D5 Research Priorities
June 11, 2024

The Council adopts the SSC recommendations for the 5-year research priorities, including their “top ten” list, the critical ongoing monitoring list, and their proposal for additional guidance to the COM list concerning LKTKS, and makes the following changes to the wording of two of the top priorities:

Retitle RP 731 as follows:

Norton Sound Red King Crab case study as a pilot study for the incorporation of Local Knowledge, Traditional Knowledge, and subsistence information in a relatively small scale fishery that is experiencing challenges related to both stock and climate change factors (731).

Remove the word ‘coastal’ from the title of RP 811:

Examine the economic, social, and cultural effects of fisheries and fishery management policy on communities over time (including impacts from fishery policy changes and Tribal citizen and Tribal Nation reliance on, participation in, and impacts of federally managed fisheries) (811).
