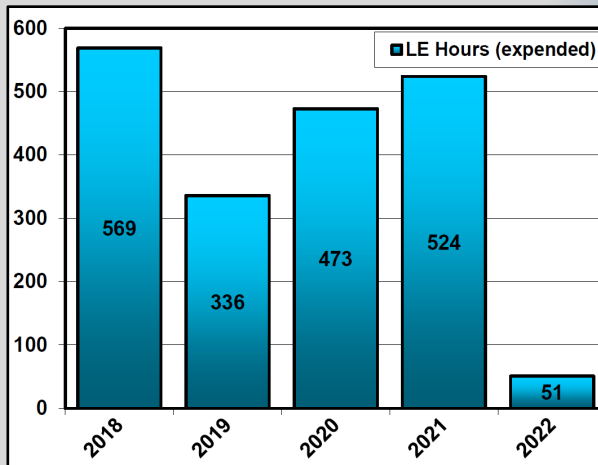


# Aircraft Resource Allocation
