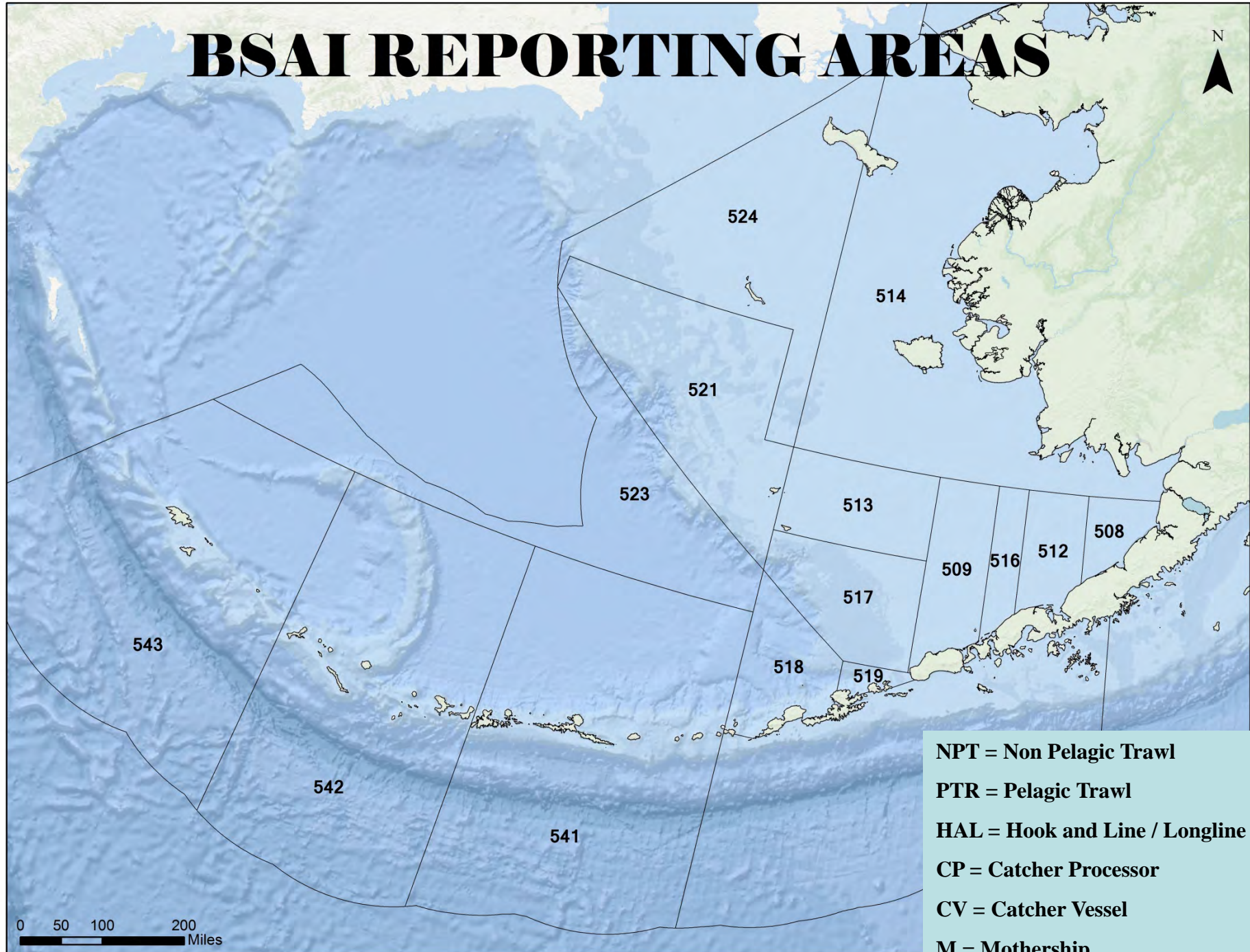

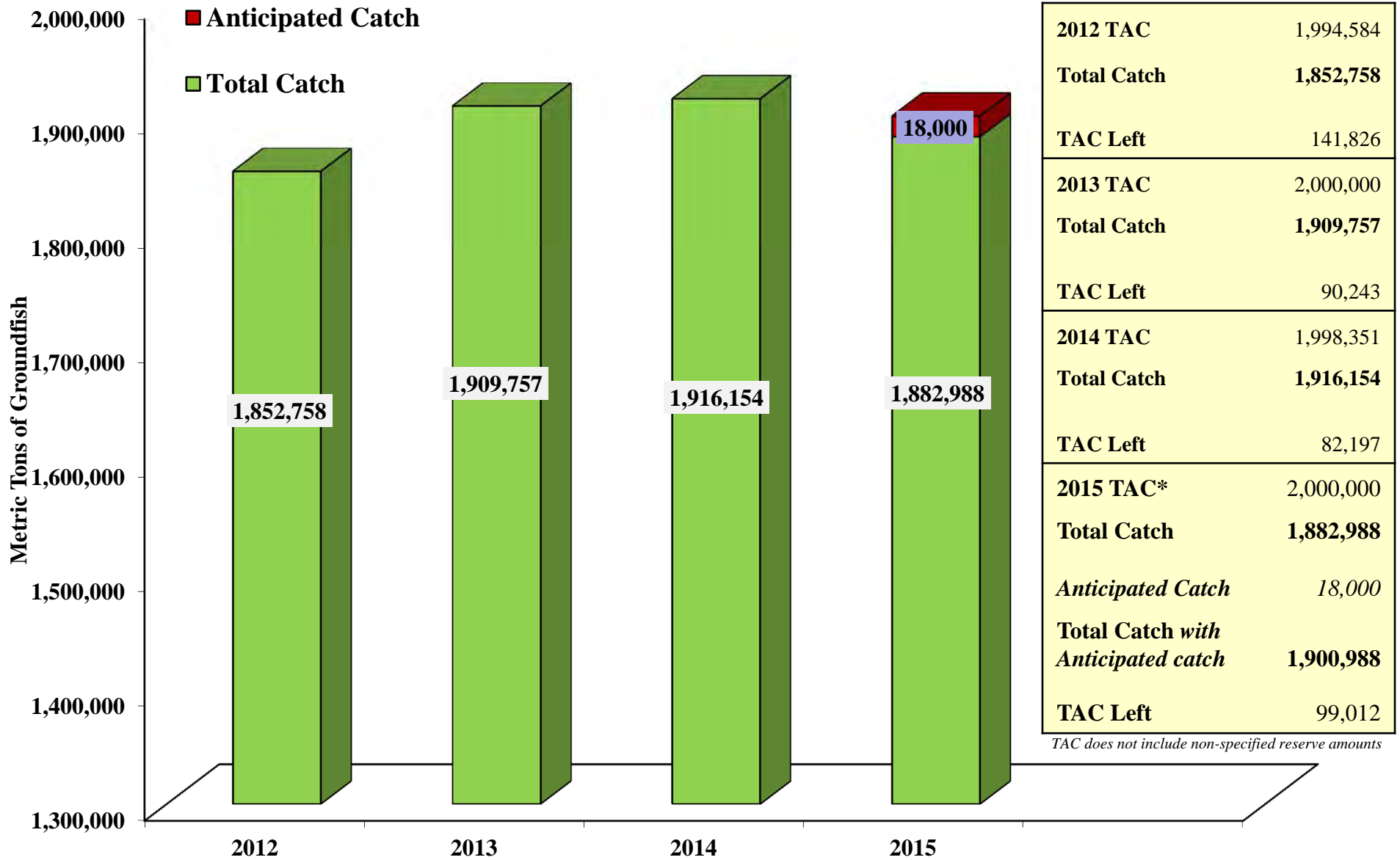

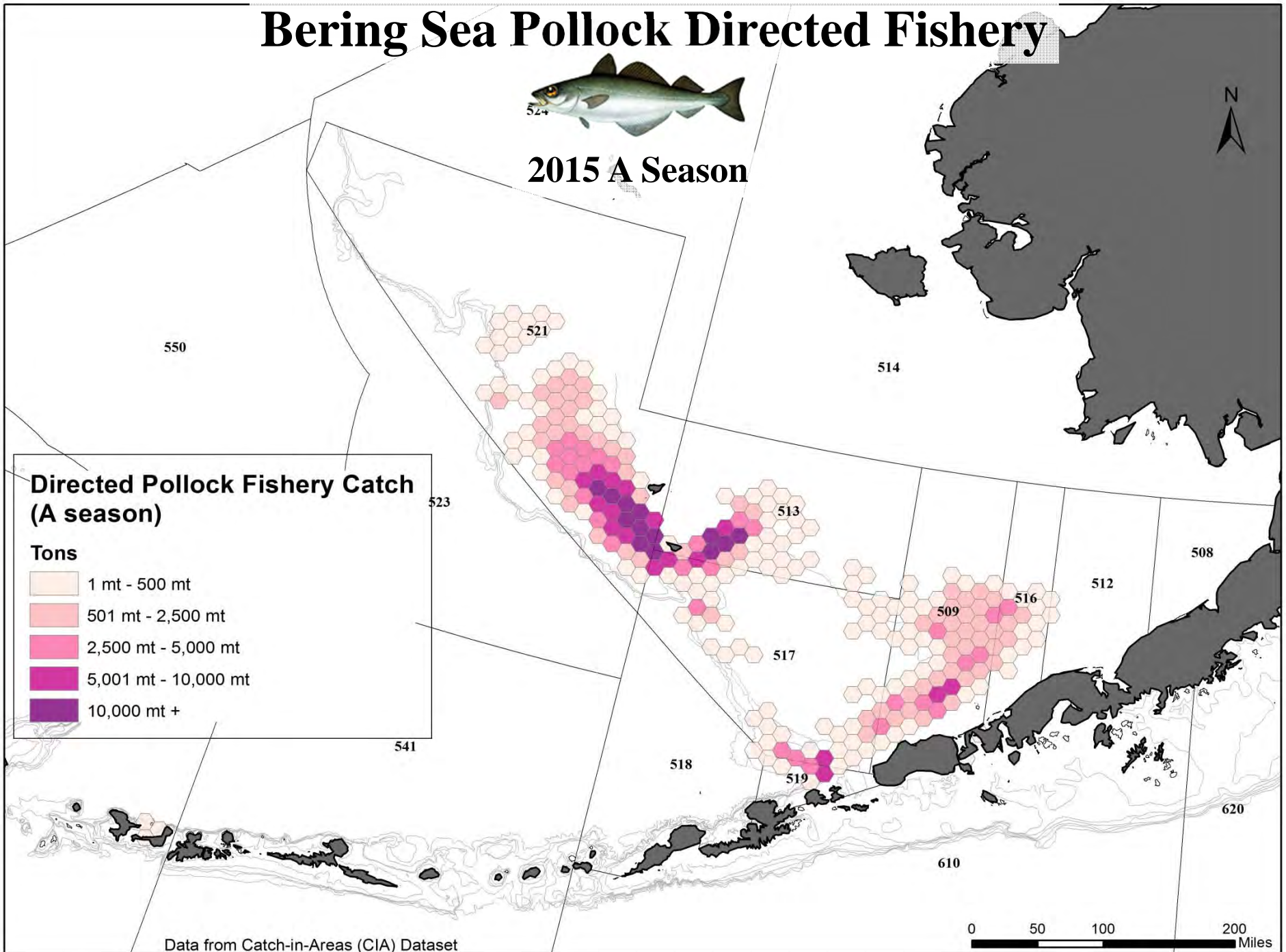
2012 - 2015 BSAI Total Catch



Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery



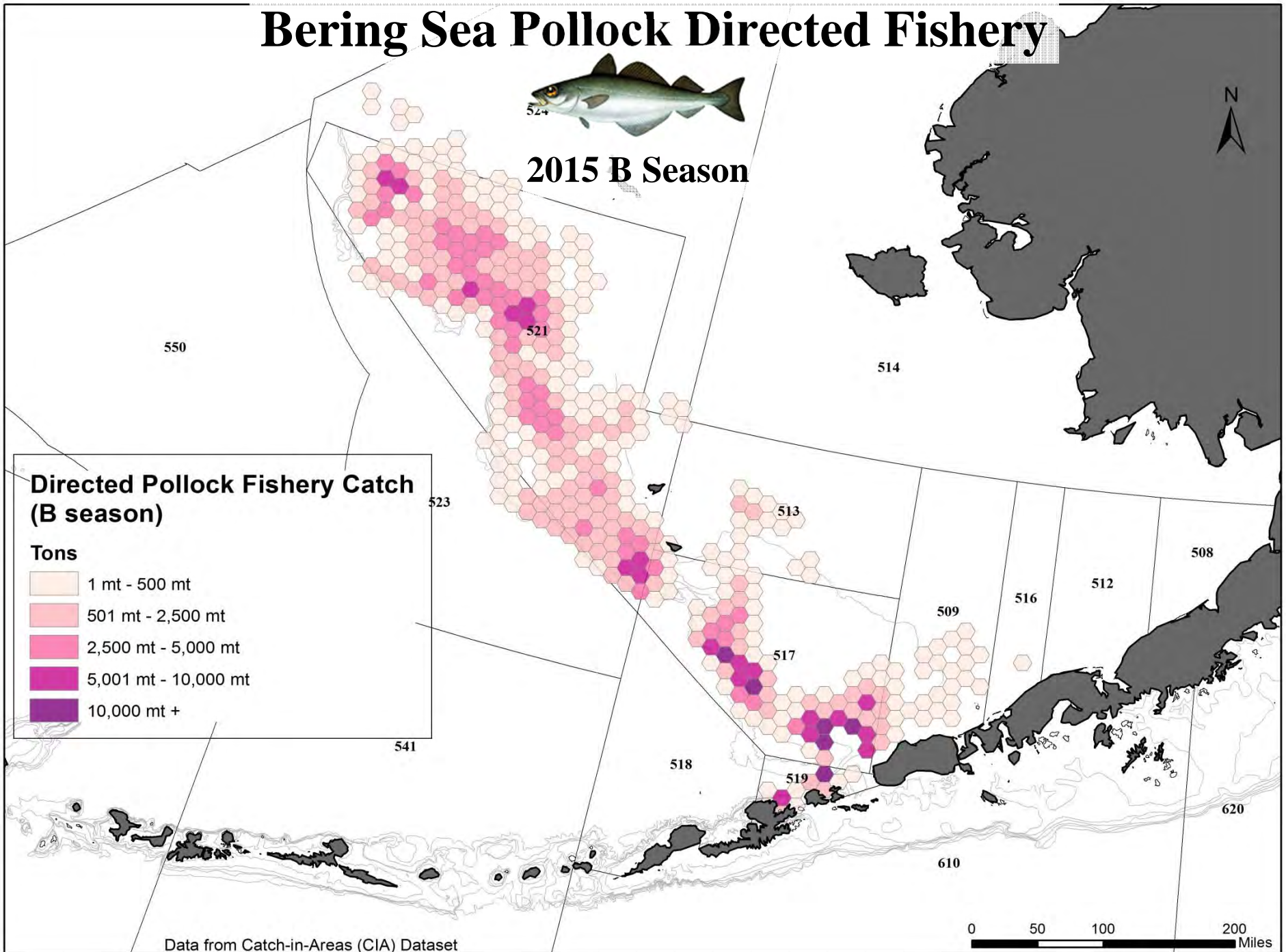

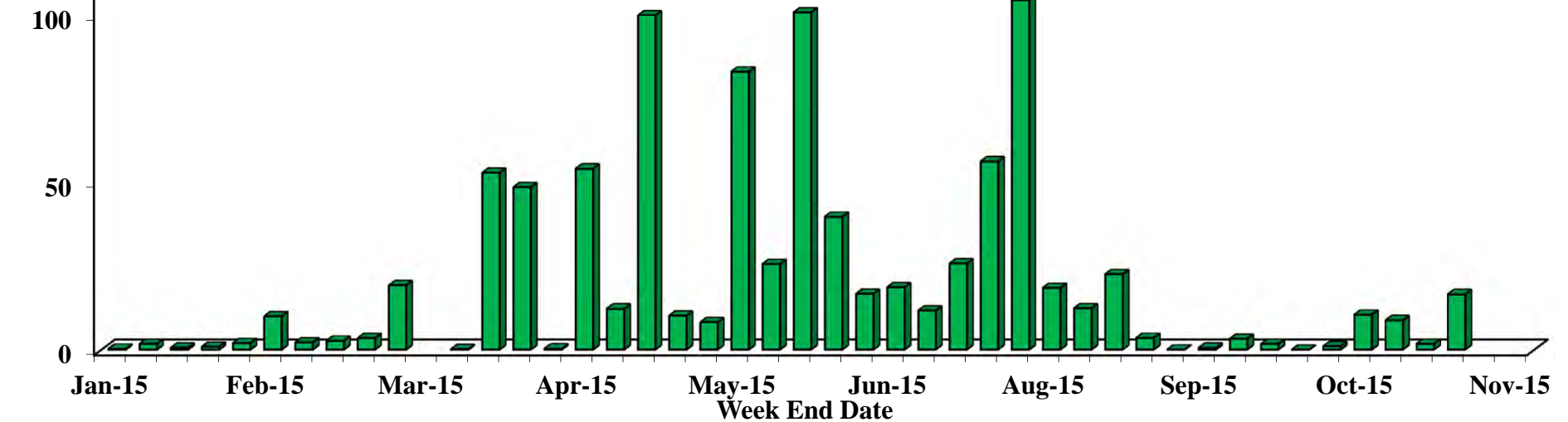
2015 Aleutian Islands Pollock Catch by Week and Sector



