- Choice of ecosystem indicators, as much a social issue as a scientific.
- Very different perceptions among our diverse stakeholders and indigenous peoples, positive for some, negative for others.
- Respectful inclusion of indigenous perspectives and knowledge
- Paying insufficient attention to COMMUNICATION!
