ECOSYSTEM AND CLIMATE COMMITTEE (ECC) PROPOSAL

- Council announced interest in reconstituting the standing Ecosystem Committee
- Broader focus: Ecosystem and Climate
- Purpose: Review, discuss, and advise on ecosystem and climate-related issues as directed by the Council.
 - Responsive to CCTF recommendation: review body with policy-based perspective on climate-related information in the Council process
- Potential tasking:
 - IRA climate readiness planning and projects
 - Ongoing implementation of Council's Climate Resilience Workplan
 - Development of Programmatic Evaluation
 - Emerging issues as needed (eg, EFH reviews, Arctic FMP/related, NMFS EBFM policy guidance)
- Operations: meet max 1-2x/year
- Membership: balanced representation of 7-10 persons, including agency staff



FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT

- Met March 27th to discuss status of Council finances report posted
- Discussed contingency planning scenarios should there be a reduction in funding
- Recommendations:
 - Remove February dates from all future scheduling
 - Proposal for 1-on/1-off cycle of in-person/virtual meetings IF NEEDED
 - Commit to holding all in-person meetings not yet contracted in least expensive venue, likely Anchorage (noting several June contracts in Pacific Northwest already obligated)
 - Explore options to control costs during in-person meetings, with tighter scheduling and perhaps no room blocks for public
 - Explore options for cheaper venue for hosting CCC meeting in 2026

- Council practice is to receive a 2-meeting snapshot each meeting in staff tasking, and conduct a triennial comprehensive review
- Snapshot maps Council actions at each meeting to groundfish policy objectives
- Last comprehensive review was in <u>February 2022</u>; 2025 review was deferred in favor of the Programmatic evaluation
