SOPP AND AP/SSC HANDBOOKS

- SOPP last updated in 2023; revisions proposed (draft posted with track changes)
 - Primarily updates throughout to make the SOPP consistent with procedural changes that the Council has already instituted
 - NPFMC code of conduct for all participants and members, and pathways for follow through
 - remote participation clarifications for all members
 - description of public comment processes and use of eAgenda
 - new expectation of 4 meetings/year rather than 5, and virtual meetings if nec. based on budget
 - Council interim appointments and change of residency, limits on questions, Council record
 - AP/SSC nomination process, removes AP minority report
 - Financial management and whistleblower language updates required under the Council grant
- AP/SSC handbook revisions similar, reviewed with AP in June and SSC in April

FUTURE MEETINGS: CONTINGENT ON BUDGET

- October 2025 virtual
 - virtual to prioritize December in-person meeting
 - reminder April Finance Committee report discussed: 4 mtgs/year, 1-on/1-off virtual/in-person IF NEEDED for budget contingencies
- December 2025 currently overscheduled (2 issues), need to adjust
 - Currently schedules "must do" time-sensitive items PLUS chum salmon final action
 - BSAI/GOA Groundfish final specifications for 2026/2027 must approve by mid-December
 - Charter halibut 2026 management measures due to IPHC by Dec. 26th
 - NSRKC harvest specifications needed by Jan/Feb for State of Alaska to open NSRKC fishery
 - Cook Inlet salmon harvest specifications needed by Feb to open June fishery
 - Chair and ED will continue to consider time management as well as staff capacity, Council funding, and new issues that may arise in determining the final Council schedule

ISSUE WITH COUNCIL SCHEDULE IN DECEMBER

Council Agenda

- Prudent scheduling of Chum action at Council is 5.5-6 days
- BSAI/GOA Groundfish specifications requires 1.5-2 days, plus .5-1 day for charter halibut, NSRKC, and Cook Inlet specs
- Council can't take up specs until after SSC deliberates, so chum must be first
- ~8-9 days just for Council, plus SSC in same room = Dec footprint of 12 days
 hard to extend in-person venue
 - Current : 9 days (Mon 12/1-Tues 12/9)
 - Can't move meetings earlier because of Thanksgiving

Solutions?

- 1. Move chum bycatch final action from December 2025 to April 2026
 - Variation: move April meeting earlier, to February or March
 - Bring forward some 3 meeting outlook April agenda items to December
- 2. Move some/all items except chum to a virtual Council meeting during week of Dec 15-19
 - Variation: groundfish and charter halibut in December, NSRKC and Cook Inlet in Jan/Feb
 - AP may need to drop specifications items or convene virtually earlier on chum – eg before Thanksgiving

ADDITIONAL CHUM BYCATCH ANALYSIS CONSIDERATIONS

- Council analysis of new management measures to minimize chum salmon bycatch, particularly that of western Alaska origin, in the Bering Sea pollock fishery
- Council reviewed <u>revised Initial Review Analysis</u> in February 2025
 - Modified alternatives
 - Approved the analysis for publication as the Draft Environmental Impact Statement
 - Directed staff to schedule final action (tentatively December 2025)
- Analysis of new alternative 5 and other changes taking time
 - Council staff working with agency to ensure timely publication of Draft EIS

COMPARISON OF TIMELINES

December 2025 Final Action

- Aug 15, 2025 (T): Draft EIS published
- Oct 15, 2025 (T): Public comment ends
- Dec 2025: Final Action
- Feb 2027 (T): Final EIS issued
- Apr 2027 (T): Record of Decision issued

April 2026 Final Action

- Oct 15, 2025 (T): Draft EIS published
- Dec 15, 2025 (T): Public comment ends
- Apr 2026: Final Action
- Jun 2027 (T): Final EIS issued
- Aug 2027 (T): Record of Decision issued

Implementation timing uncertainties:

- Response to comments, potentially complex rulemaking, NMFS review, administration priorities
- If Council adopts PSC limits, ideal to publish in the groundfish harvest specs Final Rule prior to B season

ISSUE WITH <u>SSC</u> SCHEDULE IN DECEMBER - SPECS

- SSC schedule to take up BSAI/GOA groundfish, NSRKC, Cook Inlet salmon specifications
- Agenda items require approx. 30hrs; time available is 20-24 hours
- SSC can't extend past 3 days
- Viable solution endorsed by SSC for 2025: move Cook Inlet salmon specs to a late Jan/early Feb full SSC meeting in lieu of April mtg
 - Maintains Council commitment to 4 meetings/year
- Longer term possibilities that may help: move NSRKC, Cook Inlet Tier 3 stocks to a bi/triennial cycle, changes to SSC's groundfish "update assessment" reviews