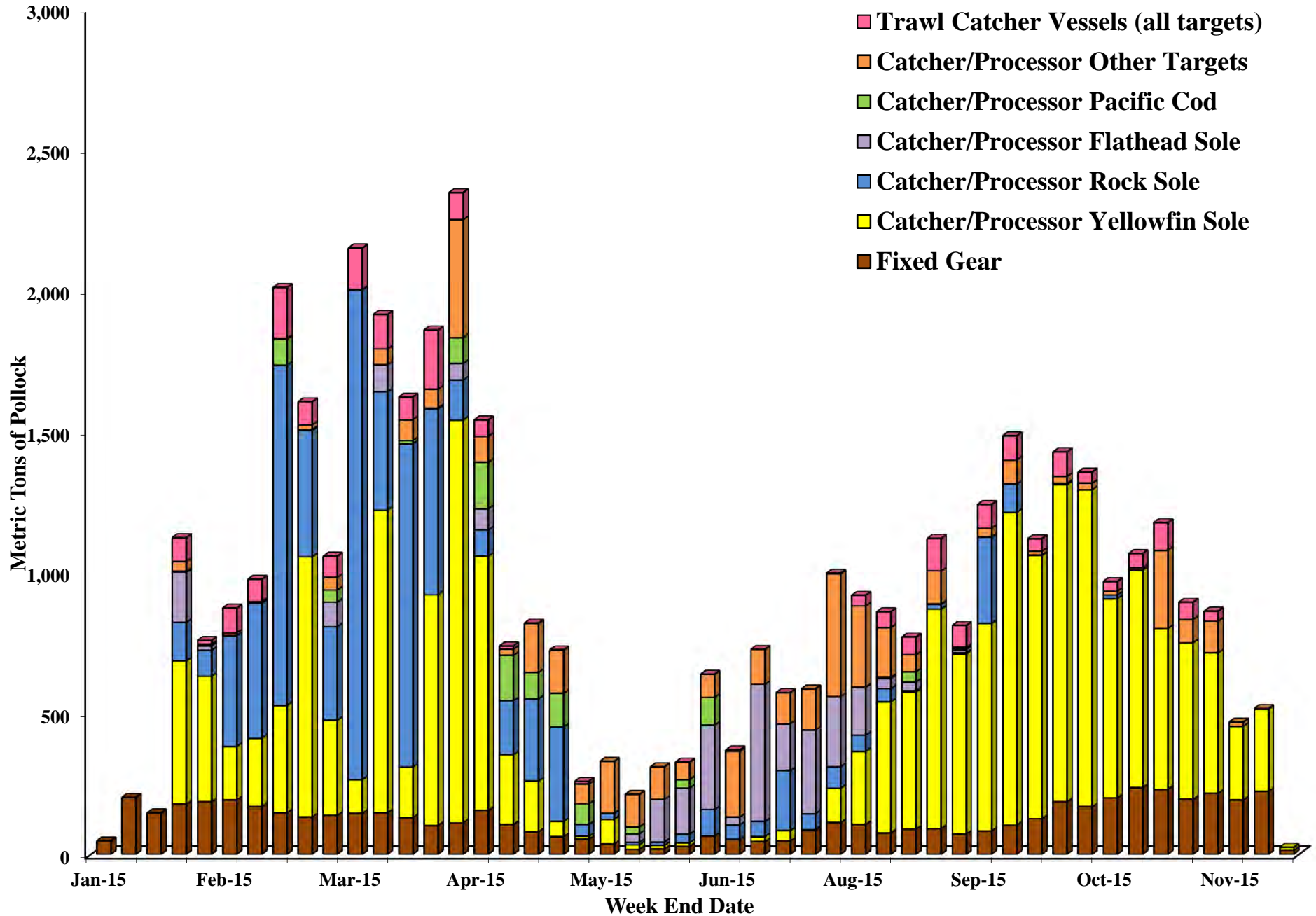

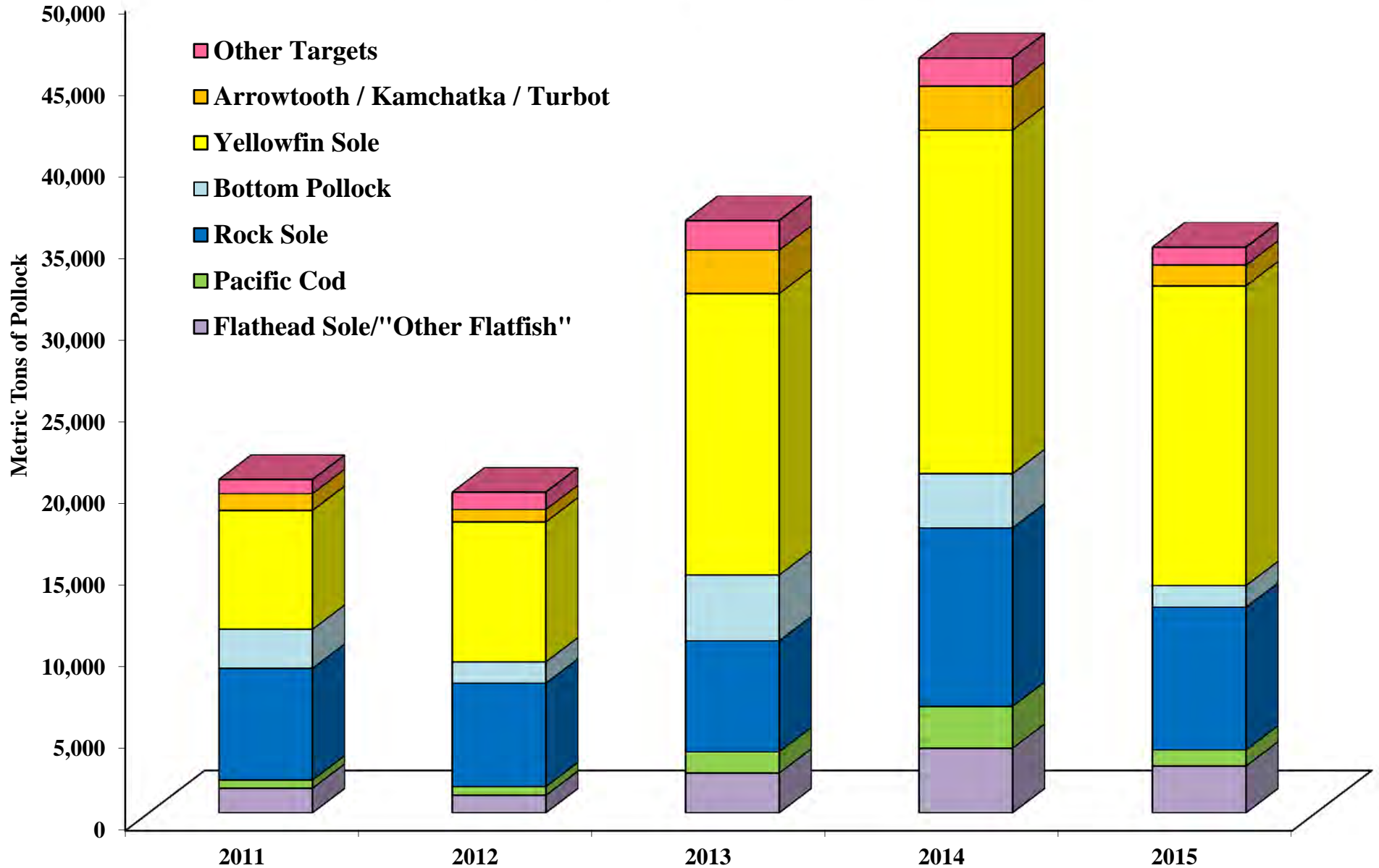


2015 Bering Sea Pollock ICA catch by Week and Sector

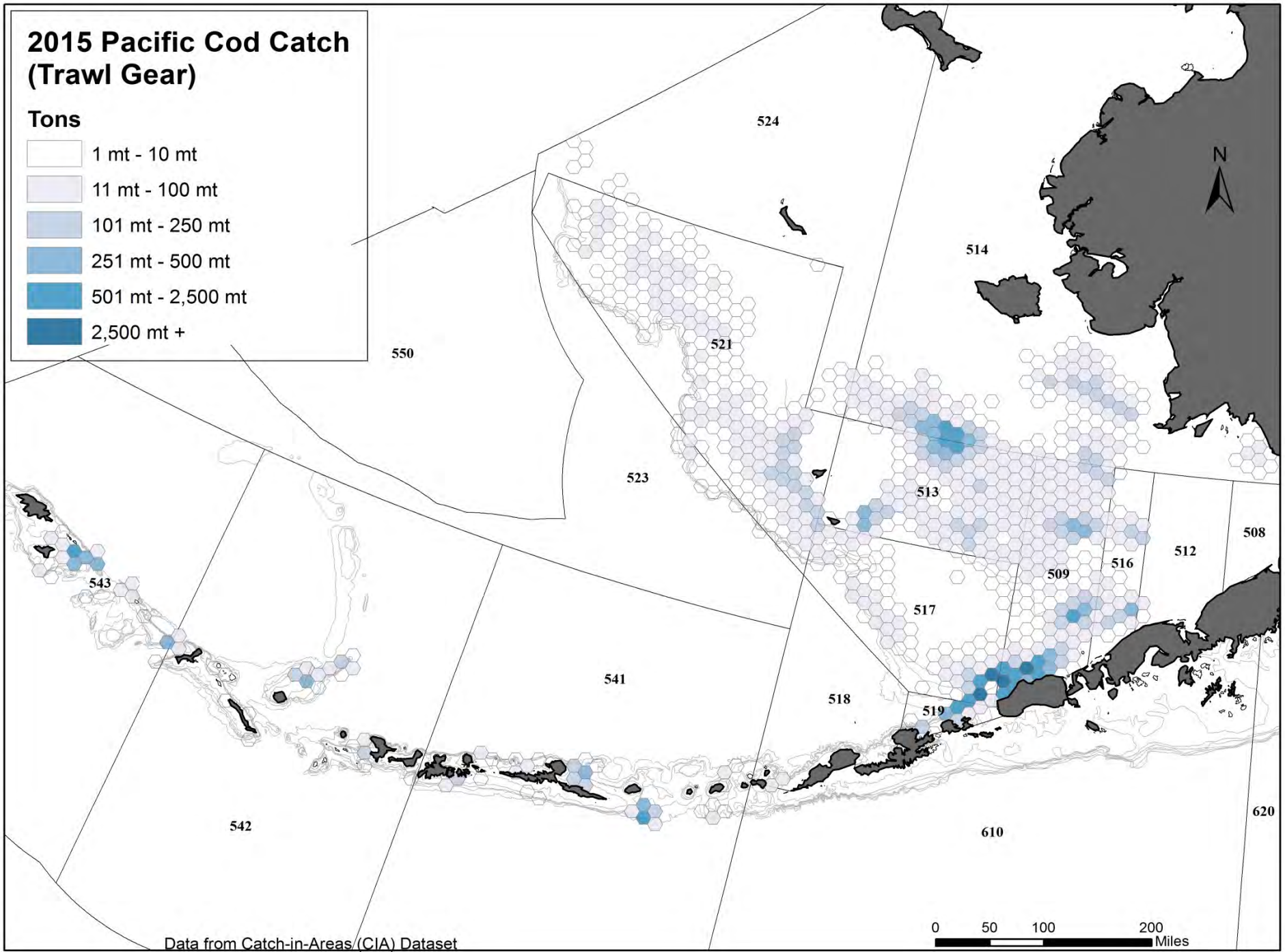
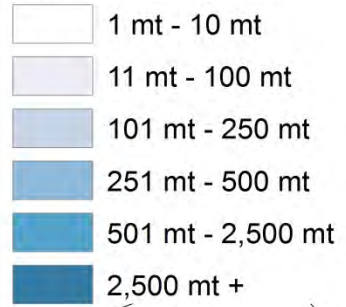
Incidental Catch by Year and Target

