REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL CONCERNING COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT

- 1. Recent FCMA Infractions. Since the last Council meeting, three reports of violations (civil penalty procedures) and two citations (written warnings) have been issued. A brief summary of each infraction is as follows:
- a. 4 November. The South Korean Trawler SOO GONG NR 51 was issued a citation by USCGC RUSH for failure to properly maintain the cumulative catch log.
- b. 7 November. The South Korean Trawler Long Liner O DAE YANG 212 was issued two reports of violation by USCGC RUSH for failure to maintain a cumulative catch log and for failure to have a boarding ladder.
- c. 15 November. The Soviet Trawler MYS VORONINA was issued a citation by USCGC CAMPBELL for improper species logging in the cumulative catch log.
- d. 20 November. The Soviet Trawler TAJIKISTAN was issued a report of violation by USCGC JARVIS for failure to properly maintain the cumulative catch log.
