

Council Staff

Note: Council staffs will be non-federal. Employee standards and procedures will have to be established and published and employees will have the right of appeal in grievances. Guidelines for "Standards of Employment Practice" is contained in Annex E of the Operations Manual (Tab 5 in this Section).

For budgetary purposes a limit of 7 full-time employees has been assumed with the Executive Director at a GS-15 level or below. The Executive Director reports directly to the Council and his duties, etc. are defined in the Manual.

1. Upon concurrence of the Council and National Marine Fisheries Service, Federal employees may be detailed to Councils under Section 302(f)(2) of P.L. 94-265. (Sections of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act--IPA-- may also apply. Such employees shall remain on such details not more than two years and shall retain full Civil Service benefits. The personnel ceiling remains in the detailing office, however, costs incurred including salary shall be deducted from the Council's grant.