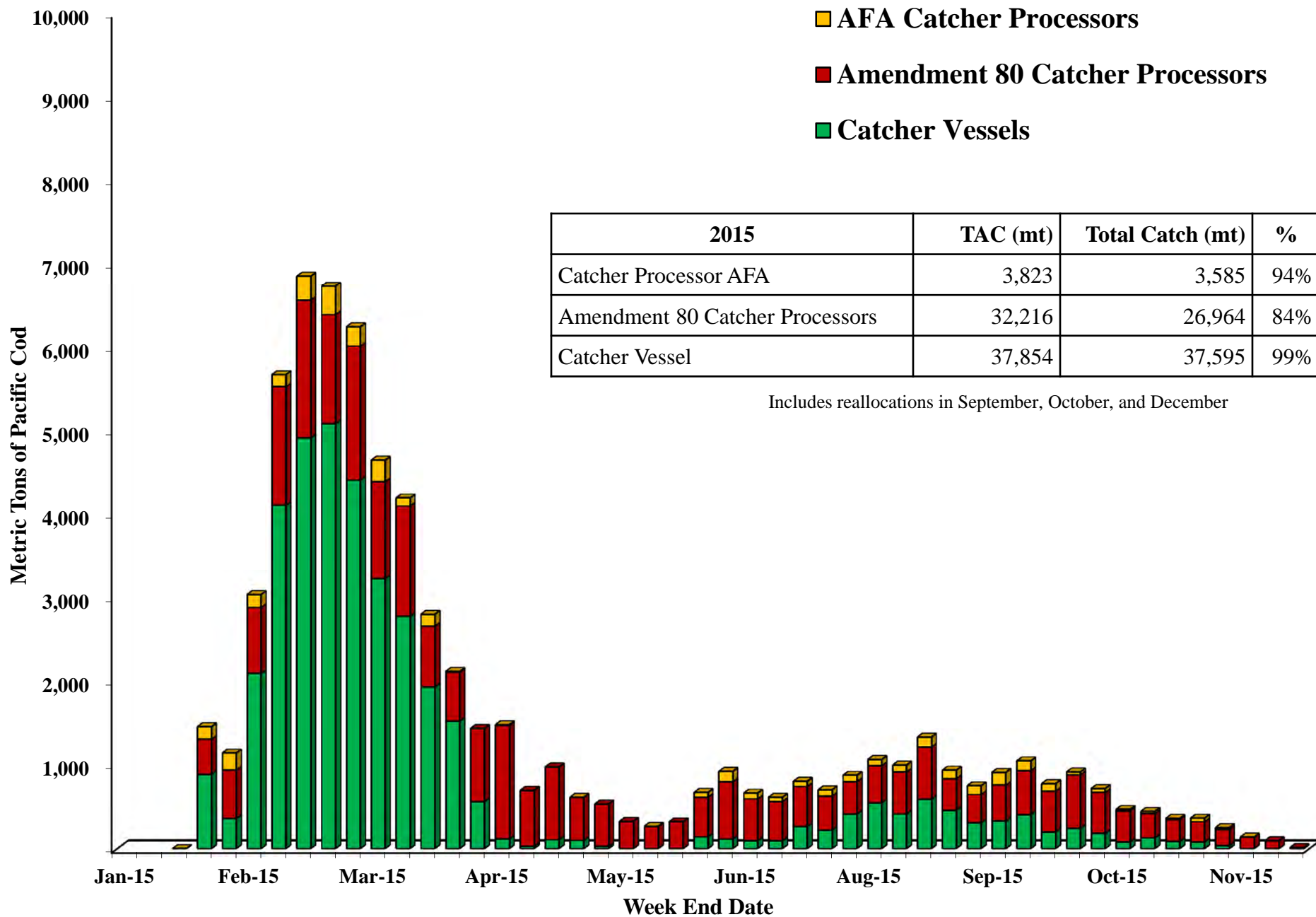

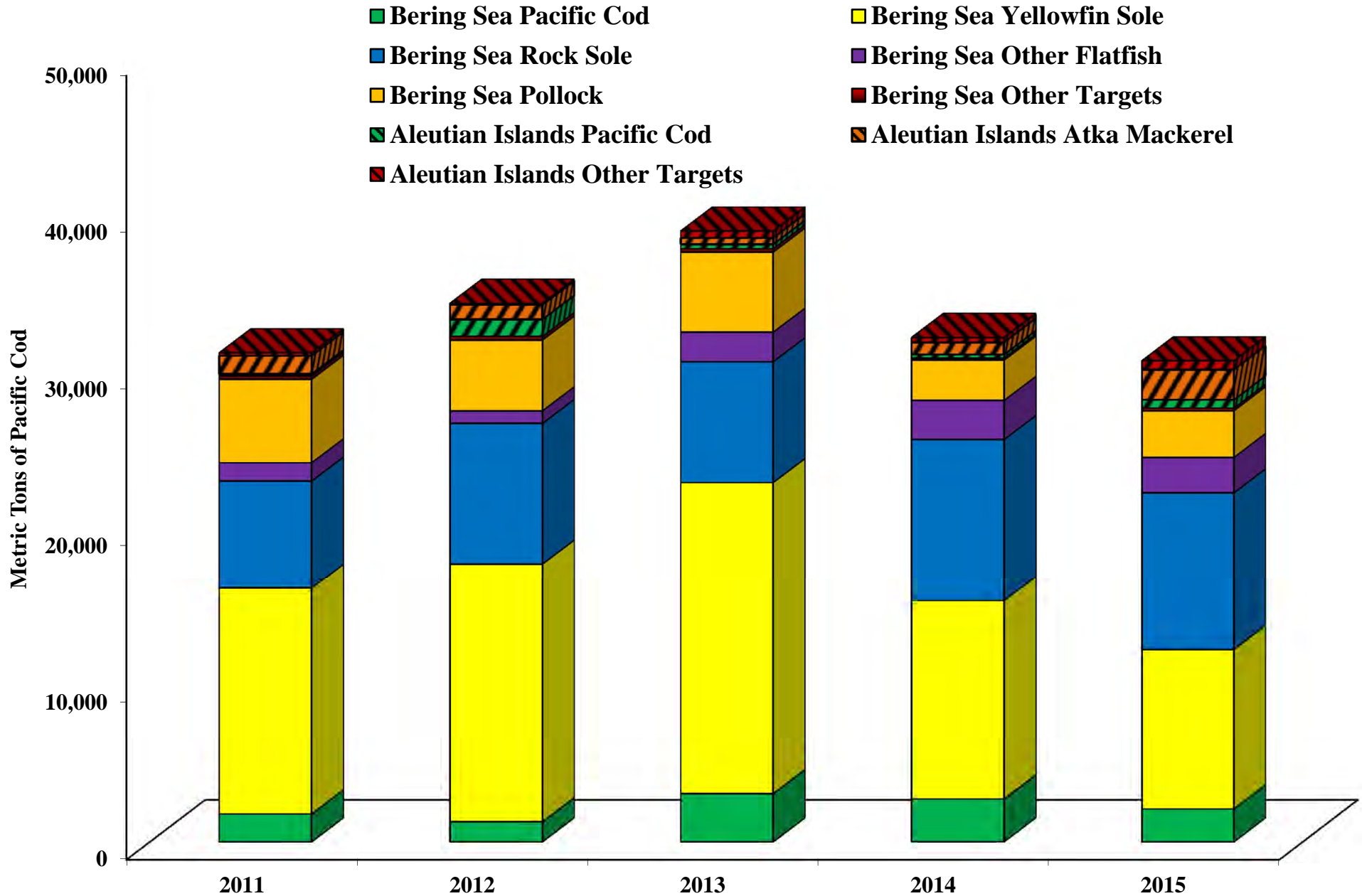

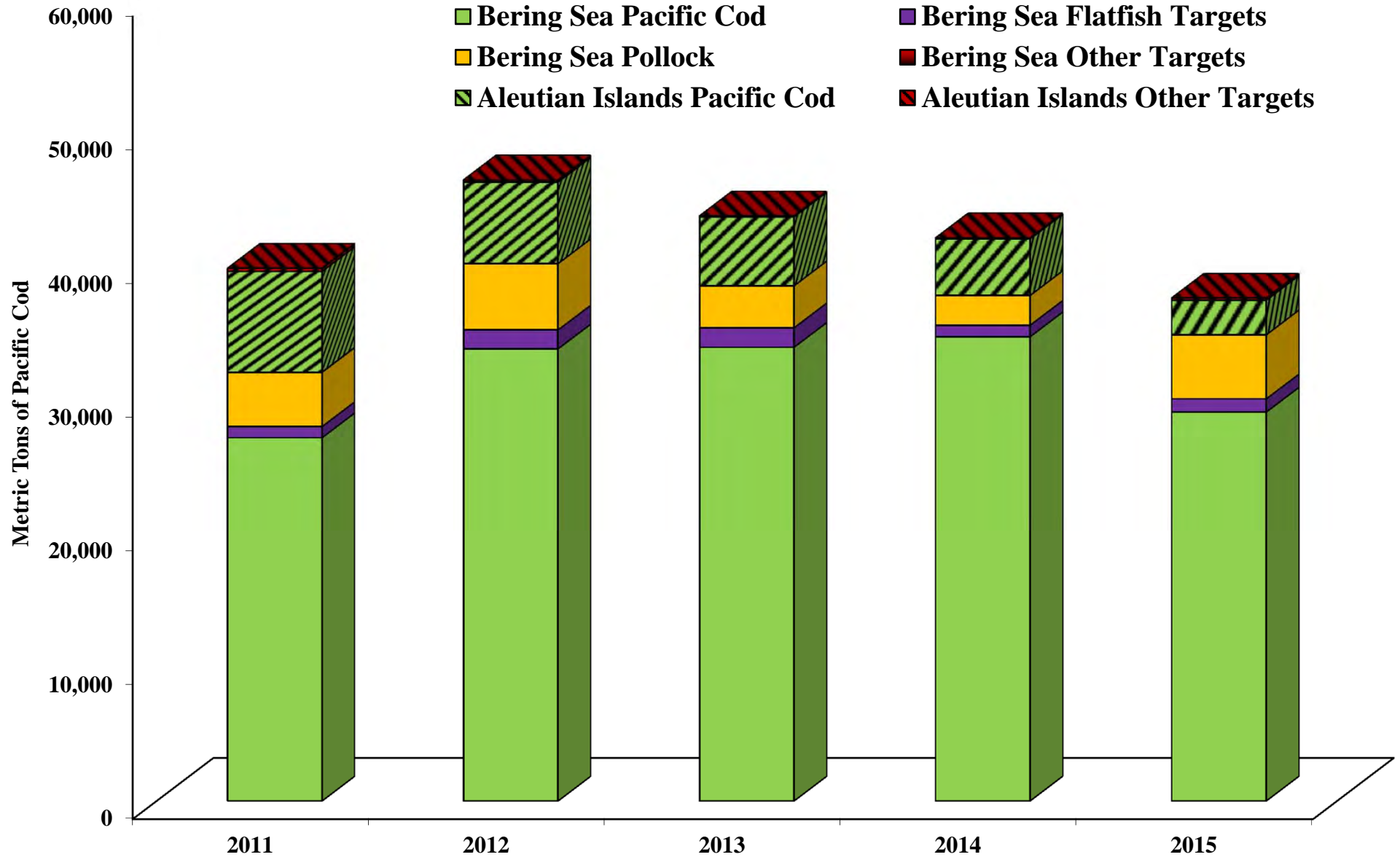
2015 BSAI Trawl Pacific Cod Catch



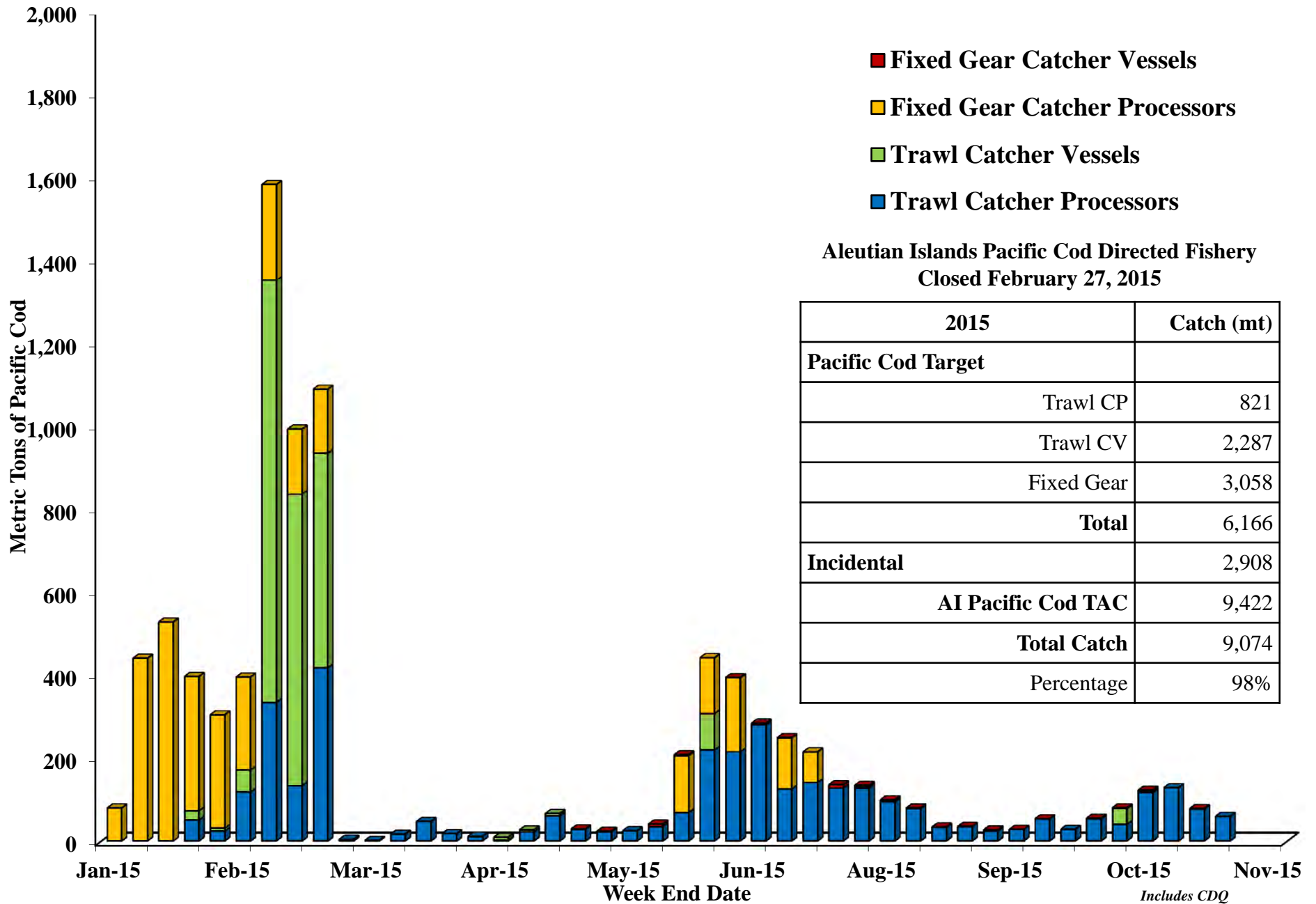
BSAI Trawl Catcher/Processor Pacific Cod Catch by Target



