




2C Yield and Harvest 1995 - 2019

- Wednesdays closed
- Five Tuesdays closed
- Four fish annual limit
- One trip per CHP per day
- One trip per vessel per day







Preliminary 2020 Estimates

2C 2020 Charter Regulations

- One fish bag limit
- Reverse slot limit:
 - Thru June 14:
 - Less than or equal to 40 inches
 - Greater than or equal to 80 inches
 - June 15 Dec 31:
 - Less than or equal to 45 inches
 - Greater than or equal to 80 inches

3A 2020 Charter Regulations

- Two fish bag limit
 - One fish of any size
 - One fish less than or equal to 26 inches thru
 June 14 then less than or equal to 32 inches
 through end of season
- Tuesdays and Wednesdays closed thru June 14
- Four fish annual limit thru June 14
- One trip per CHP per day
- One trip per vessel per day








Figure 2 in InfoHandoutADF&G_2020






Figure 3 in InfoHandoutADF&G_2020


