










































BOARD OF FISHERIES

- At the October Pacific cod meeting the Board made changes to management plans in the Aleutian Islands
 Subdistrict and Dutch Harbor Subdistrict.
- Beginning in 2023, the Aleutian Islands Subdistrict will open 4 days after the federal catcher-vessel greater than or equal to 60 feet OAL pot gear sector closes or on February 1st, whichever occurs first.
 - Vessels fishing pot gear are limited to no more than 100 feet OAL and those longer than 60 feet OAL are limited to harvesting no more than 25% of the GHL.
- In 2023 the Dutch Harbor Subdistrict GHL for pot gear is 12% of the Bering Sea Pacific cod ABC. Beginning in 2023, If 90% of the GHL is achieved for 2 consecutive years, the GHL will increase by 1% the next year. If 90% of the GHL is not achieved for 2 consecutive years, the GHL will be reduced by 1% the next year. The GHL may not exceed 15% nor drop below 10%.