BSAI Trawl Catcher Vessel Pacific Cod Catch by Target

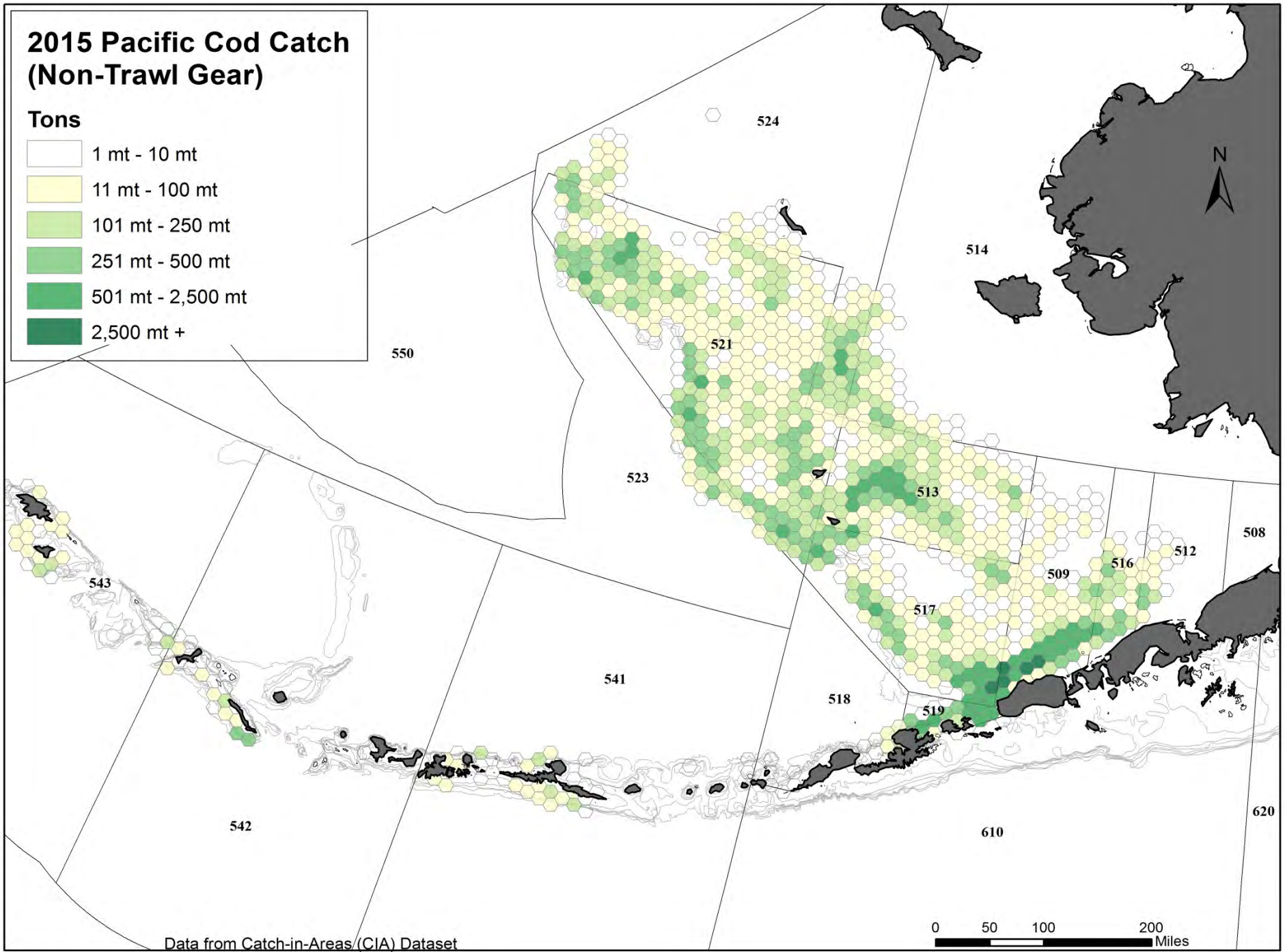
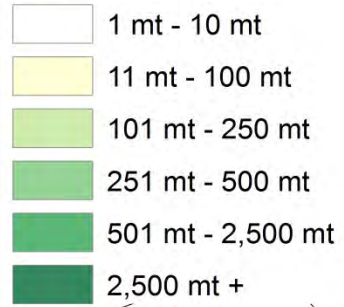


