1. ON SUBJECT JOINT VENTURE HAS NOT BEEN FINALIZED
THEREFORE COMPLETE DETAILS NOT AVAILABLE. PRELIMINARY
INFO INDICATES ROK DEAL SAME AS WITH SPANISH-MEXICAN
JOINT VENTURES:

- (A) ROK VESSELS MUST TRANSFER FLAG TO MEXICAN.
- (B) ON INITIAL TRIP AND THEREAFTER CAPTAIN AND CHIEF
ENGINEER MUST BE MEXICAN.
- (C) FOREIGN CREW TO BE REPLACED AT RATE OF 25 PER TRIP,
WITH FULL MEXICAN COMPLEMENT REACHED BY END SECOND YEAR.
- (D) AT LEAST 20 PERCENT OF CATCH MUST BE DESTINED FOR MEXICAN
MARKET AND INCREASED AS MARKET DEMAND GROWS.
- (E) BALANCE OF FISH DESTINED FOR FOREIGN MARKETS,
PROBABLY JAPAN.
