




# 2000 BSAI TRAWL GROUND FISH CATCH BY TARGET





# 2000 BSAI TRW TOTAL YEAR-TO-DATE HALIBUT MORTALITY BY GROUND FISH TARGET







# 2000 BERING SEA POLLOCK CATCH





# Steller sea lion conservation area (SCA) of the Bering Sea





# 2000 BERING SEA POLLOCK CATCH AS OF 09/16/00

# 2000 BSAI SHARPCHIN/NORTHERN ROCKFISH & ATKA MACKEREL CATCH










# 2000 GOA & AI SUMMER PACIFIC OCEAN PERCH CATCH (PAGE 1 OF 2)






# 1999 & 2000 GOA AUGUST/SEPTEMBER POLLOCK CATCH (MT) & NUMBER OF VESSELS




# 2000 GOA C & D SEASONS, POLLOCK CATCH (MT)




# 2000 GOA GROUND FISH CATCH IN SW & DW TRAWL COMPLEX TARGETS

Bycatch rate standards for trawl fisheries under the Pacific halibut and red king crab vessel incentive program during the first half of 2001 are scheduled to be published in the Federal Register by January 1, 2001. A summary of 1996 - 2000 observer data on fishery bycatch rates is listed in the attached table for review by the Council. The halibut bycatch rates for the first three quarters of 2000 have been updated. With the exception of the third quarter yellowfin sole fishery in the Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands and the third quarter Gulf of Alaska pollock fishery, the observed rates are below the bycatch rate standards. The higher third quarter rate in the yellowfin sole fishery probably reflect the mixed nature of the fishery where effort can be distributed among yellowfin, Pacific cod, flathead sole and turbot.

Unless the Council recommends a change in these standards, we will use for the first half of 2001 the halibut and red king crab bycatch rate standards listed in the attached table for the third and fourth calendar quarters of the year.


