REPORT TO THE NORTH PACIFIC FISHERIES MANAGEMENT COUNCIL CONCERNING U.S. COAST GUARD FCMA ENFORCEMENT.

- 1. Recent FCMA Infractions. Since the last council meeting seven reports of violation (civil penalty procedures) and five citations (written warning) have been issued. A brief summary of each infraction follows.
- a. 8 December. USCGC JARVIS issued a report of violation to the Taiwanese stern trawler HIGHLY No. 301 for failure to provide a safe boarding ladder for the authorized boarding party.
- b. 9 December. USCGC CONFIDENCE issued a report of violation to the Polish stern trawler SIRIUS for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log by failing to log cumulative totals for its target species (pollock) for a five-day period.
- c. 12 December. USCGC CONFIDENCE issued three reports of violation to the Polish stern trawler MARLIN for failure to properly guard channel 16 VHF/FM, failure to stop immediately to facilitate an authorized boarding, and failure to maneuver in a manner to facilitate an authorized boarding. All available means to signal MARLIN were used during the thirty minute pursuit by USCGC CONFIDENCE which resulted in MARLIN's turning in the direction of USCGC CONFIDENCE at close range prior to finally stopping to allow the boarding.
- d. 24 December. Air Station Kodiak issued a citation to the Soviet tanker ARAKS for failure to properly display its international radio call sign.
- e. 1 January. Air Station Kodiak issued a citation to the Japanese longliner TENYU MARU No. 37 for conducting fishing activities one day prior to the time submitted in its check-in message.
- f. 1 January. Air Station Kodiak issued a citation to the Japanese longliner EIKYU MARU No. 82 for conducting fishing activities one day prior to the time submitted in its check-in message.

- g. 12 February. USCGC BOUTWELL issued one violation to the South Korean stern trawler KYUNG YANG HO for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log by failing to log twenty-seven blocks (472.5 kg) of flounder.
- h. 8 March. USCGC BOUTWELL issued a citation to the South Korean stern trawler NAMBUG for failure to make proper notification of ceasing its fishing activities prior to completion and departure from the fishing area.
- i. 8 March. USCGC BOUTWELL issued a violation to the South Korean stern trawler HWA RANG HO for failure to make proper notification of the time and position of its departure from the fishing grounds.
- j. 15 March. USCGC RUSH issued a citation to the South Korean stern trawler No. 1 HAN SUNG for failure to properly maintain its daily cumulative catch log by logging its catch by total (gross weight) weight rather than round weight.
