REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL CONCERNING COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT

- 1. Recent FCMA Infractions. One report of violation (civil penalty procedures) and two citations (written warnings) have been issued since the last council meeting. A brief summary of each infraction is as follows:
- a. 6 March. The Mexican trawler KORMEX 2 was issued a report of violation by the USCGC BOUTWELL for failure to log allocated species of pacific ocean perch to the nearest hundredth of a metric ton; fishing within the contiguous zone; failure to return a prohibited species (halibut) to the sea in a timely manner and illegal retention and possession of halibut.
- b. 7 March. The Japanese longliner EBISU MARU NO. 88 was issued a citation by the USCGC BOUTWELL for failure to log discarded pollock and atka mackerel.
- c. 15 March. The Soviet trawler ALEXANDER MAXUTOV was issued a citation by the USCGC BOUTWELL for failure to maintain an accurate transfer log.
