




octopus survey biomass estimates (all species)

octopus catch by area






squid management changes

- Amendment 117 to BSAI FMP implemented effective August 8, 2018:
 - place squids in the Ecosystem Component category of the FMP
 - prohibit directed fishing for squid
 - establish a 20% maximum retention allowance (MRA)
 - retain recordkeeping and recording requirements
- will affect harvest specifications beginning in 2019 (i.e., none)
- suggest squid reporting in forage species document
