





Aleutian Islands Golden King Crab

Work Session: October 23-24, 2019 in Anchorage

ACR 6 Close Aleutian Islands waters west of 174° W long to trawl vessels >100 feet using nonpelagic trawl gear.

ACR 7 Change the Aleutian Islands state-waters fishery registration requirement from nonexclusive to exclusive.

Alaska Board of Fisheries

Lower Cook Inlet Groundfish: December 10-13, 2020 in Seward

PROPOSAL 42 Clarify possession and landing requirements for the parallel Pacific cod fishery in the Cook Inlet Area (ADF&G).

Kodiak Groundfish: January 11-14, 2020 in Kodiak

PROPOSAL 49 Create a state-waters Kodiak Area commercial sablefish fishery.

PROPOSAL 52 Increase the percentage of Central Gulf of Alaska (CGOA) Pacific cod ABC used to establish the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod GHL from 12.5% to 17.5%.

PROPOSAL 53 Add unharvested Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod jig gear quota to the Kodiak Area state-waters Pacific cod pot gear GHL allocation the following calendar year.

Statewide King and Tanner: March 7-11, 2020 in Anchorage

PROPOSAL 261 Adopt a new Bering Sea Tanner crab harvest strategy.

PROPOSAL 262 Modify the Bering Sea C. opilio harvest strategy definition of "exploited legal males".

PROPOSAL 263 Allow retention of incidentally harvested Bering Sea District C. bairdi during directed a C. opilio season.

PROPOSAL 265 Update Bering Sea and Aleutian Islands crab registration regulations.

PROPOSAL 266 Change the season dates for the Registration Area O golden king crab fishery from July 15 – April 30 to March 1 – October 31.

PROPOSAL 268 Allow gear transfers to be authorized by electronic mail.

PROPOSAL 271 Specify marine safety requirements for fishing vessels carrying observers.PROPOSAL 273 Amend the season dates for king crab in the Northern Norton Sound Section.
