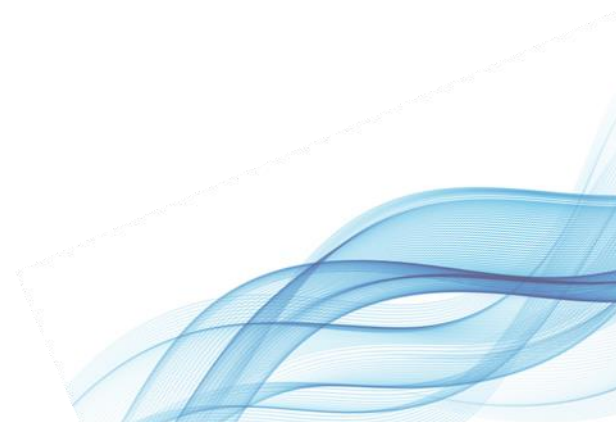

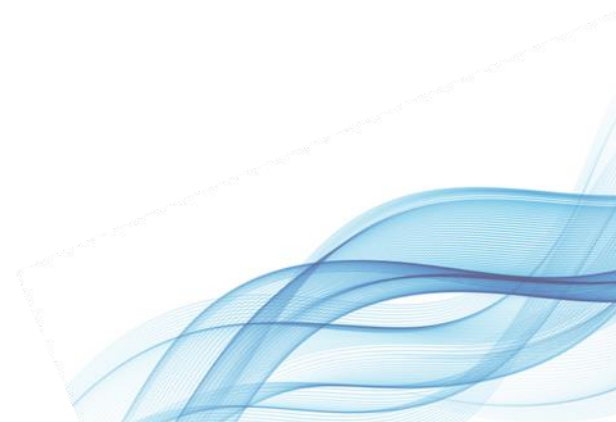


# Breakout 1: Current trajectory

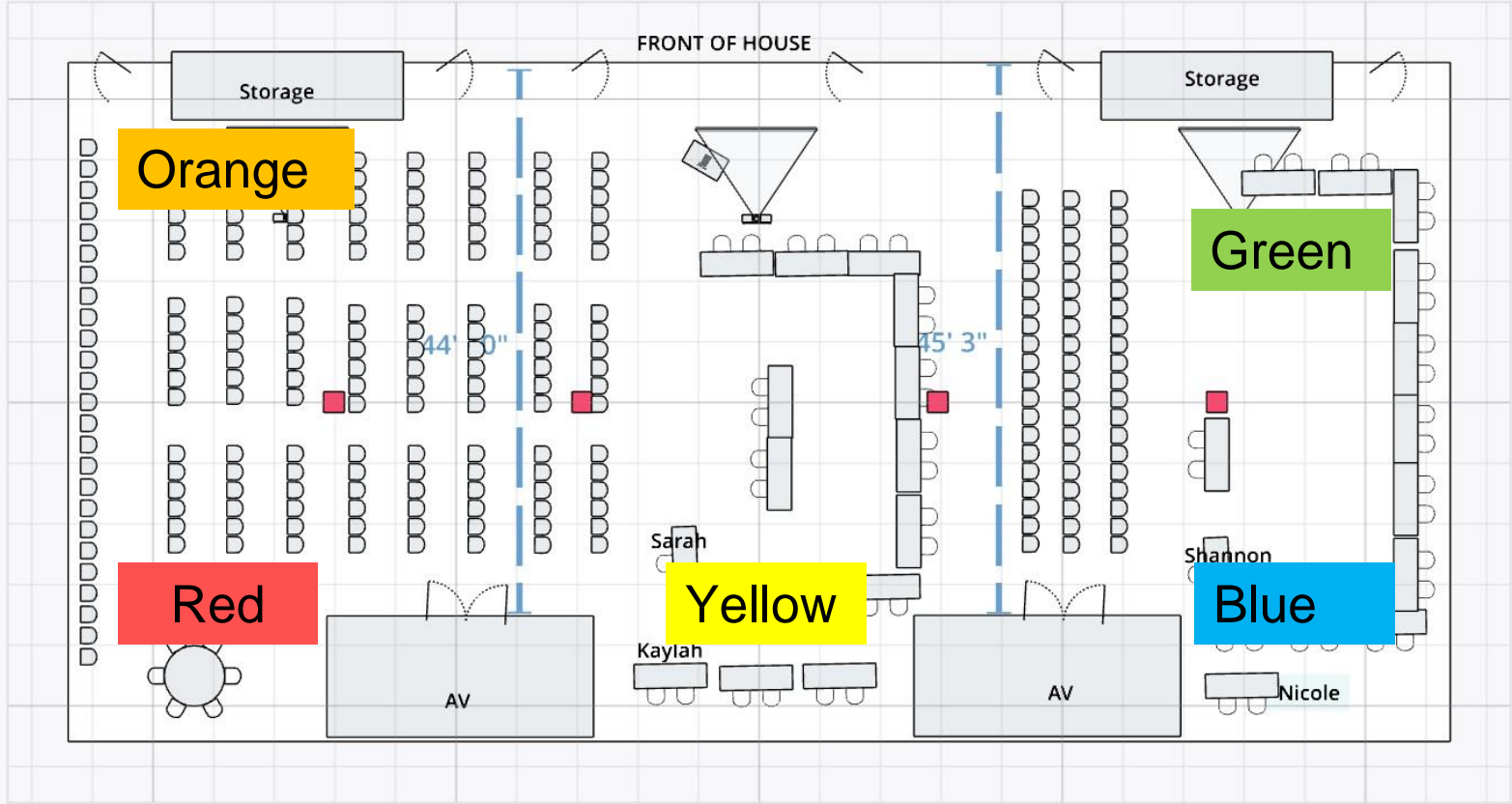

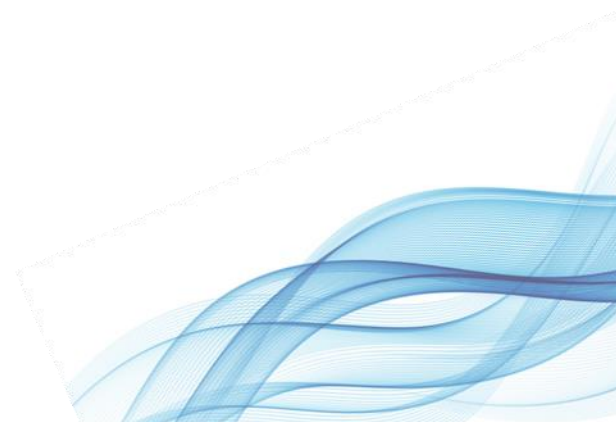
