
All AFA CVs were members to the Incentive Plan Agreements and participated in salmon avoidance measures

The 2022 Three River Index fell below the 250,000 fish threshold

#### **BSAI** Groundfish Sideboard Harvest

The BSAI Pacific Cod Fishery is the only eligible directed AFA Sideboard fishery in the BSAI region.

No Vessel or Coop exceeded its sideboard limit.

2023 will be the last year with an AFA BSAI directed P.Cod sideboard fishery due to the implementation of PCTC Program in 2024
