On 26 August 2020, Russian naval vessels and aircraft involved in the Russian Exercise OCEAN SHIELD encountered the U.S. domestic fishing fleet legally fishing in the U.S. Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) of the Bering Sea. The Russian naval vessels and aircraft directed those fishing vessels to depart the area due to safety concerns associated with a missile launch.