2015 Aleutian Islands Pacific Cod Catch



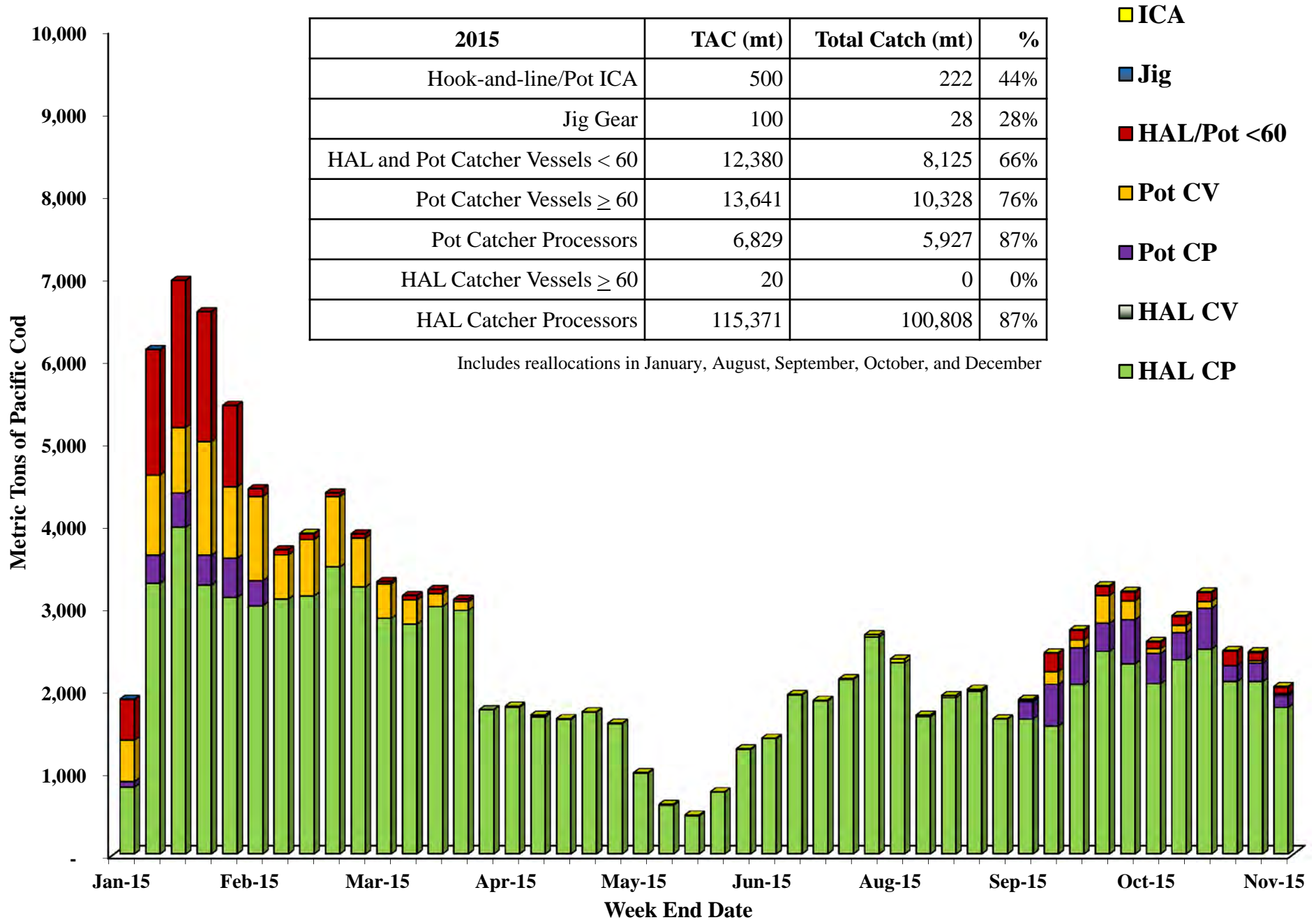

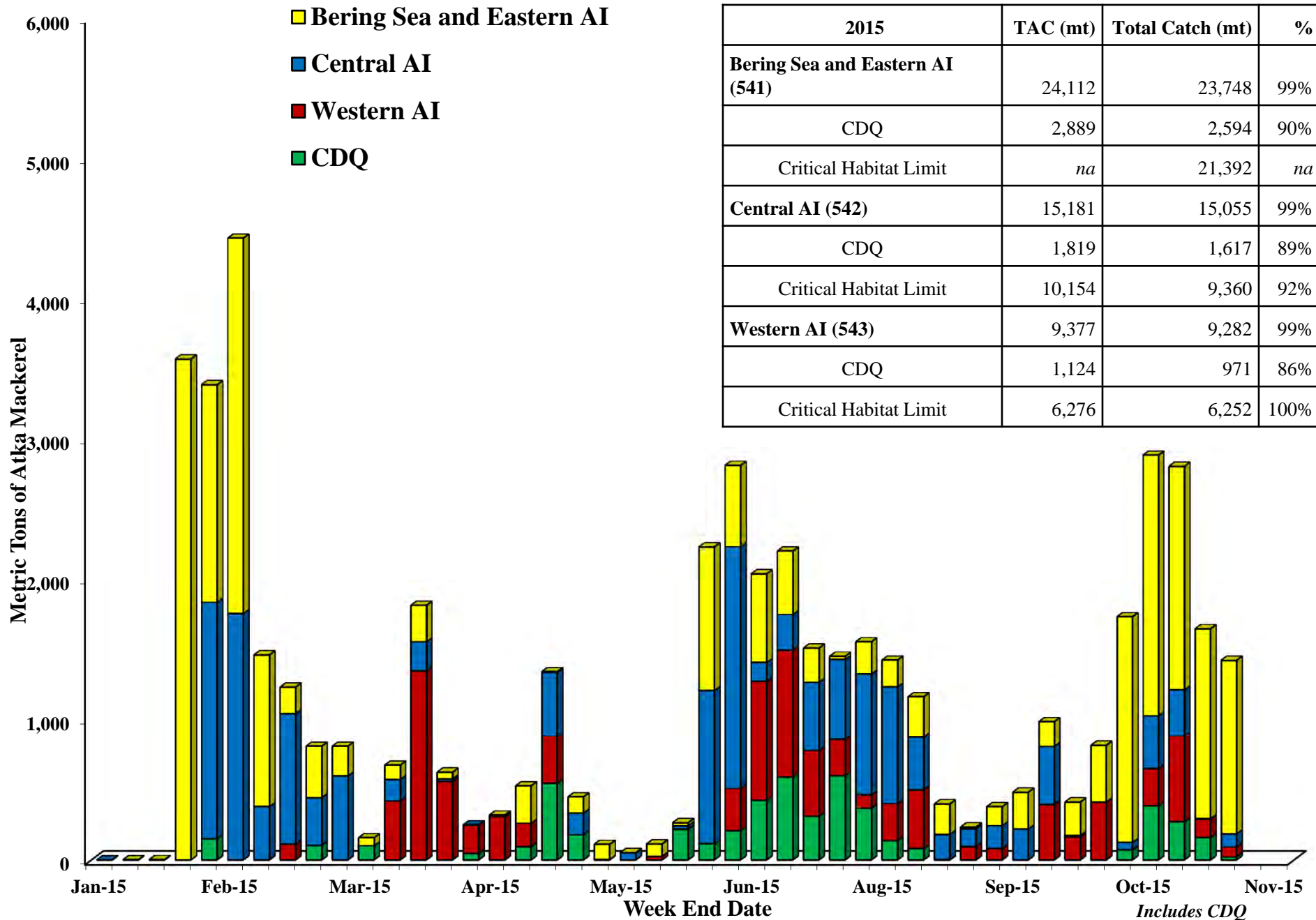

2015 Atka Mackerel Catch by Week and Area

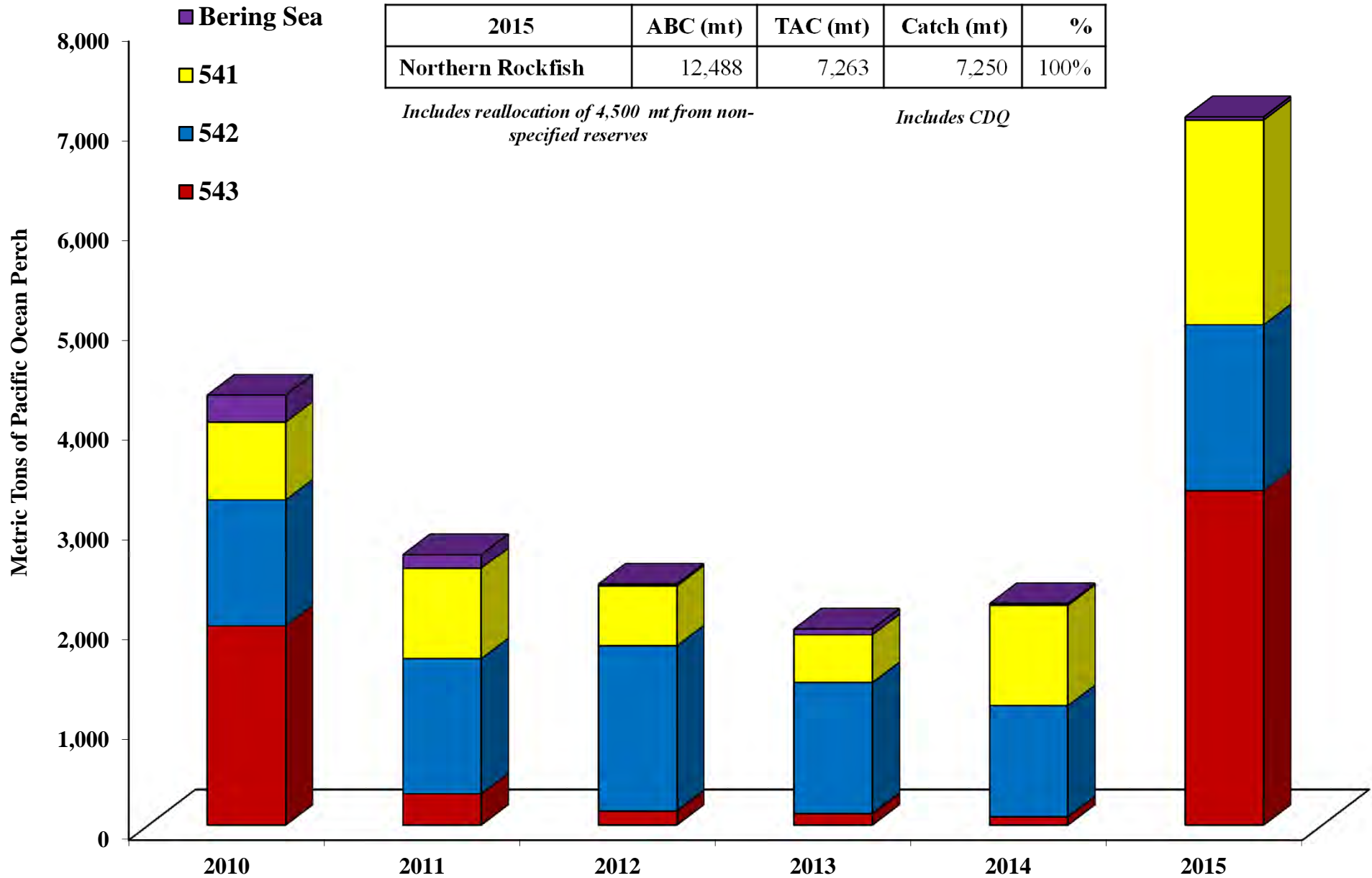

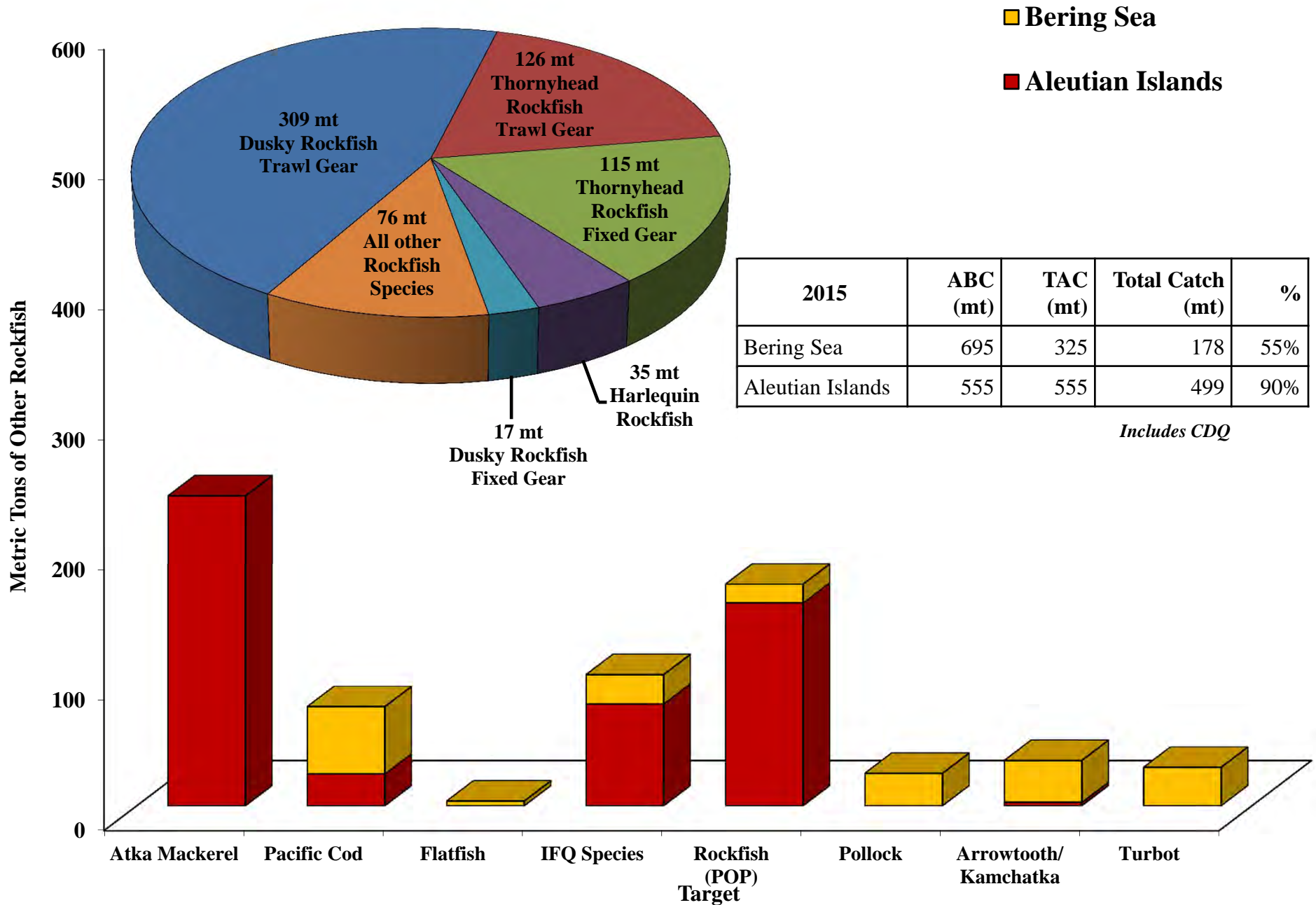
2011-2015 BSAI Pacific Ocean Perch Catch by Area



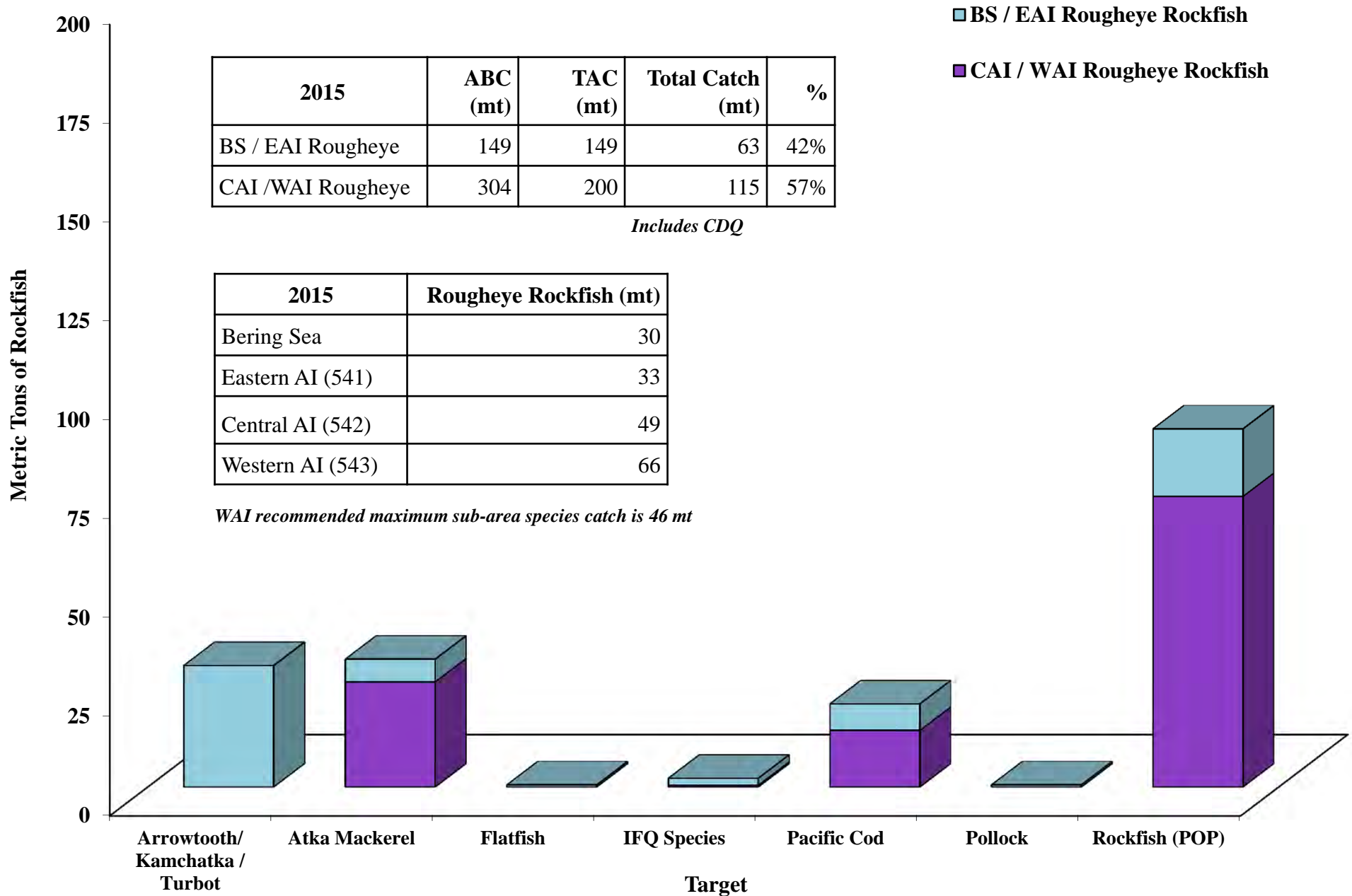
2011-2015 BSAI Northern Rockfish Catch by Area

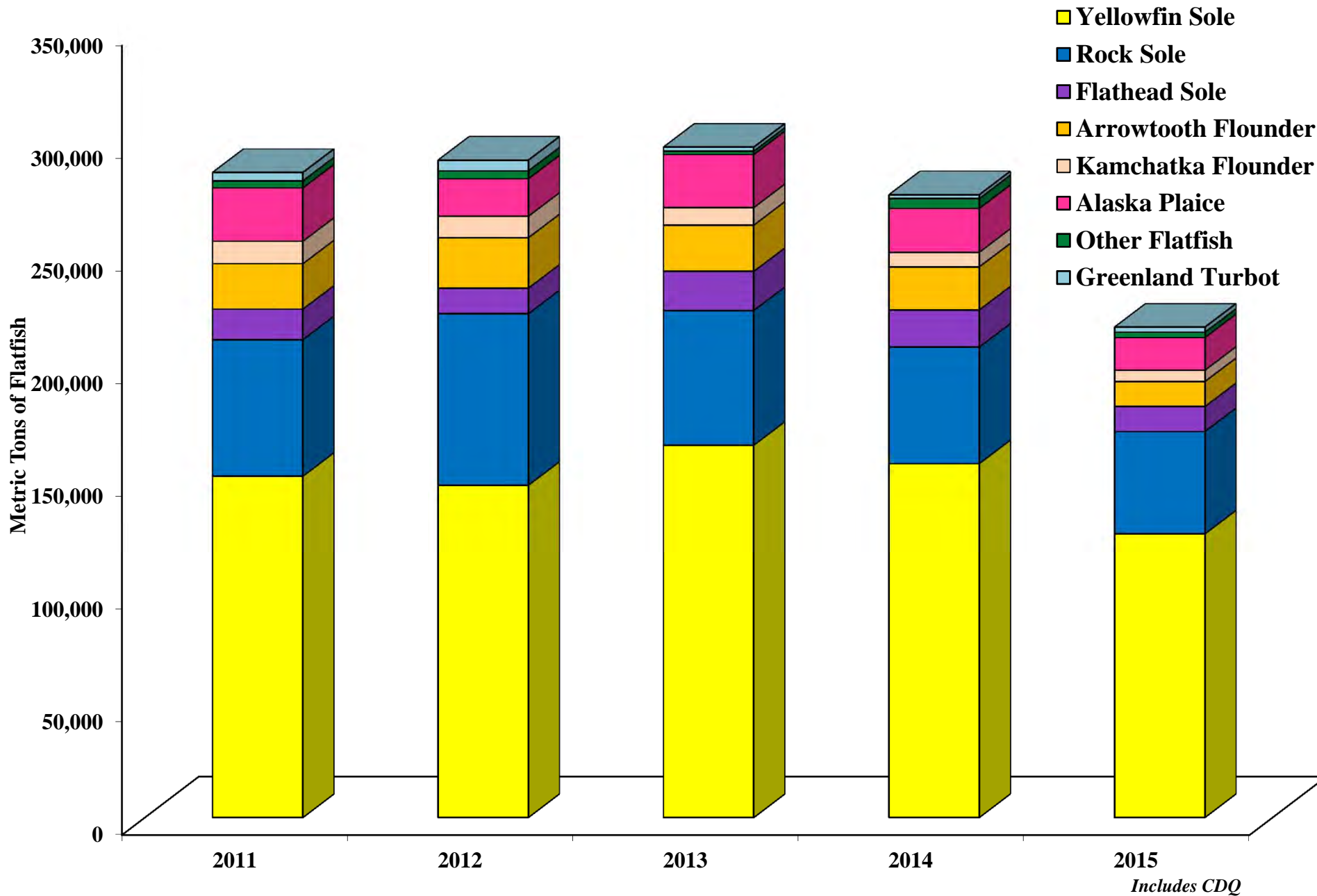
2015 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Amendment 80 CPs



2015 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Non-Amendment 80 Vessels

