


Patrol Statistics


- Patrol Days: 51

- IUU List submission



- Sheens present
 between vessels
 during refueling
 operations detected
 by aircraft.
- Sample collected to ascertain substance

- Turning off AIS during transshipment operations
- Fishing activity
 observation when AIS is
 off

- Work with RFMOs
 - Continue to work w/ US Delegation on IUU list
 - Shark Finning CMM
- NPG 2022
 - Cutter and aircraft support for longer duration
 - Increased participation from Canada's DFO.
 - Pushing for increased participation from Japan
 - Continue intel driven operations
