- May 2022: Craig Rose spoke on his work estimating crab injury and mortality from trawl encounters
- October 2022: "The SSC recommends the formation of a working group to develop a framework for how to estimate the magnitude of unobserved mortality for crab stocks and how these estimations may be utilized in BSAI crab stock assessments."
 - "The SSC acknowledges that there are studies informing some of the inputs needed for this analysis,
 but that a framework for the calculations should be very explicit about each of the data sources and
 assumptions needed. There may be multiple approaches, perhaps including the spatial overlap of stock
 and various fisheries, the mortality rate of interactions and/or the ration of unobserved to observed
 encounters."
- December 2022: Council motion supporting unobserved mortality WG
