HEARINGS

If the Council adopts management plans at the December meeting, they will need to hold public hearings beginning approximately January 5 to get public input into the management plans and hopefully into the EIS procedure at the same meetings. The process if explained more fully in Section H, Tab 4.

The Council will have to decide where they want meetings and assign Council members to run them. One or more Council members can conduct public hearings. In order to stay on the time schedule for development of the management plans, all public hearings should be conducted within a ten day period.
