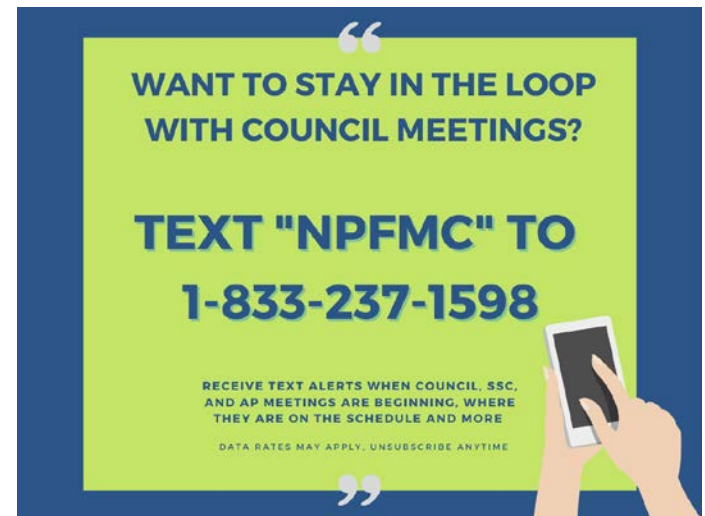

SSC HANDBOOK REVISIONS

Revised version of SSC handbook available (track changes) – please provide any additional input

- Council will approve revised version at Exec Session this meeting
- Brings SSC handbook in line with April Council SOPP changes, plus other updates:
 - Establishment of an anti-harassment policy
 - Updates on financial disclosures and recusal
 - Addition of anthropology as a qualifying area of SSC expertise
 - Updates to description of the SSC appointment process consistent with changes put in place last year
 - Travel and other housekeeping updates
- Additional changes in May 2023 version (vs April)
 - Recognition that SSC chair(s) are automatically members of the national SSC coordination committee (SCS) – p7
 - Updated language to reflect that SSC uses eAgenda for public testimony – p10



RESEARCH PRIORITIES 2024: PUBLIC INPUT

SSC Subgroup proposed plan for 2024 research priorities

- Builds on existing process used in 2021, re research priority categories (critical ongoing monitoring, urgent, important)
- **NEW**: Public solicitation period for research priorities
 - June – Oct/Nov, via online submission
- Categorized input/review by Council Plan Teams + SSC subgroup
 - Advisory groups review public submissions and provide team input re needed research, and top 3-5 priorities for each category
 - Hold virtual public meetings by January, with public comment opps
- SSC agenda item in Feb and April 2024
 - Feb: receive reports from advisory groups (no new priorities accepted)
 - April: prioritize across inputs to come up with top list of 8-12 priorities





General Public (online submission, June - Oct)





Initial Review (Oct-Jan; eg Jan CPT): 1) PTs review RP suggestions from public, authors, PT members, 2) receive public testimony (new RPs and/or support for others), 3) summarize RPs and recommend top 3-5. .

SSC step1, Feb mtg: 1) Receive presentations from all PTs, 2) receive public testimony (no new RPs), 3) draft any new SSC RPs.

RESEARCH PRIORITIES 2024: NEXT STEPS

- **Need concurrence from SSC re 2024 process** (June 2023 mtg)
- Need concurrence from Council re public solicitation (June 2023 mtg)
- If so:
 - SSC subgroup will work with staff to develop format for public to provide input
 - SSC subgroup and staff will work with PT chairs to ensure consistent approach for review of research priorities



MEETING CYCLE ADJUSTMENTS

- Remaining issue from 2022 Council effort to consider whether there are opportunities to improve Council operations
- Under consideration beginning in 2025:
 1. Drop the February meeting entirely
 2. Convert the Feb meeting to a virtual meeting
 - V1: SSC meets in person in Feb, AP/Council meet virtually
 - V2: Limit Dec meeting to specs only, with SSC in person and AP/C virtual; keep the Feb meeting as a full meeting
- Impetus?
 - Workload: insufficient time between Dec and Feb for staff to produce sufficient work for a full Feb agenda
 - Budget: with increasing operational and meeting costs, Council can save \$80,000-\$140,000 by dropping or making virtual one mtg/yr



AREAS FOR SSC INPUT RE FEB MEETING

SSC input welcomed re following considerations:

- **Drop Feb meeting**
 - Need to prioritize earlier timing of NSRKC assessment; fate of SSC workshop?
- **Make Feb virtual for SSC/AP/C**
 - Previous SSC concern about difficulty of taking up informational items virtually?
- **Make Feb in person for SSC and virtual for AP/C**
 - SSC flex re meeting location/workshop planning; requires different SSC report timing for Council but likely time certain
- **Make Dec in person for SSC and virtual for AP/C; gfish spx only**
 - Limits SSC workload in Dec to specs only; Feb is a full meeting
- **Also make another meeting virtual for SSC and in person for AP/C**
 - Provides full cost savings to Council of going virtual; parity for SSC members re number of in-person meetings



SSC OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT ON OTHER MEETING CYCLE CONSIDERATIONS

- Any input on changing the timing of the April and June meetings (to end Feb and mid May) if we drop February?
 - Adjustment will be needed to other regularly scheduled Council agenda items



- Any input on how to decide when, where, and how often to hold a meeting in the Pacific Northwest?
- Any input on how to weigh meeting in June in AK coastal communities vs cost and accessibility issues?
- Any input on occasionally having only Council meet in-person, and SSC/AP virtual, to allow Council to meet in smaller communities?
