REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL  
CONCERNING COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT

1. Recent FCMA Infractions. Since the last council meeting two reports of violation (civil penalty procedure) and five citations (written warning) have been issued for FCMA infractions. A brief summary of each infraction follows.

a. 13 February. USCGC BOUTWELL issued three citations to the Polish stern trawler MARLIN for failure to permanently affix its IRCS to the vessel, failure to maintain DCCL cumulative catches by permit period, and for failure to log the catch of 16.5 MT of fin fish.

b. 13 February. USCGC BOUTWELL issued one citation to the Polish stern trawler OTOL for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log.

c. 22 February. USCGC MORGENTHAU issued two reports of violation to the West German stern trawler FRIEDRICH BUSSE for failure to properly notify Commander, Seventeenth Coast Guard District of its area shift on 15 February 1981, and failure to return to the sea eight Pacific halibut. The halibut were observed as they entered the fish meal plant. One citation was also issued for failure to log the cumulative total of allocated species by each fishing area.
