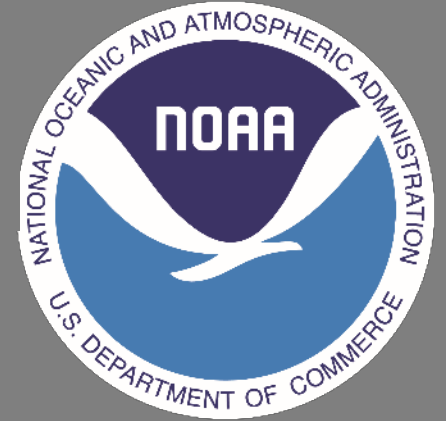

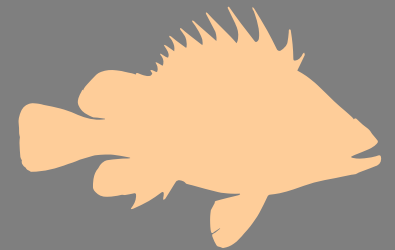

# IDENTIFICATION OF PRIORITY STOCKS

- 35 Individual stocks (Table 1)
  - “stock” is an individual species for a given assessment and area
- Seven attributes were used to rank stocks (Table 2)
  - Life history, catch characteristics, relatedness to complex
- Six weighting schemes to account for relatedness in attributes

# IDENTIFICATION OF PRIORITY STOCKS

- Top five stocks were selected as priority stocks (Table 3)
  - *GOA Pacific sleeper shark*
  - *GOA salmon shark*
  - *GOA octopus*
  - *GOA quillback rockfish (SEO)*
  - *GOA yelloweye rockfish (outside SEO)*