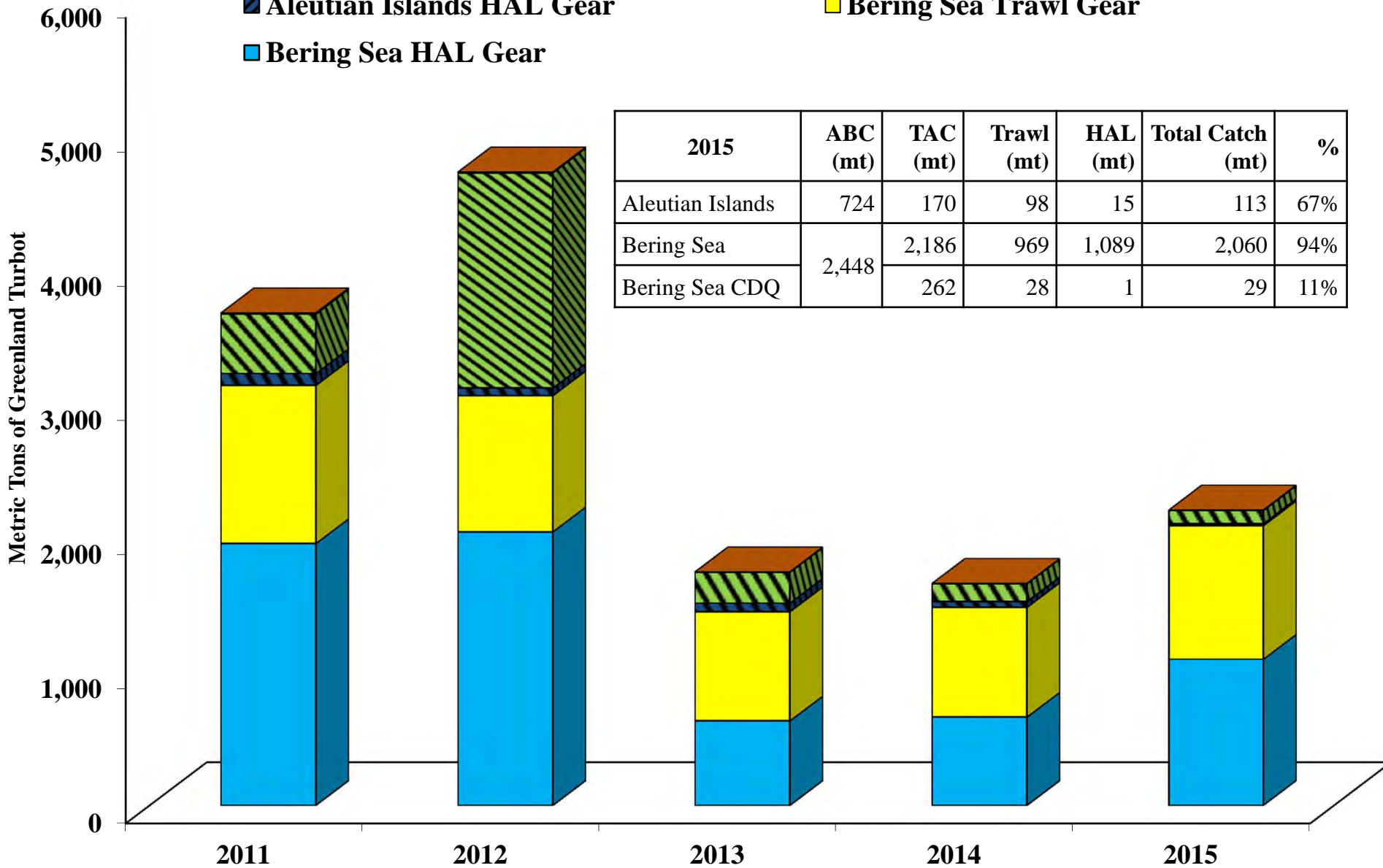


2011-2015 BSAI Trawl Flatfish Catch by Species

Metric Tons of Sharks and Octopus



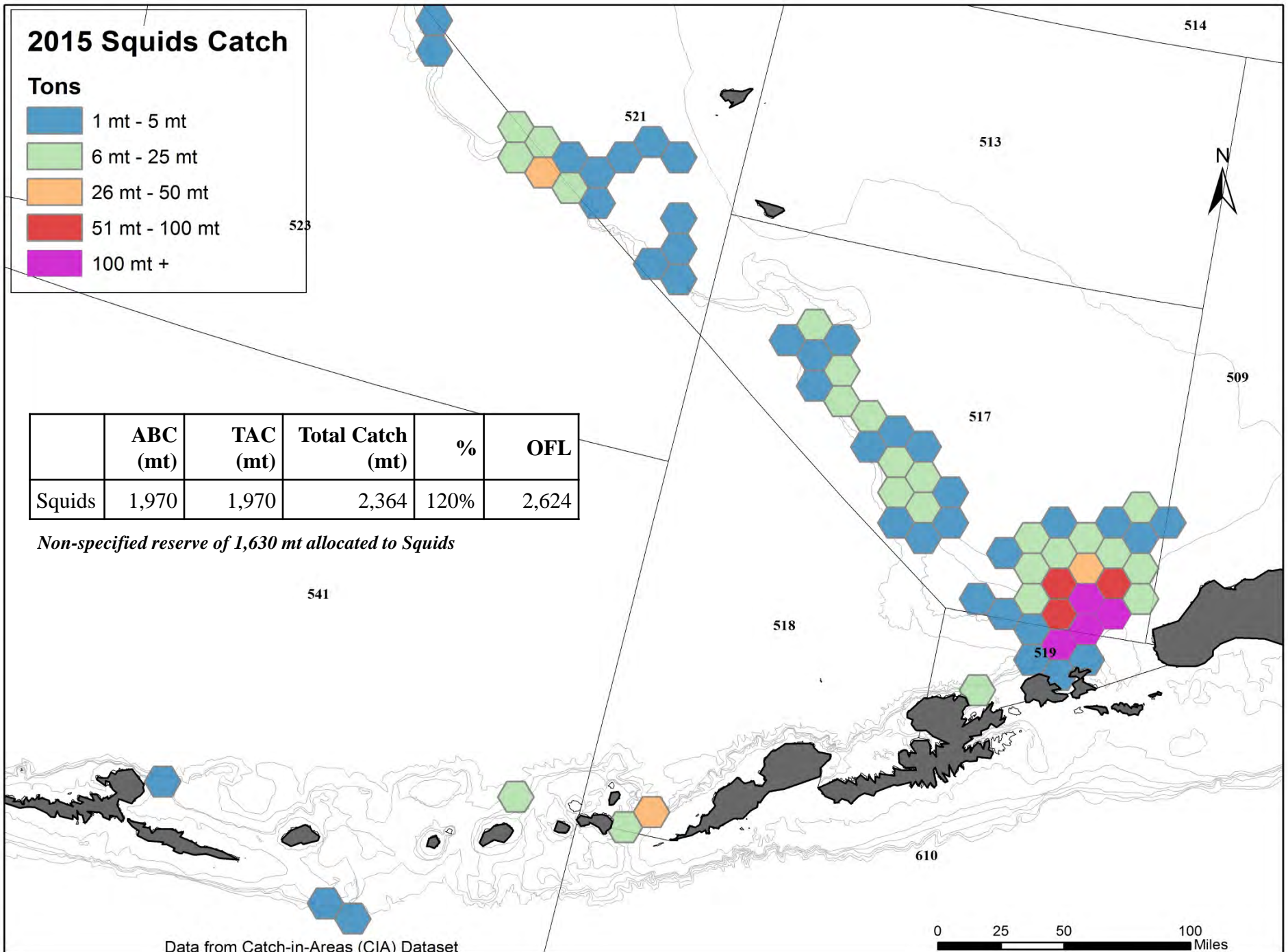

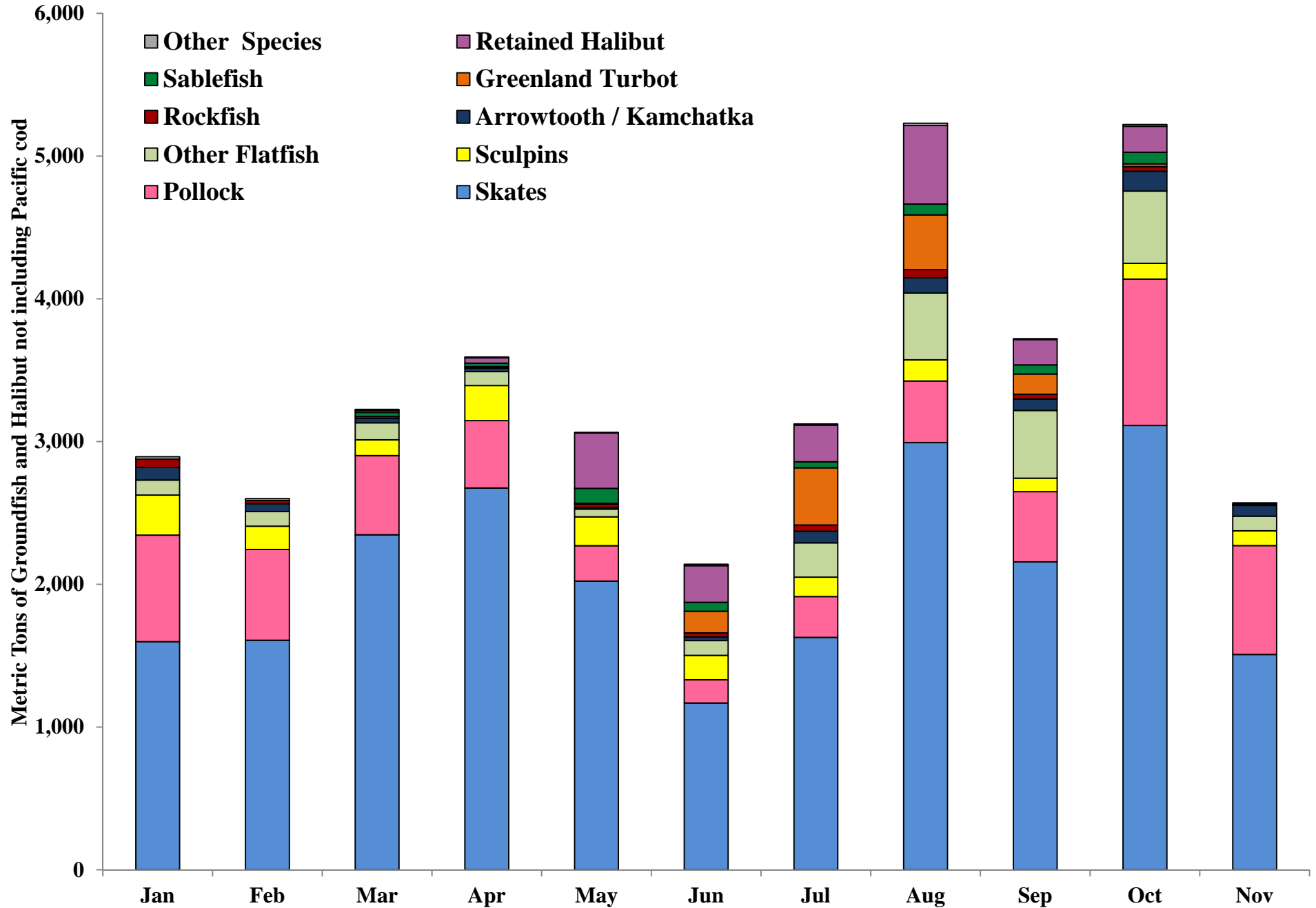

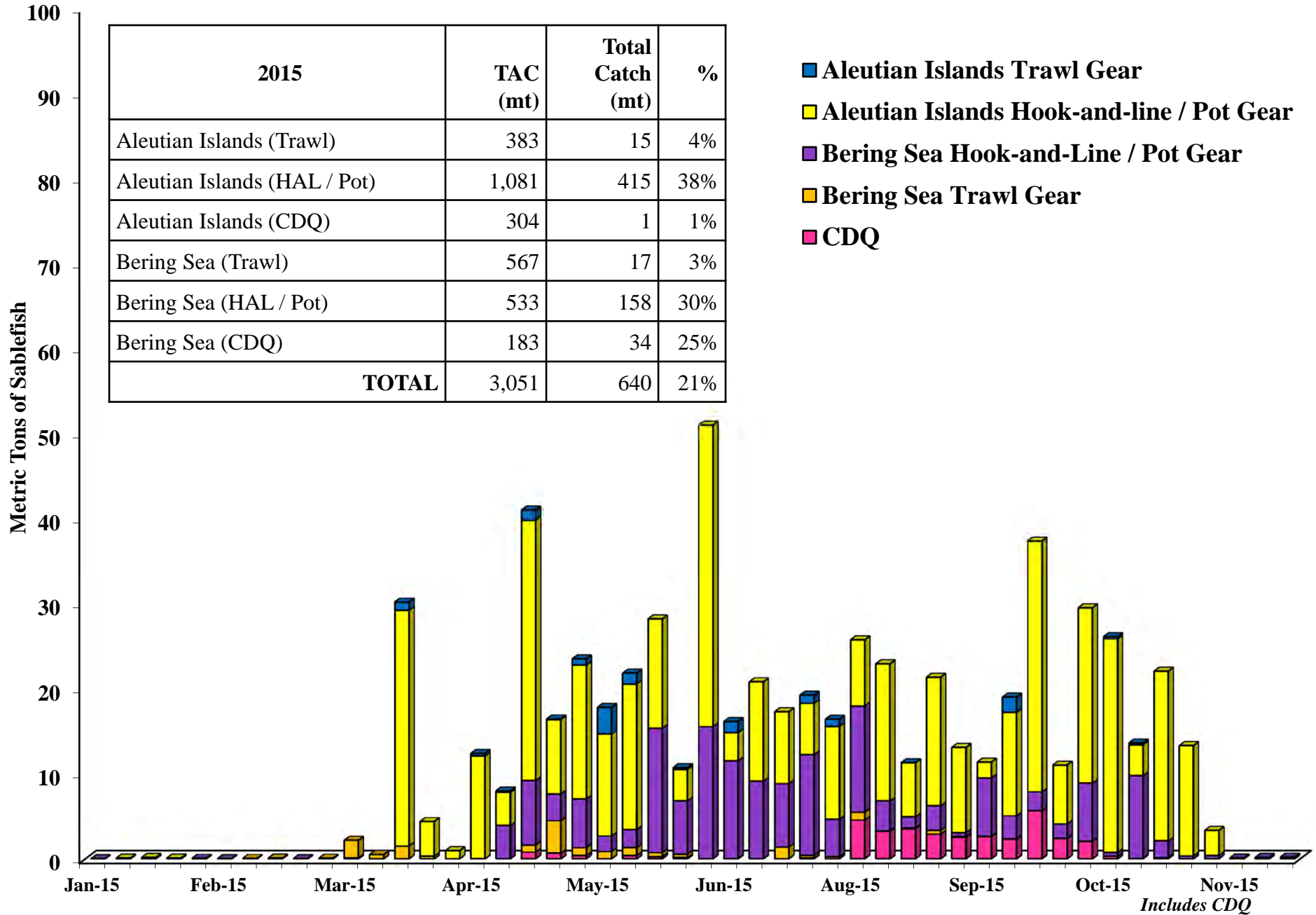

2015 BSAI Hook-and-Line Non Pacific Cod Catch

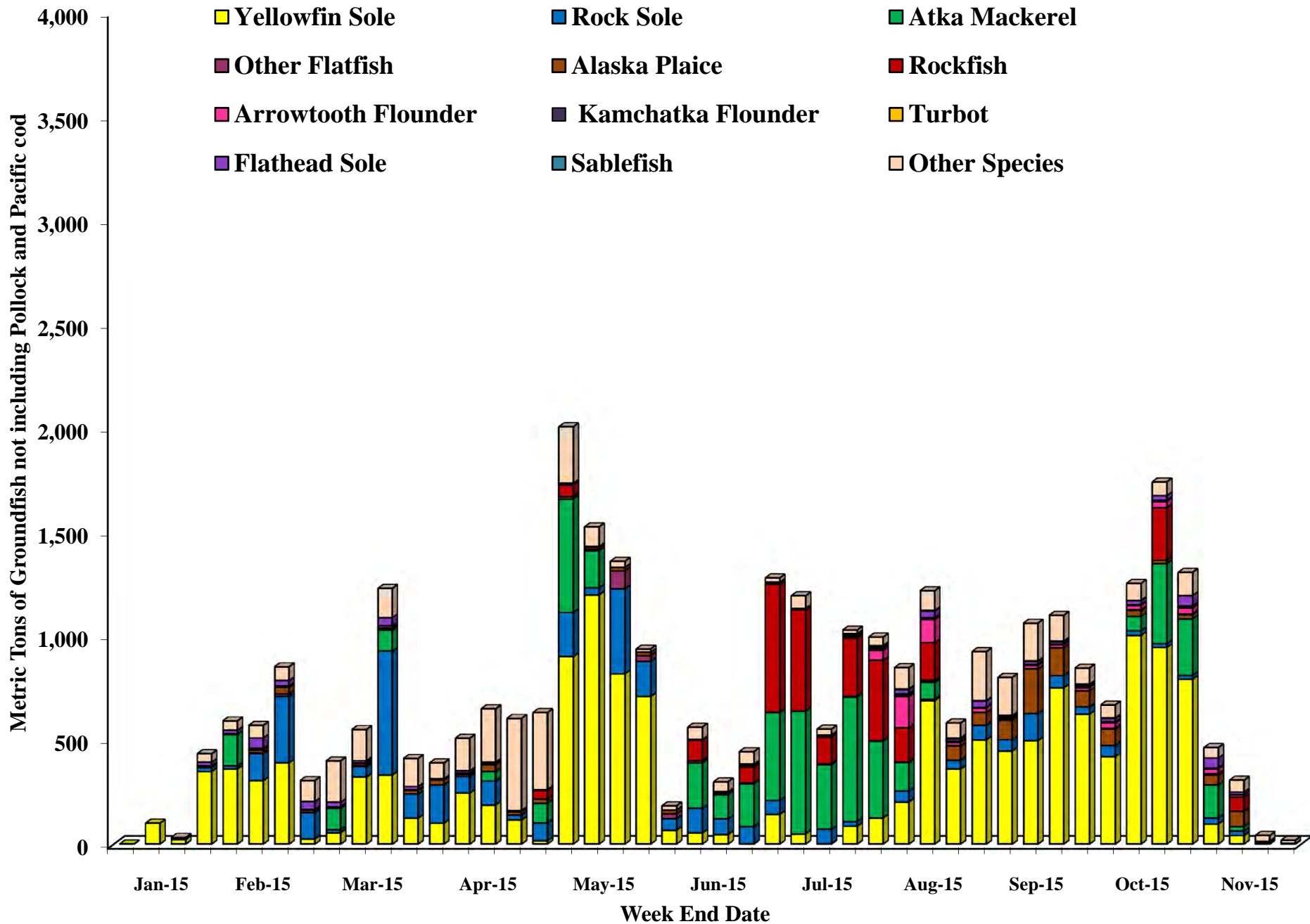

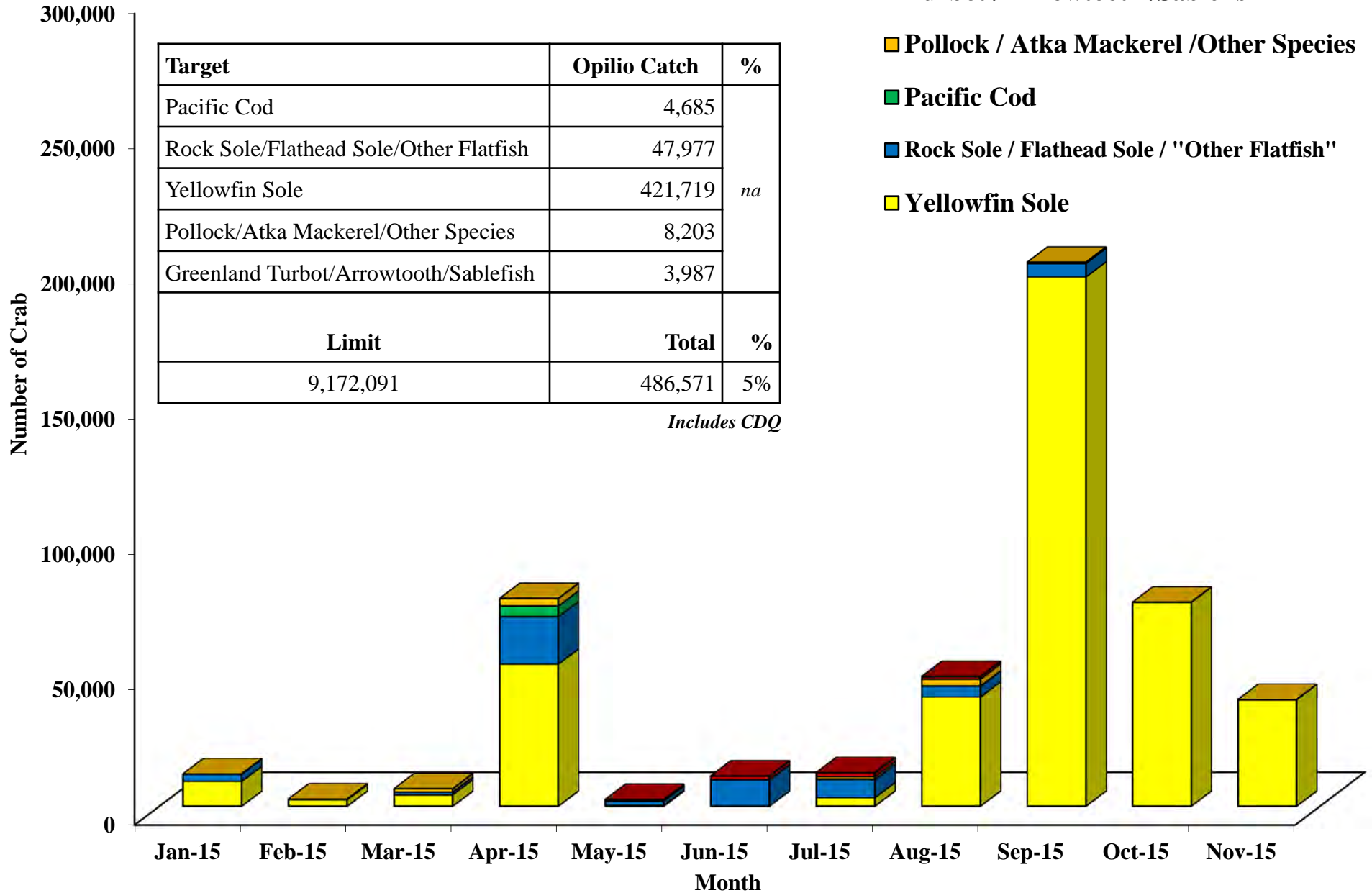

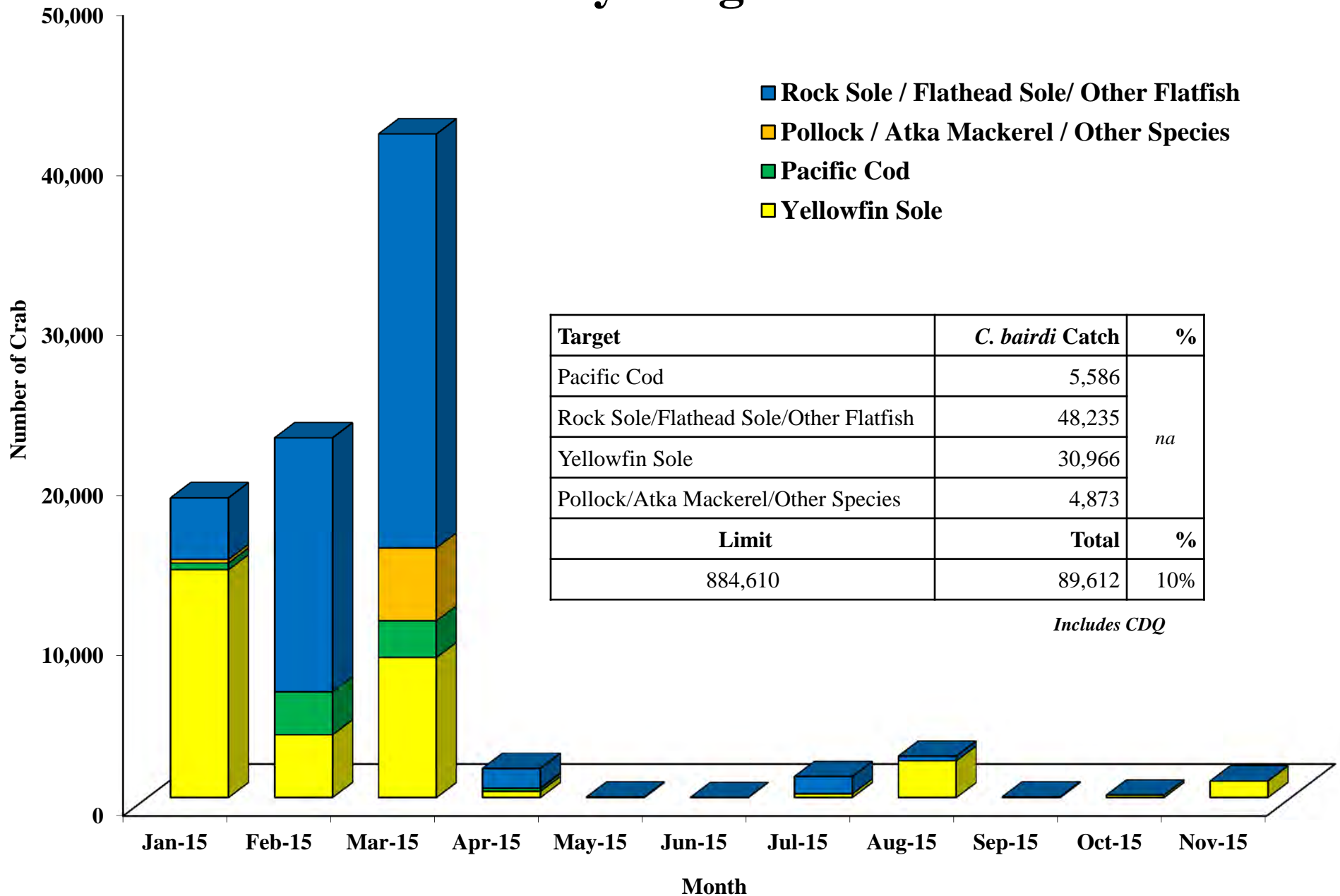

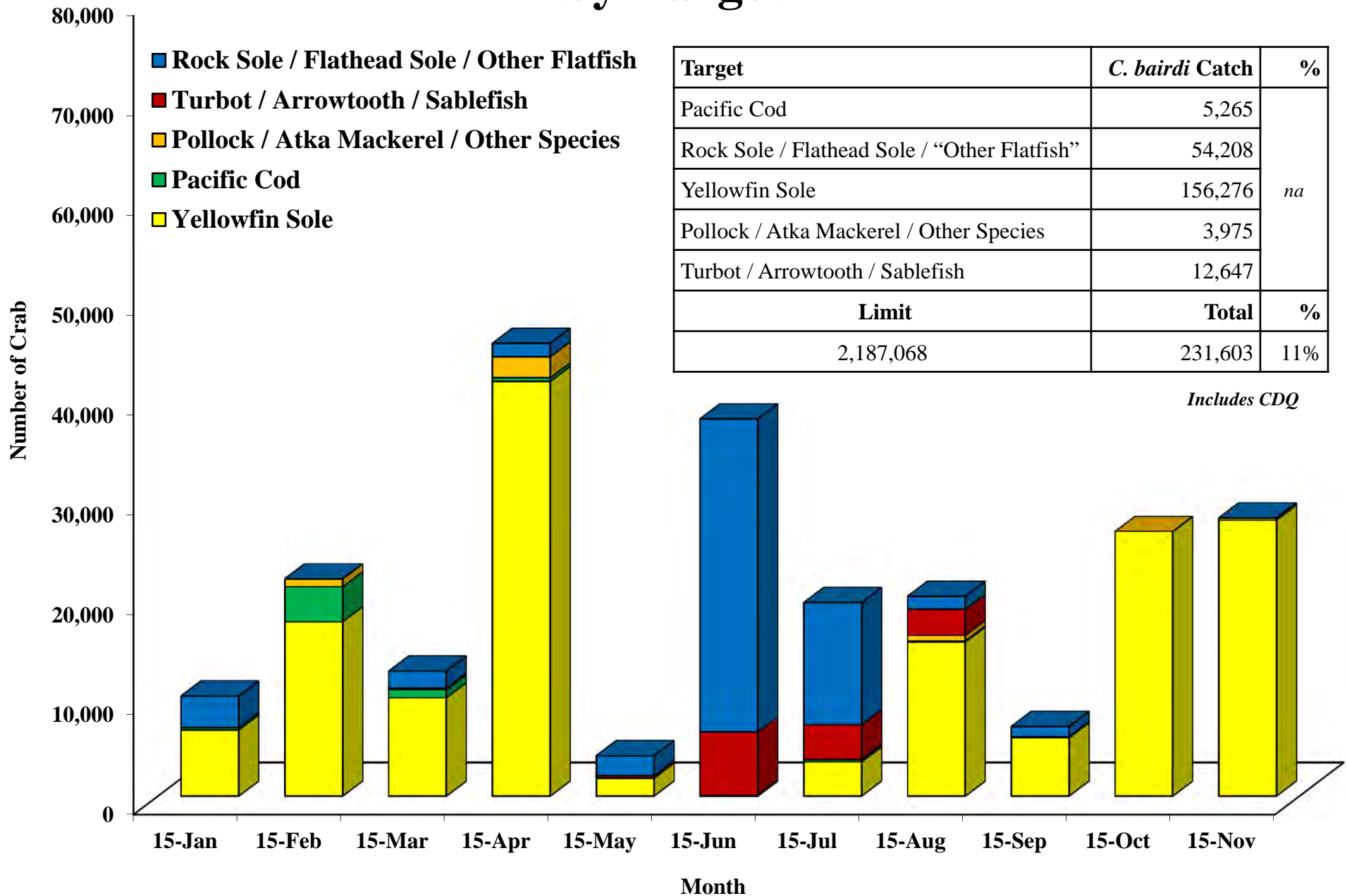
2015 Zone 1 Trawl *C. bairdi* Incidental Catch by Target



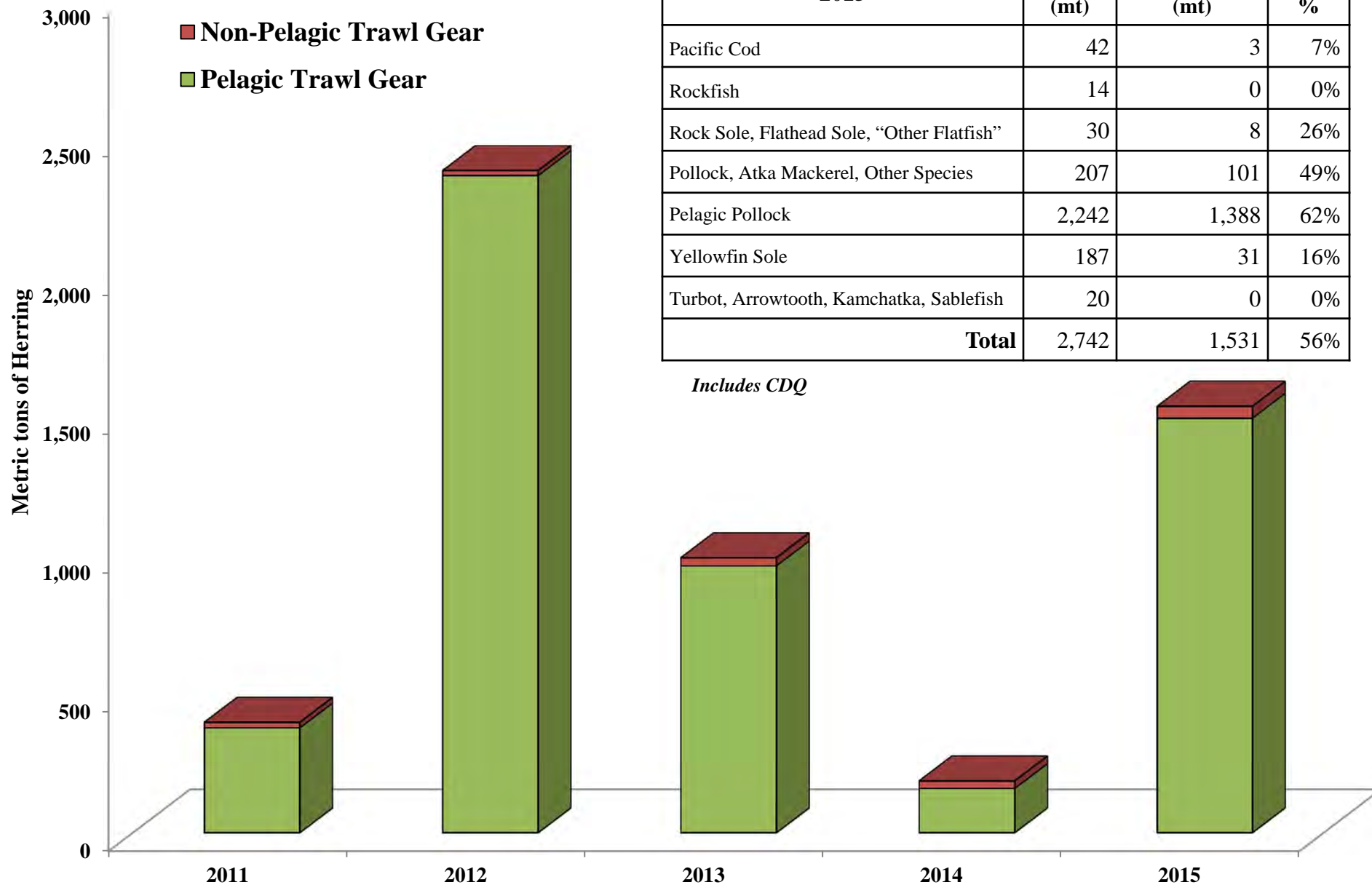

2015 Zone 2 Trawl *C. bairdi* Incidental Catch by Target



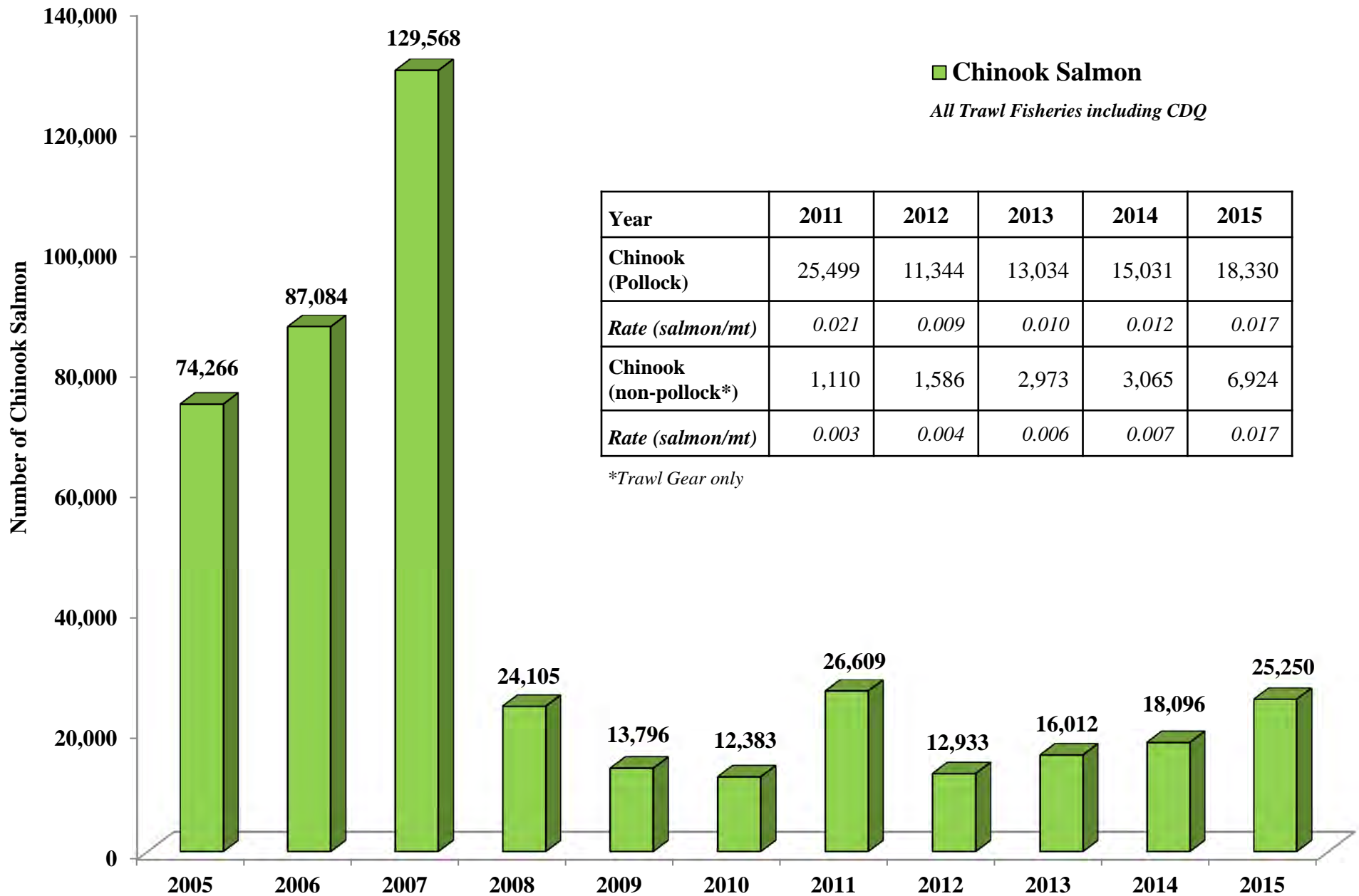

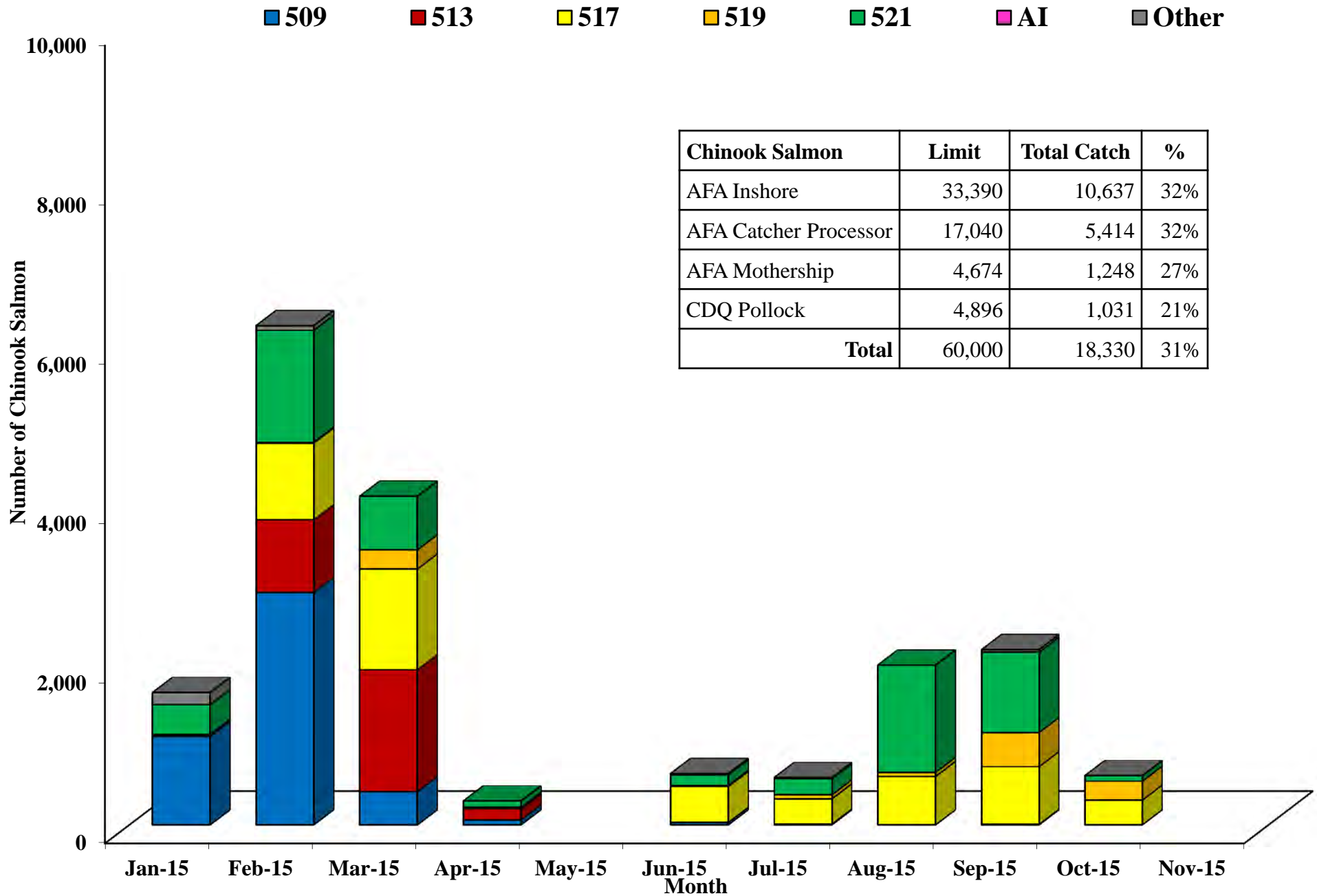

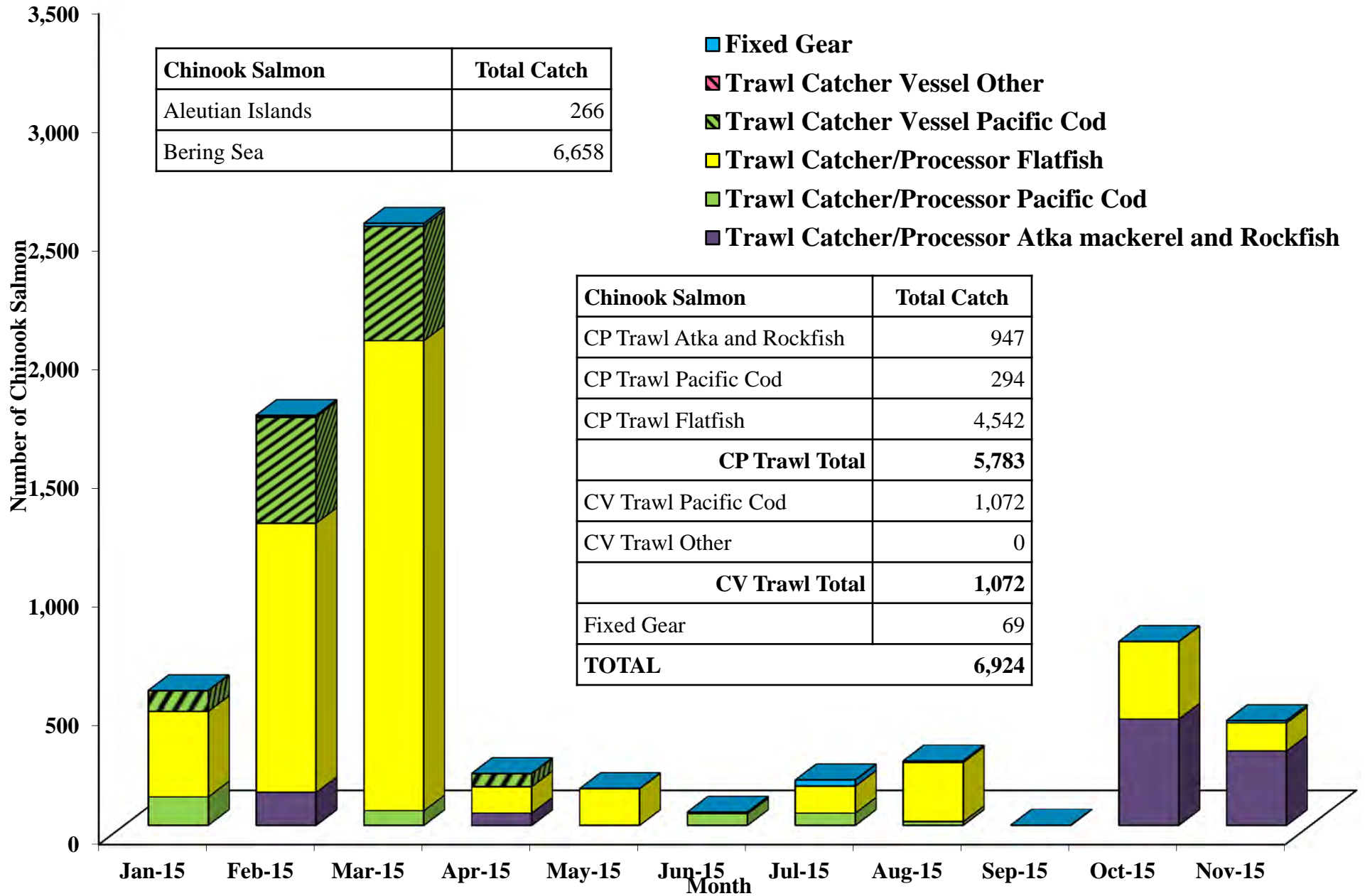


2015 Pollock Fishery Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch

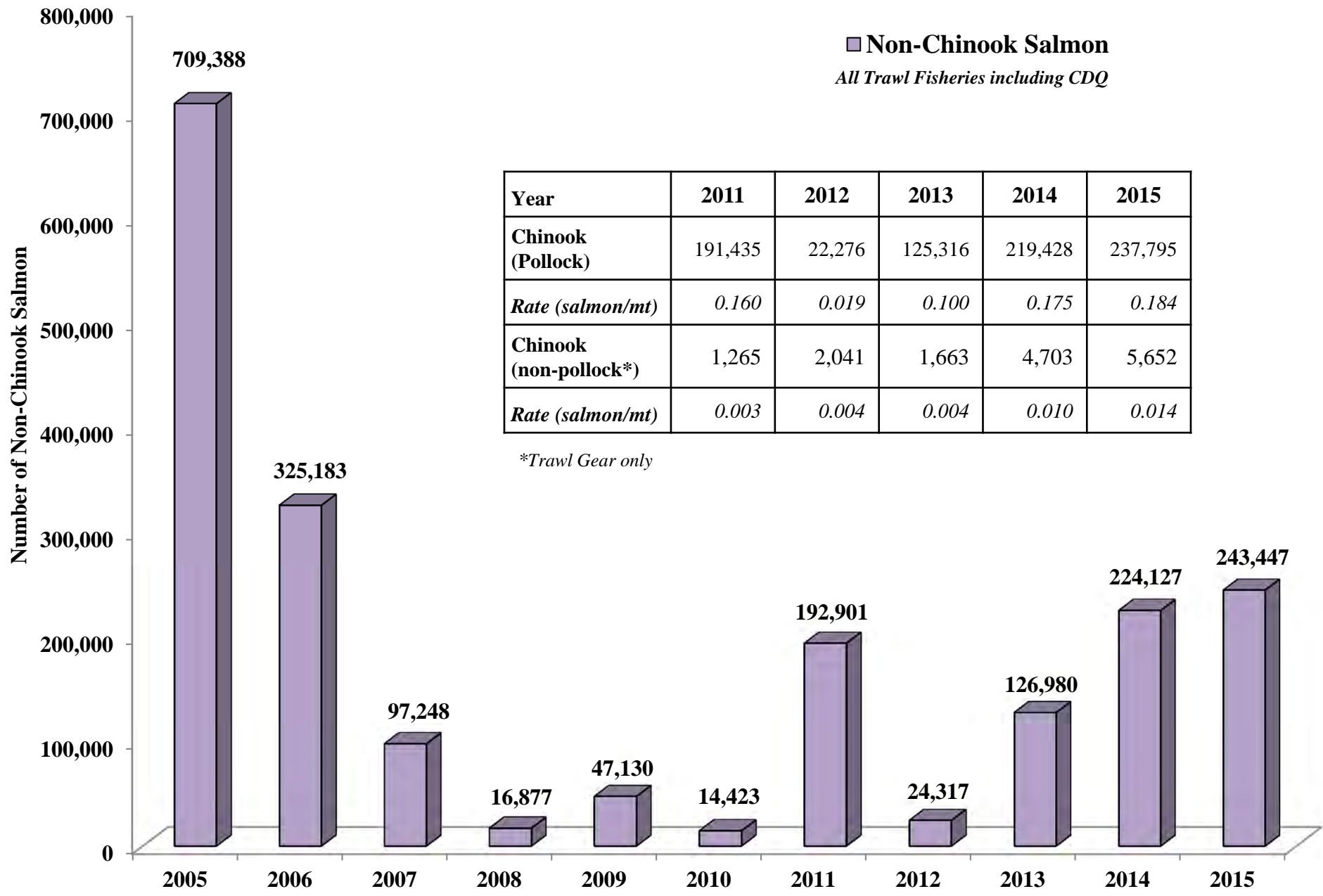
